



'Moment of much-needed reset': Lawmaker Sahney on PM Modi-Carney meet

New Delhi: Member of Parliament from Punjab, Vikramjit Singh Sahney, on Wednesday welcomed the agreement between Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Canadian Prime Minister Mark Carney to restore diplomatic representation by appointing new High Commissioners for both nations at the G7 Summit. Calling it a "moment of much-needed reset," Sahney said that this positive step would greatly ease the hardships faced by Indian citizens, especially the NRI brothers and sisters, who have long awaited regular and timely visa services to visit their families and homeland. Emphasising the economic implications of this renewed engagement, Sahney stated that with over \$8.2 billion in bilateral goods trade in 2024 and Canadian investments exceeding \$55 billion in India, there is vast scope to expand cooperation. "India imports over 63 per cent of its potash from Canada and is a major consumer of lentils and edible oils sourced from there. With restored diplomatic normalcy, we must energise this economic corridor to serve the interests of both nations," Sahney said in a statement here. Modi says will emphasise priorities of Global South On the sidelines of the G7 Summit in Kananaskis in Canada, Prime Minister Modi met with Canadian counterpart Mark Carney in



a pivotal bilateral meeting aimed at reviving strained ties between the two nations. According to India's Foreign Secretary Vikram Misri, the two leaders had a "very positive and constructive meeting" and agreed on "calibrated steps" to bring stability back to the relationship. "Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Prime Minister Mark Carney of Canada have just a short while ago concluded a very positive and constructive meeting on the sidelines of the G7 summit here in Kananaskis in Canada," Misri said. The meeting underscored the mutual desire to strengthen India-Canada ties, which have seen recent tensions.

"The meeting discussed the importance of the India-Canada relationship, which is based on shared values, democracy and the rule of law, people-to-people contact and many other commonalities," Misri added. As an initial move, both leaders agreed to restore high commissioners to each other's capitals at the earliest opportunity. "The Prime Ministers agreed to take calibrated steps to restore stability to this very important relationship, and the first of these steps that was agreed on was to restore high commissioners to each other's capitals at an early date. Other diplomatic steps will follow in due course," Misri added.

CM Chandrababu assures support to tobacco and mango crop farmers

Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu has emphasised the importance of supporting farmers facing special circumstances concerning tobacco, mango, and other crops. During a high-level review meeting at the Secretariat, he instructed officials to adopt a commercial perspective on crop products and implement measures to secure the best possible prices for farmers. The Chief Minister specifically called for an acceleration in the procurement of heddled burley tobacco, ordering the swift purchase of the remaining 53 million kilograms. Officials reported that steps are already underway to procure 33 million kilograms through 24 companies,



with additional arrangements made to acquire another 20 million kilograms via the Andhra Pradesh Mark Fed. Andhra Pradesh tourism Naidu also revealed that he has engaged with the Central Government regarding the reduction of import duties on

palm oil and the lowering of GST on mango pulp from 12% to 5%. He urged officials to liaise with the relevant departments in the central government to facilitate these changes. In addition, he stressed the importance of keeping farmers informed about the market demand for their crops. Currently, an extra support price of Rs 4 per kilogram has been implemented for mangoes, and the Chief Minister insisted that processing units ensure a minimum purchase price of Rs 8. Concluding the review, Naidu reassured that the government is committed to safeguarding farmers against potential losses, underlining their vital role in the economy.

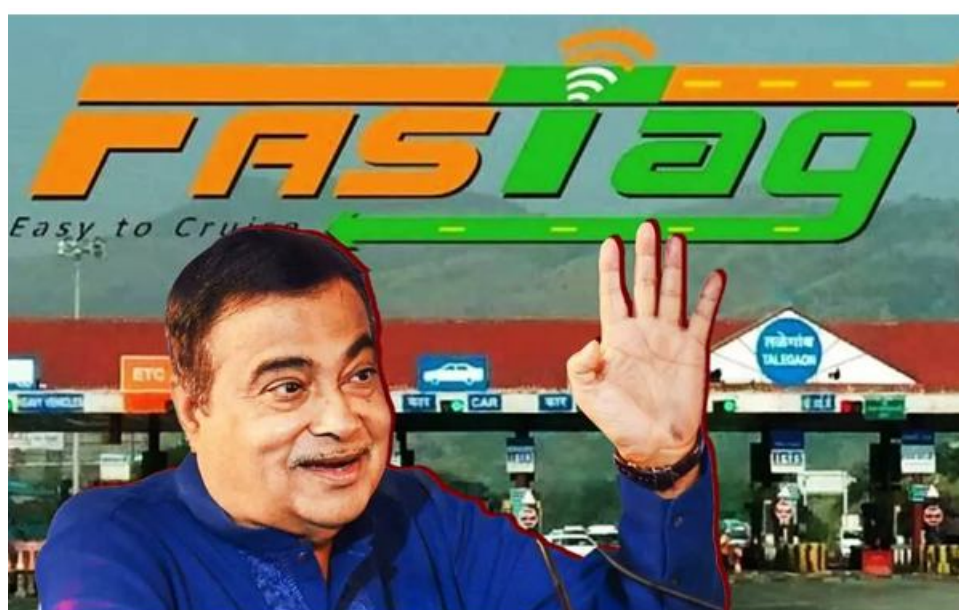
Large Yoga Event Held at Revu Polavaram Beach

To facilitate security and unhindered participation, RK Beach Road, from NTR Circle to Park Hotel Junction, will be closed from Wednesday until the event date. Additionally, vehicular movement from Park Hotel to Bhimili Beach will be suspended from the 19th to the 21st of this month. Commissioner Bagchi advised the public to comply with traffic regulations and cooperate with the police to ensure a smooth event.

Nitin Gadkari Unveils 3,000 Annual FASTag Pass for Private Vehicles, Effective from August 15, 2025

New Delhi: In a major relief for private vehicle owners, Union Minister for Road Transport and Highways Nitin Gadkari has announced a new FASTag-based annual pass aimed at simplifying toll payments and reducing congestion on national highways. The pass, priced at ₹3,000, will be effective from August 15, 2025, and is exclusively designed for non-commercial vehicles such as cars, jeeps, and vans. Taking to social media platform X (formerly Twitter), Gadkari described the initiative as a "historic move" that will enhance travel efficiency for millions of private vehicle users across India. The annual pass will be valid for one year or up to 200 highway trips, whichever comes first from the date of activation. For a one-time fee of



₹3,000, users will be able to travel across national highways with seamless toll access, without

needing to make payments at each toll plaza. Important Announcement In a transforma-

Valid for one year from the date of activation or up to 200 trips—whichever comes...— Nitin Gadkari (@nitin_gadkari) June 18, 2025 To ensure the process is user-friendly and easily accessible, the government will soon introduce a dedicated digital link for activating and renewing the annual pass. This link will be made available on the Highway Travel App and on the official websites of the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) and the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH). One of the key aims of this initiative is to resolve a long-standing issue related to

toll plazas located within a 60-kilometre radius, which has been a source of inconvenience and frequent disputes. By introducing this prepaid pass, the government hopes to reduce waiting times, ease traffic congestion, and eliminate conflicts at toll booths—offering a smoother and more predictable travel experience for private vehicle drivers. With India's national highway network rapidly expanding, this FASTag annual pass marks another step toward the government's broader goal of modernizing road infrastructure and creating a more efficient, digital tolling system. The move has been widely welcomed by frequent commuters and travel associations, who see it as a practical, time-saving solution for everyday highway users.

Three imposters held for extorting money from cattle truck driver

Kadiri: In a case of impersonation and extortion, three individuals posing as police officers were arrested and sent to judicial remand after they stopped a cattle transport truck, assaulted the driver, and extorted money from him. On the night of June 15 around 9:30 PM, a group of men intercepted a cattle-laden truck at the Kutagula-Pulivendula Junction. Claiming to be police officers, they threatened the driver and demanded 20,000. Fearing for his safety, the driver handed over 6,000 in cash. Following the inci-

dent, the driver, Marudha Muthu Archamy, a resident of Tamil Nadu, lodged a formal complaint at the Kadiri Town Police Station on June 16. Based on the complaint, police registered a case and identified the accused. During the investigation, on June 17 around 12:30 PM, Kadiri police apprehended the trio near the Velugu Office on Kadiri-Hindupur Road. A Bolero vehicle, 5,700 in cash, and two sticks used in the crime were seized from the accused. The arrested individuals were presented before the Magistrate, who remand-



ed them to 14 days of judicial custody. They have been lodged at the Kadiri Sub-Jail pending further investigation. Police con-

firmed that a case has been registered under relevant sections, and strict legal action will follow.

Aadhaar biometric update for kids aged 5 and 15 mandatory

Nandyal: District Collector G Raja Kumari has stated that children who cross the ages of 5 and 15 must mandatorily update their Aadhaar biometric details. Speaking at the District-Level Aadhaar Monitoring Committee (DLAMC) meeting held at the Collectorate's video conference hall on Tuesday, she informed that biometric updates for children at the age of 5 and 15 are free of cost. Officials including DLDO Shiva Reddy, GSWWS Coordinator Khader, representatives from the Aadhaar Regional Office, LDM Ravindra Kumar, DEO Janardhan Reddy, ICDS PD Leelavathi, and DMHO Venkataramana participated in the meeting. She stressed upon the importance of Aadhaar biometric updates for students, especially those preparing for board and competitive examinations like Class 10 and Intermediate. She instructed the DEO to spread awareness among students and parents about the mandatory update. Children who miss the free update window and are



aged above 7 or 17 years will have to pay 100 for the biometric update. She also directed postal officials to ensure training for Aadhaar operations through SVR Engineering College and ordered the DMHO to ensure that temporary birth certificates are issued immediately upon discharge of newborns from hospi-

tals. Furthermore, she instructed officials from the Women and Child Welfare Department and the Health Department to coordinate efforts and ensure data accuracy for children aged 0-5 years, and asked the LDM to ensure smooth functioning of Aadhaar centers across the district.

Telangana Inter Supplementary Results Memos Available



The officials from the Inter Board have confirmed that short memos detailing the results have been sent to colleges. Students are also able to download their results from the official website. They are advised to report any discrepancies in their mark memos to their principals within ten days. Results for the Intermediate Advanced Supplementary Examinations were announced on June 16, revealing that 50.82% of candidates who sat for the exams have successfully passed. A total of 413,880 students participated in the supplementary examinations, with 249,358 being first-year students. Remarkably, 168,079 first-year candidates passed, resulting in a pass rate of 67.4%. In the second year, 147,518 students sat for the exams, with 76,260 achieving a successful outcome. Students have until June 23 to apply for recounting and reverification of their results.
