



PM Modi to inaugurate Patna's new international airport terminal on May 29

Patna: The long-awaited new terminal of Jayaprakash Narayan International Airport in Patna is finally ready and set to be inaugurated by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on May 29. Built at Rs 1,400 crore, the state-of-the-art facility spans 65,155 square meters, several times the size of the existing terminal. The new terminal boasts 54 check-in counters, five aerobridges, eight X-ray baggage scanners, five baggage conveyor belts, multi-level car parking, a VIP lounge, cafeterias, and commercial spaces. Designed to accommodate 4,500 passengers daily, the terminal will increase annual capacity from 25 lakh to 1 crore. Daily flight operations are expected to rise from 34 to 75. The architectural design draws inspiration from Madhubani art and Nalanda University, with beautiful depictions of Chhath Puja, Lord Buddha, Mahavira, and Patna Sahib Gurudwara, giving the terminal a uniquely Bihari soul. BJP A striking 100-foot-tall tricolour now graces the airport premises, while a dedicated area pays tribute to Jayaprakash Narayan. On



the same day, PM Modi will also lay the foundation stone for the upcoming Bihta Airport, located 35 km from Patna. Designed for larger aircraft, the new airport will span 68,000 square meters over 116 acres, with the capacity to handle 3,000 passengers per hour and 50 lakh annually. Prime Minister will also launch and lay the foundation and inauguration for over 16 mega projects worth Rs 50,000 crore. The Prime Minister will lay the foundation of Nabinagar Thermal Power Plant, Aurangabad - Rs 29,947.91 crore. It will generate 1,500 MW, becoming NTPC's second-largest power plant in Bihar. He will also inaugurate the Patna-Gaya-Dobhi four-lane high-

way (Rs 5519 crore), NH-27 Gopalganj grade improvement (249 crore), Sasaram-Anugrah Narayan Road automatic rail signalling (Rs 43 crore), third railway line between Son Nagar-Muhamadganj (65 km) worth Rs 1,338 crore, hostel and staff quarters at JNV Jehanabad (Rs 8 crore). Also Read - Choose peace or perish: PM warns Pakistan over Terrorism This will be PM Modi's first visit to Bihar post "Operation Sindoor", and his fourth visit to the state in just five months. PM Modi will arrive at Patna airport at 5 PM. After the inauguration of the terminal building, a massive roadshow of approximately one hour is scheduled from Patna

Airport to the BJP State Headquarters via Sheikhpura Mor, Hartali Mor, and Income Tax roundabout. Later in the evening, the Prime Minister will interact with BJP workers, giving them "Mantra" ahead of the 2025 Bihar Assembly Elections. Deputy Chief Minister Samrat Choudhary, welcoming the visit, said: "The double-engine government led by PM Modi and Chief Minister Nitish Kumar guarantees fast-paced development and employment. His fourth visit in five months shows his trust in Bihar and in Nitish Kumar's leadership." Choudhary added that the Central government's support for Bihar's road and bridge infrastructure across 20 districts will help improve connectivity, generate employment, and facilitate access to education and healthcare in rural areas. Bihar Industry Minister Nitish Mishra said, "It is our great fortune that the Prime Minister is visiting Bihar. His presence is especially significant as it marks his first trip after Operation Sindoor. These projects reflect his unwavering commitment to the state's progress."

YS Jagan Criticizes TDP's Mahanadu Event, Calls It a Drama

As the TDP's Mahanadu event is being held in Kadapa, YSRCP chief and former Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister YS Jagan Mohan Reddy strongly



criticized the event. He called it a drama and questioned whether TDP leaders can go to any home in the state and show real work they have done. Jagan said that the promises, pamphlets, and bonds shared by TDP in the past are still in people's homes, and now people are asking what happened to the "Super Six" and "Super Seven" promises. He said TDP leader Chandrababu Naidu is only posing for photos at the event. Jagan mocked the party by calling TDP the "Telugu Drama Party." He added that holding a Mahanadu meeting in Kadapa does not show real leadership. According to him, real leadership means keeping promises and working for the people. Jagan accused Chandrababu of spoiling politics by trying to tempt, threaten, and scare elected leaders. He said this is harmful to democracy and called Chandrababu a bad influence on the system. He also said that even during the COVID-19 crisis, when the government had less money and more expenses, his team continued working for the public. He claimed that his government did not use problems as an excuse and continued to do good work. He said they fulfilled 99 percent of their promises and kept the election manifesto visible in all offices. According to him, these efforts led to a clean sweep in the local body elections.

Covid-19 cases resurface in Patna with 6 new infections confirmed in last 24 hours

Patna: With fresh concerns over Covid-19 resurgence, six new Coronavirus infections have been confirmed in Bihar's capital Patna, including among healthcare workers at AIIMS-Patna. The latest spike has prompted hospitals across the state to go on high alert, with precautionary measures being swiftly reinstated. Among the newly-infected are a female doctor, a female nurse, and another employee of AIIMS-Patna, all currently undergoing treatment under the supervision of senior doctors. Two additional patients at Nalanda Medical College Hospital (NMCH) have tested positive, while another case involves a 42-year-old man from the RPS Mod area, whose test was conducted at a private lab in Raja Bazar. According to Civil Surgeon Dr. Avinash Kumar Singh, the city now has a total of nine active Covid-19 cases. Of these, three have been hospitalised, while the remaining six are in home isolation. In response to the spike, hospitals have started to gear up for a possible rise in cases. At IGIMS, Superintendent Dr. Manish Mandal confirmed that 12 oxygen-supported beds and 3 ICU beds have been reserved exclusively for Covid-19 patients. A Quick Response Team of doctors has also been deployed for immediate attention and care. Similarly, NMCH is preparing to launch a new 100-bed prefabricated Covid-19 ward, as informed by Superintendent Dr. Prof. Rashmi Prasad, to ensure timely treatment if infections continue to rise. Speaking on the matter, Health Minister Mangal Pandey reassured the public, stating that the new sub-variants of Covid-19 reported in India are not fatal, as per WHO guidelines. "There is no need to panic. Testing and treatment systems are fully functional in state hospitals, and the Health Department is prepared to handle any emergency," he told reporters. The Health Department has issued an advisory urging people to immediately get tested if they experience symptoms such as cold, cough, fever, or body aches, and to wear masks, especially in crowded public areas. Districts outside Patna have also been put on alert, with medical institutions instructed to increase vigilance and ensure readiness. As Bihar enters a potentially critical phase in the ongoing Covid-19 fight, authorities are urging civic responsibility and adherence to health guidelines to curb any further spread.

WBSSC job case: Questions surface over Mamata Banerjee's announcement on fresh recruitment

Kolkata: After West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee said the notification of fresh recruitment for teaching and non-teaching jobs will be issued on May 30 and the "untainted" teachers, who lost jobs following a Supreme Court order last month, will have to appear for the written examination, questions and loopholes have started surfacing over her announcement. The fact that the Chief Minister's announcement about the fresh recruitment process and the state government's persuasion on the review petition in the Supreme Court order will go on simultaneously has led to concerns. The question that is surfacing on this count is whether the state government and West Bengal School Service Commission (WBSSC) have submitted the segregated lists of "untainted" and "tainted" candidates along with their respective review petitions. The opposition parties and the legal experts have said that since the inability of the state government and the



commission to furnish the segregated lists was the main reason for both the Calcutta High Court and the Supreme Court to cancel the entire panel of 25,753 jobs, any review petition without that segregated list is bound to pose questions on how serious is the state government to protect the jobs of the "untainted" teachers. The Leader of Opposition (LoP) in the West Bengal Assembly, Suvendu Adhikari, has already challenged the Chief Minister to publicly clarify whether the state government and WBSSC have submitted the segregated list along with the review petition. "The Chief Minister is highly optimistic

about the outcome of the review petition. So she should clarify whether she had submitted the segregated list along with the review petitions. Otherwise, it will be evident that the state is just conducting a time-killing exercise by projecting the review petition," Adhikari said. The second question that is arising over the Chief Minister's announcements and clarifications on Tuesday is that while she stressed mainly that part of the Supreme Court order that details the fresh recruitment, she virtually avoided that portion of the order which details the steps to be adopted by the government to ensure the termination of services of

the "tainted" ones and also recover the money they received as salaries. "How could the state government abide by one part of the apex court and ignore the other part? Instead, on Tuesday, the Chief Minister said she would try to protect even the jobs of those who were not included among the 'untainted' ones. Does not this hint at another corruption?" questioned senior advocate and the CPI(M) Rajya Sabha member Bikas Ranjan Bhattacharya. He also questioned the legal sanctity of the Chief Minister's claims that the fresh recruitment process and the state government's persuasion on the review petition in the Supreme Court order will go on simultaneously. "The question is whether any scope for review prevails once the fresh recruitment process starts as per the apex court order. The Chief Minister is just using the review petition as a tool of time-killing exercise and giving false hopes to 'untainted' candidates," Bhattacharya said.

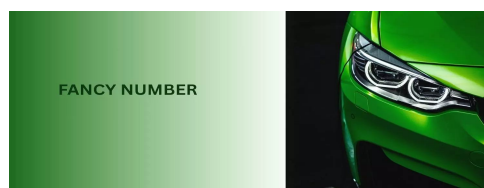
