



Jitendra Singh urges ANRF to help medical colleges boost clinical innovation

New Delhi: Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Science and Technology Dr. Jitendra Singh on Monday chaired a comprehensive review of the Department of Science and Technology (DST). He urged the newly constituted Anusandhan National Research Foundation (ANRF), to help medical colleges boost clinical innovation in the country. "Explore the possibility of helping medical colleges establish their own medical research parks -- a move that could boost clinical innovation and local biotech entrepreneurship," Singh asked the ANRF. The Minister reviewed ANRF's plan to create a "cloud of research and innovation infrastructure," a digital platform that would offer deep-tech startups and academic institutions access to underused sci-



entific equipment and facilities across the country. This move is expected to democratise research capabilities, especially for smaller players who often lack access to high-end lab tools. The Minister also called for bold new directions in science-driven growth, including AI-led innovations, focussing on ANRF's "AI-for-Science". The programme aims to leverage artificial intelligence to accelerate

discoveries in physics, chemistry, and biology by using machine learning to model complex scientific equations. Singh also revisited the concept of "deep science-to-deep tech acceleration," urging the ANRF to focus on converting academic research -- such as publications and patents -- into commercial technologies. He emphasised the need for partnerships with top-tier industry players and

the creation of venture-builder models to ensure that discoveries don't remain confined to laboratories. "Prioritise key areas of national relevance, including climate forecasting, material science, aerospace, biochemistry, and drug development," Singh asked the ANRF. "The time has come for India to move from isolated innovation to a more integrated, impact-driven ecosystem that links research, startups, and industry," he added. The Minister further underscored the importance of building an indigenous "India AI Open Stack" -- a foundational AI architecture embedded with science and engineering models tailored for Indian researchers. This, he noted, could position India as a global frontrunner in AI-driven scientific applications.

Telangana transport minister urges RTC employees not to go on strike



Telangana Transport Minister Ponnampalapati Prabhakar on Monday appealed to Telangana State Road Transport Corporation (TGSRTC) employees not to go on strike as this would inconvenience people. Leaders of TGSRTC employees' unions met the minister to bring their problems to his notice. Stating that the government was ready to address their issues, the minister urged the employees to withdraw their decision to go on strike from May 6. Ponnampalapati Prabhakar told the unions that he and Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy were always ready to hear their grievances. He stated that the government was giving priority to protection of the RTC, welfare of employees and amenities to passengers. The minister urged the unions not to go on strike as the RTC has just started recovering from its losses and problems were being addressed. Telangana tourism He also told the union leaders that the previous BRS government had neglected the RTC for 10 years. It neither purchased a single new bus nor provided a job. He alleged that the previous K.C. Rao-led government used the Employees Cooperative Credit Society (CCS) and Employee Fund (PF). Ponnampalapati Prabhakar stated that after the Congress government came to power, it paid Rs 400 crore towards the bonds issued to RTC employees and also paid Rs 1,039 crore to clear long-pending PF arrears and gave Rs 345 crore towards CCS arrears. The transport minister mentioned that 1,500 appointments were made on compassionate grounds while 3,038 new jobs were approved. Chief Minister Revanth Reddy had also made an appeal to TGSRTC employees last week not to go on strike. Stating that TGSRTC has just started earning profits, he told the employees that it is their organisation and they have the responsibility to protect it. The Joint Action Committee of TGSRTC employees last month announced that they will go on strike from the midnight of May 6. CM Revanth Reddy assured the employees that profits earned by the organisation would be kept in their hands and they should suggest how to spend the money. The Chief Minister told the employees that the state's financial position was not good and urged them to reconsider their decision and cooperate with the government.

Cash at judge's residence: SC 'in-house' panel submits probe report to CJI

New Delhi: The Supreme Court-appointed enquiry panel formed to probe into cash discovery allegations against Justice Yashwant Varma has submitted its report to the Chief Justice of India (CJI) Sanjiv Khanna. Then Delhi HC judge, Justice Varma is embroiled in a controversy surrounding the alleged discovery of a huge pile of burnt cash in the storeroom attached to his bungalow in Delhi after the fire brigade had gone there to douse a blaze on March 14. "The three-member Committee consisting of Mr Justice Sheel Nagu, Chief Justice of the High Court of Punjab and Haryana, Mr Justice G.S. Sandhawalia, Chief Justice of the High Court of Himachal Pradesh, and Ms Justice Anu Sivaraman, Judge of the High Court of Karnataka, constituted for conducting an inquiry into the alle-



gations against Mr Justice Yashwant Varma, a sitting Judge, has submitted its report dated 03.05.2025 to the Chief Justice of India on 04.05.2025," said a press released issued by the apex court on Monday. Justice Varma's transfer from Delhi High Court to Allahabad HC, amid an in-house probe, was cleared by the Union government on March 28. The CJI

Khanna-led Supreme Court Collegium had earlier recommended that the Centre repatriate Justice Varma to the Allahabad High Court. It had said that the proposal for the transfer of Justice Varma, who is the second senior-most judge in the Delhi High Court, to his parent High Court, i.e. the Allahabad High Court, where he will be the ninth in seniority, is "independent and separate from the in-house enquiry procedure". Justice Varma was taken off judicial work before being sent to the Allahabad HC. His shift to Uttar Pradesh came despite opposition from the bar associations in Lucknow and Allahabad. While Justice Varma has denied any wrongdoing, CJI Khanna constituted a 3-member committee in the last week of March to conduct an in-house inquiry.

Govt committed to making India a sporting superpower ahead of Olympics 2036: PM Modi

Showcasing the exploits of Bihar's 14-year-old wonder-boy Vaibhav Suryavanshi in IPL, Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Sunday said his government is committed to improving sports infrastructure to help the youth turn the country into a sporting superpower ahead of fulfilling the dream of hosting the Olympics in 2036. In a video address to launch the 'Khelo India Youth Games 2025', PM Modi said, "The government has increased the sports budget by three times over the past decade and allocated Rs 4,000 crore this year." Linking sportsman spirit with patriotism, the PM stressed the need to nurture a sporting culture in the country, saying, "The



more the sporting culture grows in the country, the more will be the growth in India's soft power." Highlighting his government's top priority to promote sports and improve infrastructure, he said sporting events are now organised round the year, and even the National Education Policy has recognised sports by making it a part of mainstream studies. "Be it university

games, youth games, winter games or para-games, the government is committed to exposing sportspersons to new forms of sports," PM Modi said. He also highlighted the push for improving facilities in Bihar and said a sports city being developed on the Patna-Gaya Highway, and the growing facilities in villages in the state are examples of the gains from NDA's "double engine" government. Reflecting on the economic aspect of sporting culture, PM Modi said, "The sports economy is not limited just to the stadium, but its impact goes beyond that as it creates hundreds of jobs and opens new avenues for employment." Sports also open avenues in fields like

sports entrepreneurship, physiotherapy, data analytics, sports technology, e-sports, sports media and event management, he said. Urging the 6,000 participants of the Games to benefit from the event and practise more by taking part in different events, PM Modi said, "I hope all the participants will leave the arena by becoming successful ambassadors of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat." In his video message, the PM also welcomed the players by speaking a few lines in Bhojpuri-Maithili and encouraged them to make the best use of their visit to Bihar by enjoying the state's traditional delicacies like litti chokha and makhana.

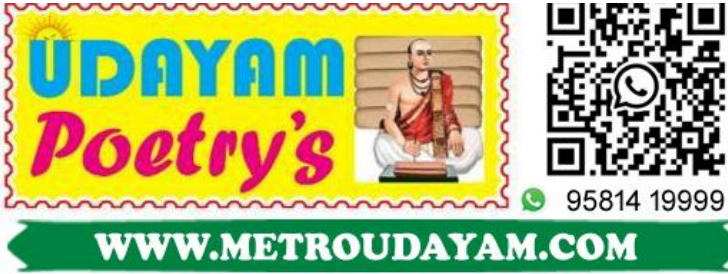
He said that for the protection of the environment this month, activi-

A guard of rights and liberty.

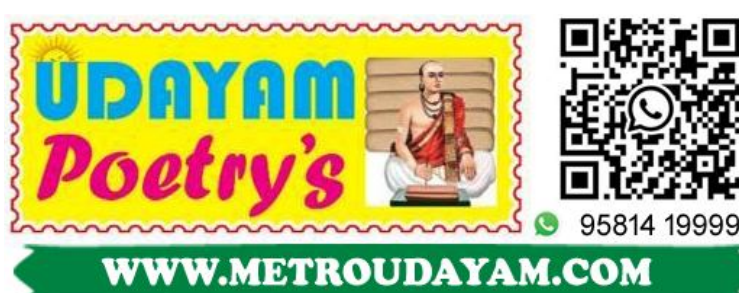
