

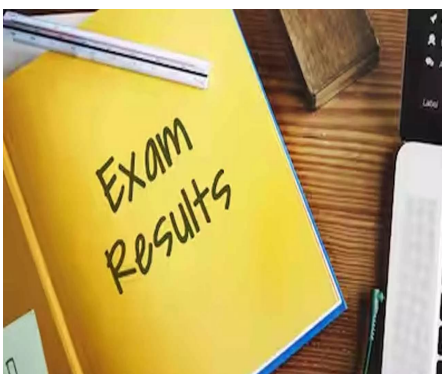


Telangana govt. decides to hold cabinet meetings twice a month



In a significant move, the Telangana state government has announced that Cabinet meetings will now be held twice a month, under the leadership of Chief Minister Revanth Reddy. This decision aims to expedite government administration and mitigate delays in policy deliberations. According to government sources, the meetings are scheduled for the first and third Saturdays of each month. Previously, Cabinet meetings were convened only as needed; however, the government believes that a regular meeting schedule will facilitate prompt decisions on critical issues affecting the public. Officials suggest that this increased frequency of meetings will promote greater transparency in governance and allow the government to respond more effectively to the needs of citizens. This approach is expected to provide an opportunity for thorough reviews of essential development, welfare, and administrative matters, enabling immediate action where necessary.

RCB Employee Taken into Custody Following Bengaluru Stampede

Royal Challengers Bangalore news: Police from Bengaluru RCB employee arrest Nikhil Sosale, who leads marketing and revenue at Royal Challengers Bengaluru at Kempegowda International Airport on Friday. The police detained Kiran Kumar who served as Senior Event Manager and Sunil Mathew who worked as Vice President - Business Affairs from DNA Entertainment Network. Karnataka's chief minister Siddaramaiah ordered the arrests of RCB and DNA officials. The decision resulted from the tragic Bengaluru stampede outside the Chinnaswamy stadium incident that killed 11 people during RCB's IPL celebrations on June 2. The Karnataka Chief Minister gave orders on Thursday to arrest RCB and



DNA personnel while suspending key law enforcement officials including Bengaluru Police Commissioner B. Dayananda and additional high-ranking officers. The cabinet decided to set up a one-man judicial commission led by retired high court judge Justice

Michael D'Cunha to investigate yesterday's tragedy according to the Karnataka chief minister's announcement on Thursday. The commission has been ordered to submit their report within 30 days and both the IGP and DGP of the state have been directed to

arrest the RCB representative DNA event managers and KSCA representative without delay. The government recently issued an immediate suspension order for the Police Inspector at Cubbon Park Police Station as well as the Assistant Commissioner of Police for the locality, the Deputy Commissioner for Central Division, the Additional Commissioner of Police together with stadium in-charges and the Bengaluru City Police Commissioner. The police had registered an FIR by yesterday. I have entrusted the inquiry to CID. The cabinet finalized these decisions today. The Commissioner's office did not provide written rejection for the event since there wasn't enough time to organize the crowd control issue for the large public gathering.

Kakani Goverdhan Reddy taken into custody in a case

Former Minister Kakani Goverdhan Reddy, currently a remand prisoner linked to the irregularities in the quartz mining sector, has been taken into police custody. On Friday morning, Circle Inspector Subbarao visited the district jail where Kakani underwent medical examinations. In response to the former minister's custody, authorities have implemented heightened security measures at the jail. It is anticipated that Kakani will be transferred from the jail to the Krishnapatnam Port Police Station. His custody is set to last for three days, concluding at 5pm on the 8th of this month. Kakani is referred to as A4 in the ongoing investigation into case. The police have submitted a petition to the Nellore court, seeking Kakani's custody to gather further information about the case. The court has granted the request but with the stipulation that the investigation must be carried out in the presence of a lawyer.



HYDRA carries out demolitions in Secunderabad

Secunderabad: The Hyderabad Disaster Response and Asset Protection Agency (HYDRA) conducted demolition operations in Secunderabad on Thursday as part of an ongoing effort to remove illegal encroachments. The team focused on clearing unauthorised constructions in the Begumpet and Patny areas, where several illegal structures had been built over



drainage canals. Officials confirmed that the demolitions aimed to restore the natural flow of nalas and prevent obstructions that could lead to waterlogging or flooding during the rainy season. The operation was carried out by HYDRA staff using heavy machinery under close supervision to ensure the removal of all illegal structures in the targeted locations.

APUWJ submits plea seeking free education for scribes' kids

The Andhra Pradesh government has finalised all preparations for the AP Mega DSC exams, which begin yesterday and will continue until July 6. This month-long examination period will feature two sessions each day, taking place across 154 designated centres. Additionally, exam venues have been established in neighbouring states including Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, and Odisha. These Mega DSC exams aim to fill a total of 16,347 vacancies, with an impressive 335,401 candidates having applied specifically for these positions. In total, 577,417 individuals have submitted applications for all available posts. Candidates concerned about any errors on their hall tickets need not panic, as corrections can be made directly at the exam centres. The exams will be conducted via online format, and education officials have emphasised the importance of punctuality, stating that late arrivals, even by a minute, will not be permitted entry. Candidates are advised to arrive at their exam centres well in advance to comply with this strict timing rule.

Gill has a chance to build a collective culture in new-look Indian team, says Chopra



New Delhi: Former India opener Aakash Chopra believes Shubman Gill has the opportunity to cultivate a strong collective culture as the captain of the Test team, which is all set to step into a new era through the five-match Test tour of England, starting on June 20. Under the leadership of Gill, the Test series in England will be India's first assignment in the 2025-27 World Test Championship cycle. "Form a leadership group—bring 4-5 players together and build a core. Include Yashasvi Jaiswal, KL Rahul, Rishabh Pant, Jasprit Bumrah, and Mohammed Siraj. Create a pack of wolves. These are the guys who'll be with you today, in six months, and five years down the line." "With a young team, it's important that the captain grows with the group. Seniors and juniors often have different routines and circles—but with this new-look team, you have a chance to build a collective culture. It's a rare opportunity to create a bond and a story that the entire nation will be proud of," said Chopra on JioHotstar. Asked if Gill should draw inspiration from the success Virat Kohli had in his Test career, Chopra said, "You can take inspiration from Virat Kohli's success, his hunger for runs, his leadership—but not necessarily his batting number. That's a very individual choice. Similarly, Shubman should play where he contributes best." "Batting position isn't about copying someone—it's about where you fit in the team and how it benefits the side. Learn from Kohli's mindset, play with an extra bowler if needed. That's what leaders do—make sacrifices for the team." Chopra reflected on the pressure the Gill-led Indian team and support staff headed by Gautam Gambhir will face in England, adding that they need to select the bowlers who are sure of picking 20 wickets collectively. "There should be pressure, and it's part of the job. When you're representing India and carrying the hopes of 1.4 billion people, it comes with immense love—even from people who've never seen you but still pray for your success. But with that comes responsibility, and with responsibility comes pressure." "I agree with Gautam Gambhir when he said that taking 20 wickets is key. I hope the team remembers that. Last time, I felt the bowling unit wasn't picked with the mind-set to take 20 wickets. We must avoid repeating that mistake." "There's always the temptation—if you get bowled out early, you want to play an extra batter. But that's a trap. You end up compromising your bowling strength. Let's not fall into that trap again," he concluded.

'Thug Life' review: A stylish showdown that sparks

Chandran Editor: Sreekar Prasad Rating: 3/5 Thug Life, the much-anticipated collaboration between cinematic giants Kamal Haasan and Mani Ratnam, finally arrives on the big screen, offering a grand gangster saga laced with style, legacy, and emotional undertones. While expectations were understandably sky-high, the film makes a valiant attempt to blend old-school action with emotional depth, showcasing flashes of brilliance even if it doesn't fully meet the towering expectations. Story: Set against the gritty backdrop of New Delhi's underworld, Thug Life traces the tale of Rangaraya Sakthiraju (Kamal Haasan), a seasoned gangster who adopts a child named Amar (Simbu) after a violent encounter. Years later, with Sakthiraju imprisoned, Amar rises through the ranks, only for a personal tragedy to drive a wedge between mentor and protégé. The story then spirals into a power-packed revenge saga, exploring betrayal, blood ties, and fractured loyalty. Performances: Kamal Haasan delivers a layered performance, effortlessly shifting across age brackets and portraying the gravitas of his character with finesse. His dialogue delivery and intense face-offs with Simbu bring gravitas to the narrative. Simbu, especially in the first half, commands attention with a powerful screen presence and well-



timed aggression. Their on-screen chemistry offers some of the film's best moments. Nassar, as always, impresses with his seasoned portrayal, while Abhirami makes her brief role count. The ensemble cast, including Trisha, Ashok Selvan, Joju George, and Aishwarya Lekshmi, though underutilized, add visual richness to the film. Technicalities: Mani Ratnam's direction is visually solid, if not emotionally piercing. The screenplay, co-written by Kamal and Ratnam, offers moments of brilliance but occasionally falters in pacing, especially in the second half. AR Rahman's music, though subtle, underlines key moments without overpowering the narrative. The cinematography stands out with its gritty frames and stylized presentation. Editing could have been crisper, especially in the slower segments,

but overall, the production values remain top-notch. Analysis: While Thug Life may not rank among Mani Ratnam's finest, it certainly attempts to revive the grandeur of classic gangster dramas. The film shines brightest in its dramatic face-offs and visual appeal. The narrative occasionally feels stretched, and some character arcs could have been fleshed out better, but the emotional core between Sakthiraju and Amar anchors the film. It may not redefine the genre, but Thug Life still delivers enough cinematic value to warrant a watch, especially for fans of the legendary duo. Thug Life may not be a flawless triumph, but it's a commendable effort that showcases moments of grit, legacy, and emotional complexity. Come for Kamal, stay for the drama.

Rajendra Prasad's foul language spark outrage; actor's image at risk

Veteran actor Rajendra Prasad has found himself in the middle of a growing controversy after making inappropriate remarks during SV Krishna Reddy's birthday celebration event. His comments involving comedian Ali, actresses Nirosha and Roja, and actor Murali Mohan raised eyebrows and quickly drew criticism from fans and the industry alike. Particularly, his reference to Ali gained widespread attention on social media. Rather than offering an apology, Rajendra Prasad added fuel to the fire by defending his remarks at a later event. "If you do not understand me, that is your fate. I cannot help it. If you find fault with me, it shows your upbringing," he said — a statement that left many disappointed and offended. While the actor had previously apologized for earlier incidents, including a controversial comment about cricketer David Warner and the Pushpa film team, this time he chose not to, prompting further backlash. Observers believe his frustration is now being misdirected at the very audience that has supported him



over decades. Comedian Ali released a video urging the public to be understanding, explaining that Rajendra Prasad may be acting out due to emotional distress following the recent loss of his daughter. Despite these appeals, insiders suggest the actor is ignoring advice to

remain composed at public events. If this pattern continues, many fear Rajendra Prasad's long-earned respect could erode. For someone of his stature, self-reflection and sensitivity to public sentiment are vital to preserving his legacy.

Rakul slams rumor about getting house gift from politician

Actress Rakul Preet Singh, who has transitioned from South cinema to Bollywood post her marriage, recently addressed one of the strangest rumors she has encountered in her career. In a candid interview, the De De Pyaar De actress recalled a widely circulated rumor in Telangana that claimed a prominent politician had gifted her a house. Though Rakul didn't name the politician, the specula-

tion had earlier linked her to ex-Telangana minister KTR. Speaking about it, Rakul said, "The weirdest rumor is that my house was gifted to me. But the truth is, my father did all the paperwork and bought it. He was extremely hurt that people would say such things when it was our hard-earned money." Rakul also revealed that her father was upset enough to urge her to respond publicly. "He asked me

to give a clarification, but I told him I can't keep reacting to every false rumor," she added. At the time, her father even issued a press statement to counter the speculation. On the professional front, Rakul is gearing up for the release of De De Pyaar De 2 and the much-anticipated Indian 3. Though her presence in Telugu cinema has lessened, her Bollywood journey continues to pick up pace.
