



India among world's top 5 countries in solar energy: PM Modi

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Sunday highlighted that India is making rapid strides in the field of green energy and renewable power generation. He remarked that a decade ago, India lagged significantly in solar power production. However, today, India ranks among the top five countries globally in solar energy capacity.

"In the changing times, India requires alternative fuels to reduce dependence on oil and gas," emphasised the Prime Minister, highlighting ethanol as one such viable option.

He said that the new plant for the production of ethanol from bamboo, inaugurated today, would greatly benefit farmers and tribal communities in Assam. Stating that arrangements are being made to ensure a steady supply of bamboo for operating the bio-ethanol plant,



PM Modi highlighted that the government will support local farmers in cultivating bamboo and will also procure it directly. He informed that small units related to bamboo chipping will be established in the region. The Prime Minister announced that approximately Rs 200 crore will

be spent annually in this sector. He emphasised that this single plant will benefit thousands of people in the area. Underlining that India is now producing ethanol from bamboo, the Prime Minister reminded the public of the earlier times when, under the opposition-led govern-

ment, cutting bamboo could lead to imprisonment.

He emphasised that bamboo, an integral part of daily life for tribal communities, was subject to restrictions.

PM Modi highlighted that the current government removed the ban on bamboo cutting, and this decision is now delivering substantial benefits to the people of the North East.

PM Modi said that Assam is playing a key role in the march towards Aatmanirbhar Bharat as the state has been chosen for a major national initiative - the Semiconductor Mission.

He explained that his trust in Assam stems from its proven potential, citing how Assam Tea, once relatively unknown during colonial times, was transformed into a global brand by the land and people of Assam.

PM Modi emphasised that in this

new era, India's self-reliance depends on two critical sectors: energy and semiconductors, and Assam is playing a vital role in both.

The Prime Minister said that from bank cards and mobile phones to cars, aircraft, and space missions, the core of every electronic device lies in a small electronic chip.

He emphasised that if India aims to manufacture these products domestically, it must also produce its own chips.

To achieve this, India has launched the Semiconductor Mission, with Assam serving as a major foundation for this initiative.

PM Modi highlighted that a semiconductor factory is rapidly being constructed in Morigaon, with an investment of Rs 27,000 crore, which is a matter of great pride for Assam.

AP Mega DSC Recruitment Nears Completion, final selection list likely tomorrow

The Mega DSC recruitment, a key promise of the coalition government in Andhra Pradesh, is approaching its final stages. Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu has signed off on the Mega DSC announcement, marking a significant step since the coalition's formation. The Education Department has finalised its list of candidates for the 2025 teacher positions, with the final selection list set to be released on Monday, September 15. This recruitment drive aims to fill a total of 16,347 teaching posts, with the verification of certificates having already taken place in various phases. Following a month-long computer-based examination from June 2 to July 2, the merit list has been published, and the certificate



verification process is complete. Education Department officials are currently making arrangements to unveil the final selection list and distribute appointment letters to the successful candidates. On September 19, CM Naidu will present the appointment letters during a ceremony in Velagapudi, Vijayawada. District officials have been instructed to accompany each selected candidate with an assistant for the event, which

is expected to attract approximately 32,000 attendees, including the 16,000 appointed candidates and their companions. A larger gathering of around 100,000 people, consisting of coalition party members, ministers, MPs, and MLAs, is also anticipated. Special bus services are being arranged to facilitate transportation for attendees. Following the appointment ceremony, selected candidates will undergo a district-wise training programme lasting 10 days. Unlike previous years, where schools were allocated to candidates during counselling, the government has decided to assign schools post-training, with allocations expected after the Dussehra holidays.

Congress gave shelter to infiltrators, disturbed demography in Assam: PM Modi

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Sunday took a potshot at the Congress party, alleging that the opposition, while in power in Assam, gave shelter to infiltrators and failed to bring development to the state. Kickstarting several projects in the Golaghat district, PM Modi said, "Congress ruled in Assam for several decades. However, they failed to bring development in the state; rather, the Congress party provided shelter to the infiltrators, which brought demographic alterations in Assam." Hailing the efforts by the present BJP government in Assam, the Prime Minister said, "The current ruling dispensation in the state has taken up the challenge to make Assam free from illegal infiltrators. The BJP government has been taking several measures to ensure the rights of the indigenous people of Assam by providing land patta to the

Scheduled Tribes (ST)." He also argued that the BJP government has focused on development, and Assam has witnessed several development initiatives in recent years due to the good work of the double-engine government. Earlier, the Prime Minister launched a sharp attack on the Congress, alleging that the wounds inflicted on the people of Assam by the policies of Jawaharlal Nehru during the 1962 Chinese aggression were "yet to heal." Addressing a massive public rally in Darrang district, the Prime Minister said Assam and the Northeast were left to fend for themselves when Chinese troops advanced, exposing what he called the "betrayal" of the then



Congress leadership. "The scars of that neglect are still remembered by the people of Assam. The Congress of today continues with the same mindset — protecting infiltrators and anti-national forces instead of standing firmly with our Army and our nation," he said. PM Modi accused the Congress of "playing with the security and identity of Assam" by allegedly shielding illegal infiltrators and conspiring to alter the state's demography. He contrasted this with the BJP's stance, asserting that his party would never allow infiltrators to grab Assam's land or undermine its cultural fabric. Lashing out at the grand old party's record, the Prime Minister said: "Congress ruled Assam for decades but built only three bridges over the Brahmaputra."

Soumya Mishra IPS congratulates referees of Kraav Maga competitions

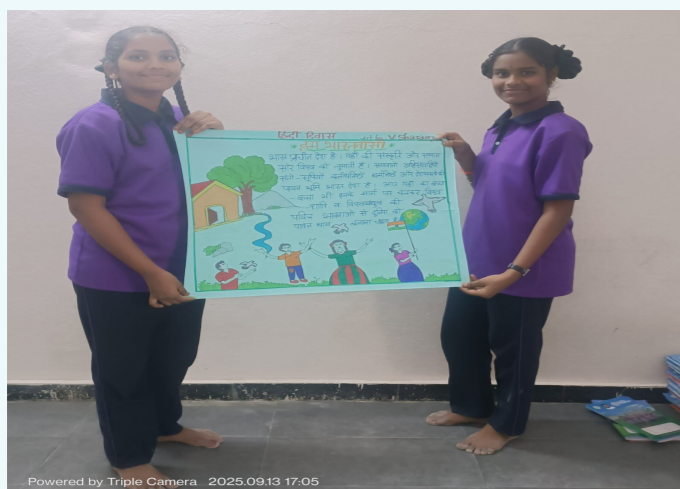

TUTF State President Lachiram demands, TET exemption before 2010 appointed teachers



Jangaon, September 14, Metroudayam:

Telangana United Teachers Federation (TUTF) state president Thumma Lachiram spoke with the media that he demanded the teachers who were appointed before 2010 should be exempted from the TET exam. A felicitation programme for the best teachers and promoted teachers of the district was organised at Adilabad

district centre today under the chairmanship of the association district president S. Srikanth. Tutf State president Thumma Lachiram presided over the meeting. The recent Supreme Court verdict making TET mandatory for in-service teachers is painful. He urged the government to file a review petition immediately in the Supreme Court. Similarly, changes should be made in the TET syllabus. The



teacher who teaches any subject should be allowed to write the TET exam in the same subject. They also demanded that the qualifying marks should be the same for all and not caste-wise, and 40% should be fixed as qualifying marks. It is not right to form a committee for the implementation of EHS. Steps should be taken to implement health cards in all corporate hospitals immediately as per the assurance given by the government to the employees and teachers unions. They demanded scrapping of CPS and bringing 2003 DSC teachers under OPS. 317 affected teachers have been asked to be brought to their home districts. Remaining spouses should be transferred immediately. He demanded the implementation of the PRC report and release of pending DAs.
