



Calcutta HC asks CBI to clarify 'rape or gang-rape', seeks diary

Kolkata: A single-judge bench of the Calcutta High Court has directed the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) to clarify to the court whether the woman doctor of the state-run R.G. Kar Medical College & Hospital in Kolkata, was a victim of "rape" or "gang-rape", and also to submit the case diary. As the matter came up for hearing at the bench of Justice Tirthankar Ghosh on Monday, the judge observed that with one individual (civic volunteer Sanjay Roy) being already convicted and sentenced for the crime of rape and murder, the central agency must clarify whether one or more were involved in the crime. "The CBI should clarify to the court whether this was a case of 'rape' or 'gang-rape'," Justice Ghosh observed. He also directed the CBI to submit the case diary in the matter to the court by the



next date of hearing in the matter. On Monday, the state government counsel and Trinamool Congress Lok Sabha member Kalyan Banerjee said that further investigation could be carried out after the trial process in the matter has been completed at a

special court in Kolkata. The CBI counsel, Rajdeep Majumdar sought some more time for the investigating officials to complete the process of follow-up investigation. After a special court has already convicted Sanjay Roy in the crime of rape

and murder, the next part of the investigation is about the angle of evidence tampering and altering during the initial phase of the investigation by Kolkata Police. The counsel for the victim's parents, Sudipto Moitra argued that the next stage of investigation in the matter should be court-monitored. He also demanded that the next stage of investigation should be carried out by a special investigation team of CBI headed by an officer in the rank of additional superintendent. Senior advocate Kaushik Gupta, who has been appointed by Legal Aid Services on behalf of Sanjay Roy, made an appeal to the court that the individual who had been convicted and sentenced in the case should also be heard by the court. However, that prayer was turned down and Justice Ghosh observed if any order is passed which might

adversely affect the convict, his counsel will be given an opportunity for a hearing. To recall, with the Supreme Court, last week, permitting a parallel hearing in the matter at Calcutta High Court, the counsels of the victim's parents approached Justice Ghosh's bench with a fresh petition. The matter was admitted by Justice Ghosh and accordingly, Monday was fixed as the first day of the fresh hearing in the matter. Earlier, when the victim's parents approached Justice Ghosh's bench, the latter was not agreeable to hear the matter since it was already being heard at the apex court. However, after the apex court's approval parallel hearings can happen both at the apex court and the high court, besides the one already continuing at a special court in Kolkata.

After forming the BRS party, the first public meeting, 'Simhagarjana', was held by KCR on May 17, 2001, at SRR Grounds in Karimnagar, breathing life into the Telangana movement. When YS Rajasekhara Reddy was the Chief Minister and the then PCC president mocked, 'Where is Telangana?' KCR resigned in response, and Karimnagar showed its strength by electing him with a margin of two lakh votes. Also Read - Economic anarchy prevailed during 10-yr BRS rule: Bhatti Rao said that Karimnagar's soil does not tolerate injustice, discrimination, or irregularities; it always stands up to them. For the past 15 months, BRS has been making the ruling party sweat and showing how an opposition should function. "When times are bad, even earthworms act like cobras, and village lions roar like cinematic heroes—we have no choice but to witness it. BJP and Congress are two sides of the same coin; both are enemies of Telangana's interests," said Rao. Kunal Kamra should apologise, action to be taken as per law: CM Devendra Fadnavis

Mumbai: Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis on Monday said stand-up comedian Kunal Kamra should apologise for referring to Deputy Chief Minister Eknath Shinde as a "traitor" in his show. "Everyone has a right to perform stand-up comedy, but freedom should not be unrestrained behaviour. Kamra should immediately apologise for his remark. Action will be taken against him as per law," the CM said. The Mumbai Police have lodged an FIR against Kamra over his jibe at Dy CM Shinde. "After the registration of FIR, the Mumbai Police have launched are tracing comedian Kunal Kamra," said the Minister of State for Home (urban) and Shiv Sena leader, Yogesh Kadam. Shiv Sena Minister Pratap Sarnaik,



who visited the Khar police station, said, "Shiv Sainiks will not tolerate and spare anyone if our leader is insulted or mocked. I am not justifying the vandalism but ultimately I am also Shiv Sainik first and all this happened because of the insulting remarks." BJP legislator Ram Kadam claimed that "Kamra's remarks on Dy CM Shinde are an insult to

Maharashtra. Kamra is speaking on behalf of the Thackeray group. The comedian chose to make his remarks to divert the attention from the controversy over the Disha Salian case especially after the Thackeray family's name has been linked to it." Shiv Sena MP Naresh Mhaske alleged that Kamra has accepted money from Thackeray

and is targeting the Dy CM Shinde. "Kamra is a contract comedian. But he should not have stepped on the tail of a snake. Once the fangs are out, there will be dire consequences...We will make sure you cannot move freely throughout the country. We are Shiv Sainiks of the late Balasaheb Thackeray. If we start following you, you will have to leave the country," he said. Further, MP Milind Deora in his post on X, said, "Mocking Eknath Shinde ji-a self-made leader who went from being an auto driver to leading India's second-largest state-reflects classist arrogance. India is rejecting entitled dynasts and their sycophantic ecosystem that falsely claims to stand for meritocracy and democracy."

Hyderabad's Local Authorities' Constituency Election for Telangana Set for April 23

The Election Commission of India has announced that a biennial election for the Telangana Legislative Council will be held on April 23, specifically for the Hyderabad Local Authorities' Constituency. This election is required as the term of BRS MLC MS Prabhakar is set to expire on May 1. The election notification will be issued on March 28, which will begin the process of submitting nominations. The deadline for submitting nominations is April 4, with the scrutiny of nominations taking place on April 7. Candidates will have until April 9 to withdraw their nominations. The voting will occur on April 23, from 8 am to 4 pm, and the counting of votes will take place on April 25. Furthermore, the Election Commission has declared that the model code of conduct is now in force, effective immediately.

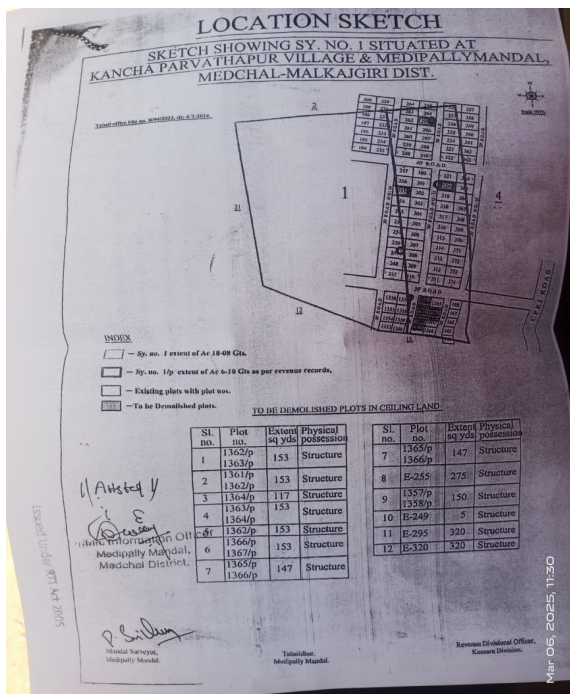

As part of the second day of his ongoing visits in the city, the Minister has inspected the condition of parks and schools at NTR Nagar, AC Nagar, Balaji Nagar, Mulapet areas in the city on Sunday. Narayana has said that the previous YSRCP government had collected Rs 5,000 for UGD connection from public. But the present government has decided to collect Rs 1 as nominal fee to give UGD connection, he said,



adding that the beneficiary has to bear the expenditure of pipelines and other materials required for the connection. Recalling that 90 per cent of UGD works were taken up with about Rs 1,100 crore of TIDCO funds in Nellore city during 2014, Narayana alleged that previous YSRCP government failed to complete the

remaining works only because of political reasons. He assured that the pending UGD works will be resumed very soon following Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu agreed to sanction funds for the purpose very soon. Stating that during TDP's regime in 2014 as many as 110 parks were developed across the State with all infrastructure facilities including central lighting system, the Minister said pending works of these parks and schools would be completed very soon. Nellore Municipal Commissioner M Surya Teja and others were present.

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There is no need to change the way we've played in last three years, says Parthiv Patel

Ahead of 2022 champions Gujarat Titans set to open their IPL 2025 campaign against Punjab Kings at the Narendra Modi Stadium, assistant coach Parthiv Patel said the side has done its preparations very well and are ready to take on anything that comes their way. "We've had a couple of camps before coming to Ahmedabad. We had a five-day camp twice in Surat. We've had great facilities there. So obviously, everyone worked really hard there. As you talked about batting, everyone has batted enough balls. There's been a lot of volume in terms of hitting the cricket ball and that's what all the players have done." "In Ahmedabad, we've got together. We started training from March 10 and played a couple of practice matches also. Obviously, we've been very conscious about not letting too many things out in social media. But I think we are very well prepared and we are ready to take on this IPL," said Parthiv to IANS in a select virtual interaction on Monday. PBKS, as compared to previous IPL editions, emerged as one of the strongest squads after last year's mega auction and Parthiv stated GT can stand up to the challenge posed by the Shreyas Iyer-led side by sticking to their well-laid plans. "I think we believe in keeping it simple, understanding the conditions, and situation, as that's what our goal will be. When the auction finished, Punjab Kings looked as another



strong side. They have change of leadership in Shreyas and Ricky Ponting. That pair also did really well when they were with DC. But I think our plans would be to making sure that we execute whatever we are thinking and what works for us," he said. After winning the title in 2022 and becoming runners-up in 2023, GT finished at seventh place in 2024. With the first week-end of IPL 2025 becoming a run-fest, barring the clash between Chennai Super Kings and Mumbai Indians, Parthiv stressed on how the batters will go their way as per the conditions on offer. "We've always believed in assessing and playing to the conditions, as that's how we want to play our cricket. It's something the way we have been playing and that's how Gujarat Titans is playing their

cricket since last three years. To be honest, it is a fair amount of success." "You have won one year, then a last ball defeat in the final. Yes, last year wasn't that great. But if you look at success ratio, it's pretty high. So I mean, that is working for Gujarat, and there is no need of changing the way we have played in last three years." "But having said that, I mean, yes, there have been 200, 250 and 280 runs being scored. But conditions are important. Like yesterday in Chennai, the conditions were not allowing anyone to score 150-200. It was a tight match for 150 also. So conditions and assessing the situation are important, and that's what we believe in doing." Though GT don't have the services of David Miller anymore, Parthiv feels the likes of

Sherfane Rutherford, Rahul Tewatia and Shahrukh Khan can cover up for his absence in the middle-order. "I don't see there's a problem. See, obviously, letting go of a player who has done really well is not easy. But the auction dynamic is such that sometimes you have to let go of someone. In this case, we had to let go of David Miller. But we have brought in Sherfane Rutherford, who is a very good hitter." "Then obviously, Rahul Tewatia and Shahrukh Khan, who's have done really well for GT. So obviously, when someone like David Miller is not there, you don't look at that. It's very difficult to fill those shoes. But we have players who can play that role and do the job for the team." Being the assistant coach at GT is Parthiv's first coaching role in the IPL. In his time as an IPL player, Parthiv mostly featured as an opener-keeper for six franchises from 2008 to 2019, and won the championship thrice: in 2010 with Chennai Super Kings and twice with Mumbai Indians in 2015 and 2017. After 2020, when his playing career ended, Parthiv had been an IPL commentator before taking up the assistant coach role with GT. "I think it is great to be back on the ground. I have done a bit of coaching with MI Emirates (in ILT20), and I've done my level two coaching course also. So obviously, there was always a desire to coach an IPL side and to coach any side. When this offer came in,

obviously, there was a lot of excitement." "The other thing was, since I've played for a lot of franchises and cities, but never represented my own state where I've played cricket for 15-20 years – that was Gujarat. So now, coming back to home team and getting this opportunity was (something I am) very grateful. Now I'm looking forward to the coaching role as well. So commentary is not going anywhere. I will still be commenting after the two months of IPL," he added. With this being his first brush of coaching in an IPL team, Parthiv signed off by explaining how he's managing to maintain the balance between data and instincts. "I am someone who actually likes looking at numbers, videos and make my own notes so that I can represent my thoughts with the player." "If someone's coming and asking me about what a certain bowler is doing, so I have my own notes ready. I do look at data, but it is very subjective. I don't force data on anyone. It depends on the player how they are thinking it. It is about accommodating players' needs." "But I have to, as a coach, make sure I'm ready with everything, and that's how I look at it. So every coach has a different way of working around it, and this is how I keep myself ready, as if a player needs it, I should be ready with my homework and notes."
