



AP legislative council sessions begins: Chairman dismisses YSRCP's adjournment resolution



The Andhra Pradesh Assembly convened on Thursday morning, but tensions escalated when the YSR Congress Party (YSRCP) proposed an adjournment resolution to address the pressing issues faced by farmers and the ongoing urea shortage in the council. However, the council chairman, however, dismissed the resolution, prompting an immediate outcry from YSRCP members. In a display of dissent, YSRCP legislators raised slogans calling for urgent solutions to the urea shortage and for a remunerative price for crops. The situation has led to the clash between ruling party and opposition counterparts. The council chairman was compelled to temporarily adjourn the session.

Centre to help ITIs become AI-driven training centres: FM Sitharaman

New Delhi: The Union government plans to transform Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) across the country into Artificial Intelligence (AI)-driven training centres, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman said on Thursday. Addressing the Indian Foundation for Quality Management's (IFQM) second annual symposium in the national capital, Sitharaman said that the government has been focussed on skilling and upskilling for the last two to three years and has made provisions for it in the annual budgets. She noted that as the ITIs were not adding to the rapidly changing production environment, the central government launched a hub-and-spoke model to upgrade them. "So, if these ITIs were to adopt the hub and spoke model within the state, we will be



able to provide them the entire money required for upgrading these places for AI-driven training centres," the FM said. "The government has identified some institutes of excellence, such as the IITs or the Indian Institute of Science, for setting up institutions of excellence for AI-related R&D and also training," she added. FM Sitharaman explained that the budget aimed to

ensure that AI-driven skills are given to youngsters at the ground level, even if they are school dropouts or pass outs, or had finished some kind of a qualification and have some degree but today want to acquire the AI-related skills. "All such people will be entertained in the ITI-based formulation that will come up. These hubs will provide hands-on AI training to students," she said,

adding that many states are keen to develop the model. Pointing out the need to urgently upskill India's youth to make them ready for 'quick and direct' employment after completing their education, the finance minister sought the private sector's participation in it. "How to bridge the human resource insufficiencies - not adequately trained, not the kind of degree I want. The rounding off of the personalities is missing. The degree is there, but the individual is not groomed adequately enough to be a part of the large multinationals or Indian companies that you are talking about. That element has to be done by all of us. I would want private sector participation together with the government in readying youth to be fit for quick and direct employment," Sitharaman said.

Supreme Court on Thursday agreed to urgently list on September 19 a petition seeking a stay on the Congress-led Karnataka government's decision

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Thursday agreed to urgently list on September 19 a petition seeking a stay on the Congress-led Karnataka government's decision to have Booker Prize winner Banu Mushtaq inaugurate the historic and world-famous Dussehra festival in Mysuru city. There is a tradition of offering floral tributes to Goddess Chamundeshwari during the inauguration of Dussehra, and opposition has arisen to Banu Mushtaq inaugurating the festival. After the matter was mentioned, Chief Justice of India B.R. Gavai agreed to list on Friday the special leave petition (SLP) challenging the Karnataka High Court's dismissal of three petitions filed by former BJP MP Pratap Simha and two others. In its decision delivered on September 15, a Bench of Chief Justice Vibhu Bakhr



and Justice C.M. Joshi of the Karnataka HC observed that no rights had been violated. The CJ Bakhr-led Bench observed that the Vijaya Dashami festival is celebrated across the country, and it signifies the victory of good over evil. Terming the decision of the Congress-led state government to invite Banu Mushtaq for the inauguration of Dussehra "incor-

rect", the petitioners claimed that Banu Mushtaq has issued anti-Hindu statements and made remarks against the Kannada language. Banu Mushtaq had reportedly made objectionable statements against Goddess Bhuvaneshwari and the Kannada flag. She also reportedly objected to the Kannada flag, which consists of haldi (yellow) and red (sin-

door) colours. The decision to choose Banu Mushtaq for inaugurating the historic Dussehra festival is being opposed by the BJP and Hindu outfits. One of the PILs, filed by a Bengaluru-based resident, H.S. Gourav, pleaded that the act of inaugurating Dussehra should be declared an integral part of Hindu tradition and must be performed by Hindu dignitaries. However, the Karnataka government has reiterated its stance to have the Dussehra festival inaugurated by Banu Mushtaq. The government has maintained that Dussehra is a 'Nada Habba' (festival of the land) and not strictly a religious event. Deputy Chief Minister and State Congress President D.K. Shivakumar's statement that Chamundi Hills is not exclusive to Hindus added to the furore.

BAC Meeting Decides to Hold AP Assembly Sessions for Ten Days



In a recent decision, the Business Advisory Committee (BAC) has agreed to conduct the Andhra Pradesh Assembly sessions over a span of ten days. Chaired by Speaker Ayyannapatru, the sessions will take place on both working days and holidays. The Telugu Desam Party (TDP) has put forth a proposal for 18 items to be discussed during these meetings. The assembly sessions commenced today, featuring a series of Question and Answer sessions where concerned ministers addressed various issues raised by members of the Legislative Assembly and the Council.

Heavy Rainfall Warning for Telangana

Hyderabad: The Meteorological Department has issued a warning for heavy rainfall across the state of Telangana, predicting moderate to heavy rains in several districts over the next three hours. Areas likely to be affected include Karimnagar, Mulugu, Janagama, Yadadri Bhuvanagiri, and Rangareddy, with potential occurrences of thunder and lightning. Residents are advised to venture outside only when necessary. This warning follows a week of consistent rainfall in Telangana, with particularly heavy downpours impacting Hyderabad on Wednesday. The city experienced torrential rain that led to significant water-



logging, with many areas witnessing up to 15cm of rainfall in just a few hours. As a result, roads were transformed into ponds, causing severe traffic disruptions at major intersections until midnight. Overflowing drains added to the chaos, and some two-wheeled vehicles were swept away by the floodwaters.

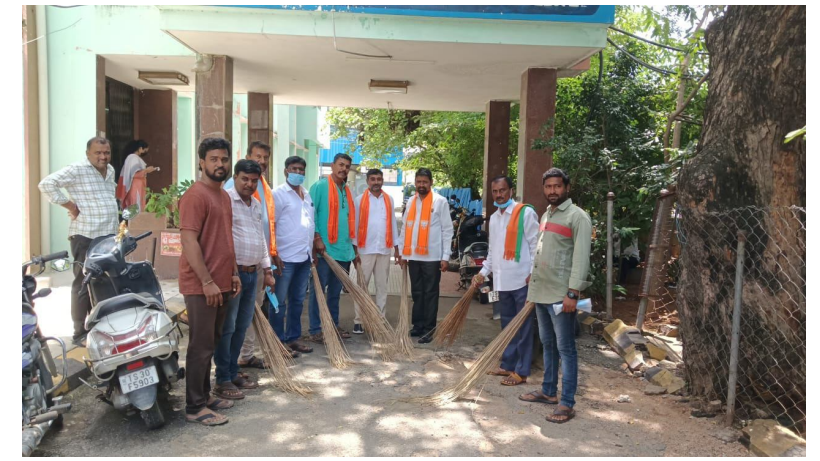

partner. Waltair Divisions enthusiastic participation reflects its ongoing dedication to public health and social empowerment.

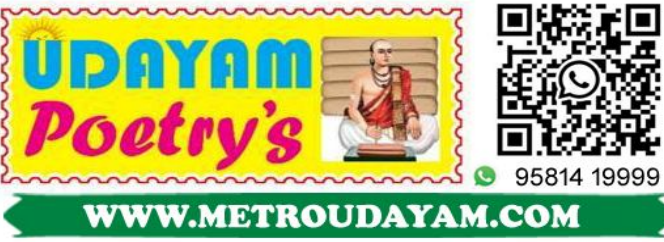
The launch event at the Divisional Railway Hospital was graced by ADRM (Operations) Shri Manoj Kumar Sahoo;

Chakravarthy No.1 T20I bowler in ICC rankings

Dubai: Mystery spinner Varun Chakaravarthy on Wednesday rose to the top of the ICC T20 Bowlers' Rankings for the first time in his career, becoming only the third Indian to achieve this feat. The 34-year-old emulated fast bowler Jasprit Bumrah and leg-spinner Ravi Bishnoi by moving up three spots following spells of 1/4 against the UAE and 1/24 in against Pakistan. Chakaravarthy, whose previous best was second place in February 2025, displaced New Zealand's Jacob Duffy, who had held the top position since March. "India spinner Varun Chakaravarthy has been



rewarded for his consistent form in 2025 by becoming the No.1 ranked bowler on the latest ICC Men's T20I Player Rankings," the ICC said in a statement. Left-arm spinner Kuldeep Yadav has made a significant leap,

jumping 16 places to 23rd, while spin all-rounder Axar Patel has moved up one place to 12th. Bumrah has also improved his position, rising four spots to 40th. In the all-rounders' rankings, Hardik Pandya continues to hold the top

spot, while Abhishek Sharma has climbed four places to 14th. Abhishek has also consolidated his position at the top of the T20 batting rankings. His explosive innings of 30 off 16 balls against the UAE and 31 off 13 against Pakistan have helped him achieve a career-high 884 rating points.

His opening partner Shubman Gill has moved up four places to 39th. However, Tilak Varma and captain Suryakumar Yadav have slipped in the rankings. Tilak is down two spots to fourth, while Suryakumar has dropped one position to seventh.

Neeraj qualifies for World C'ship final with 1st throw

Neeraj qualifies for World C'ship final with 1st throw Highlights 27-year-old two time Olympic-medallist sent his spear to 84.85m in his first throw in the Group A of the qualification round Tokyo: Defending champion Neeraj Chopra stormed into the men's javelin throw final of the World Championships in style after clearing the automatic qualification mark of 84.50m in his very first throw here on Wednesday. The 27-year-old two time Olympic-medallist sent his spear to 84.85m in his first throw in the Group A of the qualification round. In fact, Chopra was the first thrower and he packed up after making it to the final. Those who touch the automatic qualifying mark of 84.50m or the best 12 finishers will make the



final round to be held on Thursday. Chopra has been clubbed with German star Julian Weber, who also qualified with a throw of 87.21m, Keshorn Walcott, Jakub Vadlejch and Sachin Yadav in the 19-man Group A qualification round on Wednesday. The 18-

strong Group B will feature Olympic champion Arshad Nadeem, Anderson Peters, Julius Yego, Luiz Da Silva, Rohit Yadav, Yashvir Singh, and rising Sri Lankan Rumesh Tharanga Pathiranga among others. In the last edition in Budapest, Chopra had thrown 88.17m to win the gold, while Nadeem (87.82m) and Vadlejch (86.67m) had pocketed silver and bronze respectively. Chopra will aim to become the third male javelin thrower in history to defend the World Championships gold. Czech legend Jan Zelezny (1993, 1995), who is now Chopra's coach, and Peters (2019, 2022) are the other two who have won the world championships crown on two consecutive occasions.
