



Simplified language in new Income Tax Bill a significant shift: FM Sitharaman

New Delhi: The use of simplified language in the new Income Tax Bill, 2025 marks a significant shift in making the provisions easier to understand, reducing the potential for misinterpretation and enhancing taxpayer-centricity and compliance, according to Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman. Urging the I-T Department to accelerate disposal of disputed tax demands pending before faceless appellate authorities and ensure timely resolution of litigation backlog, she said the Department should identify and withdraw departmental appeals falling below the revised monetary thresholds announced in Union Budget 2024-25 within 3 months. "Ensure timely processing of tax refunds and proactive and timely resolution of taxpayer grievances. Analyse the grievances and devise strategies not only to resolve the exist-



ing pendency but also to address the challenges that are causing the grievances in the first place," she said at an event here on the occasion of the 166th Income Tax Day. She also requested the Department to undertake region-wise performance reviews to help identify factors hindering performance and streamline operations through indicators such as grievance disposal,

Orders Giving Effect (OGE) issuance, rectification completion and processing of condonation cases under Section 119. The Finance Minister also congratulated the Department for its commendable work in efficiently drafting the New Income Tax Bill, 2025 within the stipulated timeline. She appreciated that the Department is actively addressing the recommendations received

from the Select Committee. Looking ahead, the Finance Minister emphasised the importance of continuing this momentum, reaffirming the potential for further technological advancements to enhance consistent and efficient service delivery. She encouraged the Department to reaffirm its duty to serve taxpayers with fairness, empathy and professionalism, earning public trust not just through policy but through conduct. "The CBDT must ensure that we provide adequate support to the staff and officers in terms of better workspaces and residential accommodations, so they don't have to commute in difficult situations and conditions. I would emphasise that the CBDT and the Department of Revenue prioritise the swift development of family accommodations and improved workspaces," said the Finance Minister.

Anam Ramanarayana Reddy visits Simhachalam Temple, Highlights Government Initiatives

Supreme Court rejects plea to increase Assembly seats in Andhra, Telangana



New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Friday declined to issue a direction to the Centre to increase the number of Assembly seats in Andhra Pradesh and Telangana. A Bench of Justices Surya Kant and N. Kotiswar Singh was dealing with pleas seeking implementation of the provisions under the Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act, 2014, which provided for delimitation of Assembly seats in the two successor states. In its judgment, the Justice Kant-led Bench refused to direct delimitation in Andhra Pradesh and Telangana, observing that Article 170 of the Constitution allows delimitation only after the first census conducted post-2026. Delimitation under Article 170 has been frozen until the first census after 2026, as per the 84th and 87th Constitutional Amendments. The apex court rejected the contention that the Centre's decision to carry out delimitation in Jammu and Kashmir, raising the number of Assembly constituencies from 83 to 90 based on the 2011 census, while excluding Telangana and Andhra Pradesh, was arbitrary and discriminatory. Highlighting the constitutional distinctions, it opined that J&K, having been reconstituted as a union territory, is regulated by parliamentary legislation and provisions of the Constitution under Chapter III of Part VI will not apply. In a related development, the Telangana Assembly, in a resolution passed in March this year, urged the Centre to increase the number of seats from 119 to 153, pursuant to the A.P. Reorganisation Act, 2014 and as per the latest census. Telangana food Hyderabad shopping The state Assembly urged the Union government to introduce necessary Constitutional amendments for this purpose in order to strengthen representative democracy. Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy pointed out that the Centre, in reply to his question when he was a member of the previous Lok Sabha, had stated that the delimitation of Assembly constituencies would be done only after the 2026 census. Reddy slammed the Centre for its double standards on the issue. He said the Centre increased the number of Assembly constituencies from 83 to 90 as per the 2011 census in Jammu and Kashmir, and, in Sikkim, a resolution was passed in the Cabinet in 2018, and the process of delimitation of constituencies is currently underway.

PM Modi lands in Male to attend Maldives' 60th Independence Day as guest of honour

Male: Prime Minister Narendra Modi arrived at Velana International Airport in Male, Maldives, on Friday, to a ceremonial welcome, marking the beginning of a high-profile state visit to the island nation. He was received by Maldivian President Dr Mohamed Muizzu at the airport amidst traditional songs and chants of "Vande Mataram", reflecting the warmth and cultural ties between the two countries. PM Modi is visiting the Maldives at the invitation of President Muizzu to participate as the Guest of Honour at the country's 60th Independence Day celebrations, a significant diplomatic gesture symbolising deepening bilateral ties. This is PM Modi's third visit to the Maldives and notably the first by any head of state or government during President Muizzu's tenure. Also Read - PM Modi's much-awaited Maldives visit to strengthen development partnership, solidify ties: Indian envoy The Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) noted, "The two leaders will also take stock of



the progress in the implementation of the India-Maldives Joint Vision for a 'Comprehensive Economic and Maritime Security Partnership', adopted during the State Visit of the President of Maldives to India in October 2024." The visit highlights India's continued commitment to its 'Neighbourhood First' policy and the broader strategic framework of Vision MAHASAGAR, aimed at fostering regional cooperation and security in the Indian Ocean. The discussions between the two leaders are expected to focus on key areas such as infrastructure devel-

opment, defence cooperation, and economic connectivity, strengthening the multi-faceted partnership between the two countries. India and the Maldives share longstanding ethnic, linguistic, cultural, religious, and commercial links. India was among the first countries to recognize Maldivian independence in 1965 and establish diplomatic relations. Over the years, the relationship has remained close, cordial, and free of political contention. India's prompt military assistance during the 1988 coup attempt in the Maldives built enduring trust. The swift withdrawal of Indian troops afterwards helped assure Maldivian sovereignty, reinforcing India's image as a reliable partner. Further, this visit by the Indian Prime Minister carries profound significance as it coincides with the 60th anniversary of the Maldives' independence, along with the 60th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between the Maldives and India, according to the official press release.

Tensions flare up between TG, AP over water release from Nagarjuna Sagar

Nagarjuna Sagar: Dispute escalated between the states of Andhra Pradesh (AP) and Telangana over water sharing from the Nagarjuna Sagar Project, specifically concerning the release of water into the right canal of the project. AP irrigation officials have released water without permission from the Krishna River Management Board (KRMB). Telangana officials have expressed strong objections and lodged complaint against AP irrigation authorities for releasing water without proper authorization. In response, AP officials maintain that they have obtained the required KRMB approval before releasing water for irrigation purposes. Hyderabad shopping Telangana food The Nagarjuna Sagar reservoir currently has a water storage capacity exceeding 570 feet, making water release necessary for



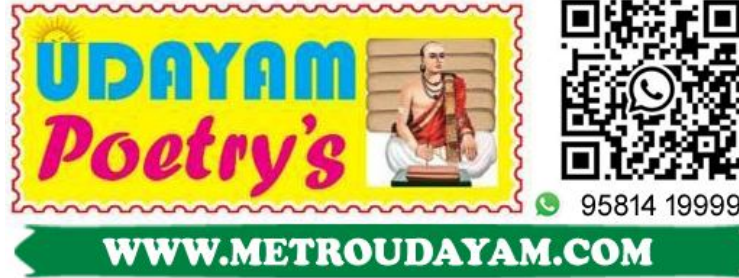
ongoing irrigation needs. Telangana officials argue that AP's unilateral water release into the right canal, without prior information or coordination with Telangana authorities, violates established agreements and protocols governed by KRMB. This has triggered tensions, with Telangana complained to KRMB for justice. This issue touches upon the broader context of water sharing in the Krishna River basin, where both states rely on the Nagarjuna Sagar reservoir for irrigation and drinking water across more than 2.3 million

acres. Seasonal factors are significant, as the monsoon season replenishes reservoirs, potentially leading to further water releases downstream. The issue highlights the cyclical nature of these disputes, as water management during the agricultural season is critical. The KRMB plays a central role as the regulatory authority overseeing water allocation and distribution between the two states. Telangana accuses AP of bypassing this regulatory mechanism, while AP insists on compliance with KRMB's directives. The situation remains fluid, with stakeholders awaiting KRMB's response to Telangana's complaint. The issue underscores the unresolved nature of the water sharing conflict and the need for cooperative dialogue to manage the Krishna basin water resources effectively.

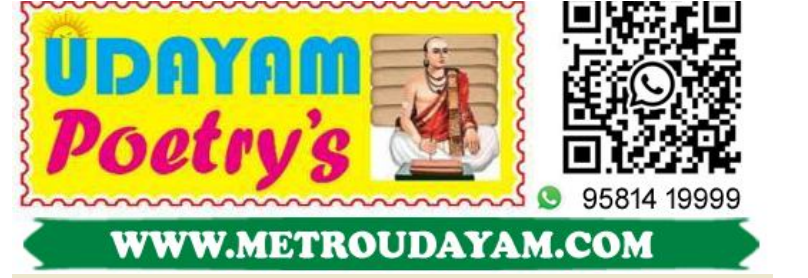

Srisaillam temple receives Hundi offer- ings of over Rs 4.17 cr



Srisaillam: The authorities of Sri Bhramarambha Mallikarjuna Swamy temple at Srisaillam have completed the counting of offerings received in the temple hundis over a 27-day period, from June 27 to July 23, 2025. DRM, WALTAIR INSPECTS NAUPADA-VISAKHAPATNAM SECTION

'Bravery is one thing, but the team must take care of Pant': Surinder Khanna

Amid the praise of bravery and courage for Rishabh Pant's act to come out to bat again after severely hurting his right foot, former India cricketer Surinder Khanna had a distinct view and felt the team should have guided the wicketkeeper-batter to take care of himself after a severe injury. Pant, who was retired hurt on 37 after being hit on the right toe by Chris Woakes in the final session of the opening day, came out to bat again despite the reports of a fracture on his right foot. When Pant walked out to bat again at Old Trafford on Thursday, the crowd gave him a rousing welcome and former cricketers also hailed his courageous act of putting his body on the line for the team. "At the moment, it was brave - the way he played that reverse sweep and the ball struck his toe. Now, what the medical reports say is all speculation. The fact that he came out to bat after that was



very brave. After his car accident, the issues he'd faced should be monitored closely by the medical team to ensure it doesn't turn into a career-threatening injury. It's good to be brave, but at the same time, for longevity, it's important to be careful," Khanna told IANS on Friday. The veteran cricketer remarked that Rishabh Pant should have been rested follow-

ing the blow to his finger during the Lord's Test, and suggested that Dhruv Jurel - who is currently handling wicketkeeping duties at Old Trafford due to Pant's foot injury - should have replaced him earlier. "And on this tour, this is the second successive time Jurel is doing the wicketkeeping duties. If he's so competent, he should have been played, and Pant

should've been given rest. In the previous match too, when Pant injured his finger, it was Jurel who kept wickets. This is turning into a mockery. Either you send Pant to bat at No. 10 or 11... He was playing alongside Washington Sundar. "If I talk about cricket — if I'm out there batting and I want to take a quick single, he (Pant) wouldn't be able to make it. Even sending Pant to bat at No. 11 would have been a brave move. Bravery is one thing, but the team must take care of him. Courage is fine from his side, but not to the extent that it ends up damaging his foot. If that happens, his movement will be restricted, and recovery takes a long time," Khanna explained. The former wicketkeeper-batter further criticised the medical team's approach for not guiding Pant properly in the current situation and called it "foolish". "You're playing for the country, and

that's absolutely fine—but in this situation, when you came out to bat, it didn't really benefit the team much. You were on 37-38 and made it to 50 - that goes into your personal record... Sometimes, being brave can actually be foolish. It shouldn't reach a point where you miss the next match or are out for 2-4 months... "You're playing for India, not in the IPL, where people might assume you're doing it for money... It's not like the team went on to post a score of 400-450 either... Our medical team needs to be good enough to guide the player properly in such situations," Khanna said. Pant's 54 guided India to 358, just adding 17 runs to his total after returning to bat again with an injured foot. In response, half-centuries from Ben Duckett and Zak Crawley guided England to 225/2 in 46 overs at stumps, trailing India by 133 runs.
