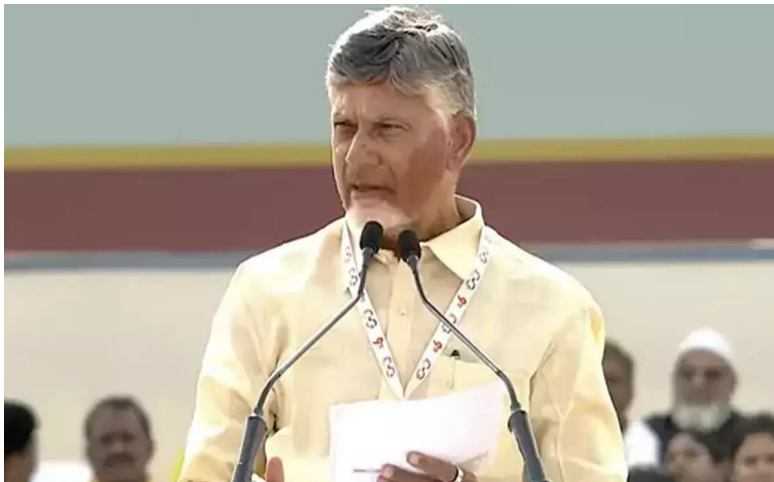




Chandrababu addresses at 'Super Six' meeting, says super six initiatives became success

In Anantapur, Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu addressed attendees at the Super Six Super Hit public meeting, asserting that recent elections have transformed history. He emphasised that the gathering was not merely a political rally, but a platform to reaffirm the commitments made during his government's 15-month tenure.

"I am here to declare that our Super Six initiatives have been a resounding success," stated CM Naidu, expressing gratitude to the farmers, women's groups, and young supporters who played a vital role in this achievement. He acknowl-



edged ongoing protests in Nepal, noting that 200 Telugu individuals were currently stranded there, and announced that Minister Lokesh has been tasked with facilitating their return. Naidu highlighted the

importance of governance as a means of fulfilling promises rather than engaging in vote-seeking politics. He took pride in the electoral participation, revealing that 57 per cent of voters turned out, resulting in a 94 per cent suc-

cess rate for the alliance, which secured 164 seats and left the opposition without significant representation.

Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan, who also attended the public meeting, reiterated the alliance government's commitment to the Super Six programmes despite facing financial challenges. He outlined several initiatives, including comprehensive health insurance for families, expedited gram sabhas, and an ambitious plan to plant one crore saplings, all aimed at transforming Rayala seema into a prosperous region. Kalyan assured the public of maintaining law and order in the region.

Updated figure of 215 Telugu people stranded in Nepal; Minister Nara Lokesh directs officials to collect update on an hourly basis



Amid the unrest in Nepal, Andhra Pradesh Minister for Real Time Governance, Nara Lokesh, has taken charge of coordinating rescue operations for Telugu citizens stranded across various regions of the neighboring country. Minister Nara Lokesh on Wednesday reached the Real Time Governance (RTG) Center at the State Secretariat and held a review meeting with senior officials. AP Bhavan authorities briefed him on the ground situation, informing that as many as 215 Telugu people have been reported stranded so far. Taking serious note of the situation, Minister Lokesh directed officials to initiate measures on a war footing to ensure the safe return of those trapped. He instructed that immediate relief must be extended, stranded people shifted to safer locations, and regular updates provided. "Updates on their safety and well-being must be collected every two hours," minister told officials during the meeting. The minister also interacted via video call with some of the stranded citizens, including Surya Prabha, who briefed him on the present situation in Muktinath where several Telugu pilgrims are stuck in a hotel. Minister Nara Lokesh assured that the state government, in close coordination with the central government, is committed to bringing all Telugu citizens back home safely.

Telangana govt sets up relief centre for to assist those stranded in Nepal

Several residents of Telangana are currently stranded in Nepal due to escalating violence linked to widespread protests in the country. In response to the situation, the state government has established a relief centre at Telangana Bhavan in Delhi, aimed at providing necessary assistance to those affected. A team of three officials has been designated to oversee the operation. The unrest in Nepal stems from public outcry against a recent ban on social media, leading to violent confrontations. Furthermore, the political landscape in Nepal has been shaken,

with the resignation of the Prime Minister and various ministers. In addition, ongoing demonstrations regarding political succession have emerged, now referred to as the 'Nepokid Movement'. The situation remains fluid, as authorities in both nations work to address the concerns of the stranded residents and restore order.



Weather Warning Issued for Andhra Pradesh and Telangana Amid Cyclonic

The Andhra Pradesh Disaster Management Authority has issued warnings for moderate to heavy rains accompanied by thundershowers over the next three days due to the influence of a surface cyclone. Today, substantial rainfall is anticipated across several districts, including Alluri, Eluru, NTR, Guntur, Bapatla, and Palnadu, whilst lighter precipitation is expected in other regions. Also Read - Preparations begin for national women's empowerment meet Fishermen have been cautioned against venturing out to sea from Ellundi, as gusty winds of 40-60 km/h are forecasted along the coast. Prakhar Jain, Managing Director of the Disaster Management Authority, has advised the public to exercise caution, avoiding shelter under trees, dilapidated buildings, and hoardings during this period of inclement weather. ward towards the northeast Bay of Bengal, with a cyclonic circulation persisting over the North Coastal Andhra region near South Odisha at an altitude of 4.5 km above mean sea level. Heavy rain is predicted for isolated areas in Adilabad, Komarambhim Asifabad, Mancherial, Nirmal, and several other districts including Hyderabad and Warangal, both today and tomorrow. The Meteorological Centre has warned of potential heavy rainfall coupled with strong winds of up to 40 km/h across various districts including Yadadri Bhuvanagiri, Rangareddy, and Kamareddy. Residents have been advised to remain vigilant as weather conditions may change rapidly.

Hyderabad: Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy's visit to Delhi has seen him meeting with Defence Minister Rajnath Singh to discuss transferring 98.20 acres of Defence land to the Telangana government. This land is intended for the Gandhi Sarovar project, which is set to feature the 'Gandhi Circle of Unity' near the confluence of the Musi and EC rivers. During the meeting, Reddy emphasised that the Gandhi Sarovar project would serve as a symbol of national unity and embody Gandhian values.

Prof. Singh hopes stronger institutional transformations will improve the stature of Indian science in global innovation index.

Jangaon, September 10, Metroudayam:

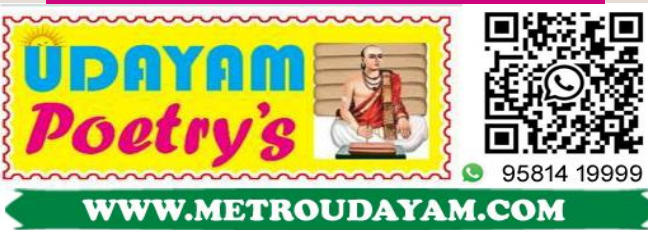

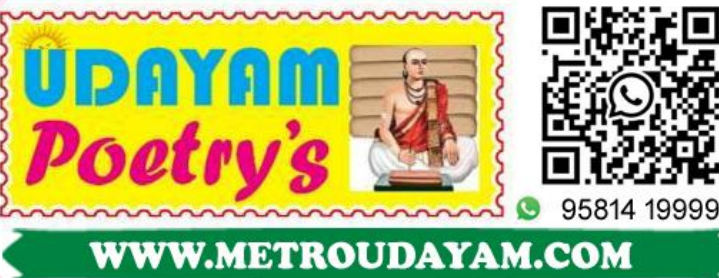

The only wealth you hold is the trembling breath between one heartbeat and the next.

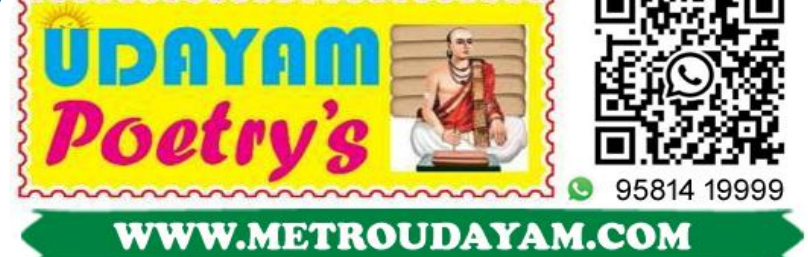


Spend it not in worry's market or regrets dim alleys. Let it grow wings, let it carve light, let it shape love.

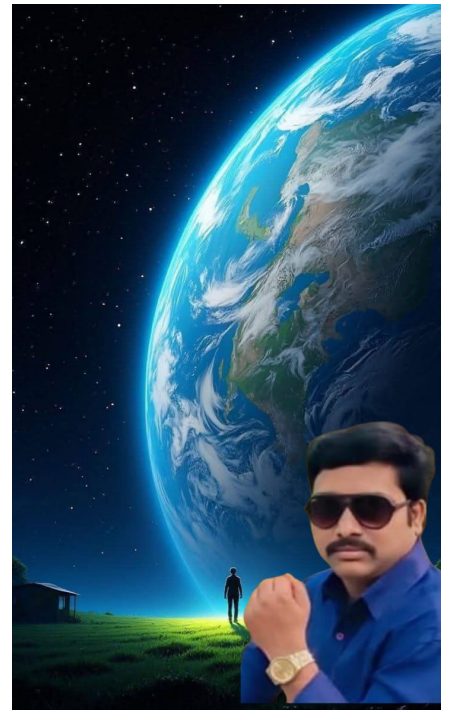

Creating Hope through Action Awareness program on World Suicide Prevention Day: Psychologist Likhitharani

Theme: Changing the Narrative on Suicide In observance of World Suicide Prevention Day, psychologist Ms. Likitha Rani, working under the District Mental Health Program (DMHP), conducted a powerful and insightful Mental Health Awareness Program focused on the theme Changing the Narrative on Suicide. The programs was specially designed to empower educators and students with the knowledge and skills to recognize mental health challenges and prevent suicide within schools and colleges environments.

Held at various schools and colleges in Jangaon Dist, the events brought together principals, teaching staff, and students from various educational institutions across the district, reflecting a strong commitment to addressing mental health concerns at the grassroots level. Ms. Likitha Rani emphasized the urgency of shifting how society perceives suicide—from silence and stigma to understanding and support. This year's theme Changing the Narrative on Suicide calls on us to challenge myths, break the stigma, and talk openly about mental health. Schools and colleges are key spaces where early signs can be identified and lives can be



saved she said. The awareness session covered a wide range of topics, including: Recognizing early signs of emotional distress and suicidal ideation Understanding the impact of academic and social pressures on students Equipping teachers with tools for early intervention Creating a supportive and stigma-free school environment Encouraging open dialogue about mental well-being Accessing professional mental health services through DMHP and other networks Interactive discussions,

real-life case scenarios, practical role-play activities were included to ensure participants could apply what they learned in real-world situations. Educators and students actively engaged in the session, with many expressing that it was both enlightening and much-needed. One participating teacher remarked We often focus so much on performance that we overlook the mental health of our students. This session gave us the perspective and tools we were missing. The events concluded with a group pledge by all participants to promote mental wellness, create safe

spaces for open communication, and actively contribute to suicide prevention efforts in their institutions. This initiative is part of DMHPs broader outreach strategy, aiming to foster resilience, compassion, and awareness throughout the community—starting with its youngest members. Municipal officials are financially bankrupting the corporation

The officials are turning a blind eye to the construction of illegal structures and commercial sheds in Peerzadiguda Municipal Corporation. When someone complains and questions, they reply that they have given notices, but there is no record of any action being taken against them. Although articles are published in newspapers every day on illegal structures, there is no movement among the officials. There are also widespread allegations that they do not even look at the irregularities even when they receive them. Many are complaining that their management is causing a huge loss to the revenue of the municipality and corporations.

People are criticizing the Town Planning Department for not seeing the construction of commercial structures, huge

sheds, and business complexes in excess of the number of buildings being constructed against the permits.

Municipal officials are not taking departmental action against illegal builders, but rather are completing the work and painting it as if they are cooperating with them. This trend continues everywhere in the corporation. People are expressing many doubts about the Municipal Commissioner as no such action has been taken so far against the huge sheds and structures being constructed without any permissions. There are also many complaints against the ward officers who should have told the officials in the beginning and stopped the illegal constructions, but are in cahoots with the builders for money and keeping the matter a secret. People are asking that they need to know what the actual duties of the ward officers are and what work they are



doing. People are demanding that the Peerzadiguda Municipal officials take action against the illegal constructions and clamp down on them.
