



Rain, Thunderstorms Forecast Across Telangana for Three Days



Hyderabad: The Hyderabad Meteorological Centre has forecast light to moderate rainfall accompanied by thunder, lightning, and gusty winds across several districts in Telangana over the next three days, starting Thursday. According to the Met Centre, showers are expected on Thursday in the districts of Yadadri Bhuvanagiri, Rangareddy, Mahabubnagar, Nagarkurnool, Wanaparthy, Jogulamba and Gadwal. On Friday, rainfall is likely in Jangaon, Siddipet, Yadadri Bhuvanagiri, Vikarabad, Mahabubnagar, Nagarkurnool, Narayanpet and Gadwal. The Centre further noted that on the 9th of August, Kumuram Bheem, Nirmal, Nizamabad and Nagarkurnool districts could experience rainfall. Residents are advised to stay alert and follow local weather advisories.

Nara Lokesh wishes on National Handloom Day, announces free power upto 200 units



Amaravati: Andhra Pradesh Education and IT Minister Nara Lokesh hailed the handloom sector as a symbol of India's rich cultural heritage, highlighting its global reputation and its vital role in providing employment second only to agriculture. Marking National Handloom Day, the Minister announced a series of welfare measures aimed at supporting handloom workers. From today, families of handloom workers will receive 200 units of free electricity per month, while spinning looms will be eligible for up to 500 units. In addition, the government will bear the burden of GST on handloom fabrics to ease the financial strain on artisans. "The coalition government stands firmly with the weavers," said Mr Lokesh, as he extended his wishes to all handloom artisans across the state.

CM Revanth Reddy Vows to Fight for 42% BC Reservation Bill

Telangana's Chief Minister Revanth Reddy has reiterated his commitment to securing the 42 percent reservation bill for Backward Classes (BCs), pressing the central government for swift approval from the President. Speaking to reporters in Delhi on Thursday, he expressed confidence that the President would make an independent decision regarding the bill. Revanth Reddy stated, "We will wait until this evening for an appointment with the President. If we are not granted time, it would appear that the Prime Minister has exerted pressure on us." He outlined the various strategies to implement the 42 percent reservation, emphasising the urgency of the

situation. Telangana tourism The Chief Minister highlighted three potential pathways for enacting BC reservations. The first involves issuing a Government Order (GO) to override the previous administration's 50 percent ceiling on reservations. He believes such an order would face legal challenges but could be stayed in court. However, he pointed out that this approach may not be feasible for the upcoming local elections. The second strategy suggests delaying local elections, although he cautioned that this could halt central funding, jeopardising essential services in rural areas. The final avenue involves advocating for 42 percent representation for BCs



within party allocations, seeking support from other political parties to ensure equitable representation.

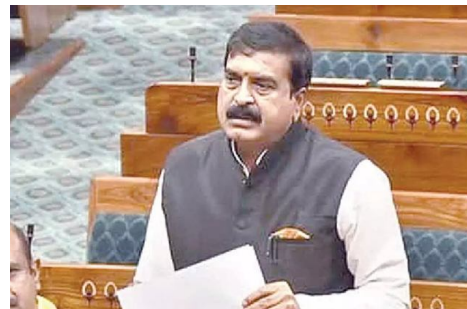
CM Chandrababu to Launch Schemes on National Handloom Day in Mangalagiri

Mangalagiri: Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu is set to visit Mangalagiri today (Thursday) to take part in a series of official programmes, including the celebrations for the 11th National Handloom Day. As part of the day's events, the Chief Minister will launch three key welfare schemes: free electricity for eligible weavers, GST reimbursement by the government, and a thrift fund initiative aimed at supporting the handloom sector. A During his visit, Mr Naidu will tour the Mangalagiri Handloom Development Centre, where he will inspect looms and examine handloom fabrics created by local artisans. A review meeting on creative policy is scheduled to take place in the afternoon at the Chief Minister's camp office in Undavalli. Later in the evening, Mr Naidu will attend the P4 programme at the Novotel hotel in Vijayawada.



MP urges MPLADS Fund hike & GST exemption

Anantapur: MP Ambica Lakshmi Narayana has called for urgent reforms to the Members of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme (MPLADS), highlighting the need to increase annual allocations and exempt development works from GST. Speaking in the Lok Sabha, he pointed out that the current allocation of Rs 5 crore per MP, unchanged since 2011, has become insufficient due to inflation, rising construction costs, and growing public needs. In large rural constituencies like Anantapur, where drinking water scarcity, poor road connectivity, and lack of basic infrastructure persist, the existing funds are barely enough to meet essential requirements. He strongly opposed the imposition of GST on development works carried out under MPLADS, stating that these should be treated on par with other welfare schemes implemented by the central government, which enjoy GST exemption. The MP urged the Union Finance Minister and the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation to consider the demands, including increasing of MPLADS funds from the current Rs 5 crore to at least Rs 10 crore per MP annually, provide complete GST exemption for all MPLADS-funded works. He stressed that these measures would significantly strengthen rural development in backward regions such as Rayalaseema, enabling MPs to address critical local needs more effectively.

A condolence meeting has been held by Vishwambara Sahithya Samastha at Sanath institute of English, at Jangaon town by the Founder & President Renukuntla Murali, poet, writer & Counseling psychologist, Skill development trainer & EFT certified trainer speaking about Dr. P.J. Sudhakar, who created a world record by obtaining 110 academic degrees from a child labourer he had enthusiasm in development of education, died in Visakhapatnam, Lets pray for their families our deep tribute. PJ Sudhakar was born on 1st December 1957, got the world record by attaining more than one hundred and ten degrees. Maharashtras Shrikant Jichkar of Nagpur has 25 degrees and Karnataka's Yajneswaran has 32 degrees. Sudhakar ji is the only person after him who

has so many degrees. Prof. Dr. P.J. Sudhakar holds the world record in public relations, social services, criminology, economics, law, political science, history, international relations and many other fields by achieving more than 110 degrees. He holds degrees in almost all academic fields except engineering. He received the 104th Degree Convocation from the Chief Justice of India from the National School of Law, Bangalore on August 31, 2014. He had a great passion for enhancement of educational qualifications. He had written above 10 books and received 25 state & international awards for his achievements. A child labourer-turned-government employee, Dr Sudhakar worked as a labourer-turned-lawyer, journalist, scientist, director of All India Radio and Doordarshan in Hyderabad, professor, human rights activist and in many other fields. Dr.

Sudhakar is raising awareness in the society on various issues. He is the founder of the National Mental Health Movement. Dr Sudhakar is a multi-faceted personality. Born to agricultural labourers Moses and Kanthamma in Pedagadi village of Pendurthi mandal in Visakhapatnam district of Andhra Pradesh, Sudhakar was poor he didn't stop his education, he did many degrees & began grazing buffaloes for a monthly salary to sustain his life, and also attended to agricultural work. However, at the age of 20, he joined as a junior assistant in CBI. Since then, he had bagged ten degrees a year through correspondence courses from open universities. In the 1980s, he received his first degree in law. So far, Sudhakar had received more than one hundred and ten degrees. As of June 2014, he did his MA Anthropology from IGNOU and a PhD in Human

Rights from Dr BR Ambedkar University. He contested for the post of President of India in 2012; he filed his nomination papers on 29 July 2012, he had 35 years of experience in teaching, administration and mass media. He worked in several organizations like Central Bureau of Investigation-CBI, DCI, MMTC, Press Information Bureau (PIB), All India Radio, Doordarshan, Publications Division and Ministry of Defence. He passed the civil services examination in 1987 and joined the Indian Information Service (IIS). He was the Additional Director General of the Press Information Bureau (PIB) in Bhopal. He was the author and historian of the 2012 Jnanpith Award-winning Ravuri Bharadwaja Official Biography. He led workshops on media, news writing, protection of wetlands, RTI, rights of minorities,

empowerment of persons with disabilities, intellectual property rights and social issues. Personality development classes were conducted to motivate the youth, especially from the weaker sections of the society. He was advisor for Institute of Education Research and Development, National Vice President - Global Forum for Public Relations and Founder President - National Public Relation Association of India. He had been a visiting or guest professor at several Indian universities, did his research on Dr. Ravuri Bharadwaja's writings, poems, novels and life. A book on his life titled Smruthi Sahitya Lu This Century Great Writer Dr. Ravuri Bharadwaja was released by the Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh Nallari Kiran Kumar Reddy on 2 May 2013 at Ravindra Bharathi, Hyderabad.

ACP Venkatarao's Nexus: Support to Builder Karthik's Illegal Construction



Builder Karthik is allegedly causing significant loss to government revenue, and locals are demanding strict action to stop such illegal constructions. In Zone 6 of GVMC, an additional floor is reportedly being constructed illegally at Sheelanagar without proper permission, under the supervision of Town Planning ACP Venkatarao. However, no action is being taken against the construction. In recent times, serious allegations of corruption have been surfacing against ACP Venkatarao in GVMC Zone 6. It is being alleged that oral permissions are being granted to builders to construct extra floors without approval, and large sums of money are being collected in return. Even staff within the zonal office are reportedly aware of these dealings. The most recent case involves a builder at Sheelanagar who is allegedly constructing an additional floor without official approval. No Transferable Development Rights (TDR) have been submitted either, further adding to the suspicion of corruption. Reports suggest that ACP Venkatarao accepted around ₹5 lakhs from the builder for allowing the construction. Moreover, it is being alleged that TPO Varaprasad is acting as a benami for these corrupt dealings. It is said that both officials go to various construction sites within the channel limits and collect bribes based on the percentage of work. In the Sheelanagar building case too, both ACP and TPO reportedly used their influence to allow illegal construction. Complaints regarding this construction have already been filed at the zonal office by locals. However, all these complaints have seemingly been ignored or buried. Locals are now demanding an immediate, high-level investigation by an unauthorized (independent) committee into the actions of these officials and the construction activities.

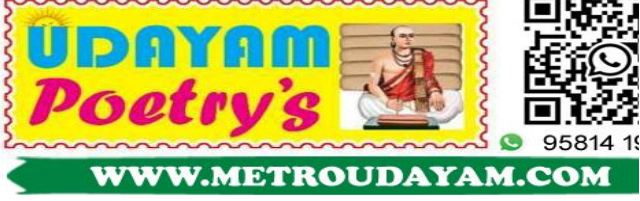

हमारे देश में जो मान सम्मान स्त्री को दिया गया उसकी बात ही कुछ और है। यहां के जीवनदाई नदियों को भी हम मां कहते हैं। हम जन्म से सीखी हुई भाषा को भी मातृ भाषा ही कहते हैं, पितृ भाषा नहीं कहते। यहां तक के हमारे जन्म भूमी को मातृ भूमी कहते हैं। हमारे देश को मातृ देश कहते हैं। हम जब हमारे देश का जय जयकार भी करते हैं तो भारत माता की जय के नारे के साथ जय जयकार करते हैं। यह है हमारी संस्कृति, हमारी सभ्यता और हमारे देश का गौरव। लेकिन इससे हटकर भी एक सत्य है जो इसके उलट है।

जहां स्त्री को इतना गौरव है वहीं स्त्री के अधिकारों का हनन भी हुआ है। स्त्री जाती पर अन्याय और अत्याचार भी हुआ है और हो भी रहा है। लेकिन इस अन्याय, अत्याचार में धर्म, देश और संस्कृति का कोई हाथ नहीं है। फिर भी इस में धर्म को घसीटना कौनसी अक्लमंदी है? कहने का मतलब यही है के हमने एक तरफ स्त्री की गरिमा को बहुत ऊंचा रखा लेकिन दूसरी तरफ उसी स्त्री जाती का अपमान करने वाले भी हम ही हैं।

वैसे ही इस्लाम में भी स्त्री को बहुत सारे अधिकार दिए गए। विवाह स्त्री के इच्छा के विरुद्ध नहीं हो सकता। विवाह के लिए जिस तरह पुरुष की सहमती होना चाहिए उसी तरह स्त्री की सहमती को भी अनिवार्य ठहराया गया। स्त्री विवाह प्रस्ताव को अपने स्वेच्छा से स्वीकार या अस्वीकार करने का अधिकार रखती है। इसके व्यतिरिक्त और भी पत्नी के अधिकार बहुत हैं, इन अधिकारों को वैवाहिक संबंधों में भी न्याय, सम्मान और समानता की बुनियाद पर रखा गया है।

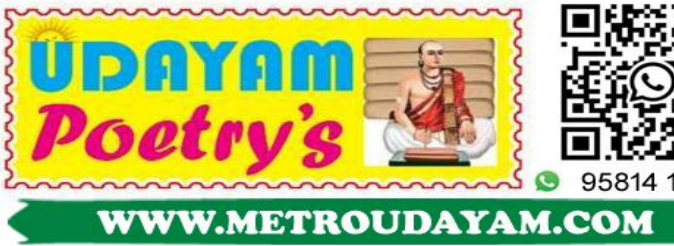
किसी कारण पति और पत्नी एक साथ नहीं रह सकते तो दोनों को भी तलाक (विवाह विच्छेद करने) का अधिकार दिया गया है। अगर पुरुष स्त्री को छोड़ना चाहता है तो उसे तलाक और स्त्री खुद पुरुष को छोड़ना चाहती है तो उसे खुलआ कहा जाता है। अपने न पसंद विवाह संबंध को विच्छेद करने का अधिकार तलाक के रूप में जैसा पुरुष को दिया गया वैसे ही खुलआ के रूप में स्त्री को भी दिया गया है।

पवित्र कुरआन में तलाक की चर्चा सविस्तार से है। लेकिन इसे अंतिम उपाय माना जाता है। कुरान में तलाक के बारे में कुछ नियम और मार्गदर्शन दिए गए हैं, जिनमें पती और पत्नी दोनों के अधिकार और जिम्मेदारियां शामिल हैं। तलाक एक वैध प्रक्रिया होने के बावजूद निंदनीय माना जाता है। जब विवाह में सौहार्द, सद्भाव और प्रेम समाप्त हो जाता है तब पती, पत्नी को अंतिम पर्याय के रूप में तलाक का पर्याय दिया गया अधिकार है। अगर इस अधिकार का कोई दुरुपयोग करता है तो इसमें दोष व्यक्ती का होगा, धर्म का नहीं।

किसी के केवल तीन बार तलाक कहने मात्र से किसी का भी तलाक नहीं होता। जैसे किसी के तीन बार निकाह कहने मात्र से निकाह नहीं होता वैसे ही तीन बार तलाक कहने से तलाक नहीं होता। जैसे निकाह एक शब्द है, निकाह के लिए स्त्री और पुरुष की दोनों की सहमती, दोनों के तरफ से गवाह और मौलवी (धर्मगुरु) की कार्यवाही जरूरी होती है वैसे ही तलाक एक शब्द है, तलाक के लिए पती और पत्नी की सहमती, दोनों के तरफ से गवाह और मौलवी (धर्मगुरु) की कार्यवाही जरूरी होती है।

लेकिन कुछ पाखंडियों ने इस मामले में स्त्रियों पर अन्याय किए हैं जिसका विरोध सभी को करना चाहिए। तलाक के बारे में पवित्र कुरआन में अध्याय क्रमांक 02, सुराह अल बकरा, अध्याय क्रमांक 229 में तलाक के बारे में हम तफसील के साथ देख सकते हैं। फिर भी कोई व्यक्ति इसी तलाक को आधार बनाकर स्त्री पर अन्याय करता है तो इसमें धर्म का नहीं बल्के व्यक्ती का दोष है।

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I obviously said sorry for the broken foot: Woakes reveals exchange with Pant



London: England all-rounder Chris Woakes has revealed that he said "sorry" to Rishabh Pant for the delivery that broke his toe during the recent Test series at the end of which he was left quite touched by his Indian rival's generosity. Woakes had struck Pant's foot during the fourth Test in Manchester, ruling him out of the series-deciding fifth game. India battled past the setback to win the finale at the Oval by six runs to tie the series at 2-2. Both Woakes and Pant became symbols of heroism for their respective teams by coming out to bat despite major injuries. While Pant padded up with his broken toe in Manchester, Woakes came out during the fifth Test despite a dislocated shoulder. "I saw Rishabh (Pant) had put an image of me on Instagram with a salute emoji, so I replied thanking him: 'Appreciate the love and hope the foot is OK,' etc," Woakes recalled in an interview to 'The Guardian'. "He then sent me a voice note saying: 'I hope all is OK, good luck with the recovery and I hope we meet again out there some day'. I obviously said sorry for the broken foot." Woakes also recalled being appreciated by India captain Shubman Gill for coming out to bat in the fifth Test. Woakes did not get to face a ball but said running between the wickets was tough. Advertisement "(India captain) Shubman (Gill) said something like: 'That was incredibly brave'," he said. "I told him: 'You've had an unbelievable series, well played, and credit to your team'. Both sets of players had been through the mill in the series and deserve credit for the show we put on. Both teams wanted the win, of course, but it does kind of feel fair that it was drawn."

Probably Root should be Man of the Series: Brook



London: Star England batter Harry Brook disagreed with India coach Gautam Gambhir's decision to name him as Player of the Series, saying the honour should have gone to Joe Root for his prolific run in the five-Test series. With the series ending 2-2, each team's coach selected one player from the opposition for the Player of the Series award. While England head coach Brendon McCullum picked India captain Shubman Gill, Gambhir chose Brook as England's standout performer. Brook played a destructive innings of 111 off 98 balls on the fourth day of the final Test, putting England on the brink of a record chase before the visitors collapsed, losing seven wickets for 66 runs to concede the match. "I didn't score as many runs as Rooty (Joe Root), so I probably think he should be Man of the Series—and Man of the Summer again, like he has been for many years," Brook told the BBC. "I think we're in a great place. Obviously, it has been an awesome series. 2-2, I didn't think it was going to be like this, to be honest." While Brook scored 481 runs at an average of 53.44, Root amassed 537 runs at an average of 67.12 across nine innings in the five-match series.
