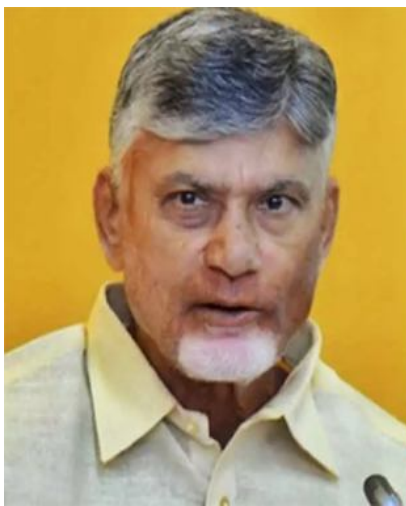
SSC results released



Hyderabad: Telangana Chief Minister along with officials of Telangana State Board of Secondary Education has officially declared the SSC Result 2025 on Wednesday. Around 92.78 percent candidate passed and The percentage of passes secured by Boys is 91.32% whereas Girls secured 94.26%. Girls secured 2.94% higher percentage of passes than Boys.Out of the 5,03,579 students who appeared for the exams in the regular category, 4,53,201 have passed, with the pass percentage at 90%.

CM Naidu orders probe over Simhachalam wall collapse incident

Visakhapatnam: In the wake of the tragic wall collapse incident at Simhachalam temple happened during the 'Nijarupa darshan' organised on Wednesday that claimed devotees' lives and left others injured, the Andhra Pradesh government initiated swift measures to provide relief for the families of the victims.Hyderabad nightlife Responding to the incident, Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu announced Rs.25 lakh ex-gratia for the deceased families each and Rs.3 lakh compensation for the injured who are undergoing treatment. The Chief Minister chaired a high-level teleconference



with senior officials and ministers to review the situation and devise immediate measures to reach out to the victims and their families. Anam

Devasthanam Chairman Ashok Gajapathi Raju were part of the meeting. Expressing grief over the incident, the Chief Minister reviewed the causes that led to the accident and assessed medical assistance being provided to the injured through discussions involving district officials. Also, Naidu ordered a probe into the incident by constituting a three-member committee. To support the affected families, the government also decided to offer employment opportunities under the outsourcing system in temples managed by the Endowments Department.

CCS meet at PM Modi's residence ends, big decisions likely to be announced soon

The Cabinet Committee on Security, which was chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Wednesday at his residence, has concluded, said sources, adding that a press briefing will be held at 3 p.m., where big decisions are likely to be announced. The crucial meeting was held to discuss the security scenario and the future course of action in the aftermath of the April 22 horrific terrorist attack in Pahalgam. The top decision-making body on national security was convened for the second time at the Prime Minister's residence within days. The CCS comprises Defence Minister Rajnath Singh, Home Minister Amit Shah, External Affairs Minister Subrahmanyam

Jaishankar, and Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman. The meeting was followed by sessions of the Cabinet Committee on Political Affairs (CCPA) and the Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA). The top ministers continue to be in a huddle at the PM's residence as the Cabinet meeting continues. The government is going to meet the media at 3 p.m. The Union Cabinet meeting is the first one since the barbaric terror attack in Jammu and Kashmir's Pahalgam that killed 26 people, most of them tourists. There was no meeting of the Union Cabinet last week, and only the CCS had met on April 23, condemning the terror attack. In the first CCS meet

chaired by PM Modi, India took a slew of measures against Pakistan. The country announced the suspension of the Indus Waters Treaty, the shutdown of the Attari border, the cancellation of visas of Pakistani nationals, the blockade of many of its YouTube channels and Xhandles, and downgrading the diplomatic ties with Pakistan by downsizing the already truncated staff in embassies, thereby forcing them back to their country of origin. The CCS is also likely to consider the military options available to New Delhi to avenge the terror strike. The April 23 CCS had reviewed the security situation and directed all Indian forces to maintain the highest level of vigilance. India



has resolved to ensure that the perpetrators of the Pahalgam attack are brought to justice and that their sponsors are held accountable.

Visakhapatnam: A pall of gloom descended on the Pilla's family as four of the family members died in the wall collapse incident occurred at Simhachalam Devasthanam in Visakhapatnam on Wednesday. Pilla Umamaheswara Rao (30) and his wife Pilla Shailaja (29) along with her mother P Venkataratnam and aunt G Mahalakshmi died in the incident when they were waiting for the Nijarupa darshan at the Rs.300 ticket queue line. The other family members belonging to Madhurawada were inconsolable as they lost four members of their family in the tragic incident. Both Umamaheswara Rao and Shailaja were software employees and opted for work from home. They got married three years back.
