



Adverse possession plea can't be raised at appeal stage: Supreme Court

New Delhi: The Supreme Court has upheld a Jharkhand High Court decision that had set aside a first appellate court's decision granting ownership rights on the basis of adverse possession in a civil suit. A Bench of Justices J.B. Pardiwala and R. Mahadevan concurred with the Jharkhand High Court's view that the first appellate court had acted beyond the pleadings in introducing and deciding an adverse possession claim not originally pleaded in the suit. The Justice Pardiwala-led Bench said, "It is a settled position of law that the foundation for the plea of adverse possession must be laid in the pleadings and then an issue must be framed and tried. A plea not properly raised in the pleadings or issues at the stage of trial would not be permitted to be raised for the first time at the stage of first appeal under Section 96 of the Code of Civil Procedure (CPC)." The civil dispute arose from a title suit filed in



1999, seeking cancellation of a 1997 sale deed executed in favour of the defendants, terming it "bogus" and "inoperative", along with a prayer for possession and permanent injunction. The trial court dismissed the suit in August 2018, finding no fraud or misrepresentation in the execution of the sale deed. On appeal, the Deoghar District Judge decreed the suit in the plaintiffs' favour in respect of a certain property, holding that they had perfected title through adverse possession as the defendants had not reclaimed possession since 2000. The defendants challenged

this before the Jharkhand High Court, which held that there was no foundational pleading of adverse possession and that such a claim cannot mature during the pendency of a suit. "There is no concept of perfection of title by adverse possession during the pendency of the suit between the parties. [A]dverse possession cannot be decreed on a title which is not pleaded," observed the Jharkhand HC. Advertisement Expressing its agreement, the Supreme Court said that a plea of adverse possession is fact-specific and must be expressly raised in the plaint. "It is

important to remember that the basic rule of law of pleadings is, that a party can only succeed according to what he has alleged and proved, otherwise, on the principle of *secundum allegata et probata*, a party is not allowed to succeed, where he has not set up the case which he wants to substantiate," observed the Justice Pardiwala-led Bench. It further underlined the principle that "the decision of a case cannot be based on grounds outside the pleadings of the parties and it is a case pleaded that has to be found". The apex court, affirming both the trial court's and the Jharkhand High Court's decision, held: "Unless the plea of adverse possession has been specifically raised in the pleadings, put in issue, and then cogent and convincing evidence led... the plea of adverse possession cannot be allowed to be flung as a surprise on an unsuspecting defendant, for the first time in appeal."

Cloudy sky in Delhi; rain, thunderstorm likely during the day



New Delhi: Delhi on Tuesday morning witnessed a cloudy sky and recorded a minimum temperature of 23.4 degrees Celsius, the India Meteorological Department (IMD) said while predicting thunderstorms and rain in the city during the day. In the 24 hours ending at 8.30 am on Tuesday, the capital's primary weather station at Safdarjung recorded 18.7 mm of rainfall, while Palam recorded 16.7 mm, Lodhi Road 19.8 mm, and Ridge 32.6 mm, according to IMD data. Relative humidity at 8.30 am stood at 98 per cent, it stated. The minimum temperature was recorded at 23.4 degrees Celsius, 3.6 notches below normal, while the maximum is expected to settle around 32 degrees Celsius. Delhi's air quality was in the "moderate" category with an Air Quality Index (AQI) of 102, according to a Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) bulletin. According to the CPCB, an AQI between zero and 50 is considered "good", 51 to 100 "satisfactory", 101 to 200 "moderate", 201 to 300 "poor", 301 to 400 "very poor" and 401 to 500 "severe".

Severe Flooding Hits Warangal Due to Heavy Rains



Warangal, Hanumakonda, and Kazipet have been severely affected by heavy rainfall that commenced around midnight on Monday. The continuous downpour has led to extensive waterlogging in several areas, particularly at the Hanumakonda bus stand and various low-lying localities. Residents are grappling with the challenges posed by standing floodwater, especially in Kazipet, Hassanparthi, Reddypuram, Gokul Nagar, Ambedkar Nagar, and New Shayampet. Authorities have urged individuals living in vulnerable areas to relocate to safer locations. The impact of the flooding is evident throughout Warangal city, where roads in Battala Bazaar and Old Beat Bazaar are inundated. Communities along Hunter Road, NTR Nagar, Ramannapet, Shivanagar, Karimabad, and Sakarashi Kunta are also experiencing significant flooding. Warangal Railway Station is facing severe waterlogging, with floodwater penetrating homes in DK Nagar near Ursugutta. Authorities have commenced the evacuation of slum dwellers to rehabilitation centres to ensure their safety amidst the rising waters.

Polling underway for two ZPTC seats in Jagan's constituency, Kadapa MP in preventive custody

Kadapa MP Y. S. Avinash Reddy was taken into preventive custody by police in view of polling for the by-elections to Pulivendula and Ontimitta Zilla Parishad Territorial Constituencies (ZPTCs) in YSR Kadapa district on Tuesday. Polling in both constituencies began at 7 a.m. amid tight security. The process will end at 5 p.m. Eleven candidates each are in fray in the two segments in Pulivendula Assembly constituency, the home turf of former Chief Minister and YSR Congress Party president Y. S. Jagan Mohan Reddy. A total of 10,600 voters are eligible to vote at 15 polling centres in Pulivendula ZPTC, while there are 24,000 voters in Ontimitta ZPTC. YSRCP leader and Kadapa MP Y. S. Avinash Reddy was arrested at his residence in Kadapa. He initiated a protest after a large number of police officers were deployed outside his residence. The police dispersed YSRCP workers and took the MP into custody. Avinash Reddy is the cousin of Jagan Mohan Reddy. Police also placed under house arrest YSRCP state secretary Satish Reddy in Vempally and TDP MLC Ramgopal Reddy in Pulivendula. The State Election Commission (SEC) has made elaborate arrangements for the peaceful and smooth conduct of the polling. The police have made tight security arrangements to prevent any untoward incidents. Police check-



posts have been set on the borders between the two ZPTCs and also on the district borders. Deputy Inspector General (Kurnool range) Koya Praveen was supervising the security arrangements. Though these are only by-elections for two seats in the local body, they have attracted the attention of all due to the high stakes involved. The by-elections are a battle of prestige for both the ruling Telugu Desam Party (TDP) and the opposition YSRCP. While Jagan is going all out to maintain his grip on Pulivendula, the TDP is looking to make further inroads into the YS family's bastion. The TDP-led NDA alliance had won seven out of 10 Assembly seats in Jagan's home district, Kadapa, last year. Pulivendula Assembly seat has been the pocket borough of the YSR family for nearly five decades. The family has

never lost an election here since 1978, when Jagan's father and former Chief Minister Y. Rajasekhara Reddy (YSR) scored his first victory. The bypoll for Pulivendula ZPTC was necessitated after the death of YSRCP leader T. Maheshwar Reddy. While YSRCP has fielded his son Hemanth Reddy, TDP's candidate is Latha Reddy, wife of former MLC and the ruling party's Pulivendula constituency in-charge, Mareddy Ravindra Reddy (B Tech Ravi). Ontimitta is also going to a ZPTC by-poll as its member, YSRCP leader Akepati Amarnath Reddy, resigned after winning the Rajampet Assembly election last year. In Ontimitta, TDP's Muddu Krishna Reddy contests against YSRCP's Iragamreddy Subbareddy. The YSRCP on Monday sought immediate intervention by the State Election Commission to ensure free and fair polls. A delegation of YSRCP leaders met the State Election Commission and sought steps to halt what they described as "unprecedented subversion of democracy". Earlier, Jagan Mohan Reddy accused Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu of conspiring to hijack the ZPTC by-election. The former Chief Minister alleged that, together with certain officials, TDP's anarchic gangs, and police officers, Chandrababu Naidu is conspiring to hijack the election.

KTR sends legal notice to union minister Bandi Sanjay over phone tapping allegations

Bharatiya Rashtra Samithi Executive President K.T. Rama Rao (KTR) has issued a legal notice to Union Minister Bandi Sanjay, accusing him of fabricating false statements concerning the recent phone tapping case. KTR expressed his outrage, stating that Sanjay's comments were not only irresponsible for some-

one in his position but also detrimental to public representatives. In his notice, KTR asserted that such baseless allegations are politically motivated and aimed at ensuring his own political survival. He demanded an immediate apology from Sanjay, emphasising the importance of responsible discourse among public offi-

cials. KTR further warned that should Sanjay continue to make false accusations in the future, he would be held legally accountable for his actions. This conflict arises after Sanjay's statements made during a recent SIT hearing related to the phone tapping case, where he levelled allegations on KTR.

ACP Venkatarao's Web of Deceit, Support to Builder Karthik

Builder Karthik Causing Loss to Government Revenue



Locals are demanding that strict action be taken against such illegal constructions. In the jurisdiction of GVMC Zone 6, at Sheelanagar, an additional floor is being constructed without approval, allegedly under the supervision of Town Planning ACP Venkatarao. However, no action is being taken to stop this illegal activity.

In recent times, allegations of corruption against ACP Venkatarao of GVMC Zone 6 have been increasing. It is being reported even within the zonal office that builders are being granted verbal permissions to construct additional floors without proper approval, in exchange for lakhs of rupees. Recently, an apartment being built by a builder at Sheelanagar was found to be constructing an extra floor without permission. This construction was also done without paying the required TDR (Transferable Development Rights), further highlighting the deep-rooted corruption. It is alleged that ACP Venkatarao received around 75 lakhs from the builder. It has also come to light that TPO (Town Planning Officer) Varaprasad has been operating as a benami (proxy) in this zonal jurisdiction. Both officials are said to be visiting construction sites and collecting money based on a percentage of the building value. In the Sheelanagar case too, both ACP and TPO reportedly exercised their influence to allow the illegal construction. Complaints have already been submitted to the zonal office regarding this building, but they seem to have been ignored or dismissed.

Locals are now demanding an immediate high-level investigation by an authorized independent body into these violations and alleged corruption within GVMC Zone 6.

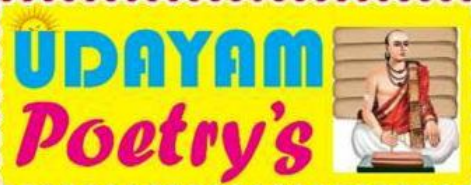

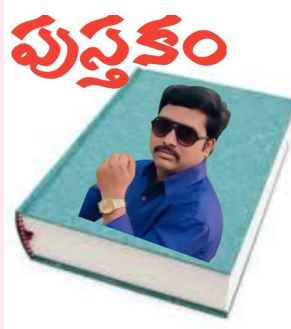

India's Asia Cup Squad Revealed: Gill Named Vice-Captain, Jaiswal Misses Out, Fitness Update on Suryakumar Yadav

Shubman Gill leadership role when India's T20I squad for the India Asia cup squad 2025 is picked in a few weeks. The BCCI senior selection committee led by Ajit Agarkar could name the team on August 19 or 20, after they receive medical reports of all players from the Sports Science unit of the Centre of Excellence. India's premier fast bowler Jasprit Bumrah is confirmed for the Asia Cup but is likely to be rested for the first Test against the West Indies in early October owing to the congested schedule. Gill had just led India in Tests, where



he amassed 754 runs against last home T20I series, Axar Patel was made the vice-cap-

tain. In Suryakumar Yadav's first series as T20I skipper in Sri Lanka last year, Gill and Suryakumar Yadav fitness. Now the two players are again in the contention for the same leadership position and selectors will have to make a tough choice between rewarding form and allowing for continuity once more. The report suggests that the selection panel will unlikely disrupt the nucleus that has functioned well under Suryakumar's captaincy so far. India's current batting combination of Suryakumar Yadav, Abhishek Sharma, Sanju

Shubman too had a good IPL and his Test form is phenomenal, but how do you fit everyone into the top order? That will be a big challenge," a BCCI insider was quoted as saying by PTI. Sai Sudharsan and Yashasvi Jaiswal dropped but may have to wait for their turn, as KL Rahul, the preferred choice in ODIs, will not be in reckoning for not featuring in Asia Cup 2025 India team plan.

Coolie' Craze: First Show Tickets Hit 4,500 as Fans Travel Across States for Early Screening



Coolie mania is on, with first-day, first-show tickets being sold at prices up to ₹4,500. It could be the excitement of advance bookings or the eagerness to see the Rajinikanth starrer at the earliest, but the demand is unprecedented not just in Tamil Nadu but in the rest of the country and even in foreign countries. Fans have been voicing their displeasure at the exorbitant pricing of FDFS coolie early screening, in parts of South India at least. On the condition of anonymity, sources tell India Today Digital that a popular theatre in Chennai has priced the tickets for the Coolie ticket price 4500. In Pollachi, a theatre employee was caught on camera, selling tickets for the first-day, first-show at the rate of ₹400. This is against the directives by the Tamil Nadu government, but theatres, especially single screens, along with fan clubs are trying to cash in on the demand by selling tickets on the black market. Prabakar, a die-hard fan of Rajinikanth, who was trying to buy tickets to the first Coolie movie show, told India Today Digital, "I have tried my luck at all the popular theatres in Chennai. Prices range between ₹600 and ₹1,000 with the costliest seats pegged at ₹4,500. Buying tickets for the first show online has been almost impossible since they are either blocked or sold out in most cases. Fans are heading to theatres where Coolie is being screened in the hope of buying black market tickets and, in some cases, waiting until later shows to buy tickets at the government-approved pricing. Movie buffs in these states are also looking forward to getting the nod from the authorities to go ahead with large scale celebrations. The two states also allow special ticket price changes and allow early morning shows in such cases.

comparison, Coolie has sold a total of 1,07,897 tickets across all languages, nearly three times more than War 2.
