I thank the people of Prayagraj for making this event a global success," he said. The Prime Minister underscored the event's role in reinforcing nation-

al consciousness. "The Maha Kumbh has provided a strong response to the doubts and suspicions some may have about us. Last year, during the Pran Pratistha of the Ram Temple, we felt that India was preparing for the next thousand years. Now, exactly a year later, the Maha Kumbh has strengthened this

belief." Citing the Bhakti Movement and its role in shaping India's spiritual consciousness, PM Modi mentioned figures like Swami Vivekananda, Mahatma Gandhi, Bhagat Singh, and Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose, whose efforts contributed to the country's independence. "I see the Maha Kumbh as a continuation of this sentiment, a reflection of a country becoming more self-aware. For over one-and-a-half months, thousands of devotees, without concern for personal comfort, participated with unmatched enthusiasm. This is our strength." PM Modi also highlighted the global recognition of the event and shared that he carried the holy water of the Triveni Sangam to Mauritius during his recent diplomatic visit. sacred water." Acknowledging the role of the youth in the festival's success, he said, "India's youth are embracing our traditions with pride. The Maha Kumbh has strengthened the 'Amrit of unity' -- the most important takeaway from this event." He further elaborated on how the festival reinforces national unity. "When people from every corner of the country come together at the Maha Kumbh, it strengthens our national spirit. There was no distinction of big or small, proving that unity is deeply embedded in India. In a world filled with divisions, India stands as a shining example of unity in diversity," he said. PM Modi concluded by urging people to preserve and carry forward this spirit of unity. "It is our collective responsibility to sustain and nurture this feeling of oneness, which is our biggest strength."

Nara Lokesh announces plans to establish new universities in the state

Minister Nara Lokesh emphasized the Andhra Pradesh government's commitment to prioritizing education through the introduction of the AP Private Universities Establishment and Regularization Act Amendment Bill in the Legislative Assembly. Lokesh recalled that the initial Private Universities Act was enacted in 2016, with the intention of decentralizing development in the state. He highlighted the successful establishment of Centurion University in Visakhapatnam as a key milestone. The minister explained that the newly proposed amendment aims to facilitate significant institutional changes within private universities. Moreover, he announced plans to attract foreign university campuses to Andhra Pradesh, underscoring that 70 acres have already been allocated in Amaravati for the prestigious BITS Pilani institution. The government is also in discussions with companies like Tata to establish a Deep Tech University in the state.



Additionally, Lokesh revealed that an AI and Sports University is set to be developed in Visakhapatnam. He assured that strategic measures are being implemented to ensure that leading universities from across the country can establish campuses in Andhra Pradesh, further reinforcing the state's educational framework.

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A Blessing

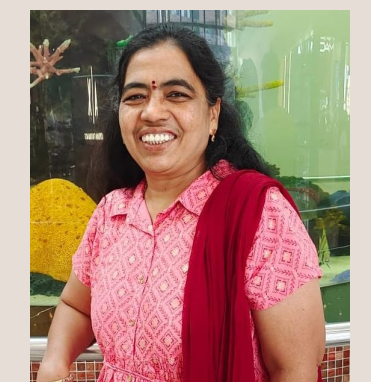
In the stillness of the night,

Jamie Lever talks about being typecast in the industry: 'Mimicked the same person every year'

Mumbai: Johnny Lever's daughter Jamie Lever has spoken out about being typecast in the industry, revealing how she spent years playing similar roles, particularly in television.

In an exclusive interview with IANS, she shared her desire to break free from this pattern and explore new characters, highlighting how social media has allowed her to experiment and showcase a different, more sensitive side of herself in her upcoming film.

Jamie shared, "Yes, absolutely. It's something that happens often in this industry. When I did my first film, I played a woman's role, and after that, I was offered four more roles of a similar nature. People tend to stick to what's tried and tested, which is



safe, and they often don't want to take risks. Once a director sees that a certain character works, they tend to cast you in similar roles."

NZ thrash Pakistan by 5 wickets to take 2-0 series lead

Dunedin: New Zealand continued their dominant run in the T20I series against Pakistan, sealing a comfortable 5-wicket win in the second match at University Oval to take a 2-0 lead in the five-game series. In a rain-shortened 15-overs-a-side contest, Pakistan, after being put into bat, managed to post 135/9, courtesy of a 28-ball 46 from captain Salman Ali Agha, including four boundaries and three sixes. Shadab Khan (26) and Shaheen Shah Afridi (22 not out) were the other significant run-getters for the touring side. For the hosts, Ben Sears, Ish Sodhi, Jacob Duffy and James Neesham bagged two wickets apiece. In reply, opening duo Tim Seifert (45) and Finn Allen (38) provided a brisk 66-run first-wicket stand as New Zealand chased down the target in 13.1 overs, losing five wickets in the process. For Pakistan, Haris Rauf claimed two wickets for 20 in three overs. After stand-in skipper Michael Bracewell opted to bowl first, Duffy struck in the first over, forcing opener Hasan Nawaz. Ben Sears soon followed up with another crucial breakthrough, dismissing an aggressive Mohammad Haris for 11. When captain Agha attempted to counterattack, playing some enterprising



strokes to rebuild the innings, Sodhi dented Pakistan's progress as the spinner first dismissed Irfan Khan and then trapped Khushdil Shah LBW just two balls later. Agha's 28-ball 46 briefly threatened to give Pakistan a competitive total, but his dismissal in the tenth over to Sears left the visitors struggling. Late cameos from Shadab (26 off 14 balls) and Afridi (22 off 14 balls) helped Pakistan to post 135/9. Chasing 136, New Zealand openers wasted no time shifting gears as Allen kickstarted the chase with three huge sixes off Mohammad Ali in the second over. Seifert joined the onslaught in the third over, taking Afridi apart with four sixes between

extra cover and deep square leg. By the end of the third over, New Zealand had smashed seven sixes. Seifert's knock of 45 from 22 balls ended in the fifth over when he mis-cued a slower delivery from Mohammad Ali to mid-on. Allen continued his aggression, smashing Jahandad Khan for back-to-back sixes in the seventh over before falling LBW on the next ball. His 38 off 16 ensured the Black Caps were firmly in control at 88/2 in seven overs, needing just 48 more from as many deliveries. Then, Mark Chapman fell cheaply to Khushdil Shah in the next over with Rauf, picking up crucial scalps of Daryl Mitchell and Neesham in quick succession. However, Mitchell Hay's unbeaten 21 off 16 balls, along with Bracewell's boundary, sealed the win for New Zealand.
