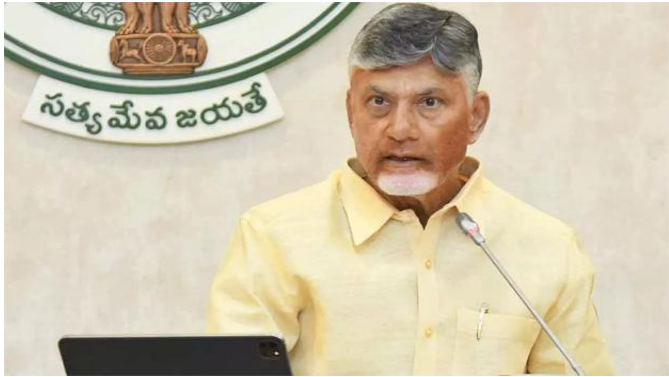




Chandrababu defends Banakacharla project, says will not cause harm to anyone



In a recent statement, Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu reiterated that the Banakacharla project will not cause harm to anyone, emphasising that an average of 2,000 TMC of water has flowed into the sea from the Godavari River every year over the past century. "If we can utilise even 200 TMC of this wasted water, it would significantly benefit the Telugu people and help resolve water scarcity issues," he stated. Naidu asserted his support for projects on the Godavari in Telangana, clarifying that he has never opposed such initiatives. The CM highlighted that his government had allocated ₹3,950 crore to the Handri Niva project in Rayalaseema, along with providing a 90% subsidy for micro irrigation. He outlined the administration's commitment to prioritising profitable crops and promoting commercial farming to increase farmers' incomes, even acknowledging the challenges posed by fluctuating market rates for these crops. "We are moving forward despite numerous difficulties. Our government is dedicated to supporting farmers in every possible way," he declared. Naidu further contrasted his government's inclusive approach with that of the previous administration, which he claimed favoured only select beneficiaries, stating, "We salute the mother, no matter how many children we have."

Cloud of uncertainty over Indo-US BTA seems to be lifting

After weeks of uncertainty and doubts over the US-India trade deal, it seems like it may finally be signed shortly. It may be recalled that the 90-day pause for the tariffs that US President Donald Trump imposed nears its end. He announced the pause on April 9. Washington imposed a 26 per cent tariff rate on Indian made goods. External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar is quoted as saying, "We are in the middle—more than the middle—of a trade negotiation. I hope to bring it to a conclusion, but I can't guarantee it as there is another party involved." He hinted that this could be done "over the next few days." Incidentally, the US has corroborated this. Saying that Trump shares a "very good relationship" with Prime Minister Narendra Modi, the White House press secretary Karoline Leavitt confirmed this much during a press briefing: "Yes, the President said that last week [that the US and India are very close to a trade deal], and it remains true. I just spoke to our Secretary of Commerce about it. He was in the Oval Office with the President. They are finalising these agreements, and



you'll hear from the President and his trade team very soon when it comes to India." Hopefully, the optimism expressed by Delhi and Washington materialises. For, quite apart from the knotty bilateral issues, there is the matter of Trump taking credit for stopping the hostilities between India and Pakistan in May. The Indian government didn't like that; this also apparently resulted in the hardened stance by our negotiators. Besides, many Sangh Parivar-affiliated bodies like the Bharatiya Kisan Sangh (BKS) and Swadeshi Jagran Manch (SJM) were opposed to certain aspects of the India-United States bilateral trade agreement (BTA). These aspects are related to genetically modified (GM) crops, dairy products, relaxed regulations on

medical devices, and data localisation. It looks like the government, while addressing the genuine concerns of the BKS-SJM types, has ignored their ideologically motivated demands. This is quite appropriate for policy formulation. The proposed US-India BTA holds significant potential to transform the economic and strategic landscape between the two nations. Beyond the immediate goal of boosting bilateral trade volumes, the BTA can catalyse deepening economic integration and fostering long-term cooperation in key sectors. Increased market access and reduced trade barriers under the agreement would likely encourage higher US investments in India, particularly in areas like manufacturing, infrastructure, energy and services.

Furthermore, the BTA could facilitate the transfer of advanced technologies, especially in critical domains like defence, information technology, renewable energy, and pharmaceuticals. This technology sharing would not only strengthen India's domestic capabilities but also enhance its global competitiveness. Small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) in both countries could particularly benefit from easier market entry and reduced regulatory hurdles, thereby promoting inclusive economic growth. On a strategic level, the BTA can consolidate the growing US-India partnership, which is increasingly seen as vital for maintaining balance and stability in the Indo-Pacific region. Moreover, enhanced economic ties will complement the existing defence and security cooperation, reinforcing the shared commitment to a free, open, and rules-based international order. Ultimately, the BTA has the potential to evolve from a mere trade pact into a cornerstone of a robust, multifaceted US-India alliance that spans commerce, technology, investment, and geopolitics.

Kejriwal launches 'Gujarat Jodo Abhiyaan', says AAP emerged as alternative in state

Ahmedabad: Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) national convenor Arvind Kejriwal on Thursday launched a mega public outreach campaign in Gujarat and vowed to fight for the people's cause, while claiming that the residents of state are disgruntled and disillusioned with the BJP government and are now looking for an alternative. Addressing a press conference, the AAP chief announced the launch of 'Gujarat Jodo Abhiyaan', a one-of-its-kind initiative which will see party workers reach out to diverse sections of people to inform them about the party's "pro-people policies and also win their support". "Over the next two-and-a-half years, AAP



workers and volunteers will visit every family in the state and seek their support," he said and also released a phone number. People will be able to connect to AAP by a missed call on this number. Stating that the victory of AAP candidate Gopal Italia from Visavadar seat was the beginning of the party's foray into Gujarat's political arena, Kejriwal said that AAP will soon emerge as an alternative force in the state. He said that the contest in Visavadar was a semi-final to the upcoming elections, and the bypoll results have sent a loud and clear message to everyone. The AAP supremo alleged that the BJP and Congress were hand in

glove in their "wicked" plan to defeat AAP in the recent by-election, but the people's clear mandate showed them the mirror. Further shedding light on the "non-existent" INDIA bloc, Kejriwal said that there exists no alliance between AAP and the Congress party. The AAP supremo slammed the BJP government over the "deteriorating" law and order situation, flood situation in various parts of the state and also accused the current dispensation of not addressing the aspirations and expectations of youth. He further said that businesses have been ruined, youths and farmers are in utter despair, while cities, including Surat, are inundated with floodwater. Fire breaks out on Govindaraja Swamy street in Tirupati

A significant fire incident occurred today (Thursday) on Govindarajaswamy Sannidhi Street, igniting in a shop and rapidly spreading. The canopy of the nearby Govindarajaswamy temple suffered partial damage as locals reacted swiftly to the alarming situation. Emergency services were promptly notified, with police and fire officials dispatched to the scene. Three fire engines have been deployed to combat the blaze, which has resulted in substantial property damage. Fortunately, a major disaster was averted, as there were no devotees present at the temple during the incident. Authorities believe the fire was caused by a short circuit. The police have initiated an investigation into the matter and have registered a case. Further details regarding the incident are still forthcoming.



Telangana Minister Konda Surekha, husband meet AICC in-charge amid party feud in Warangal district

Hyderabad: Telangana Forest and Endowments Minister Konda Surekha and her husband and Congress leader Konda Murali met AICC in-charge Meenakshi Natrajan here on Thursday amid the ongoing feud in the party in Warangal district after Murali's recent remarks against some leaders. The couple submitted a report to the AICC in-charge on the happenings within the party in the United Warangal district. After the meeting, Konda Surekha said that she has been effectively discharging her duties as the minister. Konda Surekha told media persons that she has done nothing wrong as the minister, and anybody can see the files relating to her ministry. The minister also defended the political ambitions of their daughter Sushmita, which reportedly triggered a feud in the party. She said Sushmita has the right to plan her



future. Hyderabad travel guideTelangana tourism Murali told media persons that he is the representative of the backward classes. Murali claimed that he enjoys people's support. "I have been saying that I am not scared of anybody. I was not scared of many cases filed against me," he said. Murali also stated that he wants the Congress party to thrive and is eager to see Rahul Gandhi as the Prime Minister. The

meeting of the Konda couple with Meenakshi Natrajan comes a day before AICC president Mallikarjun Kharge's visit to Hyderabad. Murali had recently made some remarks against Congress MPs, MLAs, and other leaders from the Warangal district, triggering a row in the party. The party leaders lodged complaints against Murali with the disciplinary committee of the Telangana Pradesh Congress Committee. Hyderabad travel guideTelangana tourism Last week, Murali appeared before the disciplinary committee headed by MP Mallu Ravi and gave his explanation. Murali is said to have alleged that Revenue Minister Ponguleti Srinivasa Reddy, who is also the in-charge minister for Warangal district, has been exhibiting an indifferent attitude towards his wife, Minister Konda Surekha. However, the disciplinary panel issued him a show-cause

notice. Murali has been asked to submit a written report. After giving explanation before the panel, Murali once again made certain remarks against a section of party leaders, including ministers. He demanded the resignation of turncoat MLAs who had defected from the BRS to the Congress, an apparent reference to MLA Kadiyam Srihari, the latter's daughter and Warangal MP Kadiyam Kavya and Parkal MLA Revuri Prakash Reddy. The Konda couple has considerable influence in Parkal, which was represented by Surekha from 2009 to 2012. Surekha, who now represents Warangal East constituency, and Murali are reportedly keen to field their daughter Sushmita from Parkal in the next Assembly elections. The constituency has been witnessing frequent clashes between supporters of the Konda couple and Prakash Reddy.

HDFC Bank CEO Jagdishan moves SC against Lilavati Trust's FIR; hearing today



New Delhi: HDFC Bank Managing Director and CEO, Sashidhar Jagdishan, has approached the Supreme Court to quash an FIR filed against him by the Lilavati Kirtilal Mehta Medical Trust, which runs Mumbai's Lilavati Hospital. A Bench of Justices M.M. Sundresh and K Vinod Chandran agreed to urgently hear the matter on Friday after senior advocate Mukul Rohatgi, representing Jagdishan, submitted that three Bombay High Court judges have recused themselves from hearing his plea to quash the criminal complaint. The allegations against Jagdishan stated that one of the erstwhile members of the Trust had paid him Rs 2.05 crore for the sole purpose of harassing the father of one of the current members of the trust. This transaction was allegedly recorded in a handwritten diary and was discovered by the current members. The Trust further accused the bank of offering Rs 1.5 crore in the name of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) to hospital staff, claiming it was an attempt to destroy evidence and interfere with the investigation. The controversy unfolded when HDFC Bank raised questions about financial mismanagement involving the Trust. As per the bank, trustee Prashant Mehta and his family members owe substantial amounts to HDFC Bank which were never repaid. They have now resorted to personal attacks on Jagdishan to intimidate and bully the bank. In a statement, the HDFC Bank said, "Recovery and enforcement actions have been taken by the Bank over two decades and at every stage Prashant Mehta and his other family members have launched numerous vexatious legal actions. The Bank is confident that our judicial process will recognise the fraudulent intention and devious objectives of the Trustee and officials of Lilavati Trust of tarnishing the image of the Bank and its MD and CEO." Following the episode, the Trust has filed a Rs 1,000 crore defamation case against Jagdishan, accusing him of making false and damaging statements against the organisation and its permanent trustee Prashant Mehta. The Trust said that the defamation suit was filed because of a series of "malicious, false and defamatory" comments made by Jagdishan, which they claim are part of a larger attempt to harm the image and functioning of the charitable institution.

Owning lands and the sentiments that go with it

Land is considered such a precious position that, in the Mahabharat, when the Pandavas ask for five villages, one for each of them, the Kaurava Crown Prince Duryodhana refuses to give them even so much of land as occupied by the point of a pin. There is, then, the other example of Lord Rama, who, after vanquishing Ravana, is requested by Vibhishana, brother of Ravana to rule Lanka. Rama famously replies that 'Mother and Motherland' are more important than even Heaven, and he would like to return to Ayodhya. The sense of deep attachment to Motherland and the long drawn, and frequently violent, conflicts that can arise when there is more than one claimant to the same land is best illustrated by today's Israel. The Israeli-Palestine dispute traces back to the late 19th century when Zionists sought to establish a homeland for the Jewish people in the Ottoman-controlled Palestine. After the Ottoman Empire lost the First World War, the British received a mandate to manage Palestine and promised the Jewish people a country. That country, today's Israel, declared independence in 1948. The creation of Israel remains a highly debated and sensitive issue, not susceptible straight answer. While there are those who maintain that it was necessary in order to facilitate self-




determination by the Jews after centuries of prosecution, and the other contention is that it has led to displacement and disposition of Palestinians and a continuing conflict. Another significant example of how countries value ownership of land relates to the interesting history of Alaska, which began with the Russian colonisation in the 18th century, and culminated in its sale to the United States in 1867, following America's acceptance of Russia's offer for a \$7.2 million settlement at that time. Coming to India, disputes regarding ownership of areas near the borders of states are quite common. Even after the lapse of close to seven decades after the event, a few hotspots of discontent and struggles continue to exist following the formation of states in 1956 on a linguistic basis. The primary border dispute between Odisha and Andhra Pradesh, for instance, centres on the Kotia

region, a group of 21 villages in the Eastern Ghats hills. Both states claim these villages, with Andhra Pradesh asserting their inclusion in Parvathipuram Manyam district, and Odisha claiming them as part of Koraput district. The dispute has been ongoing for decades, particularly after Andhra Pradesh laid claim to Kotia in 1971. Interestingly enough, there are even villages with two sarpanchs in office each elected by the same villagers, but voting in elections separately, conducted by the two states. On somewhat similar lines is the Karnataka-Maharashtra border dispute, arising from the disagreement over the administration of the city of Belgaum and the surrounding areas of Maharashtra. The dispute stems from the States Reorganisation Act of 1956, which redrew state boundaries based on linguistic demographics, leading to the inclusion

of the region in Karnataka. While Kannada speakers were the majority in the Marathi-speaking population also had a significant presence, leading to ongoing disagreements. Border disputes relating to ownership of land are not confined to internal issues between the states of the country. India has yet to resolve many such disputes of that nature with neighbouring countries such as Nepal, Bangladesh, and Sri Lanka. As is well known, following partition, a portion of the princely state of Jammu and Kashmir was occupied by Pakistan leading to the establishment of Pakistan Occupied Kashmir (POK). The region remains a source of conflict and continues to be a contentious issue between the two nations. As of June 12, no definitive resolution has been reached and it remains the bone of contention between the two nations. Likewise, the Sino-Indian border dispute is an ongoing territorial dispute over the sovereignty of two relatively large, and several smaller, separated pieces of territory between China and India. The India-Nepal border is yet another dispute primarily revolving around the Kalapani region, a 372 sq km area at the India-Nepal-China trijunction. Both countries claim this territory, with Nepal asserting it belongs to its Sudurpaschim province and India placing it within Uttarakhand. Similarly, the India-

Bangladesh border dispute, particularly regarding fencing and border demarcation, remains a contentious issue with ongoing challenges. While India has fenced a significant portion of the border, there remain many unfenced areas on account of objections from villagers, challenging terrain, and ongoing negotiations with Bangladesh. Belonging to the same category, is the highly vexatious issue of ownership of the Katchateevu Island, a matter of contention between Sri Lanka and India for over a century now, primarily on account of fishermen from both countries finding it a rich ground for their profession. I have great respect for the legal profession, members of both the bar and the bench. My father started off as a lawyer and retired as a judge of the High Court of the erstwhile composite Andhra Pradesh state. Many of my friends, relatives and professional acquaintances are all distinguished legal luminaries. All that notwithstanding, I simply could not pass up the temptation to end the article with this piece, which I came across the other day. God and the devil were in a dispute over a broken fence. If Bumrah was fit to play then surely you need to pick the best bowler in the world, says Finch

New Delhi: Former Australia captain Aaron Finch has voiced his disbelief over India's decision to rest Jasprit Bumrah for the second Test at Edgbaston, questioning the wisdom of leaving out the world's premier fast bowler in a crucial contest. With India trailing 0-1 in the five-match Tendulkar-Anderson Trophy series, the absence of Bumrah, who has been the leader of India's bowling attack, has sparked debate among experts and fans alike. "If Bumrah was fit to play then surely you need to pick the best bowler in the world?" Finch posted on X (formerly Twitter) shortly after the toss. "At the very least Kuldeep has to be in the XI if you're worried about taking 20 wickets. Yes, he might be more expensive but he's the next best attacking option!" India captain Shubman Gill revealed at the toss that Bumrah's exclusion was a workload management decision, with the management opting to pre-



serve him for the Lord's Test, where they feel the conditions will suit him better. Akash Deep was brought in as Bumrah's replacement to make his Test debut. India made two other changes, with Washington Sundar and Nitish Kumar Reddy coming in for B Sai Sudharsan and Shardul Thakur, thereby adding depth to the batting

line-up but arguably weakening the bowling unit. The decision, however, has raised eyebrows beyond Finch. Former England fast bowler Stuart Broad expressed surprise at seeing India take the field without their most potent weapon, especially after Bumrah's fine display in Leeds. "A week is a very good time off for a fast bowler. (Bumrah's omission) does surprise me and what also surprised me was him saying before the series he will only play three of the five Tests. You keep those cards close to your chest and play each week as it comes. They will definitely want Bumrah at Lord's because of the movement you can get through the air, so can they risk him here?" he said.

India 310/5 Shubman Gill Hits Century in 2nd Test vs England



India ended Day 1 of the second Test against England at 310/5 in 85 overs. Captain Shubman Gill led the innings with an unbeaten 114 (216 balls, 12 fours), supported by Yashasvi Jaiswal, who scored 87. At stumps, Ravindra Jadeja was batting on 41, having added a valuable 99-run stand with Gill. Karun Nair made 31, but looked scratchy. Chris Woakes took 2 wickets, while Stokes and Bashir got one each. India made three changes: Akash Deep, Washington Sundar, and Nitish Reddy came in for Bumrah, Shardul, and Sai Sudarshan. Kuldeep Yadav was left out. Session Highlights: Morning: England opted to bowl. KL Rahul fell early (2), but Jaiswal and Nair added 80 runs. Nair (31) was out just before lunch. India: 98/2 Afternoon: Jaiswal fell for 87. Gill stayed solid. Pant hit 25 before tea.

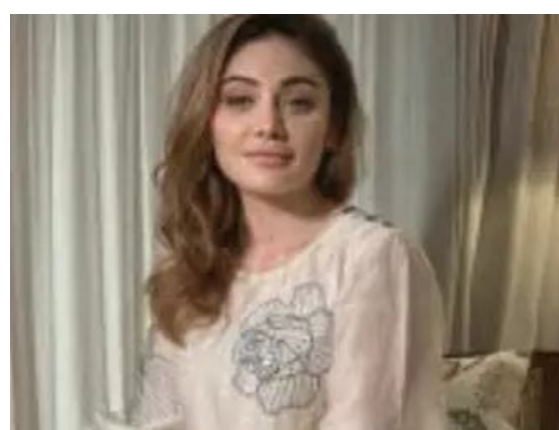

The sudden death of actress and reality TV star Shefali Jariwala at age 42 has brought renewed attention to the potential dangers of glutathione injections, widely used for skin lightening and anti-ageing. Shefali, best known for her role in Bigg Boss 13 and the iconic Kaanta Laga music video, reportedly received glutathione shots as part of a beauty treatment before her death on June 27. Though the exact cause of death is under investigation, reports suggest she may have suffered from low blood pressure, cardiac arrest, and gastric distress following an injection on an empty stomach. Medical experts are now urging the public to understand the risks and consult qualified professionals rather than following social media fads. What is Glutathione? Glutathione is a powerful antioxidant naturally produced in the body. It plays a key role in detoxifying the liver, boosting immunity, and protecting cells from oxidative stress. Due to its supposed skin-brightening properties, it has gained massive popularity in oral,



topical, and injectable forms. "People are drawn to glutathione because of its reputation as the 'master antioxidant,' but its cosmetic use, especially through injections, is not without serious risk," said Dr Sai Lahari Rachumallu, Dermatology Associate Consultant at Manipal Hospital, Bhubaneswar. Potential Side Effects and Misuse Dr Suchismitha Rajamanya, Lead Consultant and HoD of Internal Medicine at Aster Whitefield Hospital,

Bengaluru, emphasized that glutathione should only be used under strict medical supervision. "While it can help with liver issues, oxidative stress, or immune dysfunction, using it casually for cosmetic benefits—especially in unregulated settings—can be harmful," she said. Reported side effects include: Abdominal cramps and bloating Allergic reactions like rashes and itching Zinc deficiency affecting immunity and healing Risk of infection from improper injection techniques Kidney damage or renal toxicity from high doses Rare but serious conditions like Stevens-Johnson Syndrome "High-dose glutathione injections used over time can harm liver and kidney function, especially when combined with steroids or vitamin C for faster skin whitening," Dr Rajamanya added. Oral vs Injectable Glutathione Doctors also pointed out that oral glutathione has poor bioavailability—meaning only a small portion is absorbed by the body. This has led to a surge in intravenous injections, which deliver glu-

tathione directly into the bloodstream but significantly raise the stakes when it comes to side effects. "Injectables may offer faster results, but the risks are exponentially higher if used irresponsibly," Dr Rachumallu warned. Caution Against Unregulated Clinics Another growing concern is the ease with which such procedures are available in India—often without prescriptions, supervision, or proper hygiene. "People are influenced by celebrities and influencers, but health should never be compromised for beauty trends," said Dr Rajamanya. Experts urge people to seek proper clinical evaluations and avoid off-label or unapproved uses of any injectable treatments. They stress that while glutathione has therapeutic value, it should not be misused in the pursuit of fairness or youth.
