



KCR's inquiry on Kaleshwaram ends, heads to visit injured Palla Rajeshwar Reddy



Former Chief Minister K. Chandrashekar Rao (KCR) has completed his inquiry with the Kaleshwaram Commission, which lasted approximately 50 minutes. Commission Chairman P.C. Ghosh interrogated KCR regarding the Kaleshwaram project, during which the former chief minister submitted several documents. Following the inquiry at BRK Bhavan in Hyderabad, KCR greeted supporters before departing. Upon arrival, he noted he was suffering from a cold, prompting the commission to make a significant decision to cancel the planned open court session and conduct the questioning in private. , which has now interviewed a total of 114 witnesses. After concluding his testimony, KCR headed directly to Yashoda Hospital to visit Jangaon MLA Palla Rajeshwar Reddy. Reddy had sustained an injury to his hip bone following an accidental slip at KCR's farmhouse in Siddipet earlier in the day. He was promptly transported to the hospital for treatment.

Poornima is the daughter of N Ravishankar Reddy, State Secretary of the Rayalaseema Communist Party, and K Anita of Adinimayapalle village, Vallur Mandal. Polavaram will be completed by 2027

Eluru: Water Resources Minister Nimmala Ramanaidu on Tuesday inspected the Polavaram project works at the field level and conducted a review of the works. On the occasion, he measured the diaphragm wall panel thickness in the presence of journalists and showed that it was 1.5 metres. He said in a press release that the propaganda of a Telugu daily that the diaphragm wall panel thickness had been reduced to 0.9 meters was wrong. He alleged that the 'anti-development' YSRCP does not want the Polavaram project to be completed. Minister Ramanaidu said that the project work is progressing at a rapid pace as per the time-bound schedule taken



jointly by the CWC, irrigation officials and construction agencies under the leadership of Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu. The minister said that Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu has already inspected the Polavaram project works at the field level three times. He said that

Naidu himself is reviewing the Polavaram works every 15 days in the Secretariat. He expressed confidence that the target of completing the diaphragm wall construction this year is going to be achieved. He explained that more than 80 percent of the Polavaram head works

have already been completed. The minister clarified that there is no compromise on quality in the construction of the Polavaram project. He once again clarified that the coalition government, with the support of Prime Minister Modi, under the capable leadership of Naidu, will complete the Polavaram project by December 2027. Polavaram MLA Balaraju, Polavaram constituency TDP in-charge Boragam Srinivas, Irrigation Advisor M Venkateswara Rao, ENC Narasimhamurthy, Megha Engineering Director Subbaiah, and other irrigation officials and agency representatives participated in this visit.

Nitish Kumar inaugurates Bihar's first double-decker flyover in Patna

Patna: In a major boost to Bihar's urban infrastructure, Chief Minister Nitish Kumar on Wednesday inaugurated the state's first double-decker flyover in Patna, built at a cost of Rs 422 crore. The structure, hailed as a landmark in the city's smart mobility mission, aims to ease traffic congestion and improve connectivity in the capital. Constructed along Ashoka Rajpath, the multi-tier flyover introduces a three-level traffic system -- the first of its kind in Bihar. Tier 1 (Lower Deck) includes a 1.45 km stretch from Patna College to BN College. Tier 2 (Upper Deck) has a 2.2 km corridor from Kargil Chowk to

Shatabdi Dwar, passing Patna Science College. Ground Level Service Road is 90 per cent complete, providing additional support for surface traffic. The flyover links key urban nodes, including the Patna Metro Rail Project and JP Ganga Path, and is expected to significantly decongest high-traffic areas such as PMCH, Science College, and Patna University. It also facilitates smoother travel for commuters from the Mahatma Gandhi Setu, Kankarbagh, and nearby areas. Integrated with broader urban development plans, the corridor connects to Bakarganj, Nala Road, multi-level parking facilities, and vital institutions, benefiting students, medical professionals, traders, and daily commuters alike. Calling it "a confluence of technology, management, and aesthetics," Nitish



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Kumar said the project represents Bihar's evolving identity. "This is not just a bridge, but a vision. It will transform city commuting and serve as a model for urban infrastructure across the state," he said at the inauguration. The Kargil Chowk -- Science College stretch, in particular, is expected to revolutionize mobility in central Patna, reducing travel time and improving emergency response access in the vicinity of major hospitals and colleges. This landmark project marks a significant milestone in Patna's smart city journey and reflects Bihar's growing emphasis on modern, future-ready infrastructure.

Weather update: AP to receive rains for three days amid surface trough



The Meteorological Department has announced that a surface trough stretching from Uttar Pradesh to the west-central Bay of Bengal is generating widespread rainfall across Andhra Pradesh. Reports indicate that heavy rains are expected to persist for approximately a week, with particularly intense downpours anticipated in Rayalaseema on Wednesday and Thursday. Anantapur, Sathya Sai, Kurnool, and Annamaya districts are predicted to experience the heaviest rainfall during this period. In addition to the heavy rain, gusty winds are forecast, reaching speeds of 40 to 60 km/h. There is also a likelihood of significant rainfall in parts of the north coast. In the past 24 hours, Manyam recorded the highest rainfall of 4.3 cm. The state government has been alerted following the Meteorological Department's warnings, and officials have been advised to remain vigilant. In related news, this year's monsoon season commenced in Kerala eight days early in May, marking the earliest arrival in 16 years. This early onset has been met with enthusiasm from farmers, who are eager to begin planting their crops in response to the rainfall.

KCR heads to Hyderabad from Erravalli, to appear before Kaleshwaram commission

Former Chief Minister and BRS leader K Chandrashekhara Rao (KCR) has departed from his Erravalli farmhouse in Siddipet en route to the Kaleshwaram Commission inquiry. KCR is scheduled to appear before the commission today (Wednesday) at 11:30 AM. Nine BRS leaders have been permitted to attend the proceedings alongside KCR, including former minister Harish Rao and MPs Vaddiraju Ravichandra, as well as MLAs Prashanth Reddy, Padmarao Goud, Bandari Lakshma Reddy, MLC Madhusudhanachari, for-



mer MLC Mahmood Ali, and BRS leader RS Praveen Kumar. A considerable number of party

supporters are congregating at BRK Bhavan to show their support. In anticipation of KCR's

appearance, police have implemented strict restrictions in the area. Furthermore, the road adjacent to BRK Bhavan and the GHMC office has been closed to traffic. WTC final: Harbhajan backs Australia to retain title, says 'They understand conditions better than SA'



New Delhi: Former India spinner Harbhajan Singh backed Australia to retain the World Test Championship (WTC) ahead of the final against South Africa at Lord's due to the former's better acquaintance of English conditions. Pat Cummins-led Australia are eyeing to become the first team to win the WTC twice after previously lifting the mace in 2023, beating India at The Oval in the second edition of the tournament. On the other hand, Temba Bavuma's South Africa will play their first WTC final after topping the standings on the back of winning seven of their last eight matches. Though this might be their first red-ball summit clash, they have become regulars in ICC knockout matches in recent years. "Australia will come prepared. They've played a lot of cricket in England - Ashes, the last WTC Final - and that experience will count. They understand these conditions better than South Africa. Plus, they're a champion side. The difference lies in how you handle pressure during big matches, and Aussies are masters at that. That's why they've won more trophies than anyone else," Harbhajan said on JioHotstar and Star Sports network. The legendary spinner further praised Cummins' leadership qualities which make him a "very special captain" for Australia. "Cummins is one of those leaders who brings everyone together. More importantly, he's a proven match-winner with great command in the dressing room. When your team respects and rallies behind you, you win more matches. That's what makes him a very special captain for Australia," the former Indian bowler said. Former India batter and commentator Aakash Chopra also echoed Harbhajan's views on Cummins and termed him a "biggest threat" for the Proteas. "Pat Cummins is the biggest threat. His leadership, his bowling when there is a partnership, his batting lower down the order - he contributes across departments. He leads from the front and always keeps the opposition under pressure," he said.
