



Deputy CM considers options of converting Rushikonda project as MICE destination

Visakhapatnam: Through MICE (Meetings, Incentives, Conferences and Exhibitions) tourism concept, the Rushikonda palace built by YS Jagan Mohan Reddy's government spending Rs.453 crore should be converted into an income-generating project, opined Deputy Chief Minister K. Pawan Kalyan. Paying a visit to the much-restricted Rushikonda palace as part of his three-day trip to Visakhapatnam, the Deputy Chief Minister reached Rushikonda palace on Friday. After going through various blocks of the premises, the Deputy Chief Minister expressed wonder over the extravagance of the project and the exorbitant amount that went behind its construction. Responding to the Deputy CM's queries, the officials concerned mentioned that the palace was built replacing a revenue-generating Haritha Resorts developed by the Andhra Pradesh Tourism Development Corporation wherein the resorts used to make a revenue of Rs.7

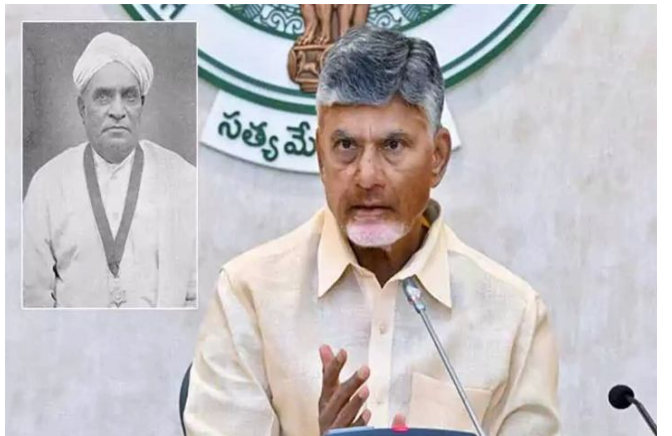


crore to Rs.8 crore per annum. "But now, instead of generating any revenue from the project, it has become a burden for the government as the pending power bill turned out to be Rs.1 crore," pointed out Kandula Durgesh, Tourism Minister, who accompanied Pawan Kalyan to Rushikonda. Sharing his views, Civil Supplies Minister Nadendla Manohar expressed concern over how the ancient Rushikonda has been exploited during the YSRCP's tenure

under the pretext of alterations made for Vastu purpose. Later, Pawan Kalyan held a meeting with the party's legislative members and sought feedback from them on how to put the mansion built by Jagan to use. Speaking on the occasion, he suggested, "There is a need to convert the Rs.453 crore project into an income-generating one on the similar lines of a private player, who had invested such a hefty sum in a project."

Severe flooding hits at Kaleshwaram Triveni confluence amid rains

Heavy rainfall has once again led to significant flooding in the Godavari region, particularly at the Kaleshwaram Triveni confluence, where both the Godavari and Pranahita rivers are flowing at dangerous levels. The floodwaters have surpassed the initial warning threshold, submerging areas around the Gnanasaraswati and Pushkara Ghats in Kaleshwaram.



Crops in several villages adjoining the Godavari catchment area have been adversely affected, with water inundating farmland in Mahadevpur mandal. Reports indicate that hundreds of acres of cotton have been submerged, particularly in the villages of Annaram, Chandrapalli, Nagepalli, Maddulapalli, Palugula, and Balijapur. Local farmers, facing the loss of their cotton crops for the second consecutive year, have voiced their concerns and are urging the government to provide assistance and compensation. The Medigadda barrage in the Kaleshwaram project is also under heavy strain, as a flood flow of 971,880 cusecs is being released downstream from the barrage, with 85 gates currently lifted. As the situation develops, the community anxiously awaits further updates and potential relief measures.

CM Chandrababu attends food summit, says AP emerges as key hub for aqua sector

Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu has asserted that the state is rapidly evolving into a significant hub for the aqua and beverage industries, urging investors to establish enterprises in food processing and related sectors. He assured that the government will expedite permissions for new initiatives. At the India Food Manufacturing Summit held today, CM Chandrababu highlighted the establishment of Quantum Valley in Amaravati, a project inspired by Silicon Valley in the United States, and announced that the state is collaborating with Bill Gates on future developments. He noted that Andhra Pradesh contributes 25 per cent of the country's fruit products and is actively seeking new international markets for farmers. Additionally, he mentioned that Orvakal in the Kurnool district is being developed as a key logistics and distribution hub. The Chief Minister pointed out that the state is home to nine food processing parks and numerous opportunities within the food processing sector. He emphasised that Andhra Pradesh currently ranks first in the country for ease of doing business. The India Food Manufacturing Summit, inaugurated by CM Chandrababu with the lighting of a ceremonial lamp, is organised by the Trade Promotion Council of India (TPCI) with the aim of positioning Andhra Pradesh as a centre for value-added food and seafood processing.

Train services between Hyderabad-Nizamabad remain disrupted

Movement of trains was disrupted for a third consecutive day on Friday between Hyderabad and Nizamabad due to damage to tracks following heavy rain and floods. South Central Railway (SCR) cancelled, partially cancelled or diverted some trains due to water overflowing on tracks in the Bhiknur - Talmadla section and the Akanpet - Medak section of Hyderabad Division. Kacheguda - Narkhed (Train number 17641), Kacheguda - Purna (77605), Narkher - Kacheguda (17642) and Bodhan - Kacheguda (57414) have been cancelled. Kacheguda - Medak (77603), Medak - Kacheguda (77604), Medak - Kacheguda (57302), Malkajgiri - Siddipet (77653), Siddipet - Malkajgiri (77654), Malkajgiri - Siddipet (77655) and Siddipet-Malkajgiri (77656) also stand cancelled. Kacheguda - Bodhan (57411) has been cancelled between Calvary Barracks and Bodhan.



Kacheguda - Medak (57301) stands cancelled between Medchal and Medak. Lingampalli - Mumbai CSMT (17058) has been diverted via Secunderabad - Kazipet - Peddapalli Bypass - Karimnagar - Armoor - Nizamabad. Stoppages between Secunderabad and Nizamabad have been skipped. Bhagat Ki Kothi -Kacheguda (17606), which departed on August 27, is diverted via Nizamabad-Armoor-

KarimnagarPeddapalli Bypass- Kazipet - Moula Ali 'G'- Kacheguda. CST Mumbai - Lingampalli (17057) is diverted via Nizamabad- Armoor - Karimnagar Peddapalli Bypass- Kazipet. Kacheguda - Bhagat Ki Kothi (17605) is diverted via Kacheguda - Moula Ali 'G'-Kazipet-Peddapalli By-Pass-Karimnagar-Nizamabad. Earlier, the SCR announced cancellations of 14 trains in the Secunderabad division due to bad weather. These include Kazipet-Sirpur Town, Blaharshah-Kazipet, Kazipet-Balharshah, Bidar-Kalaburgi, Kalaburgi-Bidar, Karimnagar-Sirpur Town, Sirpur Town-Karimnagar, Karimnagar-Bodhan and Bodhan-Karimnagar. Four other trains were partially cancelled. Bhadrachalam-Balharshah (17033) cancelled between Kazipet-Balharshah, Sirpur Town-Bhadrachalam (17034) cancelled between

Sirpur Town-Kazipet, Secunderabad - Sirpur Kaghaznagar (17233) cancelled between Kazipet-Sirpur Kaghaznagar and Sirpur Kaghaznagar - Secunderabad (17234) cancelled between Sirpur Kaghaznagar-Kazipet. Meanwhile, a tragedy was averted when a farmer alerted railway staff about floodwater flowing under the Shannapur railway bridge in Medak district. The flood water had washed away soil and gravel. Officials immediately halted train services on the Secunderabad-Nizamabad and Akkannapet-Medak routes. Officials reached the spot and launched railway track restoration work. Meanwhile, the SCR has also cancelled a couple of trains due to heavy rain and waterlogging in Nanded yard. The cancelled trains are Nanded - Dharmavaram (07189) and Dharmavaram - Nanded (07190), which were scheduled to depart on Sunday.

Heavy rainfall fore-casted for six districts in Telangana



The Meteorological Department has issued a warning of heavy rainfall across six districts in Telangana due to shifting surface circulation patterns. Moisture-laden winds from the Bay of Bengal and the Arabian Sea are primarily responsible for the anticipated downpours. Particularly, the districts of Kamareddy, Medak, and Siddipet are expected to experience very heavy rainfall, influenced by a high-pressure system over Kamareddy. A low-pressure area in central Chhattisgarh is also contributing to the adverse weather conditions. In recent hours, Kamareddy has been significantly affected, receiving up to 20 cm of rain in the last 24-48 hours, with total rainfall reaching 60 cm. Meanwhile, Siddipet has recorded over 20 cm, and Medak has seen up to 30 cm of rainfall. Residents are advised to remain vigilant as weather conditions are expected to continue deteriorating in the coming days.

RTC bus catches fire in Vizag: no casualties

Visakhapatnam: An RTC bus was engulfed in flames in Shantipuram of Visakhapatnam after a short circuit ignited the vehicle. The incident occurred when the driver swiftly halted the bus upon noticing the fire, allowing all passengers to evacuate safely. Fortunately, no injuries were reported, although the bus was completely destroyed in the blaze. Authorities are investigating the cause of the short circuit.

Chandrababu launches double decker buses in Vizag

Visakhapatnam has reached a significant milestone in its tourism sector with the inauguration of electric double-decker buses, allowing residents and visitors the chance to enjoy breathtaking views of the coastline from above. Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu launched the initiative on Friday, taking a ride on one of the buses alongside party leaders. The tourist buses will operate on a scenic route spanning 16 kilometres from RK Beach to Thotlakonda. During the inauguration, Naidu expressed his commitment to transforming the city's beaches to attract international tourists. He highlighted past decisions to overlook Visakhapatnam as the state capital and asserted that the city is on course to becoming both an Asian technology hub and the financial capital of Andhra Pradesh.



Naidu announced plans for a new data centre and an undersea cable that will enhance connectivity and link Visakhapatnam to global networks. He also emphasised the city's designation as a safe city for women, positioning Visakhapatnam as a competitor to major metropolitan areas such as Delhi, Mumbai, Bangalore, and Chennai.

Traffic jam reported on NH 44 in Kamareddy amid rains

A significant traffic jam has occurred on National Highway No. 44 in Kamareddy district due to heavy rainfall, causing severe delays and disrupting vehicular movement. The situation has persisted for over an hour, with vehicles travelling from Hyderabad to Adilabad crawling along a stretch of approximately 15 kilometres, from Sadashivanagar mandal to the Bhikanur toll gate. The heavy rains on Wednesday and Thursday have resulted in the closure of the bridge at Tekriyala and Sarampalli, with additional damage reported as the road has been washed away at another location. Consequently, traffic movement has been severely hindered since Wednesday. Superintendent of Police Rajesh Chandra has been actively monitoring the situation, especially as large numbers of vehicles became stranded on Thursday night. Commuters are expressing significant distress due to the ongoing traffic issues and are urging immediate repairs to the affected roads.

Andhra Pradesh will emerge as global food processing hub, says CM Naidu

Visakhapatnam: Andhra Pradesh will emerge as global hub for food processing, said Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu on Friday. He said that with five climatic zones rich in both aquaculture and horticulture production, Andhra Pradesh has the best advantages in the food processing sector. He was speaking at the India Food Manufacturing Summit organised by the Trade Promotion Council of India (TPCI) here. Stating that India is fast emerging as a global food processing hub, he said that Andhra Pradesh contributes 9 per cent of food processing output in the country, which stands at \$49 billion. He claimed that by contributing 15.6 per cent of total fruit production, Andhra Pradesh had emerged as the fruit capital of India. In addition, Andhra Pradesh contributes around 32 per cent of marine seafood exports and covers 2.26 lakh acres under aquaculture. Andhra Pradesh also ranks first in registered food industries with 6,000 functional units, he said. He noted that with increasing demand for quality food, the



demand for food processing units is increasing. He told the investors that Andhra Pradesh has a world-class food processing ecosystem with nine integrated food parks equipped with plug-and-play facilities, cold storage and warehousing facilities. CM Naidu said that Andhra Pradesh is going to emerge as a global food processing hub with the largest food producers in the country. The state remains a top producer of rice, mango,

banana, chilli, turmeric and shrimp. It also operates in fish, shrimp and egg production. The Chief Minister stressed the need for bringing value addition to food products in the global market. He said that Andhra Pradesh is one of the largest food producers in the country with a net cultivable area of 8.45 million hectares. Andhra Pradesh is number one in fish, shrimp and egg production, contributing 17.85 per cent of India's

eggs and 10.41 per cent of meat exports. The Chief Minister said the 'Andhra Pradesh Food Processing Policy 4.0' offers the best incentives, which are highly attractive, including investment subsidy, power cost subsidy and several other benefits. He said investors will get clearances immediately under the single window clearance for food processing units. He revealed that the state has set a target to attract Rs 30,000 crore of

investments and create 3 lakh jobs in the next five years. Last year, the state attracted investments to the tune of Rs 9,000 crore in the agro-food processing sector alone. The Chief Minister stressed the need for achieving product perfection to meet global market demands. He said the state government is ready to adopt next-generation reforms to meet the global standards in quality food production. Earlier, addressing the gathering, Avinash Joshi, secretary, Union Ministry of Food Processing Industries, lauded the efforts of the Andhra Pradesh government in the food processing sector. He stressed the need for value addition to food products and to prevent wastage of food. Trade Promotion Council of India chairman Mohit Singla announced the opening of the TPCI southern regional office in Amaravati. He noted that Andhra Pradesh is in the forefront in food processing. State Industries Minister TG Bharath, Principal Secretary of Food Processing, AP, Chiranjeevi Chowdary, addressed the gathering.

Update Incoming for Metal Gear Solid Delta – PS5 Performance Not Addressed

Unfortunately, in an online Q&A with fans on social media, the company didn't address the MGS Delta PS5 issues with the game's performance. Metal Gear Solid Delta patch on PS5 suffers from a low-resolution presentation and inconsistent frame rate in certain segments of the game. But it's even more of a problem on PS5 Pro, where the absence of graphics settings means there's nothing users can do other than tolerate constant frame rate drops and dynamic resolution fluctuations, with Sony's PSSR upscaler having been employed to smooth things out. Results so far have been lacklustre, to say the least. So, what's in patches? According to Konami, more urgent tasks include squashing particular crash triggers and some gameplay bugs, rather than broader PS5 performance improvements. Konami hasn't handed a time



frame for the patch either, saying only "We're laboriously probing the cause of the below issues, but it'll take a little longer to apply the fixes." It's also worth flashing back that Metal Gear Solid Delta is being developed by Virtuos, the same plant responsible for The Elder Scrolls 4 Oblivion

Remastered, which came out before this time. Oblivion took over a month of patches and updates to feel like a coherent experience, and it's still an unpredictable title to run on some hardware. Of course, optimism is running thin with Delta right now, and a quick fix seems unlikely. Konami has listed some of the specific crashes and bugs in Metal Gear Solid update. Here are a few. • Removing the Crocodile Cap from the Survival Viewer while wearing it causes the game to crash. • The game can crash when you pick up food near a crocodile that's displaying a "hungry" state. • Moving from a roll into a crawl results in the character becoming levitated at times. If you have any doubts on whether the game can be saved given these concerns about stability and optimisation, you're not alone.

'AP has a world class food processing ecosystem', highlights CM

Visakhapatnam: Andhra Pradesh has a world class food processing ecosystem. Expansion of the sector through global brands from India is the target, emphasised Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu.

Delivering a keynote address as chief guest at the third edition of the India Food Manufacturing conference organised by the Trade Promotion Council of India in Visakhapatnam on Friday, the Chief Minister highlighted that the state has a capacity of nine integrated food parks, 17 lakh metric tonnes of cold storage capacity, 33 lakh tonnes of godowns and recommended value addition for food products in global market.

The Chief Minister assured that industrial parks would be set up in each constituency across the state. With new policies in place, AP is certain to attract Rs.1 lakh crore investments in the food pro-



cessing sector in the next five years, the CM expressed confidence.

With fruits, spices, aqua, coffee and cocoa clusters spread across Guntur, Chittoor and Coastal Andhra Pradesh, the CM mentioned that Andhra Pradesh

is considered as the fruit capital of India. He expressed confidence that the state would reach 25 percent of the total production. Reiterating that food preferences of the people are ever evolving, Naidu underlined that the industry should cater to the

emerging demands of the sector and changing preferences of the people.

Underlining that Visakhapatnam is considered special for various reasons, the Chief Minister stressed that there is a huge scope for setting up industries in Visakhapatnam. Further, the Chief Minister said that the Centre estimates that the country's food processing industry is poised to grow its market size by Rs.700 billion dollars by 2030. Even as AP's share in the food processing industry is 9 percent which equals Rs.50 billion dollars, Naidu emphasised that there is a need to consider concrete measures to thrive in the industry further. Later, the Chief Minister flagged off the 'hop on-hop off' double-decker bus service at RK Beach in Visakhapatnam. Boarding the bus after inauguration, the CM interacted with the passengers.

जिसमें कहा गया है कि, "ऐ ईमान लाने वालों! खुदा (ईश्वर) के लिए ईसाफ (न्याय) पर मजबूती से कायम रहो, और ईश्वर के गवाह बनकर, सच की गवाही दो, भले ही वह तुम्हारे अपने खिलाफ हो, या तुम्हारे माँ-बाप या करीबी रिश्तेदारों के खिलाफ हो। चाहे वह अमीर हो या गरीब, ईश्वर उन दोनों से ज्यादा करीब (निकट) है। तो अपनी इच्छाओं के पीछे मत चलो कि तुम ईसाफ (न्याय) से भटक जाओ। और अगर तुम अपने बयान (वचन) को तलख (कट) करो या उससे मुँह मोड़ो, तो बेशक खुदा (ईश्वर) तुम्हारे कामों से खबरदार है।" (पवित्र कुरआन, 04/135)।

न्यायपूर्ण विधान से ज़िदगी बसर करना और अपने जीवन में न्यायपूर्ण आचरण करने का आदेश सच्चा धर्म देता है। आदमी समाज में अपने स्वार्थ के लिए फितना (उपद्रव) फैलाने की कोशिश करता है तो समाज में अन्याय, अत्याचार, हिंसा और भ्रष्टाचार जैसी बुराइयाँ पनपने लगते हैं जिन्हें धर्म ने कभी पसंद नहीं किया।

जीओ और दूसरों को जीने दो के सूत्र को हर व्यक्ति अपने जीवन का भाग बना लेना चाहिए। ईसान हमेशा फितना फसाद (उपद्रव और अराचकता) से दूर रहना चाहिए। पवित्र कुरआन अध्याय क्रमांक 02, सुराह अल बकरा, आयत क्रमांक 217 कहता है कि फितना फसाद (उपद्रव और अराचकता) हल्ला से भी बड़ा पाप है।

Harare: Zimbabwe faced a major blow as captain Craig Ervine has been ruled out of the ODI series against Sri Lanka due to a calf injury. An MRI scan on Thursday revealed a Grade II strain in Ervine's left calf, along with a chronic and healing Grade I strain in his right calf, sidelining the 40-year-old for the entire series. In his absence, seasoned all-rounder Sean Williams is leading Zimbabwe in the two-match ODI series, which commenced on Friday at Harare Sports Club. This series marks Zimbabwe's return to ODI cricket after their recent home fixtures, which included two Test matches each against South Africa and New Zealand, as well as a T20I tri-series. It also signals a comeback for veteran batter Brendon Taylor, who returns to international action nearly four years after his last appearance for Zimbabwe in September 2021 against Ireland. In the series opener, the host won the toss and elected to bowl first. "We are going to bowl first. This is a really good wicket. If we are going to get our fast bowlers to get anything out of the surface, it's going to be early on in the morning," Williams said of his decision at the toss. "Craig (Ervine) has a grade 2 tear on one calf, and grade 1 on the other, we wish him all the best in his recovery. Very good to be back here. The support here is phenomenal. Our team plays really well here. We've done reasonably well against them (Sri Lanka), we've been unfortunate in a few cases. We fancy our chances. We want to play positive cricket.
