



Atmanirbhar Bharat is the foundation of a strong, developed India: PM Modi

New Delhi: On the 79th Independence Day, Prime Minister Modi underscored 'Atmanirbhar Bharat' as one of the key foundational planks for 'Viksit Bharat', citing India's advances in Defence, technology, energy, space, and manufacturing. Highlighting 'Operation Sindoor', PM Modi said strategic autonomy and indigenous capabilities are key to decisively tackling threats, making self-reliance the bedrock of national strength, dignity, and the journey to a developed India by 2047. Here are the key highlights of PM Modi's address at Red Fort. Defence Self-Reliance and 'Operation Sindoor': PM Modi hailed 'Operation Sindoor' as a demonstration of India's Defence self-reliance. He emphasised that indigenous capabilities, including 'Made-in-India' weapons, enable India to act decisively and independently, proving that national security cannot rely on foreign dependence. Space sector independence: Celebrating the remarkable achievements of Group Captain Shubhanshu Shukla, PM Modi announced ambitious plans for India's very own space station, signalling a new era of indigenous space capabilities. He highlighted that



over 300 startups are actively innovating in satellites, exploration, and cutting-edge space technologies, ensuring that India is not just participating but leading globally in space science and exploration. Clean and renewable energy: PM Modi stressed the importance of energy independence, saying that for the bright future of the nation's youth and for welfare of farmers, this has to be done. He declared that while the world debated global warming, India had resolved to achieve 50 per cent clean energy by 2030, yet, thanks to the commitment of its people, that goal was met by 2025. Solar, Nuclear, hydro, and hydrogen energy have been advanced, marking a decisive

step towards energy independence. PM Modi highlighted India's focus on expanding Nuclear energy through private sector participation. He noted that 10 new Nuclear reactors are currently operational and emphasised that by India's 100th year of Independence, the nation aims to increase its Nuclear energy capacity tenfold, strengthening energy self-reliance and supporting sustainable growth. National critical minerals mission: To secure resources essential for energy, industry, and Defence, India has launched the National Critical Minerals Mission, exploring 1,200 sites. PM Modi highlighted that controlling these minerals strengthens strategic autonomy,

ensuring India's industrial and Defence sectors remain self-reliant. National Deepwater Exploration Mission: India will harness its deepwater energy resources, strengthening energy self-reliance and reducing dependence on foreign fuel imports. Agricultural self-reliance and fertilisers: PM Modi stressed the urgent need to produce fertilisers domestically to empower farmers and protect national food security. Reducing import dependence ensures the nation's agricultural sector thrives independently, safeguarding farmers' welfare and strengthening India's economic sovereignty. Digital sovereignty and indigenous platforms: The Prime Minister called on the youth to develop India's own social media platforms and digital infrastructure, ensuring communication, data, and technological ecosystems remain secure and independent, reinforcing India's digital autonomy. Self-reliance in medicines and innovation: The Prime Minister highlighted India's strength as the "pharmacy of the world" and stressed the urgent need to invest more in research and development. He asked, "Shouldn't we be the ones providing the best and most affordable

medicines for the welfare of humanity?" He also highlighted India's growing strength in domestic pharmaceutical innovation, emphasising the need to develop new medicines, vaccines, and life-saving treatments entirely within India. Drawing inspiration from India's COVID-19 response, where indigenous vaccines and platforms like CoWin saved millions of lives globally, he urged the nation to expand this spirit of innovation. Championing swadeshi: He urged citizens and shopkeepers to champion India-made goods under the 'Vocal for Local' initiative, stressing that swadeshi should stem from pride and strength, not compulsion. Mission Sudarshan Chakra: PM Modi announced the launch of 'Mission Sudarshan Chakra', aimed at neutralising enemy Defence infiltrations and enhancing India's offensive capabilities. He linked the mission to Lord Krishna's 'Sudarshan Chakra', highlighting how India draws inspiration from its rich cultural and mythological heritage to guide modern Defence innovations. This mission underscores India's commitment to strategic autonomy, ensuring rapid, precise, and powerful responses to any threat.

Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy's speech highlights at Independence Day celebrations.

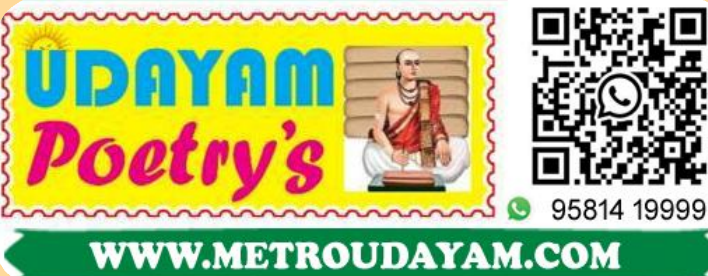

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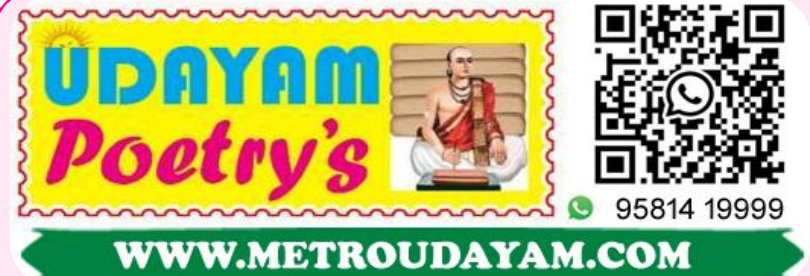

महर्षि "कश्यप" की पत्नी "विनता" के दो पुत्र हुए एक "गरुड़" और दूसरे "अरुण"। गरुड़ जी विष्णु की शरण में चले गए तो अरुणजी सूर्य के सारथी बने। जटायू इन्हीं अरुण के पुत्र थे। श्रीराम जी के पिताश्री राजा दशरथ के मित्र जटायू के बड़े भाई सम्पाती हैं। यह दोनों भाई विंध्याचल पर्वत की तलहटी में रहने वाले "निशाकर" ऋषि की सेवा करते थे। यह दोनों भाई निडर और बहादुर थे। जटायू का वास्तव्य रामायण में को नाशिक के समीप पंचवटी बताया गया है।

बचपन में सम्पाती और जटायू ने सूर्य-मंडल को स्पर्श करने के उद्देश्य से लंबी उड़ान भरी थी। सूर्य के तेज से जटायू जलने लगे तब सम्पाति ने उन्हें अपने पक्ष ने नीचे सुरक्षित कर लिया, इस समय सूर्य के ताप से सम्पाती के पंख जल गए और वे समुद्र तट पर गिरकर बेहोश हो गए। चन्द्रमा नामक मुनि ने उन पर दया करके उपचार किया और माता सीता जी की खोज करने वाले वानरों के दर्शन से पुनः उनके पंख ठीक होने का आशीर्वाद दिया।

जटायू ने देखा के सीता माता को रावण उठाकर ले जा रहा है। जटायू रावण से भीड़ गये रावण की ताकत और उसके बल को जानते हुए भी। जटायू ने रावण से युद्ध करते हुए पूरी तरह घायल हो गए। घाव इतने गहरे थे के बड़ी मुश्किल से अपने प्राणों को बचाए रखे हैं। जटायू चाहते हैं के किसी तरह श्री रामजी को सीता माता के बारे में बताकर अपनी आंख मूंद लें। जटायू ने अपनी मृत्यु को अपने किसी स्वार्थ के लिए नहीं रोक रखे हैं। श्रीराम जी को सीता मां की खबर सुनाने मृत्यु को रोक रखे हैं। जटायू का मृत्यु को रोकना निस्वार्थता की हद (सीमा) थी।

4.5 lakh people registered for Ayushman Bharat scheme in Delhi: CM Rekha Gupta

New Delhi: A total of 4.5 lakh people in the national capital have registered for the government's flagship health insurance scheme Ayushman Bharat Yojana, said Chief Minister Rekha Gupta on Friday. In her maiden Independence Day address from the Chhatrasal Stadium, Gupta stated that all the beneficiaries are being provided with a health insurance cover of Rs 10 lakh. "On the very first day, our government implemented the Ayushman Bharat scheme in Delhi, and so far, 4.5 lakh people have registered for it," the CM said. "Under this scheme, each beneficiary is being provided with a health insurance cover of 10 lakh rupees,"



she said, adding that 166 Ayushman Arogya Mandirs (neighbourhood clinics) have also been opened in the national capital. Ayushman Bharat -- the world's largest health insurance scheme, which covers 580 million people and provides free treatment. It was officially launched in Delhi on April 10, and registration was

opened on the same day for eligible beneficiaries. Around 6.54 lakh families in Delhi will be benefitted under the scheme. Further, the Chief Minister noted that the permanent jobs that were pending for years have been filled in the national capital. Enabling better healthcare in Delhi, "1,500 nurses and medical staff have been

provided permanent employment," Gupta said. Gupta said her government is committed to providing clean water and piped supply to all, from slums and unauthorised colonies to affluent neighbourhoods. The CM also announced several welfare measures, including that the government will create a board for gig workers, provide housing for all slum dwellers, and establish crèches for working women. Gupta also announced Atal Canteens to serve food for Rs 5 to workers to enhance food security and improve the nutritional status of economically weaker sections.

Over 1,200 sites under exploration as India targets self-sufficiency in critical minerals: PM Modi

New Delhi: Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Friday announced that the country is intensifying its efforts to achieve self-sufficiency in critical minerals, with exploration activities currently underway at over 1,200 locations nationwide. With applications ranging from electronic chips and household appliances to electric cars and solar panels, the PM, during his address to the nation on the 79th Independence Day, noted that the significance of critical minerals, such as lithium, cobalt, rare earth elements, and graphite, has increased dramatically on a global scale in recent years. now the main focus, India must also become self-sufficient in vital minerals," the Prime Minister stated. PM Modi emphasised that the National Critical Mission was established because critical minerals are essential to industries, technology,

energy, and defence. The PM said that the government wants to improve India's industrial and technological capacities while lowering reliance on imports. He emphasised the financial burden of importing necessary resources and connected the initiative to the nation's larger goal of energy independence. The Prime Minister stated that the government is currently working to increase self-reliance to reroute wealth back into the country. PM Modi also outlined a detailed vision for reforms and achieving self-reliance -- from transforming taxation to empowering small businesses and more. Speaking to the nation from the Red

Fort, Prime Minister Modi emphasised India's path of independence and change, stating that while the country has been performing, reforming, and changing over the last 10 years, the time has come to advance even more forcefully. PM Modi also established a Task Force for next-generation reforms to review all existing laws, regulations, and practices about economic activity.
