All communities need to contribute for peaceful Manipur, says Union Minister

Imphal: Union Minister of State for Law and Justice Arjun Ram Meghwal on Sunday urged people of all communities to contribute sincerely and unitedly for a peaceful and prosperous Manipur. The state has been devastated by the Meitei-Kuki-Zo community ethnic violence for over 22 months. Addressing a function here to mark the 12th-anniversary of the Manipur High Court, the Union Law Minister said that the peace process is going on in Manipur and it should be speeded up further. "With the early restoration of peace and normalcy in Manipur, the state would further progress and play a significant role in the Viksit Bharat," Meghwal said. "Not only myself, everyone is hopeful that peace and normalcy will be restored soon in Manipur," Meghwal said, urging people of all communities to contribute their sincere and united role for a prosperous Manipur. Highly appreciating the Manipur High Court's performance and achievement in various projects, the Union Minister said the Union government earlier sanctioned Rs 7,210 crore for various court-related projects including e-court. He said, "Remarkable achievement was done by the Manipur High Court in virtual hearing of cases and implementations of e-court projects. Over 90 per cent of works have been completed in the Manipur High Court." He suggested that various Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) schemes of different Corporate organisations must be implemented in the court and judiciary sectors. "Representatives of four pillars of democracy --



Legislature, Executive, Judiciary and the Media -- along with students, youths, and common people are present in the High Court function. This is very unique," the Union Minister pointed out. He said that it is a very good gesture that five Supreme Court judges at a time visit Manipur. Supreme Court judge, Justice B. R. Gavai led a five-member team of apex court judges, visiting the violence-hit state since Saturday. Justice Gavai accompanied by fellow apex

court judges, Vikram Nath, M.M. Sundresh, K.V. Vishwanathan, and N. Kotiswar Singh and the Manipur High Court's Chief Justice D.Krishnakumar and Justice Golmei Gaiphulshilu, on Saturday also virtually inaugurated legal services camps, medical camps and legal aid clinics in various districts of the state from the Mini Secretariat in the tribal-inhabited Churachandpur district. While visiting Churachandpur and Bishnupur districts on Saturday, the apex court judges met displaced men, women and children sheltering in the relief camps in the two districts. Manipur Governor Ajay Kumar Bhalla, Supreme Court judges, and Manipur High Court Chief Justice were also addressed in the High Court event. The High Courts of Manipur, Tripura, and Meghalaya were established on March 23, 2013, following the North-Eastern Areas (Reorganisation) and Other Related Laws (Amendment) Act, 2012, which provided for separate High Courts for these states.

Haleem fever grips Karimnagar



Karimnagar : Once a delicacy confined to Hyderabad, Haleem has now become a Ramadan staple across Karimnagar district, with numerous food stalls and restaurants setting up Haleem counters ahead of the holy month of Ramzan. Arrangements are made for the preparation of this dish before the beginning of the month of Ramadan. This tasty special dish is prepared from the first day of the month of Ramadan. Adding dry fruits to it is very good for the body. Mutton and dry fruits are rich in antioxidants. Apart from that, the use of wheat improves the functioning of the digestive system. The spices used for its preparation are high in potassium. It reduces high blood pressure and kidney-related problems. Nutritionists say that it is a good food for those suffering from diabetes. Generally, Haleem is a delicacy in all parts of Karimnagar district. This dish stands as a mine of nutrients. The month of Ramadan is a holy month for Muslims, during the month of Ramadan, Muslims continue their fast for 30 days. In this context, the dish that Muslims like the most after the end of the fast is Haleem, Haris, which instantly gives energy to the body. Due to its fiber content, it is digested slowly. Therefore, the filling that is felt during the party is created. Manager of the Arabian Kitchen, Azeem said that they have been making and selling Haleem in Karimnagar town for several years. "For about the last one and a half years, customers have been supporting them. Not only the Muslim minority, are people from all walks of life interested in eating the dish," he said. The ingredients used in its preparation are very beneficial for health. "Moreover, it is a strong food that provides quick energy to the body that is getting tired during fasting. Wheat, gram, gram and gram are ground and turned into rava and used in the preparation of this dish," said Azeem. Along with these, naturally available spices like cloves, cardamom, dried shajera, biryani leaves, ginger, garlic, coriander powder, onions, coriander and mint along with a mixture of chili, salt, turmeric, ghee and oil are added to fresh chicken or natan and cooked well to prepare this special dish. "It is cooked for hours on a specially prepared batti, i.e. on a charcoal stove, until the fumes dissipate," Azeem said.

Salman Khan's 'Sikandar' Trailer to Release on March 22 or 23



The much-anticipated trailer of Salman Khan's upcoming action film Sikandar's set to drop soon, ahead of its theatrical release later this month. The film, directed by AR Murugadoss, follows the actor's tradition of releasing films on Eid and is expected to generate massive buzz among fans and moviegoers. Director AR Murugadoss has confirmed in an interview with Pinkvilla that the Sikandar trailer will premiere on either March 22 or March 23. Alongside this announcement, the filmmaker revealed that international advance bookings have already commenced, while advance ticket sales in India will begin soon. Providing insights into the film's runtime, Murugadoss shared that the first half of Sikandar lasts approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes, while the second half runs for about 1 hour and 5 minutes. The total duration stands at 2 hours and 20 minutes. The film's premiere shows will take place on March 29, a day before its nationwide release. The director emphasized that the trailer aims to appeal to first-day, first-show audiences while also highlighting the film's broader appeal beyond action sequences. He described Sikandar as a complete entertainer with strong emotional depth, designed to engage a diverse audience, including Salman Khan's fanbase, mass viewers, and family audiences. On March 19, the official release date for Sikandar was confirmed as March 30. The announcement was accompanied by a new film poster. Coinciding with the festival of Eid, the release aligns with Gudi Padwa and Ugadi, marking the New Year celebrations in Maharashtra and South India. The trailer launch will also mark the announcement of advance ticket bookings in India. This move is expected to drive significant pre-release ticket sales, given the immense anticipation surrounding the film. Filmed across Mumbai and Hyderabad, Sikandar sees Salman Khan reuniting with producer Sajid Nadiadwala, their first collaboration since the 2014 hit Kick.
