



AP Home Minister Anitha announces plans to fill police jobs

In a recent assembly session, Home Minister Anitha Vangalapudi addressed questions raised by Member of Legislative Assembly (MLA) Konatala Ramakrishna regarding the number of vacant constable positions in the state. The Home Minister confirmed that a total of 16,862 constable posts are currently unfilled, with recruitment for 6,100 positions already in progress.

"Proposals have been sent to both the government and the Director General of Police (DGP) for the recruitment of the remaining 10,762 vacancies," Vangalapudi stated. She emphasized the government's commitment to expediting the recruitment process as soon as the necessary permissions are granted. In addition to addressing staffing shortages, Vangalapudi outlined new welfare measures for police personnel. She announced that arrangements would be made to provide financial sup-



port ranging from 10 to 15 lakhs in the event of an accidental death of an officer. The session also saw inquiries from other members, including Kuna Ravikumar, Dhulipalla Narendra, and Gorantla Butchaiah Chowdhury, regarding the status of centrally sponsored schemes in the state. Finance Minister Payyavula Keshav disclosed that there are currently 94 such schemes, with 24 being halted by the central

government. He criticized the previous administration for neglecting these initiatives and assured that the current government is taking steps to effectively implement and revitalize central schemes. The discussions during this assembly session highlight the government's ongoing efforts to tackle police staffing shortages, enhance welfare measures, and revamp centrally sponsored initiatives.

AP Assembly Budget Session: Members to discuss on SC classification report

The Andhra Pradesh Assembly Budget Session is set to commence at 9 AM on Thursday, coinciding with the Legislative Council's meetings beginning at 10 AM. Both Houses will engage in interactive Question and Answer sessions, tackling a range of pressing issues. In the Legislative Council, discussions will focus on important topics including ayacut stabilization, modernization of the Thotapalli project, the replacement of police constables, promotions of Sub-Inspectors to Deputy Superintendents of Police, and centrally sponsored schemes. Following this, Minister Dola Bala Veeranjanya Swamy will present the report from the one-member commission on Scheduled Caste classification, which will be followed by a brief discussion. A resolution regarding SC classification is expected to be passed in the Legislative Council later today. related to fishing harbors in the state, the establishment of mini Gokulas, modernization of hospitals, and the promotion of new industries. In the evening, a cultural program will be held for Members of the Legislative Assembly (MLAs) and Members of the Legislative Council (MLCs) at A Convention in Vijayawada. The event will feature Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu, Legislative Council Chairman Moshen Raju, Speaker Ayyanna Patrudu, and Deputy Speaker Raghurama Krishnam Raju among the chief guests. During the program, CM Naidu and Speaker Ayyanna will also honor the winners of various sports and cultural competitions.

Congress Leader N.D. Vijaya Jyoti urges for development of Rayalaseema

In a statement issued today, N.D. Vijaya Jyoti, the District Congress Party President, emphasized the need for the Chief Minister to prioritize the comprehensive development of the Rayalaseema region. She reiterated her demand for immediate attention to critical sectors including drinking water, irrigation, education, health, employment, agriculture, and orchard cultivation. Vijaya Jyoti made a strong case for declaring Rayalaseema as the seed capital and urged the establishment of a High Court bench in Kurnool. She also proposed transforming the region into an automobile hub by attracting major automotive companies, such as Kia and Isuzu, which would significantly bolster local employment and economic growth. Highlighting the industrial potential of Rayalaseema, Mrs. Vijaya Jyoti called for the development of an industrial cluster that links the Chennai-Bangalore industrial corridor with the major cities in the region. She reiterated the promise of 'Mission Rayalaseema' outlined in the 2024 election manifesto and urged the government to take immediate steps to fulfill the aspirations of the people, aiming to transform Rayalaseema into a developed and prosperous region.

The event, marking the conclusion of the sporting festivities, will commence at 4:30 PM and is expected to draw significant attendance, including Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan, who will also be present. During the ceremony, CM Chandrababu will award prizes to the winners of various competitions held throughout the meet. A diverse range of cultural programs featuring artists displaying their works is scheduled for the evening, providing entertainment for the legislators and guests. Additionally, it is anticipated that the Chief Minister will actively participate in some sports activities during the event. YSRCP protests removal of YSR's name from Vizag cricket stadium

Visakhapatnam : YSR Congress Party (YSRCP) leaders and workers staged a protest here on Thursday against the removal of former Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Y.S. Rajasekhara Reddy's name from the Visakhapatnam Cricket Stadium. A large number of YSRCP leaders and workers led by former minister Gudivada Amarnath staged the protest at the stadium in Madhurwada. Holding party flags and raising slogans, they condemned the action of the TDP-led NDA government in removing the name of Y. S. Rajasekhara Reddy (YSR) from the stadium. They warned that the party would intensify its protest if the name of YSR was not restored. A controversy erupted after YSR's name was found missing



from the stadium renovated for Indian Premier League (IPL) matches. The stadium is usually called Dr Y. S. Rajasekhara Reddy ACA VDCA Stadium. However, following renovation, YSR was missing from the arch and main stadium building. Police stepped up security at the

stadium in view of the protest by the YSRCP. Some party leaders were allegedly placed under house arrest ahead of the protest. The stadium is scheduled to host two IPL matches on March 24 and 30. YSR was the Chief Minister of

undivided Andhra Pradesh between 2004 and 2009. The senior Congress leader died in a helicopter crash in 2009. YSR's son Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy is the President of the YSR Congress Party and he served as the Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh between 2019 and 2024. YSRCP leader Amarnath alleged that the coalition government was systematically erasing the legacy of YSR. He asked why YSR's name instils fear in the ruling alliance and whether renaming institutions will erase his contributions. He demanded the government and the Andhra Cricket Association (ACA) reverse the renaming of the Visakhapatnam VDCA Cricket Stadium, previously named after YSR.

Amarnath accused the government of prioritising the elimination of the YSRCP and YSR brands over election promises, citing the demolition of YSR's statues at Nagarjuna University and Vemuru (Bapatla), and the removal of his name from the Health University, the Visakhapatnam stadium, Sitakonda's YSR viewpoint, YSR district, Rythu Bharosa Kendras, and Tadigadapa Municipality. He stressed that while YSR's name can be removed from structures, his legacy endures in people's hearts. Amarnath highlighted YSR's reforms in education and health-care, his support for the poor, and his leadership in undivided Andhra Pradesh.

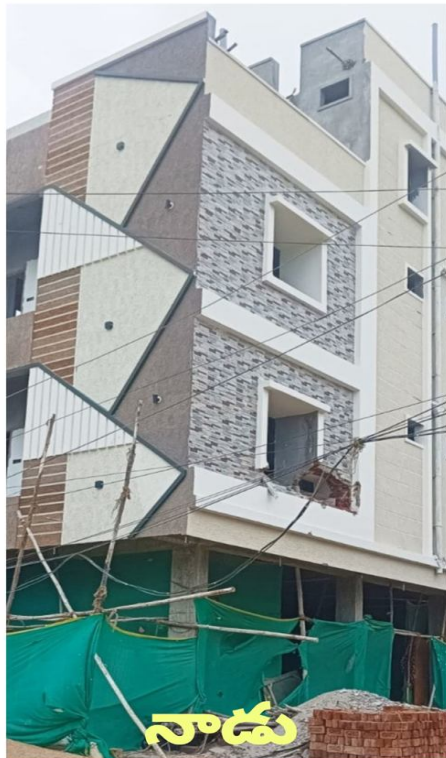

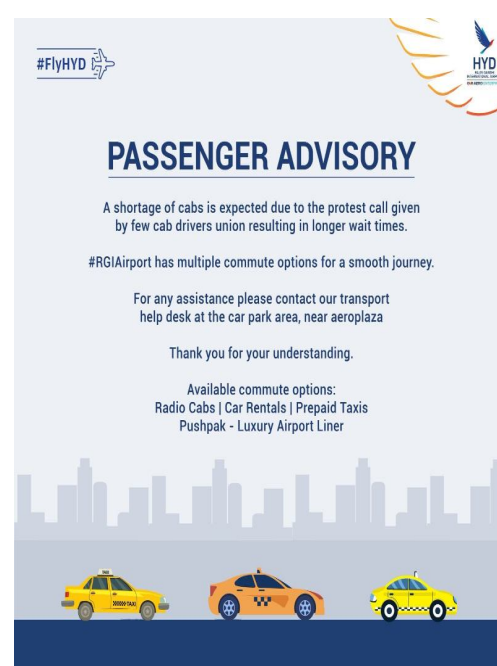

TGPWU Expands Boycott of Airport Trips -- 57,000 Cab Drivers Join Campaign Against Unfair Fares

The Telangana Gig and Platform Workers Union (TGPWU), under the leadership of Shaik Salaudin, Founder President, has intensified its boycott of airport trips facilitated by Ola, Uber, and Rapido. This campaign is a direct response to the unfairly low fares imposed by aggregator companies, which have severely impacted the livelihoods of cab drivers, especially those operating at Rajiv Gandhi International Airport (RGIA), Hyderabad.As of today, 57,000 Cab drivers have joined the campaign, making this a historic protest for fair pay and just treatment.Despite multiple representations to the Government of Telangana, Hon ble CM Revanth Reddy, the Transport Department, aggregator companies, and GMR Airport authorities, no meaningful action has been taken. TGPWU demands immediate intervention to implement a uniform fare structure that guarantees fair pay and economic security for gig and platform workers.Shaik Salaudin, Founder President of TGPWU, stated Our members have repeatedly voiced concerns about unfair fare structures.



These low fares not only reduce driver earnings but also fail to acknowledge their time and efforts. government, transport department, and airport authorities to regulate and standardize pricing policies for aggregator companies.

Accountability from Ola, Uber, and Rapido to ensure fair compensation for drivers.

• Awareness campaign to educate passengers on the financial struggles faced by gig and platform workers.

In the budget introduced by the Congress government in Telangana state yesterday, the funds allocated to the education sector are not enough for the education sector at the CM Revant Reddy AISF state president Kasireddy Manikantha Reddy demanded that the budget be amended immediately and allocated more funds for education.

Today, AISF Medchal Malkajgiri district committee under the auspices of the AISF Medchal Malkajgiri district committee, demanding that at least 15% of the funds be allocated in the election manifesto to protest the allocation of less funds for



education in the budget introduced by the state government yesterday. Were protesting with placards. Speaking on the occasion, Manikantha Reddy said that the government had introduced a budget of Rs 3,04,965 lakh crore yesterday and only Rs 23,108 crore has been allocated to education, only 7.5% of the funds have been allocated to education, only 0.2% for the last budget. The Congress has promised to allocate 15% of the funds for education in the

Congress manifesto, but it is inappropriate to allocate the funds in the second budgetary allocation, and that there is no development of higher education in the budget speech. It is said that the establishment of residential schools is ambitious and Rs 11,000 crore has been allocated and the existing public schools, KGBV and Gurukulas model schools, minority schools and junior degree colleges are not raised and welfare hostels are inappropriate for students to raise a mess

charges and not funding the construction of new buildings for students in rented buildings, and the fee reimbursement and scholarship dues are pending 8000 crores. In the public rule, the Congress has said that there is no mention in the budget, saying that it has been given electric scooters to students, and that the announcement of an international school for the zone is not even in the budget. Since the Ministry of Education is at the Revant Reddy, the Congress has also allocated funds to dismantle the education department, and the Congress government will immediately revise the funds allocated to education in the budget. Six Tollywood actors booked for promoting betting apps

In a new twist to the alleged promotion of betting apps by celebrities, Cyberabad Police have registered a case against Tollywood actors Rana Daggubati, Vijaya Devarakonda, Prakash Raj, Manchu Lakshmi, Nidhi Agarwal and others. A case against six actors and 19 social media influencers has been registered at Miyapur Police Station of Cyberabad Commissionerate. The First Information Report (FIR) has been registered under sections 318 (4), 112 r/w 49 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 3, 3 (A) and 4 of Telangana Gaming Act and 66D of Information Technology Act 2008. Telangana travel guides The police registered a case on a complaint by one Phanindra Sharma, a resident of Miyapur, who stated that he found several celebrities and social media influencers actively promoting illegal betting apps, websites and other platforms. The complainant said the



promotion of betting apps was causing harm to individuals and society by encouraging this addictive short-term risky money-making behaviour leading to financial distress.
