

Election for Vice President to Be Held on September 9, Announces EC

New Delhi: The Election Commission of India has announced that the election for the post of Vice President will be held on September 9, if required. The polling and counting of votes will take place on the same day. The announcement follows the resignation of Jagdeep Dhankhar from the post on July 21, nearly two years before the scheduled end of his term in August 2027. According to the election schedule released by the Commission, the last date for filing nominations is August 21, while the last date for withdrawal of candidatures is August 25. The Commission has also finalized the electoral college for the 2025 Vice Presidential election, which consists of elected and nominated members of the Rajya Sabha and elected mem-



bers of the Lok Sabha. The list of electoral college members will be available for purchase at the Election Commission office following the formal notification of the election. As per Article 68(2) of the Constitution, a vacancy in the office of the Vice

President—caused by resignation, removal, death, or any other reason—must be filled "as soon as may be." The newly elected Vice President will serve a full term of five years from the date of assuming office. The election will be conducted

through a single transferable vote system using proportional representation, with voting by secret ballot. Members of the electoral college are required to indicate their preferences against the names of the candidates. To contest the election, a candidate must be a citizen of India, at least 35 years of age, and eligible for election to the Rajya Sabha. The ruling National Democratic Alliance (NDA) holds a clear numerical advantage in the upcoming vote. Of the 543 seats in the Lok Sabha, one (Basirhat, West Bengal) is currently vacant. In the Rajya Sabha, there are five vacant seats—four from Jammu and Kashmir and one from Punjab. The Punjab vacancy was created after Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) MP Sanjiv Arora resigned following his election to

the state assembly in a recent bypoll. Taking these vacancies into account, the effective strength of the electoral college stands at 782. A candidate will need at least 391 votes to secure a win, assuming full participation. The BJP-led NDA currently has the support of 293 MPs in the Lok Sabha and 129 in the Rajya Sabha, giving the coalition a total of 422 members—well above the required majority. With the NDA holding a strong position, the Vice Presidential election is likely to reinforce the ruling alliance's influence over the upper echelons of government. However, the final outcome will depend on how parties position themselves and whether any surprise alliances emerge in the coming weeks.

CM Rekha Gupta launches door-to-door cleanliness drive; says Delhi needs new Secretariat

New Delhi: Delhi Chief Minister Rekha Gupta on Friday launched a month-long door-to-door cleanliness campaign from Inter-State Bus Terminus (ISBT) Kashmiri Gate, aiming to improve sanitation and workplace conditions across the national Capital. The campaign will be conducted across all districts of Delhi and involve active participation from government officials, civic agencies, and local communities. Leading by example, the Chief Minister personally took part in the cleanliness drive by sweeping the premises at the ISBT, where she also inspected the condition of the offices and public facilities. Expressing concern over the deteriorating infrastructure and unhygienic conditions at government offices, CM Gupta said, "If our officers are working in such conditions, how will they benefit anyone? Water is dripping from here, and this is where an officer's



chair is placed. This is the kind of furniture provided, where people are expected to sit and work." While inspecting the ISBT office area, the Chief Minister was visibly dissatisfied with the poor maintenance and lack of basic facilities, calling for immediate structural reforms and better upkeep of public infrastructure. In a significant

announcement during the campaign launch, CM Gupta said the capital urgently requires a new secretariat building. "Delhi needs a new Secretariat. From today itself, we will begin identifying suitable locations so that all departments can operate from a single place," she stated. The month-long campaign will focus not only on residential and commercial areas but also on government buildings, transport hubs, and public service offices, aiming to set a new standard for urban cleanliness in the national Capital. The Chief Minister urged citizens and officials alike to treat cleanliness as a shared responsibility. The initiative is being coordinated with municipal bodies and is expected to involve school-children, Non-Government Organisations, Resident Welfare Associations, and volunteers in the coming weeks.

Chandrababu holds teleconference with party leaders, urges to promote welfare schemes

Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu has announced that the coalition government will deposit ₹20,000 into the accounts of farmers along with the support provided by the Central government. During a teleconference with party MLAs, ministers, MPs, MLCs, and coordinators, the CM reiterated the launch of two key welfare schemes — Annadata Sukhibhav and free bus travel for women — both of which will be implemented this month. He called on party leaders and activists to actively participate in and promote these initiatives among the public. Naidu emphasised the need for better communication of government programmes, noting that past electoral losses were partly due to the party's failure to highlight its achievements. He assured that all nominated posts would be filled shortly and reaffirmed his commitment to rewarding dedicated party workers with appropriate positions.



Telangana govt to distribute ration cards from today in Hyderabad

The government has finalised the schedule for distributing new food security cards (ration cards) in Hyderabad district. District In-charge Minister for the Transport Department, Ponnampati Prabhakar Goud, announced that



arrangements have been made to distribute the cards at three locations in the city. The new ration cards will be distributed from 1 to 3 August to eligible individuals. The distribution will commence in the Khairatabad, Cantonment, and Jubilee Hills assembly constituencies. Hyderabad tourism A total of 55,378 new ration cards have been prepared, benefitting 2,01,116 individuals. Additionally, by including 1,37,947 eligible people under the existing old ration cards, the overall number of beneficiaries will rise to 2,32,297. Collector Harichandana Dasari assured that the distribution process will proceed smoothly, ensuring that all eligible citizens receive their new food security cards.

First unit of Yadadri Thermal Power station dedicated to nation

Damaracharla, Nalgonda: The first unit of the Yadadri Thermal Power Station (YTPS), with a capacity of 800 MW, has been officially dedicated to the nation by Ministers Bhatti Vikramarka, Uttam Kumar Reddy, Komatireddy Venkat Reddy, and Adluri Lakshman. Telangana Legislative Council Chairman Gutta Sukhender Reddy was also present at the commissioning ceremony. Telangana travel guide On the occasion, the ministers laid the foundation stone for an integrated township at the YTPS site, which will be developed on 55 acres at an estimated cost of ₹970 crore. As part of the Vanamahotsavam celebrations, the ministers planted Ikka saplings on the premises. They later interacted with landless residents in the area and assured them of employment opportunities by 15th August. The YTPS project was initially



undertaken by the previous government in 2015, aiming to build five units of 800 MW each. Construction began in 2017, with the original project estimate of ₹30,000 crore now seeing a cost overrun of ₹5,000 crore. The second unit of the plant was inaugurated by the Chief Minister on 7th December last year. The third and fourth

units are nearing completion and are expected to be operational by the end of this year. The fifth and final unit is scheduled for completion by March 2026. To accommodate plant employees, a separate residential township will also be constructed over 60 acres in Dubbatanda, located three kilometres from the plant site.

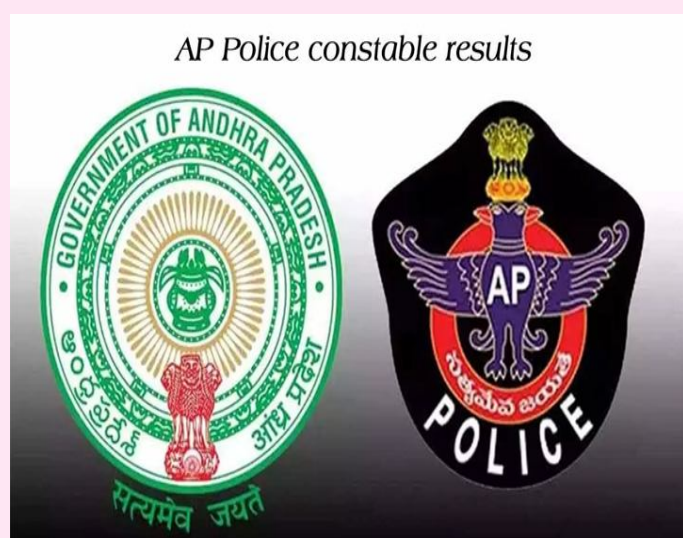

Govt flayed for adopting 'oppressive' measures

Anantapur: YSRCP Anantapur district president Ananta Venkatarami Reddy strongly criticised the government's actions during YS Jagan Mohan Reddy's visit to Nellore, calling them oppressive and politically motivated. 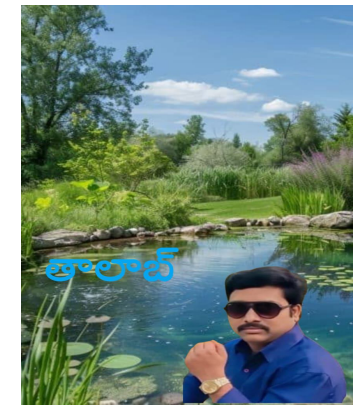

Woakes ruled out of remainder of 5th Test with shoulder injury



London: England's experienced seamer Chris Woakes has been ruled out of the remainder of the ongoing fifth Test of the Anderson-Tendulkar Trophy against India after injuring his shoulder on opening day, the England and Wales Cricket Board (ECB) said on Friday. "England seamer Chris Woakes will continue to be monitored throughout the remainder of the Fifth Test at The Kia Oval, following a left shoulder injury sustained on day one of the match against India," ECB said in a statement. "At this stage, the injury has ruled him out of any further participation in the Test. A further assessment will be conducted at the conclusion of the series," it added. In the 57th over of India's first innings on Day 1, Woakes walked off the field after he landed awkwardly on his left shoulder and stayed down clutching it while saving a ball hit to the boundary by Karun Nair at long-off. He received medical attention from England physio, before using his sweater as a makeshift sling on his way to the dressing room. Woakes bowled 14 overs on Day 1, returning figures of 1 for 46. His injury added to England's growing list of concerns, with the team already missing several key players for the all-important final Test, including captain Ben Stokes, who was ruled out of the series decider due to a right shoulder injury. Woakes' absence would leave England with an attack short of experience, with the rest of the attack having a combined 18 Test caps for England. The 35-year-old has been a workhorse for England throughout the series, one of only two seamers — along with India's Mohammed Siraj — to feature in all five matches. Across the series, he has bowled 181 overs and taken 11 wickets at an average of 52.18.

Sourav Ganguly Says India Missed Chance by Not Playing Kuldeep Yadav in Lord's, Manchester Tests



Former Indian captain Sourav Ganguly said India missed a good chance by not including spinner Kuldeep Yadav in the Lord's and Manchester Test matches. He believes spinners can be very useful on the fourth and fifth days of a Test. Ganguly said, "Kuldeep should have played at Lord's and Manchester. Even in Birmingham, he could have helped. Without a top spinner, it's hard to get the other team out in the last two days." He explained that England could not take 20 wickets in the fourth Test because they didn't have strong spinners. Even after bowling 143 overs on the final day, the match ended in a draw. Ganguly also mentioned famous spinners like Shane Warne, Muralitharan, Kumble, and Ashwin, saying good teams always have strong spinners.
