



Three terrorists were killed in jammu

Srinagar: Three terrorists were killed on Tuesday in a gunfight with the joint forces in Keller area of Jammu and Kashmir's Shopian district. V. K. Birdi, IGP (Kashmir), told reporters that three terrorists have been killed. "Terrorists are yet to be identified, and a search operation is still going on there," he said. Joint forces had launched a Cordon and Search Operation (CASO) in the Shukroo Keller area of Shopian district after intelligence inputs said that a group of terrorists was hiding there. When challenged, the terrorists fired, after which an encounter started during which three terrorists were killed. The operation is continuing in the area, police said. As per sources, two to three terrorists were believed to be trapped in the area. The Indian Army, in a statement, said that based on specific intelligence about the presence of terrorists in Shoekal Keller, a search and destroy Operation was launched. During the operation, terrorists opened heavy fire, and



fierce firefight ensued, which resulted in the elimination of three hardcore terrorists, it added. "Operation is in progress," the Indian Army said. This is the second terrorist act in Jammu and Kashmir after the ceasefire understanding between Indian and Pakistan on May 11. On the same evening, suspected terrorists fired at and injured a guard at the gate of the Army's Nagrota Corps headquarters. One soldier was injured in the terrorist firing,

after which the terrorists escaped. Security forces continue to remain on alert across Jammu and Kashmir as the Pakistan Army had violated the ceasefire understanding on Saturday, even after the two countries announced cessation of all hostilities on land, air and sea. Police have advised hundreds of residents of border areas along the LoC and the IB not to hurry back home for now, till the situation is fully calm.

AP Chambers urges govt to repeal NALA Act

Vijayawada: Andhra Pradesh Chambers of Commerce and Industry Federation (AP Chambers) in a letter to Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu urged to repeal the AP Agricultural Land (Conversion for Non-Agricultural Purpose) Act 2006 also known as NALA Act immediately. The State government has announced in March 2025 that the Act will be abolished soon. In the letter, AP Chambers president Potluri Bhaskara Rao mentioned, "We thank the State government for announcing that the AP Agricultural Land (Conversion for Non-Agricultural Purpose) Act 2006 will be abolished soon. Since the announcement with regard to the repeal of this Act was made by the Chief Minister on March 27, 2025, entrepreneurs have been eagerly waiting for the abolishment of the Act."



He recalled that it has been a long-pending demand of the citizens and business enterprises to abolish the Act. On account of this Act, there was redundancy in the regulation process, causing unnecessary delays in the conversion of land from agricultural to other purposes. This has been a major hurdle in the Ease of Doing Business (EoDB) in the state. Abolishment of this Act will further simplify the EoDB. Because of the excellent industrial and other policies introduced by the State government, the economic activity has picked up and there is a lot of enthusiasm from entrepreneurs to set up industries in the state. The Real Estate sector has also picked up momentum. The elimination of NALA Act will help speed up the grounding of many investments, thereby boosting the economy of Andhra Pradesh. He said that the State government will earn more income with the grounding of innumerable projects across the State. He requested the State government to abolish this Act immediately and stated that it will be hugely beneficial to entrepreneurs looking to set up new business.

Qatar to Gift Boeing 747-8 to Trump: A \$400 Million Surprise

The Trump administration in the US is currently considering accepting a Boeing 747-8 plane as a gift from the Qatari royal family. Air Force One, which is used by the US president, has been in service for the past 40 years. It is understood that Trump will temporarily use the plane provided by Qatar. As we know, the US president uses Air Force One wherever he travels around the world. If Qatar accepts the gift, it will be the largest gift in history. The Boeing aircraft provided by Qatar is

expected to replace Air Force One. However, its cost is reportedly Rs. 3,300 crore. Two officials revealed that this gift, which Trump is set to receive, will allow him to use the plane not only during his presidency but also after it. The expensive plane that Trump will receive will come free of charge. However, Trump is looking to acquire it in a completely transparent manner. It is known that Democrats have come forward to fund the plane. However, it has been revealed

that the matter of this gift is still in the discussion stage at the White House, with efforts being made to ensure the transaction is legal. The Qatari Royal Family's decision to gift a \$400 million plane to the current US president has surprised many, both in the US and around the world. Some people are criticizing it. Trump currently owns his own Boeing 757 jet, Trump Force One, which he bought from Microsoft co-founder Paul Allen in 2011.



Political leaders laud PM Modi's clear message to Pak on terrorism, PoK

New Delhi: Prime Minister Narendra Modi's address to the nation on Monday drew widespread praise from BJP leaders and NDA allies, who said his speech sent a clear and firm message to both the global community and India's adversaries. The address, which came in the wake of 'Operation Sindoor' and the ceasefire understanding with Pakistan, underscored India's uncompromising stance on terrorism and reiterated that any dialogue with Pakistan would be restricted to issues concerning terrorism and Pakistan-occupied-Kashmir (PoK). In his remarks, PM Modi firmly stated that "Nuclear blackmail" will not deter India from taking resolute action against terrorism anywhere in the world. Outlining a three-pronged "new normal" in India's anti-terror doctrine, the Prime Minister said India is committed to tracking and eliminating terror threats globally, and that state-backed terror operatives will be treated at par with their masterminds. He stressed that India's responses will not be curbed by Nuclear threats and that the country reserves the right to act decisively against any terror attack. Leaders,



speaking to IANS, called PM Modi's address "highly commendable" which they said, shows India's response against terrorism will be decisive. BJP MP Praveen Khandelwal praised the address, and told IANS, "PM Modi clearly outlined India's priorities to the world. He made it clear what India's terms are, and if anyone attempts an invasion or a terrorist attack, India will respond decisively." He further added that 'Operation Sindoor' is not over but merely suspend-

ed, and any future provocation would invite a strong Indian response. Highlighting the effectiveness of indigenous weapons, Khandelwal noted, "The precision with which our indigenously made missiles hit their targets is a matter of pride for every Indian." Speaking to IANS, BJP National General Secretary Tarun Chugh said, "Prime Minister Narendra Modi's address is the united voice of 140 crore citizens of India. This is a new India that desires peace but will go to any extent to destroy terrorism." "PM Modi has given a clear message to the world. We will not tolerate Nuclear blackmail, there will be no talks with terrorists, and there will be no trade with terrorism (sponsoring nations). Blood and water will not flow together. If talks happen, they will only be about terrorism and PoK," he said. Maharashtra Minister Uday Samant also lauded the Prime Minister, urging all political parties to support national security matters without indulging in divisive politics. "Even when something good is done, Congress plays politics and tries to provoke citizens. This is not right, especially in matters related to national

defence," the Shiv Sena professed to IANS. He echoed the pride in India's indigenous Defence manufacturing, saying, "It's a matter of pride that weapons made under 'Make in India' have caused significant damage to the enemy." BJP leader Dilip Ghosh commented on the significance of PM Modi's address in clarifying India's position. "There were many comments and speculations after the temporary pause in the conflict. The Prime Minister's clear explanation has now removed all confusion," he said, adding, "Operations are ongoing, and India remains vigilant." Speaking to IANS, Shiv Sena leader Raju Waghmare called the Prime Minister's statement "highly commendable," and reiterated support for PM Modi's clarity on key issues. "The PM clearly said that apart from terrorism and PoK, there will be no talks with Pakistan. If Pakistan commits any act of terrorism, India will respond accordingly, even with military action if needed," Waghmare told IANS. He also emphasised that PoK remains an internal matter for India and no third party will be allowed to interfere.

Visakhapatnam.... A press meet was held for the ganja seizure at Anandapuram Police Station, North Sub-Division, Visakhapatnam City on 13.05.2025 on at 11:30 AM, based on reliable information received by S. Bhaskara Rao, CI of the Visakhapatnam City Task Force, regarding the illegal transportation of ganja, the SHO of Anandapuram Police Station was informed. SI G. Santosh of Anandapuram Police Station, along with his staff and the Task Force CI and his team, went to the vicinity of Pydah College, Boyapalem Junction with intermediaries to conduct vehicle checks. While they were checking vehicles, a bike with registration number OD 10 K 1279 and a Bolero vehicle with registration number AP 05 TA 7810 attempted to flee back upon seeing the police. In response, the CI and SI, with their team's assistance, apprehended the Bolero vehicle and a suspicious vehicle following it. Upon questioning the occupants of the Bolero vehicle, three individuals were found



in the Bolero, and one person was on the bike, totaling four individuals, and upon checking those vehicles, they discovered that... Approximately 40 brown color packets were found in 4 bundles. When questioned by the CI in the presence of mediators, four individuals decided to earn easy money in a short time and chose to engage in ganja business, collecting ganja from the hills in Jammuguda village, Paduva panchayat, Kolhapur district, Odisha, and selling it in Visakhapatnam. They were caught by the police near Pydah

College, Boyapalem Junction while transporting the ganja in the mentioned vehicles. The police arrested the four and confiscated ganja, a Bolero vehicle, a bike, and four cell phones, registering a case at Anandapuram Police Station under Cr.No.107/2025. In the previous notification, a full-fledged direct recruitment

Playoff Schedule: Qualifier 1 – May 29 Eliminator – May 30 Qualifier 2 – June 1 Final – June 3 Venue Changes: Though early reports suggested that Hyderabad, Bengaluru, and Chennai, the BCCI has excluded Hyderabad and Chennai from hosting the remaining matches. The matches will be held at Bengaluru, Jaipur, Delhi, Lucknow, Ahmedabad, and Mumbai. With this, Hyderabad will lose the league as well as the Qualifier 1 and Eliminator matches allotted in the original schedule.
