CM Revanth Reddy Highlights Govt Achievements at Telangana Prajapalana Day



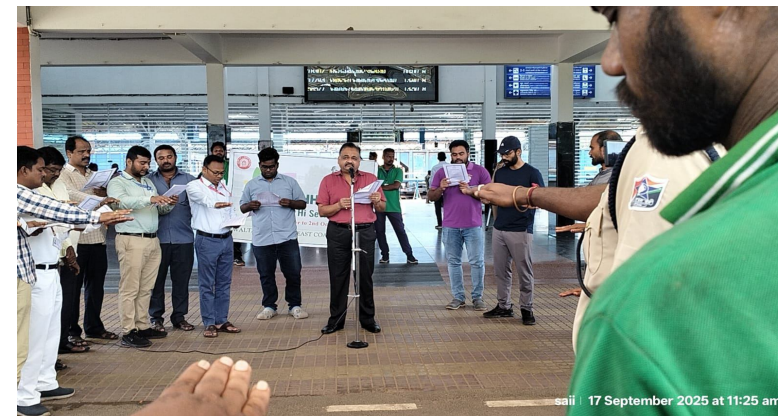

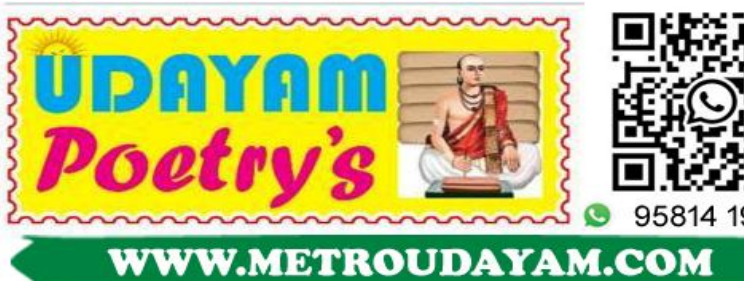

Amidst the voices of her own people!

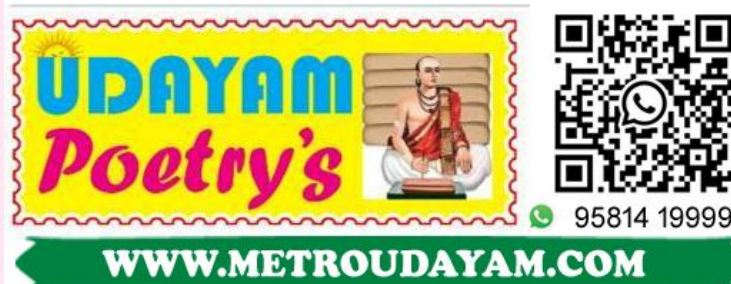
A woman, self-reliant, conquers,

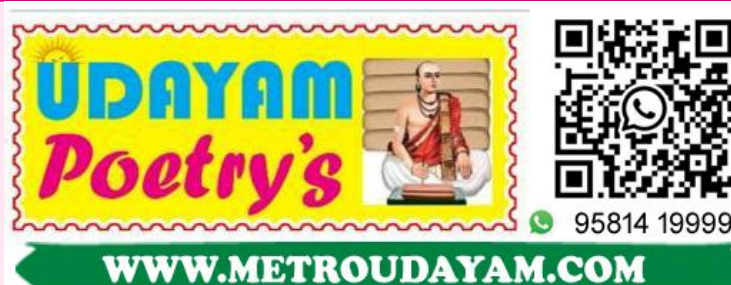

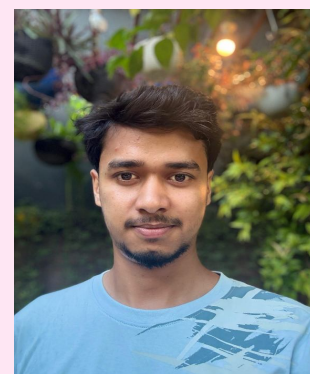

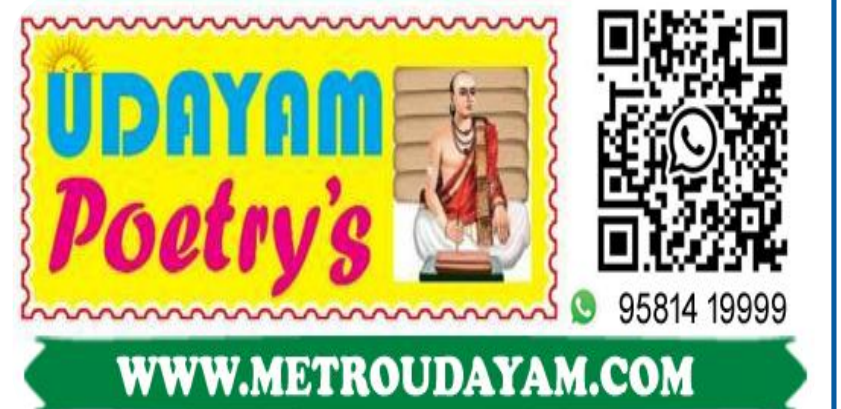

Bigg Boss 19: Nagma Mirajkar calls out Amaal Mallik for playing the “dirtiest game

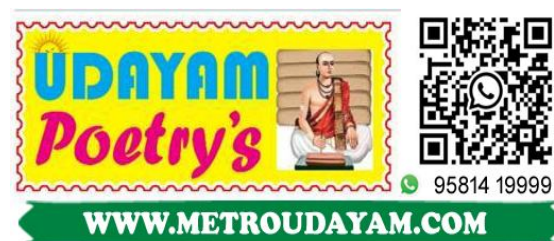
