



Supreme Court adjourns hearing on bail pleas of Umar Khalid, Sharjeel Imam till Sep 22

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Friday adjourned hearing on the bail pleas of Sharjeel Imam, Umar Khalid, Meeran Haider, and Gulfisha Fatima -- all accused in the 2020 Delhi riots conspiracy case and booked under the stringent Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act (UAPA). A Bench of Justices Aravind Kumar and Manmohan deferred hearing till Monday, September 22, on the batch of special leave petitions (SLPs) after an adjournment was sought on the petitioners' behalf. In the previous hearing, the Justice Kumar-led Bench expressed difficulty in taking up the batch of SLPs and directed that the matters be listed for hearing on September 19. Earlier, the Delhi High Court had



denied bail to several activists and student leaders in connection with the alleged larger conspiracy behind the North-East Delhi riots. In its order passed on September 2, a Bench of

Justices Shalinder Kaur and Navin Chawla observed, prima facie, that there was sufficient material on record to suggest that Imam and Khalid had masterminded the conspiracy. The

Justice Kaur-led Bench noted that Khalid and Imam had delivered inflammatory speeches on February 24, 2020, coinciding with the then US President Donald Trump's State visit, which the prosecution alleged was deliberately timed to trigger riots on February 23 - 24 and draw international attention. "The alleged inflammatory and provocative speeches delivered by the appellants, when considered in totality, prima facie indicate their role in the alleged conspiracy," the Delhi High Court said. In relation to Meeran Haider, it noted that she allegedly provided funds to the Alumni Association of Jamia Millia Islamia (AAJMI), where meetings of the JCC (JMI Coordination Committee) were

held. The Justice Kaur-led bench further noted the prosecution's submission that the completion of the investigation against Haider did not constitute a material change in circumstances to justify bail, citing pending witness examination and the gravity of the alleged conspiracy. According to the prosecution, Gulfisha Fatima used code words to instruct protesters to undertake actions in furtherance of the alleged conspiracy and received funds for it. The February 2020 Delhi riots, which broke out during protests against the Citizenship Amendment Act (CAA) and the National Register of Citizens (NRC), left 53 people dead and more than 700 injured.

Dy CM Pawan Kalyan outlines action plan for plastic-free AP

Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan has announced his commitment to creating a plastic-free Andhra Pradesh, revealing plans for an action strategy aimed at reducing plastic waste. Speaking in the Assembly on Friday, Kalyan called upon citizens to actively participate in achieving a plastic-free society. Kalyan acknowledged that plastic has become ingrained in daily life and stressed the importance of exploring alternatives. He reiterated that a ban on plastic in Tirumala will be enforced with diligence and expressed concerns over the rampant use of flex banners for even minor events. To combat single-use plastic, Kalyan has instructed district collectors to imple-

ment stricter controls. He outlined that the secretariat has already been designated as plastic-free, with water now served in glass bottles. As part of a circular economy initiative, Kalyan announced plans to establish parks and recycling units for plastic, alongside encouragement for biodegradable manufacturing industries. He urged citizens to take an active role in this environmental effort, pointing out that political parties contribute to pollution through excessive use of plastic materials during events. Highlighting the severity of the plastic crisis, Kalyan noted that plastic takes around 300 years to decompose and is increasingly found in the food chain, affecting both live-



stock and human health. He explained that micro and nano plastics are becoming ubiquitous, calling for a detailed plan to be unveiled within the next two to three months. In recognition of communities making strides towards reducing plastic waste, Kalyan announced

the introduction of incentives for plastic-free villages through the Nirmal Gram Puraskar awards. He concluded by indicating that a special discussion on environmental issues and pollution will take place in the upcoming assembly session.

Dussehra Holidays scheduled changed in AP, schools to have holidays from September 22



In a significant announcement, the government of Andhra Pradesh has revised the Dussehra holiday schedule for schools across the state. State Education Minister Nara Lokesh disclosed the changes on Friday, September 19. Initially, the holidays were set from September 24 to October 2, but the latest announcement brings the dates forward to September 22, extending the holiday period by two additional days. With the change, students will now enjoy a total of 11 days off instead of the previously planned 9 days. Minister Lokesh explained that the decision to adjust the holiday schedule was made in response to teachers' requests for an earlier break. He shared the news via a post on X-Vediya, stating that he had consulted with education department officials prior to making the announcement. Schools are scheduled to reopen on October 3. In a related note, junior colleges will maintain their holiday schedule from September 28 to October 5, with no changes. Furthermore, the government has also announced that Christian minority schools will observe their Dussehra holidays from September 27 to October 2, providing them with a total of 6 days off.

AP Assembly Sessions underway for second day with question hour

Vijayawada: The second day of the Andhra Pradesh Assembly session commenced with Speaker Ayyannapatturudu leading the question-and-answer session. Minister Satyakumar addressed concerns raised by MLA Mohammed Nazir regarding outstanding payments to hospitals. During the session,

Minister Satyakumar disclosed that hospitals are currently facing arrears totalling ₹110 crore. Specifically, he noted that ₹4.09 crore is owed to the Government Hospital in Guntur. The revelation sheds light on the financial challenges affecting healthcare facilities in the region.



KTR to meet BRS leaders to discuss on strategies for Jubilee Hills by-election

Hyderabad: The Bharat Rashtira Samithi (BRS) leadership is keen to secure the Jubilee Hills assembly seat once again, as they embark on strategic preparations for the upcoming by-election. Party executive president KY Rama Rao (KTR) is currently convening a series of meetings with division-level leaders from the constituency. Notably, he is set to address booth-level committees from the Erragadda division at Telangana Bhavan on Friday, where he will outline the party's strategy for the by-election. KTR has already held discussions

with party cadres in Vengalrao Nagar and Rahmat Nagar, and BRS leadership has appointed in-charges for the various divisions within the constituency. The BRS has demonstrated sig support within the Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC) limits during previous assembly elections. Consequently, the ruling Congress party is also focused on winning the by-election for Jubilee Hills, understanding that the outcome will likely influence the forthcoming GHMC elections. All political parties are treating this by-election

with considerable ambition. Speculation is rife regarding candidate selection, with reports s that the BRS is poised to nominate Sunita, the wife of the late Maganti Gopinath. Gopinath won by a significant margin in the 2023 Telangana Assembly elections and had a history of victories from the same constituency until his recent passing due to illness. Meanwhile, Congress Chief Minister Revanth Reddy disclosed in a recent review meeting that the party's high command will soon announce their candidate choice.

Prasad (A1), Veena Saraswathi (A2), Vijay Kumar Shetty (A3), and Salvasai Ramaraju (A4). A private criminal case has been filed against Lingamoorthy (A5) and Aban Ichaporla (A6) in the Secunderabad court. He

said that cases have been registered against them under sections 351(2), 356(2), 61(2), 79, 3(5) of the IPC. They demanded that those involved in corruption in the Lions Club, which is home to service programs, be immediately

removed from the Lions Club membership. Otherwise, they warned that they would stage a dharna in front of the Secunderabad Lions Bhavan. He said that a woman who was expelled from the Lions Club against the rules had approached the court, explaining the injustice done to her and seeking a thorough investigation into the misuse of club funds and restoration of her illegally expelled Lions Club membership. They asked Lions International representatives and government officials to ensure that justice is done to the woman who was questioned about the misuse of funds and suspended.

Adopt technology and make use TLM:Additional collector Pinkesh Kumar,Jangaon district



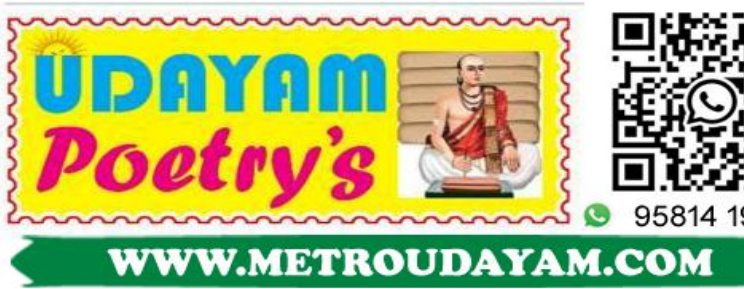
Jangaon, September 19, Metroudayam: On the occasion of Dist TLM mela,

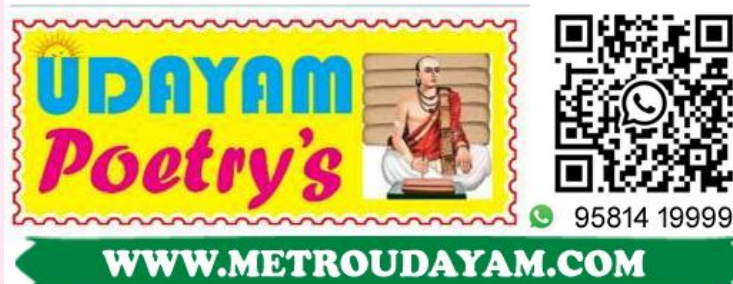


Delhi Public School Nacharam Issues Clarification on Student Safety Incident

Hederabad, metro udayamHyderabad, August 30 Delhi Public School (DPS), Nacharam, has issued an official clarification regarding an incident that occurred on August 29, 2025, during lunch break involving a small group of students. According to the school, the matter was identified through CCTV surveillance, following which the injured child was immediately taken to the Medical Inspection (MI) Room and given first aid. With parental consent, the child was shifted within 30 minutes to Prasad Hospital in a school vehicle, accompanied by the school

nurse. Later, upon the parents decision, the child was moved to a hospital in Banjara Hills, where senior school staff continued to assist and support the family. The school management stated that all necessary evidence, including CCTV footage, has been provided to the police to aid the investigation, adding that there has been no negligence whatsoever. Strict disciplinary action has been taken: the vigilance officer of the concerned floor has been suspended, students involved have been suspended with parental counselling, and one student has been permanently expelled due to

the seriousness of the matter. The school leadership emphasized that they are in constant touch with the family and are extending academic support to ensure the child's education continues without disruption during recovery. DPS Nacharam also urged the public and media to respect the privacy and safety of the child and the family, requesting that no information be circulated that may harm their dignity. The school expressed deep regret over the incident and reaffirmed its commitment to student safety and well-being.

आचार्य पुष्पदंत भूतबली द्वारा दिगंबर ग्रंथ षट्खंडागम में मंगलाचरण के रूप में लिपिबद्ध किया एक महा मंत्र है जिसे 'नमस्कार मंत्र', 'नमस्कार मंत्र' और 'पंच परमेष्ठि नमस्कार' कहा जाता है। जिसमें पांचों परमेष्ठियों अरिहंत, सिद्ध, आचार्य, उपाध्याय और साधु को नमस्कार से सम्मानित किया गया है। 58 मात्राएं, 35 अक्षर, 34 स्वर, 30 व्यंजन और 5 पद वाले इस महामंत्र का पठन मंगलमय, पाप नाशक और मनो. कामना पूर्ण करने वाला माना जाता है।

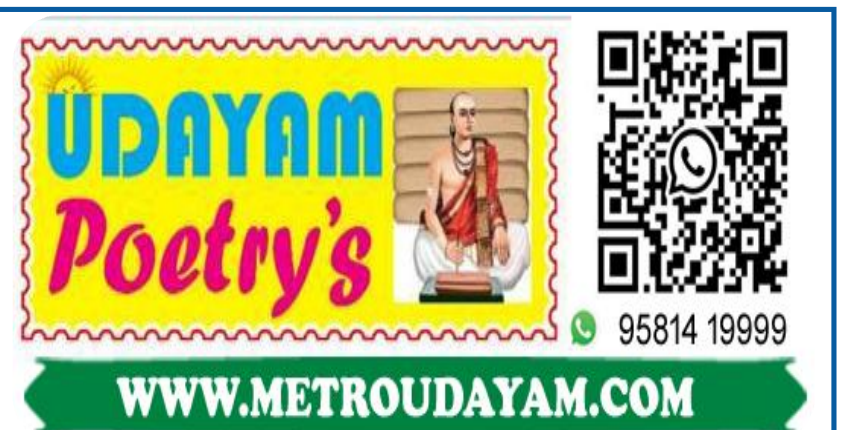

यह णमोकार मंत्र एक अनादि निधन (अनादि और अनंत) महामंत्र है, याने यह न तो कभी शुरू हुआ और न ही कभी समाप्त होगा। इसे जैन धर्म में सबसे महत्वपूर्ण मंत्र माना जाता है। कहा जाता है के इसको लिपिबद्ध रूप में आचार्य पुष्पदंत भूतबली ने लिखा है लेकिन यह महामंत्र जैन परंपरा में अनादि से चला आ रहा है। यह अनादि काल से चला आ रहा है। यह मंत्र मुझे बहुत प्यारा प्रतीत होता है। मैं भी णमो. कार मंत्र में कहें गए सभी अरिहंत, सिद्ध, आचार्य, उपाध्याय और साधुओं को नमस्कार के साथ आदर करता हूँ।

इस नमस्कार मंत्र में एक नमस्कार उनको है जो अरि. हंत कहलाते हैं। अरिहंत वह जो क्रोध, लोभ, द्वेष, मोह, मान और माया के सभी आंतरिक शत्रुओं पर विजय प्राप्त कर लिया हो। और नमस्कार उन सिद्ध पुरुषों को भी है जिन्होंने सिद्धियों को प्राप्त कर लिया। और उन आचार्यों को भी है जिन्होंने जीवन जीने का तरीका सिखाया। और उन उपाध्यायों की भी है जिन्होंने अपने शरण में आए अल्पज्ञानियों को ज्ञान दिया और उन साधुओं को है जिन्होंने धर्म की राह पर चलकर सच्चरित्र का पालन किए। और जगत का कल्याण किए।

इस महामंत्र के लाभ इस तरह बताए गए हैं के, "एसो पंच नमोक्कारो, सव्व पवप्पनसन्नो, मंगला नं च सव्वेसिं, पाठं हवै मंगलं" याने "यह पंचांगिक नमस्कार समस्त पापों का समूल नाश कर देता है। और, सभी शुभ मंत्रों में, (यह) वास्तव में सबसे शुभ है।" (यह भी बताते चलूँ के, मेरी इबादत तो केवल इलाह (पूजनीय, एकीश्वर) के लिए है लेकिन आदर, नमस्कार उन सभी को है जो ईश्वर के खास, पसंदीदा लोग हैं।)

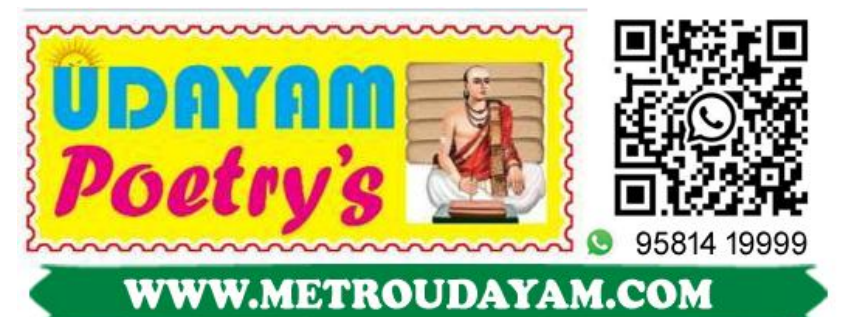

Neeraj Chopra ends 8th at World Championships



Tokyo: Defending champion Neeraj Chopra crashed out of the World Championships' men's javelin throw final after the fifth round with a best of effort 84.03m that left him eighth overall here on Thursday. He was eighth after the fourth throw and fouled the fifth one to exit the competition. Only the top six athletes will compete in the sixth and final round. Olympic champion Arshad Nadeem of Pakistan also made an exit in the fourth round. Another Indian Sachin Yadav is still in the competition, placed fourth overall with a best of 86.27m.

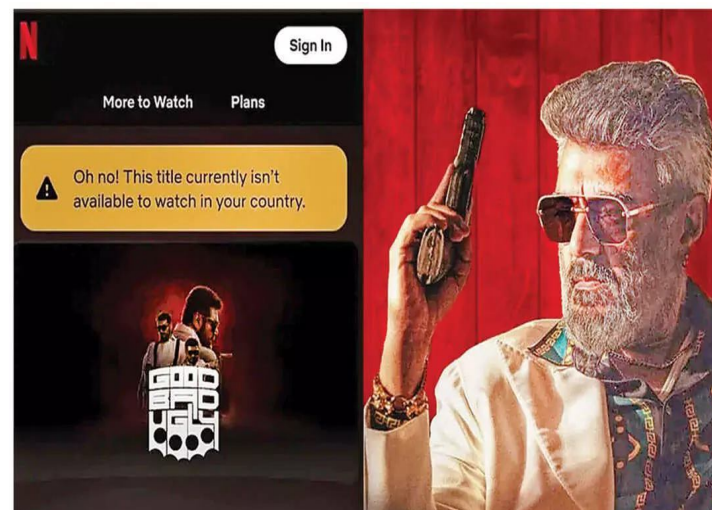

Ajith's 'Good Bad Ugly' pulled from Netflix after Ilaiyaraaja's copyright lawsuit

Copyright battles are tightening their grip on India's film and OTT industries, with yet another high-profile case drawing attention. Ajith Kumar's Good Bad Ugly, directed by Adhik Ravichandran, has been removed from Netflix following an interim order by the Madras High Court over copyright infringement claims. The film, which also stars Trisha, Arjun Das, Prasanna, Prabhu, and Sunil, hit theatres on April 10 before landing on Netflix on May 8. However, it is now unavailable for streaming after legendary composer Ilaiyaraaja alleged that several of his iconic songs were used without authorization. The disputed tracks include Ottha Ruba Tharen, En Jodi Manja Kuruvi, and Ilamai Idho Idho. According to reports, Ilaiyaraaja initially demanded ₹5 crore in compensation along with a formal apology. When negotiations failed, he filed a lawsuit against the producers, Mythri Movie



Makers. While the production house claimed they had obtained permission, they were unable to produce legal proof before the court. Justice N Senthikumar, in his interim ruling, barred the makers from exhibiting, distributing, or streaming the film on any platform, including Netflix, until the matter is resolved. The order

underscores the judiciary's strict approach toward copyright enforcement in the entertainment sector. This is not the first instance of a film being pulled from digital platforms after release. Earlier, Nani's 2021 thriller V was removed from Amazon Prime Video over similar disputes. Netflix too has faced challenges, particularly with documentaries involving actress Nayanthara, which ran into issues concerning personality rights. The Good Bad Ugly controversy highlights the growing complexities surrounding music rights and fair use in films. For now, fans of Ajith will have to wait, as the film remains offline until the legal battle reaches its conclusion.
