



Excelling in Drug Detection: AP Home Minister Praises Dog Squad at Passing Out Parade

Andhra Pradesh Home Minister Anitha Vangalapudi lauded the performance of the newly trained dog squad specialised in drug detection during the 22nd batch passing out parade held at the 6th Battalion premises in Mangalagiri. The event was graced by Anitha and Director General of Police (DGP) Harish Kumar Gupta, who served as chief guests. Anitha expressed her astonishment at the impressive display and discipline shown by the police vigils during the parade. She congratulated the staff responsible for training the dogs, noting that, for the first time, each dog has been trained in two subjects. Additionally, she announced plans to establish a facility over a hundred acres dedicated to the training and care of these animals. Discussing recent developments, the Home Minister mentioned that no evidence has emerged in the ongoing investigation of a rape incident involving a young woman in Repalle. However, she highlighted the swift response of the dog squad, which successfully tracked down suspects within 36 hours. DGP Harish Kumar Gupta also spoke at the event,



emphasising that the guards have received unprecedented training in the history of Andhra Pradesh Police, particularly in drug identification. He reported that ongoing efforts are being made to eliminate marijuana and substance abuse in the state through constant surveillance and intensive checks. Gupta noted a decrease in crime rates due to the integration of modern technology and encouraged police personnel to actively collaborate in enhancing societal welfare.

Kavitha suspended from BRS

Hyderabad: BRS on Tuesday suspended MLC Kalvakuntla Kavitha from the party. The BRS leadership took this decision after several hours of discussions at party president K Chandrashekar Rao's farmhouse on Monday. The meeting which went on late night on Monday was attended by working president KT Rama Rao, S Madhusudhana Chari, G Jagadish Reddy, Vemula Prashanth Reddy, Palla Rajeshwar Reddy and others. The party leaders said that the BRS chief was upset with the comments of Kavitha against senior leader T Harish Rao during a press conference on Monday. The BRS chief was of the view that Kavitha should not have made such comments at a time when the government was targeting the party alleging corruption and irregularities in the Kaleshwaram project, said a senior leader. Kavitha after her return from the USA trip, addressed a press conference and held senior leaders T Harish Rao and J Santosh responsible for corruption and CBI cases against KCR. She also alleged that Harish Rao and Santosh were corruption anacondas. Sources said that the party leaders wanted the president to issue show cause notice but KCR wanted a strict action to avoid such comments from any other party men.



Heavy rain alert issued to Andhra Pradesh and Telangana



The India Meteorological Department (IMD) has issued a warning of significant weather developments as a surface depression in the northeast Bay of Bengal has intensified, reaching an average height of 5.8 km above sea level. In contrast, another depression off the north Odisha coast and northwestern Bay of Bengal measures 1.5 km above sea level. As a result, a low-pressure area is expected to form in the Bay of Bengal within the next 24 hours.

Heavy to very heavy rainfall is anticipated across many parts of the Telugu states over the next two days, with gusty winds forecasted along the coast, reaching speeds of 40 to 60 km/h. Fishermen have been advised against venturing out to sea until Friday, and residents in low-lying areas are urged to remain vigilant. An orange alert has been issued for the districts of Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, Anakapalle, and Alluri Seetharamaraju, indicating that moderate to heavy rainfall is likely in Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Manyam, and Alluri districts today. Authorities in the affected regions have been alerted, and residents are cautioned to avoid staying near dilapidated buildings and hoardings situated beneath trees. Meanwhile, the Hyderabad Meteorological Centre has also warned that Telangana could experience heavy to very heavy rainfall over the next four days, prompting the issuance of an orange alert for the relevant districts.

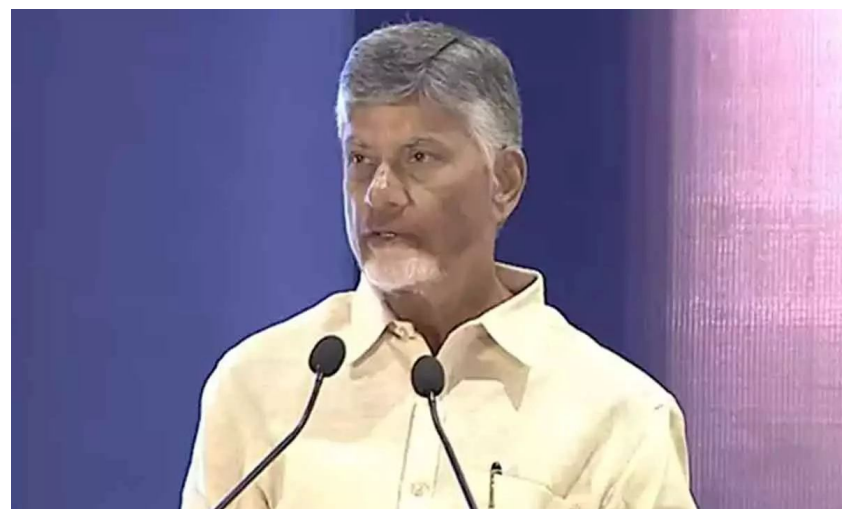
CM Chandrababu reviews on fertilisers and horticulture crops, gives directions to officials

In a decisive move to tackle the black market for fertilisers, Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu convened a review meeting on Tuesday at his camp office, focusing on the availability of fertilisers, horticultural crops, and the marketing departments.

Officials informed the CM that over 200,000 metric tons of fertilisers have been delivered to the state this season. In response, Chandrababu suggested exploring subsidy options for farmers who have reduced their use of fertilisers and pesticides. He emphasised the need for

continuous monitoring of crop cultivation, supply, availability, and consumption to preempt potential issues.

Chandrababu also directed officials to ensure that support prices for horticultural crops align with the costs of cultivation. He addressed the emergence of new pests affecting coffee plantations, stating that immediate action is required. Officials reported that a new pest currently threatens 20 acres of coffee crops, necessitating urgent removal efforts. The CM ordered the removal of the pest-infected crops, promising compen-



sation to farmers to prevent the pests from spreading to other areas. The review was attended by Agriculture Minister

Atchannaidu, Chief Secretary K. Vijayanand, and senior officials from the Agriculture and Marketing Departments.

Many people order food online, and some restaurants deliver food regardless of the time—midnight or early morning—with no differentiation. Most prefer ordering from well-known restaurants, even if it costs more than ₹10, as long as the food is reputed to be high-quality and tasty. But do these restaurants and hotels genuinely provide contamination-free, quality food? Recently, food-safety officials conducted intensive inspections to find out. Food-safety officer Apparao carried out inspections at several hotels in Visakhapatnam. Wherever illegal practices were detected, immediate action was taken. The surprise raids have shaken hotel owners. Harsh realities within these establishments have come to light. Food-safety authorities are firmly cracking down on hotels that are playing with public health

They have broadened the scope of inspections beyond just hotels and restaurants: supermarkets, ice-cream parlors, and other outlets have also been scrutinized. Authorities are rigorously enforcing



whether kitchens are maintained hygienically and whether food-safety protocols are being followed.

Inspections have been carried out across many areas of the city, including food preparation and retail outlets. Several lapses in food storage and handling have been identified, and notices issued to those responsible. As a result, many hotel owners in Vizag are now cautious. Officials warn that any establishment supplying food that could impact public health will face unavoidable action.

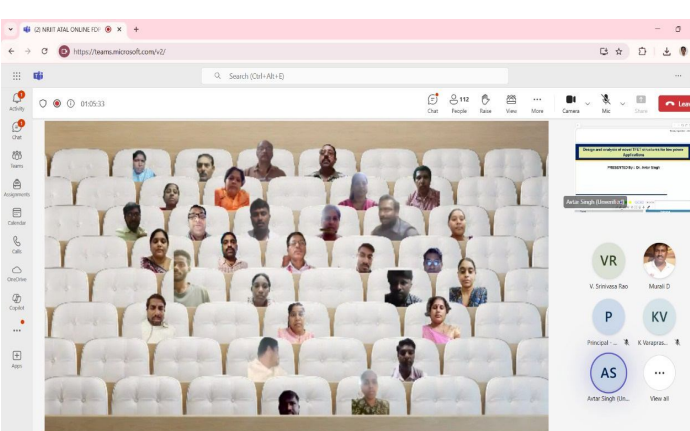
