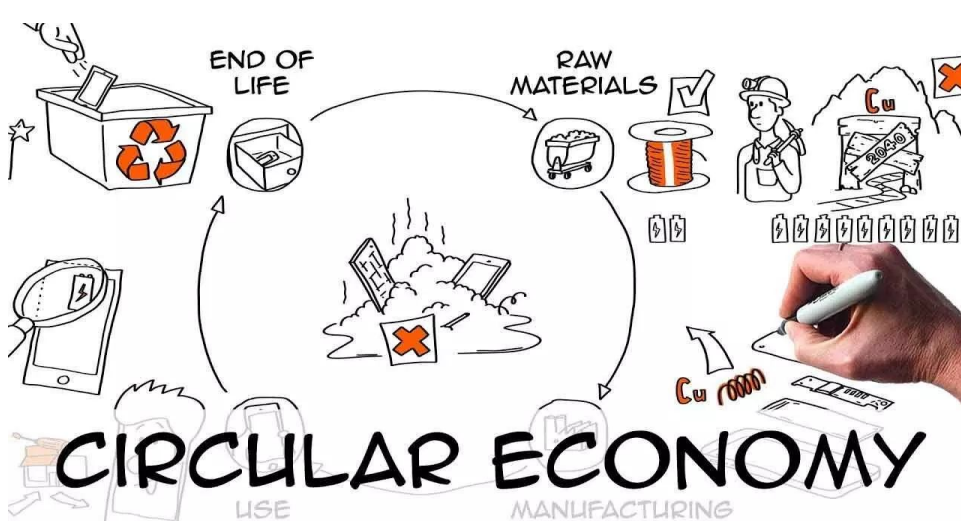




Circular economy key to sustainability

Industrial waste circularity can make a huge difference to the way we manage waste and reduce carbon emissions. By 2030, it can help reuse 750 million tonnes of industrial waste; conserve over 450 million tonnes of natural resources; and reduce 50-60 million tonne of carbon dioxide equivalent (CO₂e) lies in the range of 50-90 MT. Speaking at a National Dialogue based on the CSE report on the subject here today, CSE director general Sunita Narain said: "Industries contribute over 30 per cent of India's GDP, and are significant consumers of natural resources and generators of waste. They are also major sources of pollution and carbon emissions. Circularity has emerged as a critical focus area globally and nationally, emphasising on the principle that waste is not merely waste, but a valuable resource. This model promotes the sharing, leasing, reusing, repairing, refurbishing, and recycling of existing materials and products to extend their lifecycle." resources Narain went on to say: "A new approach is needed in management of industrial waste. We must avoid simply transferring toxins from one place to another. Instead, waste from one industry should become a resource for

tonne (MT) of various types of wastes in industries (steel slag, RDF, flyash, red mud, biomass, hazardous waste etc). Circularity can also help conserve more than 450 MT of natural resources like coal and gypsum, while the potential of reduction in carbon dioxide equivalent (CO₂e) lies in the range of 50-90 MT. Speaking at a National Dialogue based on the CSE report on the subject here today, CSE director general Sunita Narain said: "Industries contribute over 30 per cent of India's GDP, and are significant consumers of natural resources and generators of waste. They are also major sources of pollution and carbon emissions. Circularity has emerged as a critical focus area globally and nationally, emphasising on the principle that waste is not merely waste, but a valuable resource. This model promotes the sharing, leasing, reusing, repairing, refurbishing, and recycling of existing materials and products to extend their lifecycle." resources Narain went on to say: "A new approach is needed in management of industrial waste. We must avoid simply transferring toxins from one place to another. Instead, waste from one industry should become a resource for



another. Industrial activity should not contribute to pollution but instead follow a path of responsible circularity. CSE's work in this field highlights that it can be a game-changer, making a significant impact on resource use in the country." The Dialogue has been organised to explore how circularity can serve as a tool not only for effective waste management but also for achieving co-benefits such as decarbonisation, cleaner air, resource conservation, and cost optimisation. Presenting the findings of the CSE study, Shobhit Srivastava, programme manager, industrial pollution, CSE said: "Many Indian industries are already taking steps to improve

circularity – they have a number of good practices that need to be scaled up. States like Gujarat, Goa and Karnataka have taken initiatives towards circularity, but more states need to follow their example." Highlighting the circularity potential of industrial wastes, the CSE report says that out of 52.5 MT of steel slag estimated to be generated by 2030, about 35.3-41 MT can be used in cement making. Similarly, out of 437 MT of fly ash expected to be generated by 2030, roughly 208-231 MT can be used in the cement sector. Using refuse-derived fuel (RDF) in cement industries and co-firing biomass in thermal power plants can help reduce CO₂ emissions in

the range of 46.6 to 85.6 MT of CO₂e by 2030, says the report. Biomass co-firing in thermal power plants has the potential to be one of the key pathways for decarbonisation. Both RDF and biomass circularity in industries is expected to be improved with the recently introduced notification for Solid Waste Management Rules, 2024. Pointing to the challenges, K Murugesan from Odisha said: "One of the biggest roadblocks towards scaling up industrial circularity practices is the absence of attractive taxation policies for industries utilising waste." According to Satish Upadhyay, "we need a strong economic case to drive funding and make circularity viable. A 'push' strategy is ineffective for circularity – we need a 'pull' strategy. Demand must drive the market, ensuring maximum utilisation of resources to achieve full circularity." A national circular economy action plan is the need of the hour, and it should include sectoral action plans for industries. Incentivisation for industries is another pathway to enhance and encourage the practice of circularity of waste – government should come up with circularity-driven policies or industrial waste for different industries.

Govt's Sahkar taxi initiative to launch bike, cab, auto services to compete with Ola, Uber

New Delhi: The Union government has announced to launch new cooperative-based taxi service called "Sahkar Taxi" that will provide bike, cab, and auto services, to compete with popular ride-hailing platforms like Ola, Uber, and Rapido. The move is aimed at providing an alternative transport service where drivers can earn directly without sharing profits with large corporations. "Sahkar Taxi will register two-wheeler taxis, auto-rickshaws, and four-wheeler taxis across the country," Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation Amit Shah said, while announcing the initiative in Parliament. Shah said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi's 'Sahkar se Samridhi' is not just a slogan, the Ministry of Cooperation has worked day and night in the last three and a half years to realise it. Shah stated that the Sahkar taxi service will be rolled out "in the



coming months". Unlike private companies, this government-backed service will ensure that all earnings remain with the drivers, giving them greater financial benefits. "Profits from this service will not go to any big industrialist but will go solely to the drivers of the vehicles," the Union Cooperation Minister said. In addition, a cooperative insurance company will also be formed which will do the work of insurance in the cooperative system of the country, Shah

said. "In a short time, it will become the largest insurance company in the private sector," he noted. The new initiative aims to empower drivers while providing passengers with a reliable and cost-effective transport option. A similar model is already operating in West Bengal under the "Yatri Sathi" service, which was initially available in only Kolkata. It has now expanded to cities like Siliguri, Asansol, and Durgapur. Yatri Sathi offers quick bookings, local language support, affordable fares, and round-the-clock customer assistance, making it a popular option among passengers. In 2022, Kerala became the first to launch a government-owned online taxi service 'Kerala Savaari'. While it has been shut down due to low usage, the state government now plans to relaunch it with revised fares and improved software.

CM Chandrababu inspects polavaram project, learns displaced people's Concerns

Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu visited the construction site of the Polavaram project, examining progress from an aerial view before heading to the Polavaram viewpoint for a closer look. This visit, aimed at assessing the status of the vital infrastructure project, coincided with a meeting held with individuals displaced by the project. During the meeting, the displaced persons expressed their grievances, shedding light on the challenges they have faced over the years. They raised concerns regarding compensation issues, stating that those who were forced to leave their homes due to flooding were not adequately compensated, often categorized as non-residents. Furthermore, the displaced individuals reminded the Chief Minister of actions taken by the previous government, which included plans aimed at integrating them into Telangana. They urged the current administration to address their issues and work towards ensuring fair compensation and support for those affected by the Polavaram project. The meeting underscored the need for the government to actively engage with and resolve the difficulties experienced by the displaced population, as the Polavaram project continues to move forward.



Kaushik Reddy questions CM Revanth on law and order, demands action against MLA Gandhi

Hyderabad: BRS MLC Kaushik Reddy has criticised Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy for remaining silent on issues related to law and order in the state. 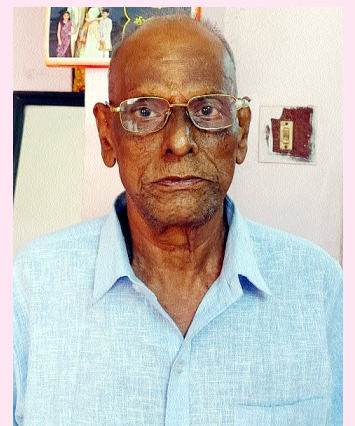

Urban Companys Insta Maids Rebranding does little to address worker exploitation

Hyderabad March:27 (Metro udayam)


Urban Companys decision to rename Insta Maidsto Insta Help is a clear indication of the power of collective worker voices and public pressure. However, changing the name does not alter the exploitative nature of the service itself. 1. Workers Deserve More Than Just a Name Change The core issue remains: the 15-minute service still commodifies workers, prioritizing speed over dignity, fair wages, and safe working conditions. True empowerment comes from ensuring labour rights, fair pay structures, and protections from arbitrary penalties—not just rebranding.

2. Gig Workers Need Consultation, Not Just Corporate Messaging Urban Company acknowledges the need to listen, reflect, and grow but has failed to engage with workers unions and labor organizations before launching such models. The platform has a history of sidestepping workers voices, as seen in its refusal to engage with workers and their unions in cases of ID blocking. If the company is sincere about change, it should openly discuss with TGPWU, IFAT, and other worker groups to co-develop policies that genuinely empower workers.

3. Demands for Immediate Action We demand that Urban Company halt the Insta Help service until workers on the platform have job security, reasonable work expectations, and protections from exploitative rating and commission systems. The company must commit to structured engagement with labor representatives to create meaningful reforms.Urban Company cannot simply shift the terms of the conversation through a rebranding effort. Telangana Gig and Platform Workers Union (TGPWU) and Indian Federation of App Based Transport Workers (IFAT) will continue to advocate for the rights of gig and platform workers to ensure that progress is not just about optics, but about real, impactful change.
