



Humbled to receive highest national award of Mauritius, dedicate it to 140 crore people of India: PM Modi

Port Louis: Spotlighting the special and unique partnership between India and Mauritius, Prime Minister Narendra Modi, who on Wednesday attended the country's National Day celebrations as the Chief Guest for the second time in last 10 years, said that he was "humbled" to receive the Highest National Award of Mauritius. "Humbled to receive the Highest National Award of Mauritius. I dedicate it to the 140-crore people of India and the centuries-old friendship between our nations," said PM Modi during his remarks at the event. PM Modi is the Chief Guest at Mauritius' National Day for the second time, an honour he first received in 2015. The rare repeat invitation underscores India's special relationship with Mauritius which remains rooted in shared history, culture, and diaspora ties. The government of Mauritius on Tuesday announced its decision to bestow the country's highest honour 'The Grand Commander of the Order of the Star and Key of the Indian Ocean' to Prime Minister Modi during his ongoing two-day State Visit to the Indian Ocean archipelago. Mauritius Prime Minister Navinchandra Ramgoolam made the announcement just before PM Modi began addressing an Indian community event in Port Louis on Tuesday evening. Prime Minister Modi is the first Indian to receive the honour. It is also the 21st international award bestowed upon PM Modi by a country. "It is very fitting for you, Prime Minister. Since we became a republic, only five foreign dignitaries have got that title and among them there is a



person who we call the 'Gandhi of Africa' - Nelson Mandela who received it in 1998. Let me tell you that we are greatly honoured to have you amongst us here today and that you managed to find time out of your very, very busy schedule," said Ramgoolam amidst huge applause. In December, Kuwait bestowed its highest honour 'The Order of Mubarak Al Kabeer' to PM Modi, in appreciation of his distinguished achievements and the efforts made to strengthen the relations between the two countries. The Order is awarded to Heads of State and foreign Sovereigns and to members of foreign royal families in sign of friendship. It has been previously awarded to foreign leaders like Bill Clinton, Prince Charles and George Bush besides other dignitaries like Queen Elizabeth and Prince Muhammad bin Salman. Before that, Prime Minister Modi was conferred with Guyana's highest civilian honour, 'The Order of Excellence', by the country's President Mohamed Irfaan Ali, for his visionary statesmanship, championing

the rights of developing countries on the global stage, exceptional service to the global community and for his commitment to strengthening India-Guyana relations. During the India-CARICOM Summit in Guyana, Dominica too had conferred its highest national honour, the 'Dominica Award of Honour,' on PM Modi in acknowledgement of his pivotal support during the Covid-19 pandemic and his commitment to fostering India-Dominica relations. Nigeria also conferred the national honour of Grand Commander of the Order of the Niger (GCON) on Prime Minister Modi during his first official visit to the country in November 2024. The Indian PM was the first foreign leader to be conferred with the award since 1969 when Queen Elizabeth received Nigeria's highest national honour. 'The Order of Mubarak Al Kabeer' takes the number of civilian honours received by PM Modi to a record 20, highlighting his leadership and India's growing stature on the global stage. Analysts reckon that it is also a reflection of India's strengthened diplomatic relationships and the country's expanding influence. Before Kuwait, Guyana, Dominica and Nigeria, PM Modi had been conferred highest civilian honours in Saudi Arabia (King Abdulaziz Sash, 2016), Afghanistan (State Order of Ghazi Amir Amanullah Khan, 2016), Palestine (Grand Collar of the State of Palestine Award, 2018), UAE (Order of Zayed Award, 2019), Russia (Order of St. Andrew the Apostle, 2019 - received by PM Modi in July 2024), Maldives (Order of the Distinguished Rule of Nishan

Izzuddin, 2019), Bahrain (King Hamad Order of the Renaissance, 2019), US (Legion of Merit by the US Armed Forces in 2020), Bhutan (Order of the Druk Gyalpo, 2021) Papua New Guinea (Ebaki Award, 2023), Fiji (Companion of the Order of Fiji, 2023), Papua New Guinea (Grand Companion of the Order of Logohu, 2023), Egypt (Order of Nile, 2023), France (Grand Cross of the Legion of Honour, 2023), Greece (Grand Cross of the Order of Honour, 2023). In addition to these highest civilian honours, PM Modi has received several prestigious awards from renowned global organisations. In 2018, he was awarded the Seoul Peace Prize by the Seoul Peace Prize Cultural Foundation, in recognition of his contributions to global harmony and world peace. In the same year, the United Nations honoured PM Modi with its highest environmental accolade, the Champions of The Earth Award, for his bold environmental leadership. In 2019, PM Modi received the first-ever Philip Kotler Presidential Award, which is annually awarded to leaders who demonstrate outstanding national leadership. The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation awarded PM Modi the Global Goalkeeper Award in 2019, in recognition of his efforts to transform India's Swachh Bharat Abhiyan into a mass movement for cleanliness. In 2021, PM Modi received the Global Energy and Environment Leadership Award from Cambridge Energy Research Associates (CERA), in recognition of his leadership on global energy and environmental sustainability.

The notices were delivered to Chevireddy at the YSRCP office in Ongole, instructing him to appear for questioning. The Erragondapalem police are conducting the inquiry into these violations as the election period heats up. As the political landscape evolves, this move underscores the scrutiny faced by candidates during election campaigns.

AP Assembly Budget Sessions: Question hour continues, members raise various issues

The Andhra Pradesh Assembly budget sessions commenced today, featuring robust discussions during the Question Hour as MLAs raised various issues to the government. Ministers fielded questions on pressing revenue concerns and measures being taken against land grabbing. Minister Anagani Satya Prasad addressed questions regarding land disputes, revealing that over 200,000 Reports of Grievance (RGs) have been filed related to land issues in the state. He committed to conducting comprehensive land surveys to ensure justice for landowners and praised the central government's recent decisions regarding land surveys. In addition to land issues, discussions also centred on housing for journalists. Minister Satya Prasad emphasised that Chief Minister

Chandrababu Naidu is keenly focused on this matter, following directions from the courts. MLAs Konathala Ramakrishna and Kalva Srinivas urged for housing plots to be allocated to journalists and public representatives, with a specific request for such plots to be made available in Amaravati. The issue of Thalassemia also garnered attention during the sessions. Vishakapatnam North BJP MLA Vishnu Kumar Raju advocated for financial support for Thalassemia patients. In response, Minister Satya Kumar assured that the government is prioritising assistance for Thalassemia victims, committing to improve financial pension facilities and stating that regular reviews of the situation are being conducted. These discussions reflect the government's commitment to addressing



key social issues, including land rights and healthcare support for those affected by Thalassemia, amidst ongoing scrutiny from the Assembly members.

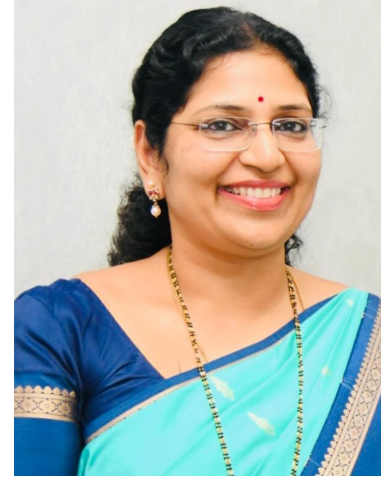

Complaint Filed Against Mohan Babu Over Alleged Role in Soundarya's Death

A complaint has been filed against Tollywood actor Mohan Babu, claiming that actress Soundarya's death in a plane crash was not accidental but linked to a property dispute involving him. The complaint, filed in Khammam district, Andhra Pradesh, accuses Mohan Babu of pressuring Soundarya and her brother to sell six acres of land in Shamshabad. When they refused, a conflict started, and after Soundarya's death, Mohan Babu allegedly took the land. No FIR has been filed yet, and it's unclear how the complainant is related to the actors. Soundarya, known for her role in Sooryavansham, died on April 17, 2004, in a plane crash while traveling to a political event. She was 31 and reportedly pregnant. Her body was never found. The complainant has asked for a fresh investigation into Mohan Babu's involvement and has requested the state government seize the land. He has also asked for police protection due to threats against him. The complaint also mentions a family dispute within the Manchu family, which escalated last year when Mohan Babu attacked a journalist.
