



United Kingdom Sends Investigation Experts To Assist with Air India Crash Probe

British Prime Minister Keir Starmer has confirmed the deployment of a specialized investigation team from the United Kingdom to assist Indian authorities in examining the catastrophic Air India flight AI-171 crash in Ahmedabad. The announcement follows the tragic incident that claimed 242 lives when the London-bound aircraft crashed shortly after takeoff on Thursday evening. The Prime Minister's statement coincided with confirmation from the Air Accidents Investigation Branch (AAIB), Britain's premier civil aviation accident investigation agency, that it would send a multidisciplinary team to support the India-led inquiry into the disaster. The AAIB has been granted "expert status" in the Indian investigation due to the presence of British citizens aboard the ill-fated aircraft. This designation allows the UK agency to play a significant role in the comprehensive examination of the



crash circumstances and contributing factors. "The UK Air Accidents Investigation Branch has formally offered its assistance to the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau, India. Additionally, the UK AAIB will have expert status in the Indian safety investigation because UK citizens were on board the aircraft," stated the British agency in an official release. The AAIB

emphasized its commitment to supporting the investigation while expressing condolences, noting that their "thoughts are with all those affected by this tragic accident." Prime Minister Starmer outlined the collaborative approach being taken with Indian authorities, emphasizing the importance of establishing factual findings through joint investigative efforts. "The inves-

tigation is ongoing, and we have dispatched an investigation team that has been deployed," Starmer confirmed during his statement. The British leader also indicated that Foreign Secretary David Lammy is spearheading the UK's response to the crisis and coordinating with Indian counterparts. Starmer assured that updates would be provided as the investigation progresses and directed affected families to contact the Foreign Office for assistance and information. The Air India Boeing aircraft crashed within minutes of departing from Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel International Airport in Ahmedabad, resulting in one of the most significant aviation disasters in recent history. The passenger manifest revealed the international scope of the tragedy, with victims from multiple countries. Among the 242 individuals aboard the aircraft were 169 Indian nationals, 53

British citizens, seven Portuguese nationals, and one Canadian citizen, in addition to the 12 crew members. This diverse passenger composition necessitates international cooperation in both the investigation and victim assistance efforts. In a video message delivered from Downing Street on Thursday evening, Prime Minister Starmer reiterated his earlier expressions of devastation regarding the scenes from the crash site in Gujarat. His statements reflect the profound impact the tragedy has had on the UK government and the British community. The Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau in India is leading the primary investigation into the crash causes, with the UK team providing specialized expertise and support to ensure a thorough and comprehensive examination of all factors that may have contributed to this devastating aviation accident.

Telangana ECET 2025 Counselling Schedule Announced

The Telangana Engineering Common Entrance Test (ECET) 2025 counselling schedule has been officially released, allowing students who have completed their polytechnic studies to gain direct entry into the second year of B.Tech and B.Pharmacy courses, starting from tomorrow, June 14. The announcement was made by Professor Balakishtha Reddy, Chairman of the State Council of Higher Education and Chair of the Admissions Committee. According to the schedule issued by Sridevasena, State Commissioner of Technical Education and Convener of Admissions, the counselling process will occur in two phases. The first phase will commence with slot booking, which will be available from June 14 to 18. Certificate verification is set to take place from June 17 to 19, followed by the opportunity for students to register their web options from June 17 to 21. Seat allocation is scheduled for June 25, with successful candidates required to report online by June 29. The second phase of counselling will begin on July 11, with applications accepted from July 11 to 13. Certificate verification will occur on July 14, and students can submit their web options until July 15. Seat allocation is planned for July 18, with online reporting due by July 20. Students are required to join their assigned colleges by July 23. Additionally, spot admission guidelines will be issued on July 22, with the completion of spot admissions set for July 29, following the established timetable.



Prime Minister Modi Visits Sole Survivor Of Devastating Air India Crash In

Prime Minister Narendra Modi visited Ahmedabad Civil Hospital on Friday to meet Vishwash Kumar Ramesh, the sole survivor of the catastrophic Air India plane crash that occurred on Thursday. The 40-year-old British national remains the only person to survive the tragedy that claimed at least 260 lives when flight AI-171 crashed shortly after takeoff. During his hospital visit, Modi spent time in the C7 ward where 25 injured individuals are receiving treatment. The Prime Minister also engaged with medical staff treating the survivors and reviewed the ongoing rescue and relief operations. Vishwash Kumar Ramesh was seated in position 11A aboard the Boeing 787 Dreamliner, strategically located near an emergency exit. This fortunate seating arrangement enabled him to escape the aircraft during the disaster. Speaking from his hospital bed, Ramesh described the terrifying moments following the crash. "When I regained consciousness, bodies sur-



rounded me everywhere. Fear overwhelmed me as I stood up and fled. Aircraft debris was scattered all around. Someone pulled me to safety and transported me to the hospital in an ambulance," Ramesh recounted to media personnel. The survivor, who holds British citizenship, was traveling to Britain with his brother after visiting family members in India. Authorities have not yet confirmed whether Ramesh managed to exit the aircraft before or after impact. Earlier on Friday, the Prime Minister conducted an on-site inspection of the Air

India crash location in Ahmedabad, assessing the ground situation firsthand. Modi arrived in the city that morning and proceeded directly to examine the site where the Boeing 787-8 Dreamliner met its tragic end. Union Civil Aviation Minister Ram Mohan Naidu Kinjarapu, State Home Minister Harsh Sanghavi, and other senior officials accompanied the Prime Minister during this critical assessment visit. The Air India flight AI-171, bound for London Gatwick, crashed merely 33 seconds after departing from Ahmedabad

International Airport on Thursday. The aircraft subsequently collided with a nearby medical college hostel, resulting in widespread devastation. The passenger manifest revealed 169 Indian nationals, 53 British nationals, seven Portuguese nationals, and one Canadian national aboard the ill-fated flight. All 242 passengers and crew members perished in the accident, except for the lone survivor. Union Civil Aviation Minister Ram Mohan Naidu confirmed on Thursday that the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB) has initiated a comprehensive formal investigation into the deadly crash of Air India flight 171. The investigation aims to determine the exact cause of the accident and prevent similar tragedies in the future. The crash represents one of the most devastating aviation disasters in recent Indian history, prompting immediate government response and international attention to aviation safety protocols.

India Records Over 7,000 Active COVID-19 Cases As Fresh Wave Continues In 2025

India's COVID-19 situation shows continued escalation as active cases reached 7,154 on Thursday morning, according to official data from the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. The country recorded three additional COVID-related fatalities since Thursday, with two deaths in Maharashtra and one in Madhya Pradesh, bringing the total death count for 2025 to 77. Despite the rising infections, there has been encouraging progress in recoveries, with over 8,000 individuals successfully recovering from the infection throughout the current year. Kerala maintains its position as the most affected state in the current wave, reporting 2,223 active cases on



Thursday morning. The southern state continues to account for the largest share of India's COVID-19 burden in 2025. Other states experiencing significant case loads include Gujarat,

West Bengal, Delhi, and Maharashtra, according to the Centre's COVID-19 monitoring dashboard. While most states have registered slight increases in active cases, the distribution remains uneven across different regions of the country. Health experts attribute the recent surge to emerging Omicron sub-variants, specifically JN.1, NB.1.8.1, LF.7, and XFC strains. These variants demonstrate

enhanced transmissibility compared to previous iterations but generally present with milder symptoms in infected individuals. The World Health Organization currently categorizes these strains as "Variants Under Monitoring," indicating they require careful observation but do not yet warrant classification as variants of concern. This designation reflects a cautious approach while acknowledging their increased spread potential. Medical authorities note that SARS-CoV-2, the virus responsible for COVID-19, has evolved from an unpredictable emergency threat to a more predictable endemic pathogen. The virus now follows recurring sea-

sonal patterns similar to influenza, representing a significant shift in how health systems approach COVID-19 management. This transition suggests that while the virus remains present and active, its behavior has become more predictable, allowing for better preparation and response strategies. Healthcare systems are adapting their protocols to manage COVID-19 as part of routine respiratory illness surveillance rather than emergency pandemic response. The current data reflects ongoing vigilance by health authorities as they monitor transmission patterns and adapt public health measures accordingly.

Telangana: Heavy Rain lashes parts of Hyderabad

Heavy rain is currently sweeping through Hyderabad and various regions of Greater Hyderabad, leading to significant challenges for residents. Areas including Nampally, Lakdikapool, Khairatabad, Panjagutta, Tankbund, Himayatnagar, Narayanguda, Musheerabad, RTC Cross Road, Abids, Koti, Goshamahall, Charminar, Malakpet, and Chadar Ghat are experiencing severe downpours. Low-lying areas are becoming increasingly waterlogged as drainages overflow, rendering many streets impassable. Citizens are finding it difficult to leave their homes, hindered by the relentless rain and accompanying thunder and lightning. Reports indicate that several colonies are submerged in rainwater, bringing daily activities in Hyderabad to a standstill. Traffic congestion has been reported in numerous locations around the city, with strong winds uprooting tree branches and causing power outages in several neighbourhoods, plunging them into darkness. In response to the ongoing deluge, GHMC officials have initiated relief measures. An orange alert has been issued for Hyderabad, Medchal, Malkajgiri, and Rangareddy districts, following the heavy rainfall recorded yesterday. Meteorological department officials have warned of potential thunderstorms and gusty winds reaching speeds of 40 to 60 kilometres per hour, alongside a risk of lightning strikes. The government has mobilised GHMC Monsoon Emergency Teams and Disaster Response Force (DRF) teams to manage the situation.

New Delhi: A week before India begins their five-match Test series against England in Leeds, head coach Gautam Gambhir has flown back home due to a family emergency. Gambhir had been with the Indian team at Beckenham ahead of their intra-squad practice match starting on Friday. "Yes it came to the light yesterday that Gambhir would be flying back home due to an important family emergency related to his mother. As of now, we believe that Gambhir has already linked up with his family in New Delhi. "Keeping in mind the current situation, it's not known yet about when he would join the India team ahead of the Test series' commencement," said sources aware of development to IANS on Friday. In Gambhir's absence, alongside batting coach Sitanshu Kotak, bowling coach Morne Morkel, assistant coach Ryan ten Doeschate and fielding coach T Dilip will help the Indian team prepare for the upcoming Test series against Ben Stokes-led England, which starts at Headingley. The Test tour of England will also be right-handed batter Shubman Gill's first assignment as the captain of the Indian team, following the retirement of Rohit Sharma last month. At 25 years and 258 days, Gill will also become the fifth-youngest cricketer to captain India in Tests. Wicketkeeper-batter Rishabh Pant will be India's vice-captain on the all-important Test series, which runs from June 20 to August 4. India and England will also play matches at Edgbaston in Birmingham, Lord's in London, Old Trafford in Manchester and The Oval in London. India are aiming to win a Test series in England for the first time since 2007. The Test series in England will also be India's first assignment in the 2025-27 World Test Championship cycle.

Ram Gopal Varma asks 'What God is doing?' amidst Air India crash

Mumbai: As the entire nation mourns the loss of life in the horrific Air India crash in Ahmedabad, filmmaker Ram Gopal Varma said that only God knows what he is doing. In the recent past, some unfortunate events have taken place which have left everyone shocked to their core. Reflecting on all that has happened, Ram Gopal Varma took to his X timeline and wrote, "GOD knows what GOD is doing?" Talking about the horrific Pahalgam attack, he added, "You to a beautiful location for a vacation and terrorists shoot you". On April 22, militants ended up killing around 26 civilians in the Pahalgam region of Indian-administered Jammu and Kashmir, mainly targeting Hindu tourists. The Resistance Front (TRF), an offshoot of Pakistan-based terrorist group Lashkar-e-Taiba (LeT), claimed responsibility for the attack. Avenging the attack, the



Indian Armed Forces launched Operation Sindoor, attacking terrorist infrastructure in Pakistan and Pakistan-occupied Jammu and Kashmir (PoJK). This led to cross-border tension between the two neighbors. Shifting his focus to the Bengaluru stampede, the 'Sarkar Raj' maker shared, "You go to cele-

brate in a trophy parade and you die in a stampede". On June 4, eleven people lost their lives in a stampede in Bengaluru, during a victory parade celebrating Royal Challengers Bengaluru's first Indian Premier League win. He also expressed grief over the horrific Air India plane crash in Ahmedabad saying "You fly in a plane and the plane crashes." "You are eating a meal in your hostel and a plane falls on you," he added. On Thursday, Air India Boeing 787-8 Dreamliner crashed soon after taking off. The aircraft plunged into a residential complex near BJ Medical College. Out of the 242 people on board the flight, only 1 survived, leaving 241 dead. After taking off from Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel International Airport at 1.38 p.m. (IST) the plane lost control moments later.
