



17 killed in a huge fire near Hyderabad's Charminar

Hyderabad: Seventeen persons, including eight children, were killed in a huge fire that broke out in a building in the old city of Hyderabad on Sunday, police said. The incident occurred at Gulzar Houz near the historic Charminar. The dead include two children and four women. Director General of Police Jitender told media persons after visiting the accident site that 17 people were shifted to various hospitals. "Eight of those shifted to Yashoda Hospital have been declared dead by doctors. We are gathering information about others," he said. Minutes later, Telangana Fire Disaster Response Emergency and Civil Defence issued a statement listing 17 dead. They have been identified as Prahlad (70), Munni (70), Rajendar Modi (65), Sumitra (60), Hamey (7), Abhishek (31), Sheetal (35), Priyansh (4), Iraaj (2), Arushi (3), Rishabh (4), Pratham (1.5), Anuyan (3), Varsha (35), Pankaj (36), Rajini (32) and Iddu (4).



According to the statement, the Fire Services Department received the information at 6.16 a.m. that a fire broke out in the ground+2 building. A water tender from Moghalpura rushed to the scene. "Firefighting, Search and Rescue operations were carried out simultaneously, and 17 people, who were trapped on the first floor, were rescued by

and shifted to the hospital," it said. It said that due to the access constraints and to speed up the search and rescue operations, an assist call was given to other fire stations, and 12 appliances reached the fire ground and participated in the firefighting and rescue operations. A total of 11 vehicles, one Fire Fighting Robot, 17 Fire officers

and 70 personnel were involved in extinguishing the fire and rescuing trapped persons. It took two hours to extinguish the fire. The police chief said the fire broke out in a building which has shops on the ground floor and a house on the top floor. "As per preliminary source, the fire was caused by short circuit. People suffocated due to smoke," he said. The DGP said the firefighters doused the fire, but some smoke was billowing out. Earlier, Hyderabad in-charge minister Ponnamp Prabhakar told media after a visit to the spot that majority of the 17 people shifted to hospitals died. He said the Fire Services Department received information at 6.15 a.m. and within minutes, fire tenders reached the spot. "There was no negligence from any side. It was an accident," he said, adding that an inquiry will be conducted into the incident. Director General of Fire Service Y. Nagi Reddy, Commissioner of Hyderabad Disaster Response

and Asset Protection Agency (HYDRAA) A. V. Ranganath and other officials visited the spot. A pearl trader had his shop on the ground floor while his family and the families of some workers were residing on the first and second floors. Union Minister of State for Coal and Mines G. Kishan Reddy, who visited the spot, told media persons that there was some delay in providing relief by the Fire Services Department. Telangana Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy has expressed shock over the fire accident. Spoke to Minister Ponnamp Prabhakar about the fire incident on the phone and ordered to intensify rescue operations. He also enquired about the steps being taken for rescue and relief operations by the Police and Fire Service wings. CM Revanth Reddy expressed condolences to the victim's families on the phone and assured them of all assistance from the government.

Condolences to those who have lost their loved ones. May the injured recover soon. An ex-gratia of Rs. 2 lakh from PMNRF would be given to the next of kin of each deceased. The injured would be given Rs. 50,000:PM," read the post by the Prime Minister's Office. A huge fire broke out in a building at Gulzar Houz near Charminar. At least eight persons, including two children, were killed and many others injured. Union Minister for Coal and Mines G. Kishan Reddy, who visited the accident site, told media persons that he would speak to the Prime Minister and request him to announce financial assistance to the families of the victims. Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu has also expressed grief over the fire accident. "Deeply saddened by the loss of innocent lives in the tragic fire at Gulzar House, Hyderabad. My heartfelt condolences to the bereaved families. I pray for the swift recovery of the injured," CM Naidu posted on 'X'. Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) working president K. T. Rama Rao also expressed shock over the fire tragedy. "Extremely shocked and pained!! Details emerging out of Gulzar House fire tragedy in Old City are very sad. My heartfelt condolences to the families of the victims of the tragedy. Wishing a speedy recovery to those injured. Hoping and praying that this fire will be contained very soon BRS team will be available for anything that you may need," Rama Rao posted.

National President of the National BC Sangathan Samiti, Mettukadi Srinivasulu, questioned what social justice is there for BCs in the appointment of Telangana RTI Commissioners.

The Chief Commissioner of the newly appointed State Information Commission (RTI) by the Telangana state government has alleged that the appointment of Commissioners has not completely followed the rules and regulations. He said that it has been turned into a political rehabilitation center and that five people have been selected so far, of which two are from the Reddy community, one is a Muslim and the other does not know which community they belong to. He said that the Right to Information Act should be accompanied by complete transparency and accountability. He started by saying that after CM Revanth Reddy reached his limit, he put all of them aside. He said that he has been appointing people who he likes, those who have allegations, and those from the state of Andhra Pradesh to key posts. He said that the Reddy community, which has the smallest population in the corporation chairman, directors, and nominated posts, has been given priority. Among the newly appointed RTI commissioners, Chandrasekar Reddy has been appointed as the Chief Commissioner, and Ayodhya Reddy, PV Srinivasa Rao, Parveen, and Deshama Bhupal have been appointed as commissioners. He questioned how reasonable it was to announce them on the clouds of the Agha Megha and then have them take oath.

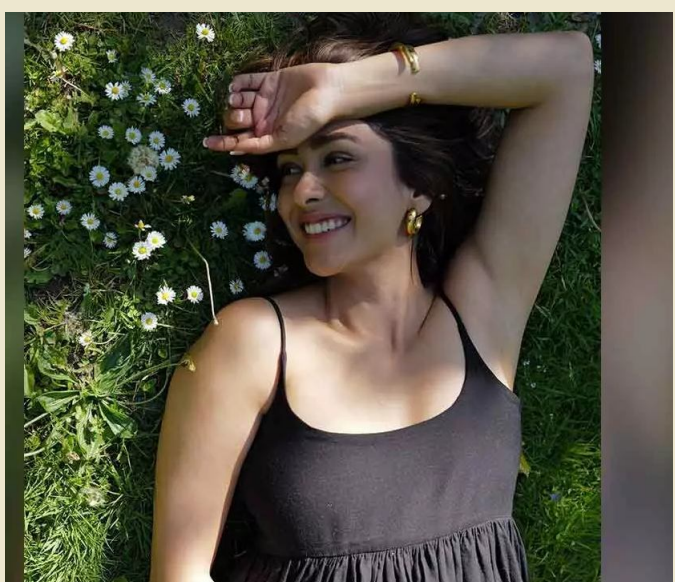
