



BJP working to fulfil dream of Viksit Haryana, Viksit Bharat: PM Modi at Hisar rally

Hisar: Reiterating his party's commitment to fulfilling the dream of 'Viksit Haryana, Viksit Bharat', Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday said, "When the BJP assigned me the duties for Haryana, I, along with several of my party companions, worked here." "Their hard work has strengthened the BJP in Haryana, and I am proud that the BJP is extremely serious and working to fulfil the dream of 'Viksit Haryana, Viksit Bharat'," he said in his public address after launching the first commercial flight from Hisar to Ayodhya and laying the foundation stone of terminal-2 building at the Maharaja Agrasen Airport in Hisar that is expected to be completed within two years. The airport terminal will be built at an estimated cost of over Rs 410 crore and is part of PM Modi's vision to make air travel safer, more affordable, and accessible to all. Haryana Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini, along with several state ministers, attended the event. PM Modi said, "Before



2014, there were 74 airports in the country, but today there are over 150 airports...Imagine 74 airports in 70 years?... Every year, there are record airline passengers in the country. On one hand, our government is working on connectivity, and on the other, ensuring the welfare of the poor and social justice." A The inauguration of the Hisar airport marked a significant mile-

stone in the state's development. It will boost regional connectivity and catalyse economic growth across the state. Saying the Congress has only appeased fundamentalists, he said, "Haryana is that state where the youth in significant numbers join the army and serve the nation. The Congress for decades cheated regarding OROP." He said that lakhs of hectares of

land are in the name of Waqf. "Now, under the new Waqf law, this Waqf Board will not be able to touch any tribal's land or property in any corner of India. The new provisions will respect the sacred spirit of Waqf. The poor and Pasmanda families of the Muslim society, women, especially Muslim widows, and children will get their rights, and their rights will also be protected. This is real social justice." The Prime Minister said the Congress government in Karnataka took away the rights of SCs, STs, and OBCs and gave reservations based on religion. "But Babasaheb, Ambedkar clearly stated that religion-based reservation will not be facilitated. The Congress' politics of appeasement has not helped the Muslim community, it has only harmed them. Congress chose to appease a few radicalists only." The Congress, he said, stabbed the dream that Baba Saheb Ambedkar had seen -- the provision for social justice that he had

made in the Constitution -- and turned the provisions of that Constitution into a means of appeasement. PM Modi said the Congress turned the Constitution into a mere tool for gaining power. "Whenever they felt that power slipping from their hands, they trampled upon the Constitution, just as they did during the Emergency." "The spirit of the Constitution clearly says that there must be one common civil code for all citizens, which I call a secular civil code. But Congress never implemented it. In Uttarakhand, we have implemented a secular civil code, but the Congress continues to oppose it," PM Modi said. He said the Congress treated SCs, STs, and OBCs as second-class citizens in this country. "While Congress leaders enjoyed luxuries like swimming pools, only 16 out of every 100 households in villages had access to piped water, and among those affected, the most were SCs, STs, and OBCs," PM Modi added.

Pawan Kalyan's wife prays at Tirumala after son's recovery

Tirupati: Andhra Pradesh Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan's wife Anna Lezhneva on Monday offered prayers at the Sri Venkateswara temple at Tirumala to fulfill her vows following the safe recovery and return of their son Mark Shankar, who was injured in a fire accident in Singapore last week. She had earlier got her head tonsured at the Tirumala temple to fulfill a vow she had taken. Hyderabad nightlife Lezhneva, who reached Tirumala on Sunday, took part in Suprabhata Seva. She offered prayers and donated Rs 17 lakh for 'annadanam' (offering of food) at the temple in gratitude for her son's recovery. Seven-year-old Mark Shankar suffered minor injuries in the fire that broke out on April 8 during



summer camp of the school he was studying in. Following the incident, Pawan Kalyan, along with his family members, had rushed to Singapore the same day. The actor-politician, his wife Lezhneva, along with their son and daughter Polena, returned to Hyderabad on April 12. The next day, Lezhneva reached Tirumala. She signed a religious declaration form affirming her faith in Lord Venkateswara before offering her hair to the deity as a mark of gratitude. On Monday morning, she had darshan of the deity. According to Jana Sena, the party headed by Pawan Kalyan, she entered the temple through the Vaikuntha Queue Complex and participated in the Srivari Suprabhata Seva. After the darshan, Vedic scholars offered Veda Ashirvachana to her at the Ranganayakula Mandapam and presented Srivari Tirtha Prasadam. Later, Lezhneva offered aarti at the Akhilandam opposite the temple. She offered prayers to the Swami by breaking a coconut. After the dar-

shan, she donated Rs 17 lakh to the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanam authorities for annadanam in the name of her son. Pawan Kalyan's wife herself served food to the devotees. Lezhneva, a Russian citizen, is the third wife of Pawan Kalyan. Following their return from Singapore, Pawan Kalyan posted on X that his son is stable and recovering well. "Following the unfortunate fire incident at my son Mark Shankar's summer camp in Singapore, I have been overwhelmed by the outpouring of prayers, concern, and support from all over the world. I wholeheartedly thank leaders from various political parties, Jana Sena Party leaders, JanaSainiks, well-wishers, members of the film fraternity, friends, and supporters from across the globe for standing by our family during this difficult time. Mark Shankar is now stable and recovering well. Your heartfelt messages have truly given us strength," the Jana Sena leader wrote.

Kerala ADM suicide case: Family files plea in Supreme Court seeking CBI probe

Thiruvananthapuram: A month after a division bench of the Kerala High Court rejected the demand for a CBI probe into the death of Kannur Additional District Magistrate (ADM) Naveen Babu, who was found hanging at his official residence on October 15, his wife on Monday filed a petition in the Supreme Court with the same demand. In January a single bench of the High Court rejected her plea and in March the division bench also rejected her plea. On both the occasions, Manjusha, Babu's wife, expressed her sadness in her plea being rejected. On March 3, when the High Court division bench also rejected it, she had said she would file a plea in the apex court as the entire family was unhappy with the ongoing Kerala Police probe. The Pinarayi Vijayan-led state government, which had initially pledged support to Babu's family, opposed the demand for a CBI probe during court proceedings. Naveen Babu, a reputed and upright officer, was found dead a day after his official farewell from Kannur. The controversy began when P.P. Divya, Kannur District Panchayat President and a CPI(M) leader, attended Babu's farewell event uninvited and accused him of corruption. The family alleged that Divya's remarks were politically motivated and caused immense distress to Babu. Divya, who was later arrested and briefly jailed in connection with the case, resigned from her position amidst mounting criticism. On both occasions, Manjusha's petition for a CBI probe cited irregularities in the investigation. Her counsel argued that the inquest and post-mortem were conducted hastily, without the family's presence. Forceful ligature marks were found on Babu's neck, requiring scientific examination. Divya's strong political connections might hinder a fair investigation by the state police, he said. The Kerala government opposed the plea, asserting that the state police's ongoing investigation was impartial and based on evidence. The government's counsel argued that the demand for a CBI probe relied on assumptions without substantial proof. Divya's corruption allegations against Babu stemmed from a delay in issuing a No Objection Certificate (NOC) for a petrol pump application by T.V. Prasanth, an electrician at the Kannur Medical College. Notably, Prasanth was reportedly a colleague of Divya's husband, raising suspicions about personal motives behind the accusations. Amid the uproar following Babu's death, Divya went into hiding but was arrested on October 29 after her anticipatory bail plea was rejected. She was released on bail on November 8. Meanwhile, on March 29, the police probing the case against Divya filed their charge sheet naming her as the lone accused.

In sheer defiance of monotony.

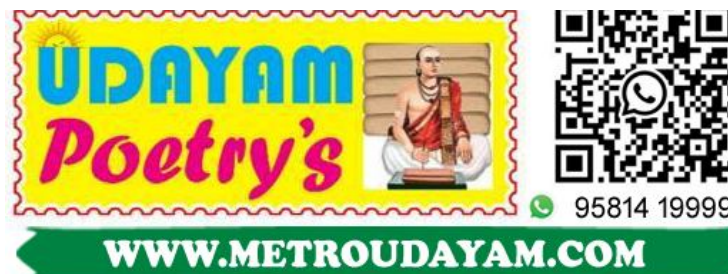
Nature is not still —

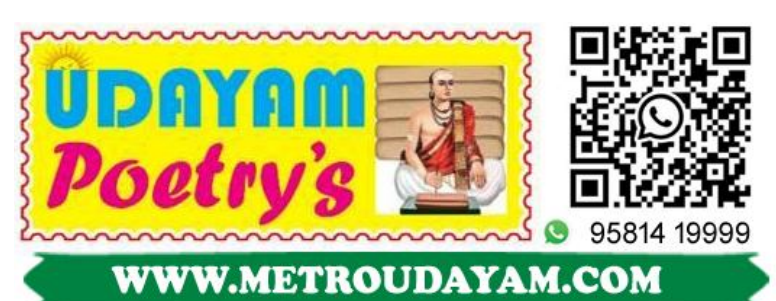
