



Mauritius PM to visit Varanasi next week, to hold bilateral meeting with PM Modi

New Delhi: Mauritius Prime Minister, Navinchandra Ramgoolam, is set to visit the holy city of Varanasi in Uttar Pradesh from September 10 to 12, a senior official of the district administration said. On September 11, he will meet Prime Minister and hold a bilateral meeting with Prime Minister Narendra Modi in New Delhi. "Ramgoolam will also attend Ganga Arti on September 11. On September 12, he will offer prayers to Baba Kashi Vishwanath and go to Ayodhya," Varanasi Divisional Commissioner S. Rajalingam said on Saturday. "PM Modi will reach Varanasi on September 11. After meeting his Mauritian counterpart, PM Modi will go back to Delhi," he added. "The Prime Minister of Mauritius will reach Kashi on September 10 for a bilateral meeting with Prime Minister Narendra Modi on September 11." In a press statement, the Union Ministry of External Affairs said, "Prime Minister of Mauritius Navinchandra Ramgoolam will undertake a state visit to India



from September 9 to September 16. This will be the first overseas bilateral visit of Prime Minister Ramgoolam to India in his present term." Ramgoolam had earlier visited India in May 2014. Prime Minister Ramgoolam will also visit Mumbai and Tirupati. In Mumbai, he would be attending a business event. While addressing a weekly media briefing in New Delhi on September 5, MEA Spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal

recalled Ramgoolam's earlier visit to India in 2014 to attend the swearing-in ceremony of Prime Minister Modi. Last month, Ramgoolam had wished PM Modi and people of India on Independence Day. While extending wishes to India on the occasion of Independence Day, Ramgoolam said that Mauritius celebrates the values of freedom, democracy and unity that India has so valiantly upheld since 1947. He emphasised that

the bond between two nations is rooted in history and culture. "Prime Minister Narendra Modi, On this auspicious occasion of India's Independence Day, I extend my warmest wishes to the Government and people of India. As we commemorate this historic day, we celebrate the values of freedom, democracy and unity that India has so valiantly upheld since 1947. The bonds between Mauritius and India are rooted in history, culture and ties that continue to inspire cooperation, friendship and mutual respect between our nations. May India continue to flourish in peace, prosperity and progress, guiding the world with its example of resilience and vision. Happy Independence Day, India!" Ramgoolam said in a post on X. PM Modi thanked his counterpart from the Mauritius and called Mauritius India's "strategic and trusted partner" in shared pursuit of progress, prosperity and a bright future for people of two nations. "Deeply appreciate your warm wishes, Prime Minister Dr. Navin Ramgoolam, on the occasion of

our Independence Day. Mauritius will always remain a strategic and trusted partner in our shared pursuit of progress, prosperity and a bright future for our peoples," PM Modi posted on X. Earlier this year, PM Modi was on a two-day State visit to Mauritius at the invitation of Ramgoolam to attend the 57th National Day celebrations of Mauritius. During the visit, PM Modi held bilateral meeting with Ramgoolam and Mauritius President Dharam Gokhool. India has "close and longstanding relations" with Mauritius, anchored in shared history, demography and culture, according to Indian High Commission in Mauritius statement. Mauritius was one of the handful of important countries with which independent India established diplomatic relations in 1948, even before the independence of Mauritius. The relationship has been characterised by a high level of trust and mutual understanding at the leadership level and continued high-level political engagement.

Fire erupts at EIPL in Visakhapatnam

A significant fire has erupted at EIPL, a Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited (HPCL) unit in Visakhapatnam following a lightning strike on a petroleum tank. The incident occurred earlier today, prompting immediate action from company management, who swiftly evacuated all employees to ensure their safety. Emergency services were promptly notified, and fire brigade personnel arrived at the scene to tackle the raging inferno. Local residents expressed their panic and concern as the fire blazed, casting an enormous plume of smoke over the surrounding area. Efforts to control the fire are currently underway, and updates are expected as the situation develops. More information regarding potential damages and injuries is pending while authorities assess the situation.



Arvind Kejriwal Challenges PM Modi To Impose 75% Tariff On US Imports, Warns Of Farmer Crisis

Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) convener Arvind Kejriwal on Sunday urged Prime Minister Narendra Modi to take a firm stand against the United States by imposing a 75 per cent tariff on American imports. His remarks came in response to Washington's decision to impose a 50 per cent duty on Indian goods. Kejriwal declared that the entire country would support Modi if he acted decisively, saying such a move would force President Donald Trump to "bow down." He accused the Modi government of failing to protect national interests and criticised it for exempting an 11 per cent duty on US cotton imports until December 31, 2025. According to him, this decision enriches American farmers while leaving Indian cotton growers, particularly in Gujarat, at a severe disadvantage. Highlighting the plight of Indian farmers, Kejriwal warned that with cheap US cotton flooding the market, local producers could receive less than ₹900, leaving them unable to repay loans taken for seeds, fertilisers, and labour. He cautioned that many could be driven to suicide due to financial distress. He further alleged that the Modi government had "bowed down" under Trump's pressure, calling the US president a "coward" and a "timid person." Kejriwal argued that instead of exempting duties, India should have imposed even stricter tariffs on cotton and other American goods. In addition to tariffs, the AAP leader demanded the restoration of the 11 per cent duty on US cotton, introduction of a fair Minimum Support Price (MSP), and financial assistance for farmers. He also claimed that the US tariffs were impacting not only the agricultural sector but also India's diamond workers. The Centre, however, defended its decision, saying that relaxing cotton import duties would benefit India's export-driven industries, especially small and medium enterprises.



Nagarjunasagar Reservoir Reaches Full Capacity

The Nagarjunasagar reservoir is now at full capacity, prompting the reopening of the project's crest gates. A total of ten gates have been lifted to release water downstream, matching the inflow of 133,824 cusecs with an equal outflow. Of the released water, 9,500 cusecs are directed to the right canal, 8,454 cusecs to the left canal, and 32,480 cusecs through the power canal. The reservoir's water level, which reached its full mark of 590 feet, has currently settled at 589.70 feet. In terms of storage, the reservoir's full capacity stands at 312.04 TMC, while the current storage level is recorded at 311.14 TMC. The management continues to monitor the situation closely as water levels fluctuate.

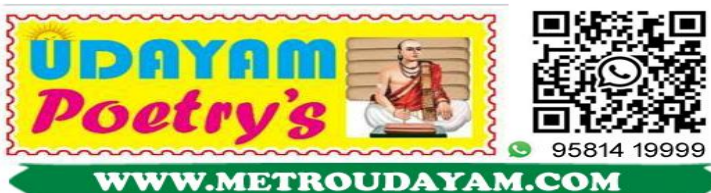

International Kuchipudi Dance Artists Competitions

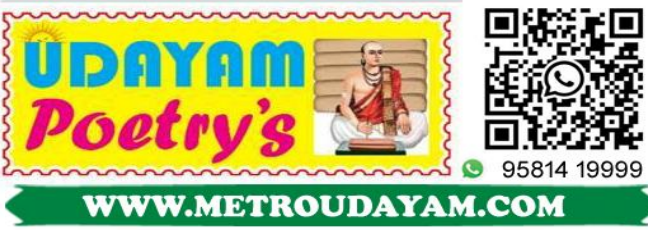
Hyderabad, September:7, Metroudayam

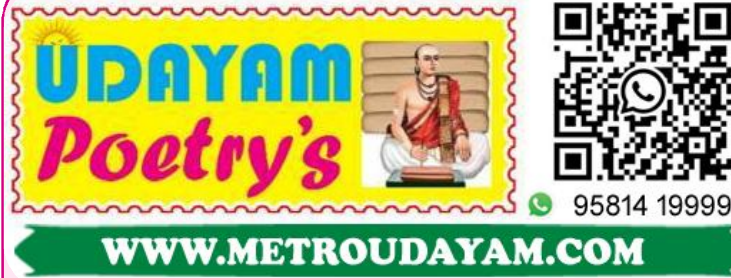

- Letters of appreciation



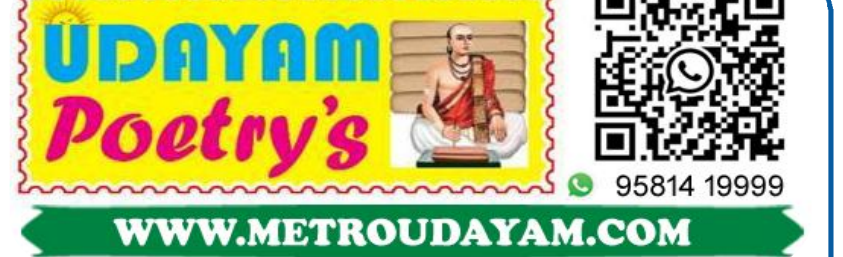
In modern times, Guru Dakshina may also include:

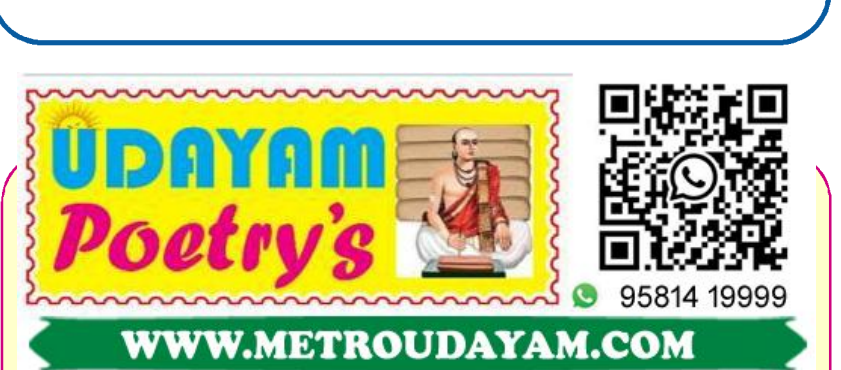

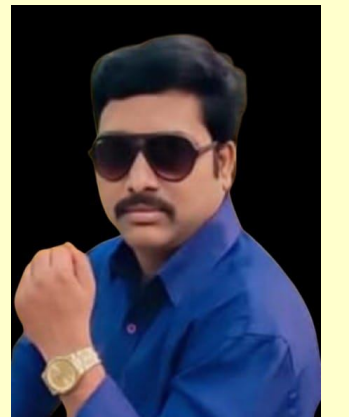

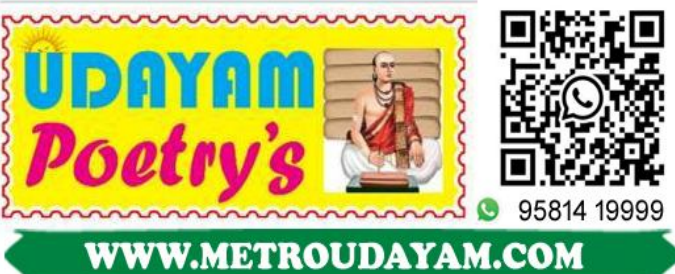

The Third Eye: Prime Minister Modi's China visit

New Delhi: In the current geopolitics, the questions attracting world attention revolve around US President Donald Trump's response to the Shanghai Co-operation Organisation (SCO) summit held at Tianjin, China, on August 31-September 1, 2025, India's equation with the US and Russia, and China's emergence as the other superpower besides the US. It needs to be pointed out that Prime Minister Modi visited China for the SCO summit, and his one-on-one meetings with President Xi Jinping of China and President Vladimir Putin of Russia were a logical part of the same. India's participation in the SCO conference at the highest level was a confirmation of the policy of the Modi regime to develop bilateral friendships with all for the country's security and economic benefits, and an expression of India's sovereign power to remain non-aligned towards world players. Russia had been acting as a 'balancing' power between the US and China, with its known antagonism coming off as a notable feature of the Tianjin meet. Also, India was able to give a message to the US that Trump's 'tariff pressure' would not shake this country's resolve to pursue its economic interests by 'diversifying' trade relations across the world. On the whole what happened at SCO summit has added to India's standing in the international community. Prime Minister Modi visited Japan on his way to China-Japan is a leading member of the US-led Quad with its declared aim of countering China's expansionist designs in the Indo-Pacific region, and this reaffirmed India's commitment to the 'nation first' policy. The event that stole the show from the SCO summit was the grand military parade held at Tiananmen Square, Beijing on September 3 to mark the 80th anniversary of Japan's World War-II surrender. The trio of President Xi Jinping,



President Putin and North Korean leader Kim Jong Un walking to the rostrum together, made for a compelling message of unity amongst them. Putin addressing Kim as 'Dear Chairman of State Affairs' and thanked him for sending North Korean troops to Russia to put up a 'courageous and heroic' fight against Ukrainian forces. The chief of Russia's Rosatom state nuclear corporation, Alexei Likhachev gave out that President Putin had promised to help China overtake the US as the world's biggest producer of nuclear power. The Beijing parade tended to confirm that China under Xi Jinping, with its military, technological and trade power now leads the anti-US block. President Trump reacted to the Beijing parade by accusing Xi Jinping of 'conspiring against the US' and, in an interview, reminded the Chinese President that the US had the 'strongest military in the world'. In a light-hearted comment, Russian President Putin said that President Trump displayed 'a sense of humour' by talking of such a conspiracy. Putin went on to claim that 'all countries with which Russia held talks in China supported the Russia-US summit in Alaska and expressed hopes that it would help to end the war in Ukraine'. President Putin

seemed committed to peace talks to resolve Russia-Ukraine conflict as he acknowledged 'the sincerity of efforts by US to find a settlement for Europe's biggest land war since WW-II' and added that he saw 'a certain light at the end of the tunnel'. The Russian President used the Beijing visit to convey a message to Kyiv that there was a chance to end the war in Ukraine through negotiations 'if common sense prevails' and stated that he would prefer that option but would not hesitate 'to end it by force if that was the only way'. He said he was ready to hold talks with Volodymyr Zelenskyy even though the latter had avoided facing reelection by imposing Martial Law and 'presided over an illegitimate regime'. President Putin as already mentioned seems to be playing a 'balancing role' between US and China and also between India and China. He reprimanded his US counterpart Donald Trump for attempting to exert 'colonial era pressure tactics' on India and China by talking of 'punitive' tariffs and pointed out that these were 'powerful economies' in their own right which deserved to be treated as 'partners'. Prime Minister Modi's visit to China after seven years has apparently yielded modest gains in the ongoing process of rebuilding bilateral relations that

had dipped because of Galwan. Indian Prime Minister made a reassuring remark that 'bilateral ties should not be seen through a third country lens' while China also claimed that India had joined China in opposing 'unilateral bullying'-a clear reference to Trump's arbitrary tariffs. In his meeting with Xi Jinping on the sideline of SCO summit, Prime Minister Modi 'underlined the importance of peace and tranquility in the border areas for continued development of bilateral relations'-the Chinese President taking the line that the two countries 'must not let the border issue come in the way' of improvement of their relationship. While maintaining vigilance against China as a potential adversary, India can explore the power of flexibility to try out a dual-track approach towards that country. In an uncertain global landscape, India's belief in a multipolar world order, strategic autonomy and position of this country as a major voice on issues of 'war and peace' as also on humanitarian development, has stood the test of time and needs to be pursued without undue expectations from any quarters. It is seen that trade negotiations between India and the US have been stalled with the sixth round scheduled for August 25 getting postponed following the tariff escalation. However, Indian Commerce Minister, Piyush Goyal, leading the Indian side maintained that both sides hoped to conclude a trade deal soon enough. Meanwhile, President Donald Trump said on September 3 that there was no lowering the punitive tariff imposed on India but added in the same breadth that 'we get along with India very well'. India has called the tariffs 'unjustified and unreasonable' but maintained that it will take all necessary measures to safeguard 'its national interests and economic security'. India is adhering to strategic patience in handling the 'transac-

tional' style of functioning of President Trump. Sticking to the principle of national sovereignty in deciding about its purchase of oil from Russia, it is using the grid of understanding that exists between India and Russia to handle the issue. On trade it is exploring the prospect of diversifying its deals with countries of Europe, the South and Eurasia. A guarded approach to India-China trade relations is fine. There is a new era of smart diplomacy setting in and India was well-positioned to make use of it. Prime Minister Modi's visit to Tianjin in China for the SCO summit was not expected to materially alter the fact of India-China relations being under a shadow of distrust and hostility that had built up around border disputes, military support of China to Pakistan in the armed confrontation between India and Pakistan following the Pak-directed terrorist attack at Pahalgam and the expansion of Chinese influence in India's neighbourhood. In spite of the provocation of 'punitive' tariff imposed on India by President Trump for the import of oil from Russia, the nature of relationship of India with US-Israel axis remained substantially strong. President Putin reportedly shared with Prime Minister Modi his impression of a favourable outcome of the Alaska summit between him and President Trump. The triangular equation of goodwill between US, Russia and India is largely undisturbed. The adverse comments of Donald Trump on SCO can be interpreted basically as an expression of Trump's disapproval of China trying to emerge as the second superpower. President Trump makes a clear distinction between Putin and Xi Jinping. All of this enables India to play its diplomatic cards for preserving its best interests and also for enhancing its standing as a major power in today's world.

Reality Star Gargi Kundu reveals she was rejected for her looks: 'Asked to Go Under the Knife'

Mumbai: Actress Gargi Kundu, who rose to fame with the Jio Hotstar reality show "Society", opened up about the harsh realities of the entertainment industry. Gargi made her debut in reality television with the show "Society." 'Lekkala Master' review: A slow-moving episode that fails to add up

ETV Win's latest outing, "Lekkala Master", from the weekly series Katha Sudha, promised a nostalgic yet heartfelt story. Unfortunately, despite a strong setup, the episode doesn't quite meet expectations. The episode follows Sahasra Deverakonda (Sumashree Madhira), a mathematics professor abroad, who returns to her childhood school as a chief guest. Her visit triggers memories of her early struggles with math and her influential teacher, Mallikarjuna Prasad (Srinivas Avasarala). The narrative explores how this teacher believed in her when she didn't believe in herself, shaping her journey. A few classroom moments about the importance of education are portrayed decently, and some family-oriented sequences connect with traditional audiences. Young actress Sahasra Sri delivers an earnest performance, convincingly embodying her role with emotional depth. Srinivas Avasarala, too, is well-suited for the part of the teacher, bringing gravitas to his dialogues and interactions with the student. The vintage backdrop and set design are noteworthy, giving the episode a visually appealing touch. The biggest drawback of Lekkala Master is its sluggish pacing. At 40 minutes, the episode feels unnecessarily stretched, with several sequences dragging instead of engaging. Logical loopholes also weaken the narrative. For instance, it's uncon-



vincing that a seasoned teacher wouldn't know how his students are performing academically. Moreover, Avasarala's sudden emotional turn feels forced and unnatural, leaving viewers disconnected from the drama. On the technical front, the production values are solid. The vintage detailing, art design, and cinematography work in favor of the episode. Even the music is decent. However, these strengths can't fully compensate for the lackluster writing

and weak execution. Overall, Lekkala Master carries a meaningful core but struggles with weak narration and sluggish storytelling. Srinivas Avasarala and child actress Sahasra Sri stand out, but beyond their performances, the episode feels like a missed opportunity. With tighter writing and sharper execution, it could have been impactful. As it stands, it's a passable watch only if approached with very low expectations.
