



Chandrababu holds teleconference with TDP leaders, says no discrimination in welfare schemes

In a recent teleconference with ministers, MLAs, MPs, and MLCs of the Telugu Desam Party (TDP), Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu addressed the ongoing efforts to fill nominated positions within the party. He expressed concern over delays in recommendations from certain leaders and emphasised the importance of identifying those who have diligently worked for these roles. Andhra Pradesh tourism packages Naidu stated, "We will appoint the right people in the right posts," and announced plans to appoint chairpersons for 21 major temples throughout the state. He noted that the party has received an impressive 60,000 applications for nominated posts, all of which are currently under close examination. He reassured party members that opportunities would be extended to remaining applicants after the two-year term concludes and highlighted that



performance evaluations of current appointees are underway. The Chief Minister urged TDP leaders to maintain dignity in their conduct and categorically instructed them to refrain from any contact with leaders of the ruling YSR Congress Party (YSRCP). He commented on ongoing campaigns suggesting that YSRCP supporters are being denied welfare schemes, asserting that "there is no discrimination in the implementa-

tion of welfare programmes." Naidu underscored that welfare initiatives should remain separate from political engagement and urged ministers to prevent group politics from developing within the party. Additionally, Naidu called for district in-charge ministers to increase their visitations to their respective districts, encouraging collaboration with leaders and activists from various allied parties to foster unity and progress.

Bara Shaheed Dargah will be developed as pilgrim center says Collector O Anand

Nellore : District Collector O Anand has said that Bara Shaheed Dargah will be developed as a pilgrim centre in South India. On Thursday, along with Nellore Rural MLA Kotamreddy Sridhar Reddy and State Waqf Board Chairman Sheikh Abdul Aziz, he laid foundation stone for the construction of entrance gates at north and south sides of Bara Shaheed Dargah with Rs 85 lakh. The Collector said that Nellore Urban Development Authority (NUDA) will construct the proposed constructions with municipal funds. The government is keen on developing the Dargah, based on its historical prominence and attracting lakhs of people of all faiths during 'Rottela Pandaga', he added. The Collector said that efforts are under progress to get Rs 5 crore sanctioned for the construction of Masque in the premises of Dargah, which was sanc-

The possibility of hydrogen-powered aircraft is also being explored, along with the development of sustainable aviation fuels (SAF). Airbus aims to operate aircraft with up to 100% SAF by 2030. Airlines like Qantas, United, Virgin, and Alaska Airlines have already conducted thousands of flights using biofuel blends. Promoting green energy in India is crucial for environmental protection, energy security, economic growth, and social development. Accelerating the transition to renewable energy will ensure a cleaner, healthier, and more sustainable future for generations to come.

Bandi Sanjay demands immediate release of water to save crops

Hyderabad: Union Minister of State for Home Affairs Bandi Sanjay Kumar demanded the State government immediately release water, with the delay resulting in standing crops in 10 lakh acres getting dry. On Thursday, he said that crops in the state are drying up due to the government's negligence. "Although paddy has been planted on 56 lakh acres and maize on 7 lakh acres statewide, the failure to release water to these crops in a timely manner has resulted in approximately 10 lakh acres already experiencing crop failure. This is



especially true for the standing crops in the tail-end areas completely drying up. Farmers who invest over Rs 30,000 per acre and work diligently to cultivate six acres faced devastating losses as

the government seems indifferent, which is an unforgivable dereliction of duty," he said. The Union Minister added that it is distressing that the agriculture department has not acknowledged the farmers' losses, even as crops dry up, are grazed by livestock, or burned. More than 20 lakh farmers are struggling to repay their debts, as the loan waiver has not been fully implemented, he alleged. He demanded the farmers' problems be discussed in the State Assembly and the government take immediate decisions to come to their rescue.

Collector inspects Panyam community health centre



Panyam (Nandyal district) : In line with the State government's emphasis on providing top-quality healthcare services, district Collector G Rajakumari has instructed medical officers to ensure that patients receive uninterrupted and effective medical care. On Thursday, she conducted a surprise inspection at Panyam Community Health Centre and reviewed staff performance, available facilities, and patient amenities. During the visit, she directed medical staff to implement shift-based duty rosters for doctors, ensuring that night shifts are covered as per the schedule. She inquired about the number of deliveries performed each month, differentiating between normal and caesarean cases. Expressing concern over the high number of caesarean deliveries, she questioned the medical officers about the reasons behind this trend. While checking the attendance register, the Collector found that only an anaesthetist was present though four doctors were supposed to be on duty at the centre. When questioned about the absence of the others, the staff informed her that one doctor had completed night shift while another was away for training. The Collector asked the District Coordinator of Hospital Services (DCHS) to explain why a doctor was sent for training when medical services at the hospital needed attention. Rajakumari also interacted with patients to assess the quality of healthcare services being provided at the hospital. Additionally, she reviewed online hospital records, pharmacy stock, delivery registers, laboratory records, and other essential documents. She instructed officials to ensure there is no shortage of medicines by placing timely procurement orders before stock runs out. Further, she emphasised the importance of registering pregnant women's details online. Some patients brought to the Collector's attention the lack of internal roads and proper lighting at the hospital. She assured them that these issues would be addressed soon. Later, Collector Rajakumari also visited Panyam RTC bus stand, where she reviewed passenger facilities and interacted with commuters to gather feedback on the available amenities. She was accompanied by Panyam Tahsildar Narendra Nath Reddy, MPDO, and other officials during the inspections.
