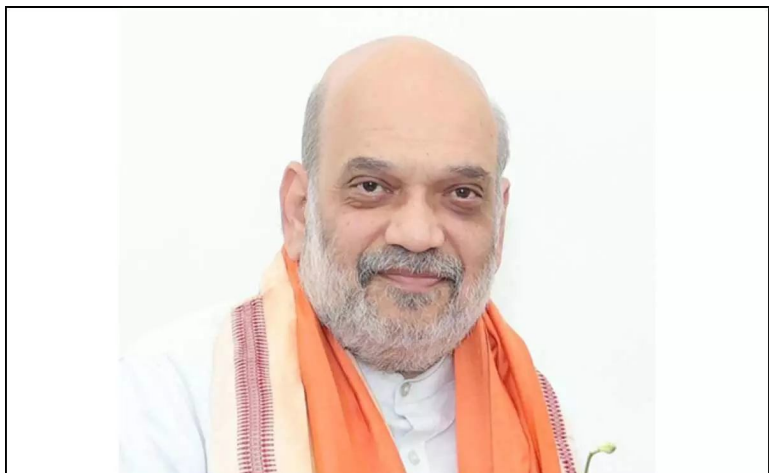




HM Amit Shah directs formation of Central team on Himachal natural disasters

New Delhi: Union Home Minister Amit Shah directed the formation of a multi-sectoral Central team given the frequency and intensity of natural disasters in Himachal Pradesh, an official said on Sunday. In a recent meeting, HM Shah was briefed about the increase in the frequency and intensity of cloud-bursts, flash floods, landslides and torrential rainfall, causing widespread loss of life, damage to infrastructure, livelihoods and environmental degradation. He immediately ordered the constitution of a multi-sectoral Central Team comprising experts from the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), Central Building Research Institute (CBRI) Roorkee, Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology (IITM) Pune, a Geologist, and the Indian Institute of



Technology (IIT) Indore, the official said. In the wake of floods, flash floods, and landslides during monsoon 2025 in different parts of Himachal Pradesh, the Central government has already deputed an Inter-Ministerial Central Team (IMCT) in advance, without waiting for their memorandum, for on-the-spot first-hand assessment of the damages, said an official statement. The IMCT

is visiting the affected areas of the state from July 18-21, and as many as 13 teams of NDRF are deployed in the State for rescue and relief operations. Under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, the Central Government stands firmly with the states in times of disasters without any discrimination, said the statement. In this direction, a high-level committee

chaired by HM Shah has already approved an outlay of Rs 2006.40 crore to Himachal Pradesh for recovery and reconstruction in areas affected by disasters like floods, landslides and cloud-bursts for 2023, and has also released the first instalment of Rs 451.44 crore on July 7, it said. To support the affected people, the Central government has already released the first instalment of the Central share of Rs 198.80 crore to Himachal Pradesh from the State Disaster Response Fund (SDRF) on June 18. The Central government has also provided all logistical assistance to all states, including Himachal Pradesh, including deployment of requisite National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) teams, Army teams and Air Force sup-

YSRCP MP Mithun Reddy Remanded in AP Liquor Case

YSR Congress Party (YSRCP) MP Mithun Reddy has been remanded until August 1 by the Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) court following his arrest in connection with the Andhra Pradesh liquor scandal.



The Special Investigation Team (SIT) stated that they would transfer him to Rajahmundry Central Jail after the court's ruling. Reddy, who is identified as A4 in the case, was subjected to over six hours of questioning before his arrest on Saturday. Following medical tests, he was deemed fit for court appearance, and he was subsequently presented before the ACB court. This session saw heated exchanges between lawyers from both sides. SIT representatives argued that further evidence is required from Reddy, asserting the need for police custody and requesting he be remanded to Guntur Sub-Jail. However, Reddy's legal team, citing his Y-category security, requested that he be housed in a special barracks at Nellore Jail for safety reasons. They also raised concerns about the failure to inform the legislative speaker of his arrest, given Reddy's role as a panel speaker.

YS Jagan Inquires About Mudragada Padmanabham's Health

Former Chief Minister and YSRCP president Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy has shown concern for the health of Kapu movement leader and YSRCP PAC member Mudragada Padmanabham. Following recent health issues, Jagan spoke with Mudragada's son, Giribabu, to inquire about his father's condition. In light of Mudragada's illness, Jagan suggested the possibility of airlifting him from Kakinada to Hyderabad if necessary, offering support for the airlift if required. Hyderabad real estate violence Mudragada Padmanabham has been unwell for some time and was admitted to Ahoobilam Hospital in Kakinada after experiencing respiratory problems. He was subsequently transferred to the local Medicover Hospital for advanced treatment on Saturday night at 10:30 PM.



According to medical staff, Mudragada's health is currently stable, and he is receiving ongoing treatment under the supervision of doctors. In a show of solidarity, YSRCP leaders Chirla Jaggi Reddy and Vanga Geetha also visited him to offer their support.

BJP tears into Rahul Gandhi over Trump's jet remark, calls him 'Pakistani propaganda campaigner'

New Delhi: The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) on Sunday launched a scathing attack on the Leader of Opposition in the Lok Sabha, Rahul Gandhi, for demanding a clarification from the government over US President Donald Trump's ambiguous statement about five jets being shot down during Operation Sindoor. Dubbing him as the "star campaigner" for Pakistan, the BJP accused Rahul Gandhi of undermining the bravery of the Indian armed forces and amplifying the narrative pushed by Pakistani media. The criticism followed Gandhi's reaction to Trump's remarks made during a private dinner on Friday. US President stated that five jets were shot down amid Operation Sindoor, India's military retaliation to the Pahalgam terror attack in April, however, he did not clarify whether the aircraft in question belonged to India or Pakistan. Rahul Gandhi took to X on Saturday to share the video clip of Trump's state-



ment and wrote in Hindi, "Modi ji, what is the truth behind the five jets? The country has a right to know." The BJP condemned the Congress leader's post, stating that while opposing Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Rahul Gandhi ends up questioning the integrity of the country and its armed forces. The party accused him of consistently

demoralising the armed forces with such remarks. Speaking to IANS, BJP MP Praveen Khandelwal said, "This is not the first time. It has been the history of Congress and opposition parties to question the bravery and valour of our armed forces. They should remember that this is PM Modi's India, and he knows how to make decisions and execute

them. Hence, if someone thinks that India will be dominated, it is wrong." BJP National General Secretary Tarun Chugh also hit out at Gandhi, saying, "Under the leadership of Rahul Gandhi and Mallikarjun Kharge, the Congress and the INDIA bloc have become star campaigners for the Pakistani army and Pakistani media propaganda. The only aim of the Opposition is to spread misinformation. This is unfortunate." Chugh added that by opposing the government's diplomatic and military moves, the Opposition was beginning to sound like "the tukde-tukde gang" and had started opposing the country itself. JD(U) MP Sanjay Kumar Jha echoed the sentiment and said that Gandhi's statements repeatedly hurt the morale of the armed forces. "They should be asked whether they are talking about India's interests or against India. Whenever they make such statements, it demoralises the country and the army. What

happened internationally? His party leaders also went in that delegation and presented their side, and the Indian Army held a press conference to explain everything. How did the Indian Army respond?" Jha asked. He went on to say, "While opposing PM Modi, he goes on to oppose the nation. He doesn't know when to speak on what. Even the nation has started to dismiss his statements. That is why Congress party repeatedly gets defeated in every election." Speaking to IANS, BJP MP Sanjay Jaiswal also criticised Gandhi, saying, "He did the same after Pulwama and the surgical strikes. He doesn't care for India. When the Galwan Valley clashes happened, he was busy dining with the Chinese ambassador. He also attended the wedding party of the son of George Soros, whose only goal is to destroy the democracy of India. One cannot expect patriotism from Rahul Gandhi."

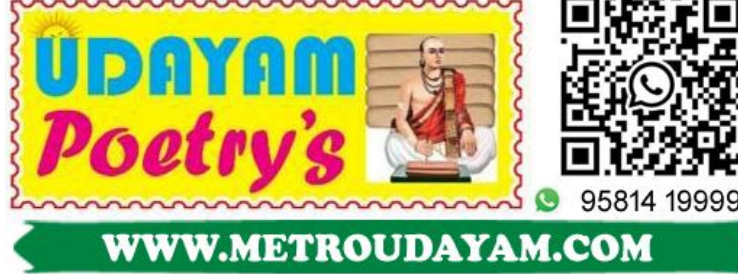

Heavy Rains Continue in Hyderabad: alerts issued



Hyderabad is experiencing heavy rainfall for the fourth consecutive day, with various areas such as Amberpet, Tarnaka, Uppal, Habsiguda, Malakpet, Chadarghat, Saidabad, Santosh Nagar, Himayat Nagar, Nallakunta, and Basheerbagh expected to receive further significant downpours. Hyderabad real estate A surface trough is developing in the Bay of Bengal, leading to a low-pressure system forming in the north Bay on July 24. The Meteorological Department has forecasted that rain will persist across the Telugu states for two days, with heavy rainfall likely in multiple districts within Telangana. In response to these weather conditions, the Meteorological Department has issued an orange alert for ten districts, including Hyderabad, as well as a yellow alert for an additional fifteen districts, indicating the potential for substantial rainfall throughout the region. In light of the heavy rains that recently battered Hyderabad, the Telangana government has been proactive in issuing warnings for residents in low-lying areas. Authorities have been instructed to assist in relocating individuals to safer zones. Chief Minister Revanth Reddy is regularly consulting with senior officials regarding the situation in Hyderabad and has made several key recommendations to mitigate risks associated with the rainfall. 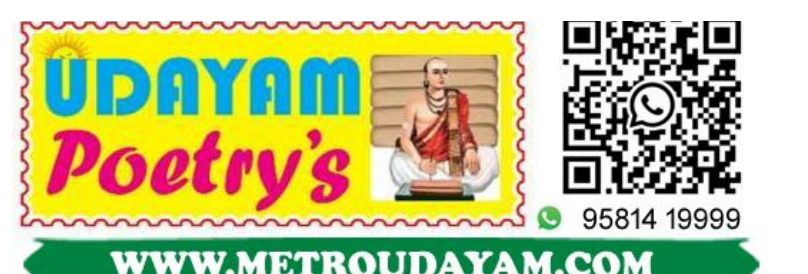

Heart diseases claim 1.5L lives in AP: Minister

Vijayawada: Minister for medical, health, and family welfare, Y Satya Kumar Yadav, revealed that 32 per cent of deaths in Andhra Pradesh are due to cardiovascular diseases (CVDs), which also account for 33 per cent of global deaths. Hyderabad shopping Speaking at a conference organised by the Cardiological Society of India (CSI) – Andhra Pradesh Chapter at NRI Medical College, Mangalagiri, on Saturday, he emphasised the state government's efforts to enhance cardiology services in government hospitals. Prominent doctors and CSI members participated in the conference which discussed the growing burden of heart diseases and potential solutions. The minister praised the CSI Andhra Pradesh Chapter and NRI Medical College for their contributions to heart health and patient care. Hyderabad shopping Referring to the government initiatives, Yadav



noted that under the STEMI programme, the life-saving Tenecteplase injection, worth Rs 45,000, is provided free during the critical 'golden hour' to cardiac patients. This initiative has saved over 3,000 lives in the state. Plans are underway to establish similar facilities for treating brain stroke cases, aligning with the STEMI programme's success. The minister attributed the rise in heart ailments to lifestyle changes, unhealthy diets, stress, tobacco, and alcohol consumption. He

stressed, "Our health is in our hands," advocating for a healthy lifestyle, nutritious diet, and positive thinking as foundations for good health. He also pointed out that Guntur Government General Hospital has successfully performed 110 open-heart surgeries and three heart transplants, calling it a commendable achievement. The minister urged private hospital doctors to volunteer for free surgeries in government hospitals at least once every 15 days, assuring that the NDA coalition government

values and honours such services. The government remains committed to strengthening healthcare infrastructure, he added. The event was attended by Dr P Chandrasekhar, vice-chancellor of NTR University of Health Sciences, Dr P John Satish, president of CSI Andhra Pradesh, Dr P S Srinivas Chowdary, organising secretary, and approximately 400 cardiologists, who discussed advancements in cardiac treatment and technology.

A video captured by an onlooker has gone viral on social media, showing Chiranjeevi and Nayanthara shooting a romantic number dressed in traditional attire. The footage, clearly recorded without consent, quickly



spread across multiple platforms, much to the dismay of the production team.

The makers — Shine Screens and Gold Box Entertainments — issued a firm statement expressing their disappointment over the unauthorized leak. They called it a breach of trust and an infringement of intellectual property. The production houses appealed to fans and the public to refrain from circulating such content, warning that further violations could result in legal action under anti-piracy and copyright laws.

"This act not only disrespects the hard work of the entire team

'Kingdom' gets pan-India release; set to release as 'Samrajya' in Hindi



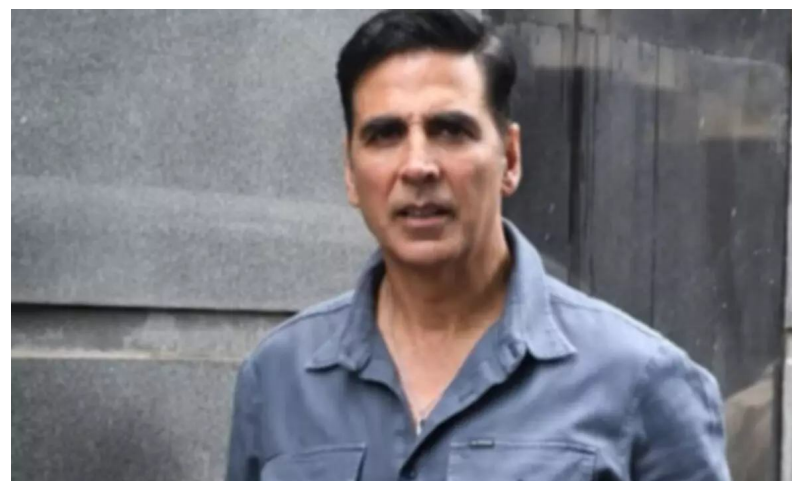

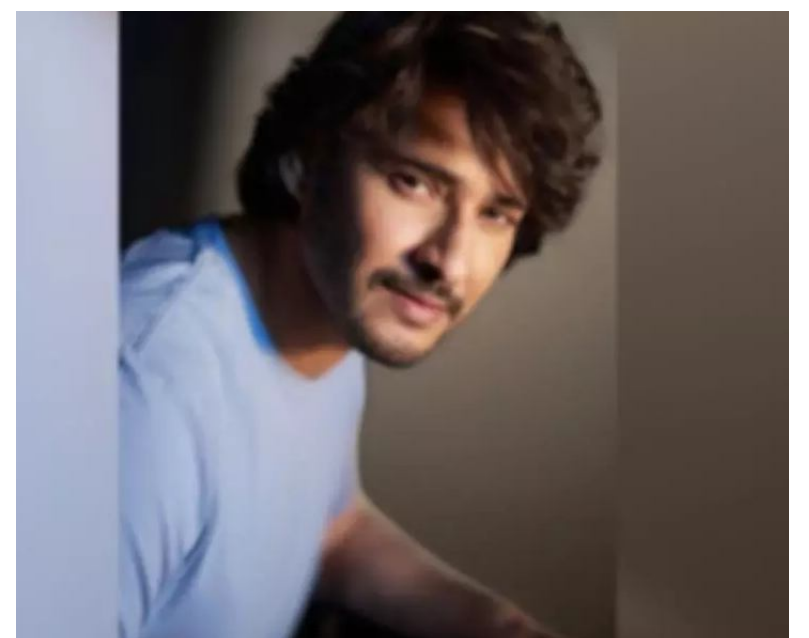
