



PM Modi meets Karnam Malleswari in Yamunanagar, commends Olympic medallist for mentoring young athletes

Prime Minister Narendra Modi met the Olympic medallist weightlifter Karnam Malleswari in Yamunanagar on Monday and also commended her efforts to mentor young athletes. PM Modi inaugurated and laid the foundation stone of various development projects in Yamuna Nagar, Haryana on Monday where he met the former weightlifter and shared a glimpse of the meeting on social media platform X. "Met Olympic medallist and noted athlete, Karnam Malleswari in Yamunanagar yesterday. India is proud of her success as a sports-woman. Equally commendable is her effort to mentor young athletes," PM Modi shared on X. Karnam is an Olympic medallist, a two-time



world champion and a two-time Asian Games silver medal winner. Having retired from the sport in 2004, the 49-year-old, along with her weightlifter husband Rajesh Tyagi, opened her first academy in Yamunanagar, Haryana in 2017. Karnam holds the distinguished honour of being the first woman from India to win a medal at the Olympics. Her

career's crowning achievement came at the Sydney 2000 Olympics. Lifting 110kg and 130kg in the 'snatch' and 'clean and jerk' categories respectively to total 240kg, Karnam Malleswari became the first Indian woman to win a prestigious Olympic bronze medal. Karnam placed third in the World Championships in 1993

and then followed up with consecutive 54kg world titles in 1994 and 1995, before bookending her run with another third-place effort in 1996. On two occasions, in 1994 and 1998, she narrowly missed on Asian Games gold medals, having to settle for silver instead. She was conferred with numerous prestigious awards by the Indian government, including the Arjuna Award (1994), Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna (1999) and the Padma Shri (1999). Besides her sporting achievements, the Olympic medallist also founded the Karnam Malleswari Foundation, a first-of-its-kind weightlifting and powerlifting academy in an effort to see her beloved sport flourish in India.

AP SSC results likely to be released in a week

The eagerly awaited results of the Class 10 public examinations in Andhra Pradesh are expected to be announced within a week. The examinations took place from March 17 to

Following the conclusion of the examinations, the evaluation of answer sheets commenced on April 3 and was completed on April 9. Currently, the process of entering marks online is in its final stages. If all goes according to plan, the education department hopes to release the results by April 22. In addition to the Class 10 examinations, the Universal Vidyapeeth Tenth Examination was conducted from April 3 to 7, while the Intermediate Examination took place from March 17 to March 28. The evaluation of answer sheets for these exams has also recently concluded, and results are anticipated shortly. In a move to facilitate easier access for students, the government has implemented a system allowing Intermediate students to check their results directly through official websites and the 'Mitra' WhatsApp app. Authorities are now working on similar arrangements for Class 10 students, ensuring they too can access their results via WhatsApp. The evaluation of answer sheets for the Class 10 examinations was conducted across 19 centres statewide and is expected to be fully completed by April 15. Once this process is finalised, the state education department will prepare for the official declaration of the results. Students and parents can look forward to the end of their anxious waiting period within the coming week.

AP Cabinet discusses on SC categorisation report



The Andhra Pradesh Cabinet, chaired by Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu, convened at the AP Secretariat to discuss approximately 24 agenda items. A significant focus of the meeting is the SC classification report from the National SC Commission. The state government has already approved the Rajiv Ranjan Mishra Commission report in the Legislative Assembly and forwarded it to the National SC Commission. Following the Commission's review, the report has returned to the state government, which is planning to issue an ordinance on SC classification, which will be deliberated upon by the cabinet. Additionally, the cabinet is set to approve decisions from the CRDA 46 authority, including the acceptance of tenders for the construction of permanent buildings for both the Assembly and the High Court. The meeting will also approve letters of acceptance for institutions that have successfully secured eleven bids.

Final stage of rescue operation underway at SLBC tunnel in Telangana

Hyderabad: The rescue operation at the Srisailem Left Bank Canal (SLBC) tunnel in Telangana has entered its final stage as efforts continue to locate the remaining six bodies of the eight workers who were trapped in the tunnel following a collapse last month. Authorities believe they are within 20 metres of the location where the remaining bodies may be found. Rescue teams have intensified soil removal operations in the D1 section of the tunnel based on expert guidance, raising hopes that the remaining victims can soon be recovered. Hyderabad sightseeing Telangana tourism The tragic incident occurred when a cement slab collapsed during maintenance work in the tunnel, resulting in the death of eight workers. Two bodies have already been retrieved – that of Gurpreet Singh, a Robbins machine operator, 16 days after the incident, and Manoj Kumar, an engineer, whose body was recovered on 25 March. Both were handed over to their families after post-mortem examinations. The search and rescue operation has been ongoing for the past 53 days, with teams carefully removing debris, including soil and parts of the TBM (Tunnel Boring Machine), using conveyor belts to ensure safety during the process. Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy expressed deep sorrow over the incident and announced a compensation of Rs. 25 lakh each to the families of the deceased. Telangana tourism Rescue personnel remain on high alert and are hopeful that the final phase of operations will soon bring closure to the families awaiting their loved ones.



State Board Schools in Telangana to Begin Summer Holidays from April 24

Students in the State are excited because their summer holidays are starting soon. Most schools that follow the State Board syllabus will begin their vacation on April 24. For Classes 1 to 7, their final exams (called Summative Assessment-II) will finish by Thursday. Class 8 and 9 students will finish their last exam, Social Studies, on April 17. That will be the end of the school year for them. All schools have been told to: Give out report cards Announce results Hold a parent-teacher meeting — all by April 23 After that, the summer vacation will start from April 24 and go on till June 11. Telangana tourism Schools will open again on June 12 for the new academic year 2025-26.



Minister Narayana inspects gravel sites in Ananthavaram village for Amaravati development

Andhra Pradesh Minister Narayana, alongside officials from the Capital Region Development Authority (CRDA) and the mining department, has conducted an inspection of the hills in search of gravel necessary for the ongoing construction of Amaravati, the state capital. During his visit, Minister Narayana commented on the delays faced in commencing capital works, attributing the setbacks to the management of the previous government. He revealed that it took eight months to resolve various legal issues, but progress is now being made with tenders for 68 projects worth ₹42,360 crore already completed and work having commenced. Hyderabad nightlife The mining department has allocated



851 acres to the CRDA for the extraction of gravel needed for the Amaravati development. Narayana pointed out that the Anantavaram hill had previous-

ly been earmarked for CRDA but faced significant excavation of up to eight metres under the previous administration. Looking ahead, the minister

noted that Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu envisions the establishment of an international airport within the capital, which will require a minimum of 5,000 acres, and potentially 30,000 acres if the land is acquired through pooling. The costs associated with land acquisition would be approximately two and a half times the registration price, with concerns raised that this method could adversely impact local farmers. Local MLAs have requested action to address these issues, although no final decisions have yet been made. Minister Narayana expressed confidence in completing the Amaravati construction within three years, with 92 works being undertaken at an overall estimated cost of ₹64,912 crore.

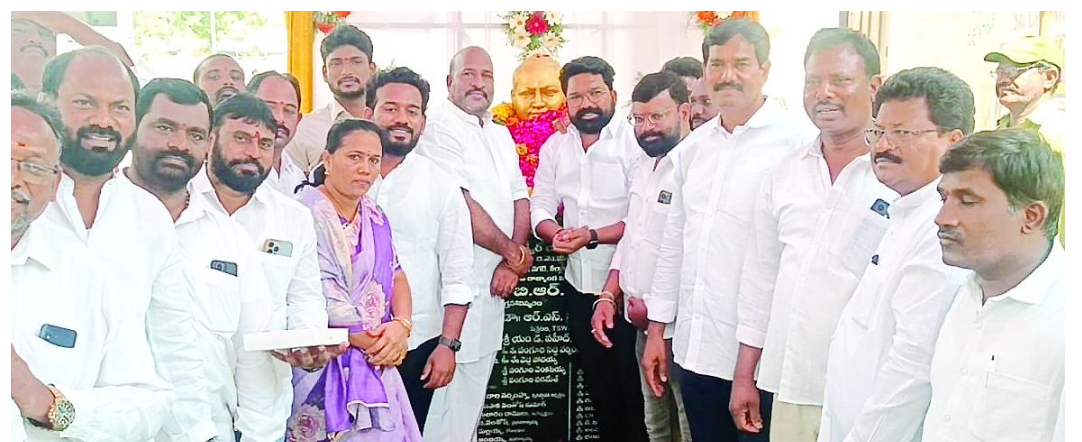

to be me.

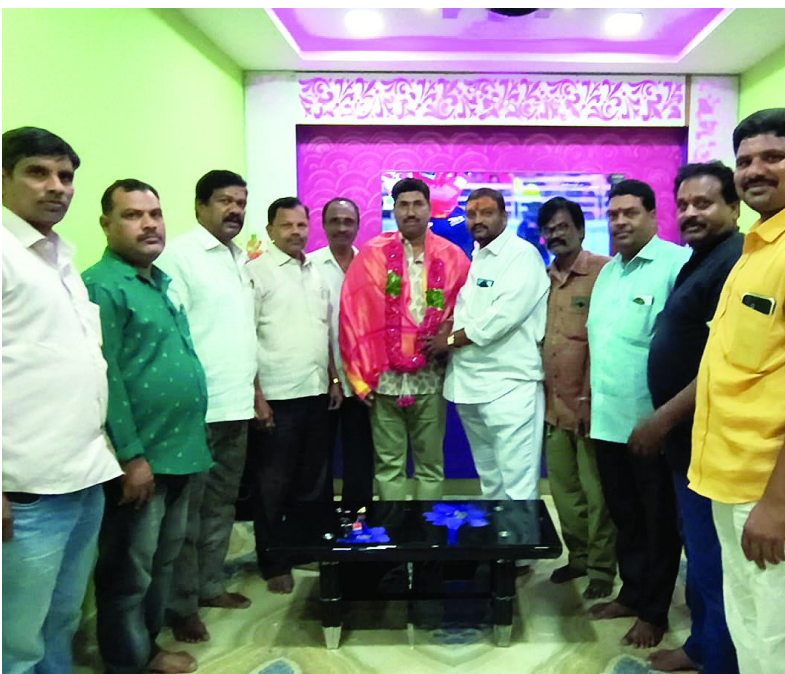
Let me fall.

CLP meeting concludes under CM Revanth's leadership; CM departs for Japan tour



Hyderabad: The Congress Legislature Party (CLP) meeting, led by Telangana Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy, came to a close just before his departure on an official visit to Japan. During the meeting, CM Revanth urged party MLAs to actively take government welfare schemes to the public. He laid out a plan for legislators to visit their constituencies from tomorrow until 2 June, aiming to strengthen their connection with the people. Hyderabad restaurants Telangana tourism He spoke about past initiatives such as rice at ₹22 per kg and said that the current fine rice scheme would leave a lasting impression. He also called for better accessibility of the 'Bhoomi Bharathi' land portal for farmers. Calling the Indiramma Housing Scheme a model for the country, Revanth said that caste-based enumeration had helped resolve a long-standing issue. He mentioned the introduction of a bill to provide 42% reservations for BCs and claimed a lasting solution had been found for the classification of SCs. Taking aim at Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Revanth said Telangana's development programmes had unsettled the PM. He added that the issue of categorisation had become a major challenge for Modi and noted that the Telangana model was drawing attention across India. Addressing the row over Kanchana Gachibowli lands, Revanth accused opponents of running a false campaign using artificial intelligence. He said both the BJP and BRS were spreading lies about the government. Telangana tourism In a strong message to Congress MLAs, CM Revanth warned them against speaking carelessly, reminding them that all their statements are being recorded. He criticised the lack of activity on social media, asking why negative campaigns against the government were going unchallenged. He also pointed out that several MLAs were staying in Hyderabad instead of visiting their constituencies. Revanth told them to avoid treating weekends as a time for political relaxation. He made it clear that ministerial positions would be decided by the party leadership and that the performance of each MLA was being closely watched.

"It's a Stupid Concept—If It Stops, the Industry Will Thrive": Nani on the 'Tier 1 Hero' Tag

Why Akshay Kumar requests audience to keep phones away during 'Kesari 2' special screening

Mumbai: Akshay Kumar made a heartfelt appeal to the audience during his film 'Kesari: Chapter 2' premiere in Delhi. Randeep Hooda Responds to Kangana Ranaut's Criticism of Alia Bhatt: 'Such Comments Don't Suit Her'

While promoting his upcoming film Jaat, actor Randeep Hooda addressed an old controversy involving Kangana Ranaut and Alia Bhatt, shedding light on his now-viral 2019 tweet that many believed was aimed at Kangana. Speaking to the media, Hooda described his professional relationship with Kangana as "cordial and communicative," despite having collaborated on multiple projects. However, he acknowledged that a rift surfaced following a tweet he posted in response to Ranaut calling Alia's performance in Gully Boy "mediocre." Back in 2019, Hooda had praised Alia's work and lauded her for not being affected by the views of what he referred to as



"very occasional actors and chronic victims." Reflecting on that tweet now, he confirmed it was indeed directed at Ranaut. "I've never had personal issues with Kangana," he said, "but I felt she was unnecessarily harsh on Alia." Hooda added that his protective stance stemmed from the bond he devel-

oped with Alia during their work on Highway. "There's a strong connection I've always felt with her and her character, Veera," he explained. "I don't know if she feels the same, but I sensed it, and that's why I spoke up." He emphasized that Kangana is a talented performer, but remarks like those about

Alia don't align with her stature. "Kangana is a very fine actor—such comments don't suit her," Hooda said, adding that he believes in uplifting others rather than tearing them down. Though he acknowledged that he too has experienced unfair treatment in the film industry, Hooda maintained that he prefers to deal with such situations with grace. "I don't believe in pulling someone else down to feel superior. That mindset just doesn't sit right with me," he stated. Hooda concluded by saying that the tweet was his way of pushing back when he felt things had gone too far, choosing to defend someone he respects rather than stay silent.

Aamir Khan Likely to Team Up with Vamshi Paidipally for a Pan-India Film

A new Pan-India film project might be in the works, as Bollywood superstar Aamir Khan is reportedly interested in a movie with Tollywood director Vamshi Paidipally.
