



Chandrababu Naidu enjoys an envious Brahmotsavams distinction

During these sacred Brahmotsavams, which devotees consider as grand celebrations, Naidu created a record by presenting silk clothes to Lord Venkateswara the highest number of times as Chief Minister. He has presented silk clothes a total of 15 times. Devotees attribute this rare privilege to the grace of the Lord of the Kali Yuga. History may never see such a privilege given to another. The countless rituals and festivals that begin daily with the Suprabhata Seva for Lord Venkateswara Swamy of Tirumala—worshipped as the visible deity of the Kali Yuga and the supreme leader of the universe—are celebrated with grandeur. Among them, the Brahmotsavams stand apart in magnificence. It is said that Lord Srinivasa himself instructed Lord Brahma, the creator, to conduct the festivals in the early days, and Brahma began the practice. To protect the world from hardships and ensure the overall well-being, these festivals have been conducted every year ever since. Since they were initiated by Lord Brahma, they came to be known as Brahmotsavams. The Brahmotsavams of Lord Venkateswara are being celebrated in great glory for over 800 years in Tirumala. The Puranas also highlight their immense significance. With the belief that Lord Brahma himself conducted these nine-day festivals for Lord Venkateswara, they are called Brahmotsavams. Over the course of these nine days, Lord Venkateswara blesses devotees by appearing in different incarnations on various vehicles (vahanams) along the streets of Tirumala. Millions of devotees



from all over the country participate in these celebrations. Since 1978, it has become a tradition for the state government to present silk clothes (pattu vastralu) to Lord Venkateswara during Brahmotsavams. In 1978, then Chief Minister Marri Chenna Reddy became the first to present silk clothes on behalf of the Andhra Pradesh government. Subsequently, officials from the Endowments Department continued the practice. In 1984, when Nandamuri Taraka Rama Rao (NTR) was the Chief Minister, he revived the tradition of CM's presenting silk clothes on behalf of the government. Since then, several Chief Ministers—NTR, Chenna Reddy, N Janardhana Reddy, K Vijayabhaskar Reddy and Y S Rajasekhara Reddy—have presented silk clothes. In 2003, when Chandrababu Naidu was on his way to Tirumala to present the silk clothes for the Brahmotsavams, he was injured in a bomb blast that was triggered by Naxalites

near Alipiri. On that occasion, then TTD chairman Pappula Chalapati Rao presented the silk robes. From that time onwards, presentation of silk clothes was shifted by TTD from Garuda Seva day to Dwajrohanam (flag hoisting) day. During these sacred Brahmotsavams, which devotees consider as grand celebrations, Naidu created a record by presenting silk clothes to Lord Venkateswara the highest number of times as Chief Minister. He began the practice in 1995 during his first tenure as Chief Minister and did so from 1995 to 2004, except in 2003 when the Alipiri attack prevented him from attending. Later, during his tenure from 2014 to 2019, and again from 2024, he has presented silk clothes a total of 15 times. Devotees attribute this rare privilege to the grace of the Lord of the Kali Yuga. History may never see such a privilege given to another. Chandrababu Naidu is known for his deep devotion to Lord Venkateswara. He has often said that it was only by the blessings of the Lord that he was able to survive several challenges in life, including the Alipiri bomb attack. He has always taken steps to preserve the sanctity of Tirumala, which he visits frequently with his family. The Nitya Annadanam (daily food offering) program, launched by NTR on April 6, 1985, at Tirumala, has since been expanded by Chandrababu Naidu. While it began with meals served to a limited number of devotees, today, under this program, over one lakh devotees are served food daily. On the birthday of his grandson, Nara Devansh, the family bears the entire cost of

annadanam for the day at Tarigonda Vengamamba Annprasadam Centre. Chandrababu Naidu has also played a major role in development activities in the Tirupati-Tirumala region, including temple services, healthcare, education, and infrastructure. He has taken many measures for the growth and sanctity of Tirumala temple. He cancelled many commercial permits given by the previous government, which were leading to commercialisation of TTD. He also directed that employees of other faiths working in Tirumala be transferred to other departments. He instructed TTD to bring about one hundred reforms in its services, improve facilities for devotees, ensure transparency in administration, and enhance the quality of the sacred laddu prasadam. He warned against misuse of temple funds under the guise of development works. His focus has always been on making darshan and facilities easy and comfortable for devotees. He emphasized that purification of Tirumala must be total, with no exceptions. Unfortunately, during the previous government, the sanctity of the Tirumala laddu prasadam and the glory of Lord Venkateswara were tarnished, which deeply disturbed the Hindu community. On regaining power 15 months back, Naidu has been making amends by bringing in several reforms. For this, he has been praised by devotees, as well as national leaders like the Prime Minister, Union Ministers and MPs, for protecting the sanctity of Tirumala. Telangana govt. announces notification for new liquor shops

The government of Telangana has announced the opening of applications for new liquor shops, inviting submissions from tomorrow (Friday) until 18 October. The allocation of licences will be determined through a draw scheduled for 23 October. The new licences will remain valid from 1 December 2025 until 30 November 2027. The tender fee has been increased to ₹3 lakh, up from the previous rate of ₹2 lakh, which marks an increment of ₹1 lakh. Applicants will benefit from the option to pay this fee in six instalments rather than in a single lump sum. The current licence period for existing liquor shops is set to expire on 30 November. It is also noteworthy that individuals convicted under the Excise Act of 1968 will be deemed ineligible to apply for new liquor shops. Within the state's 2,620 existing liquor outlets, there is a 15 per cent reservation for Gowdas, 10 per cent for Scheduled Castes, and 5 per cent for Scheduled Tribes.



AP Assembly Speaker Unveils New Building Complex

The Speaker of the Andhra Pradesh Assembly, Chintakayala Ayyannapatrudu, officially opened a new building complex within the Assembly premises on Thursday morning. This facility includes newly established offices for the Chief Whip and other whips, as well as a media point and dining hall situated on the ground floor. The inauguration ceremony was attended by notable figures including Minister Narayana, Minister Payyavula Keshav, Chief Whip GV Anjaneyulu, and various other guests. During the



event, AP Assembly Secretary General Prasanna Kumar praised the Speaker for revitalising the previously neglected building. He conveyed gratitude on behalf of the Legislative Secretariat for

the efforts taken to bring the facility to its current state. Addressing those present, Speaker Ayyannapatrudu highlighted that the building has been modernised at a cost of ₹3.57 crore, featuring 16 new cabins. He acknowledged the efforts of Minister Narayana in overseeing the construction process and mentioned plans to enhance media facilities further. Additionally, he appealed to Finance Minister Payyavula Keshav for increased financial support for future improvements.

TGPSC announces Group 1 final results

Hyderabad: In a significant development for the unemployed youth of Telangana State, the highly anticipated final results of the TGPSC Group 1 examination were released on Wednesday, 24 September, at midnight. A total of 562 candidates have been selected for Group 1 service posts, with the complete list available on the official TGPSC website. The candidates' selection has been based on their priority order for the various posts. TGPSC Chairman Burra Venkatesham announced that 562 candidates achieved success out of a total of 563 available posts, with one position withheld due to an ongoing legal dispute. The announcement of results followed a stay issued by a state High Court bench against a prior ruling from a single judge. This led the commission to expedite the result declaration process. In the final selection, 258 candidates were chosen for Group 1 positions in Multizone 1, while 304 candidates were selected for Group 1 roles in Multizone 2.



Telangana Weather Update: Heavy Rain in Some Districts, Hyderabad Light Rain

In the next 2-3 hours, moderate to heavy rain is expected in Bhupalapally, Mulugu, Hanmakonda, Warangal, Karimnagar, Nizamabad, Jagtial, Sircilla, Peddapalli, and Asifabad. 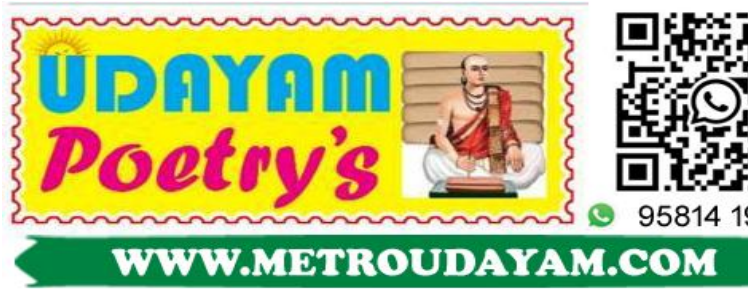
International Seminar on Girmityology : Dr.Seshni Moodliar Rensburg

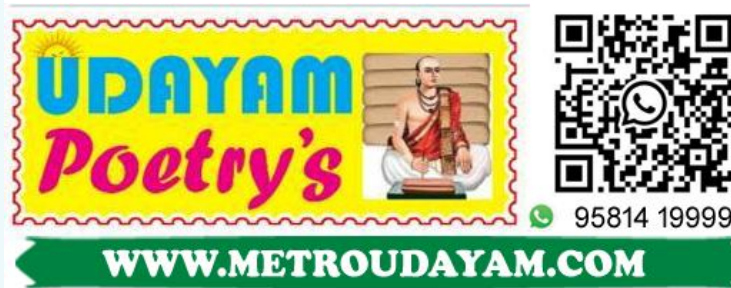

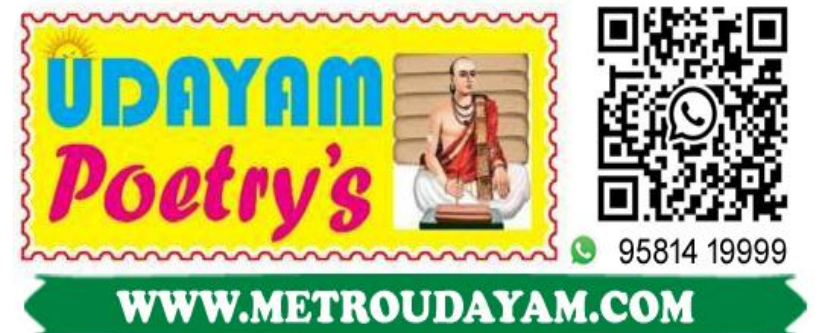

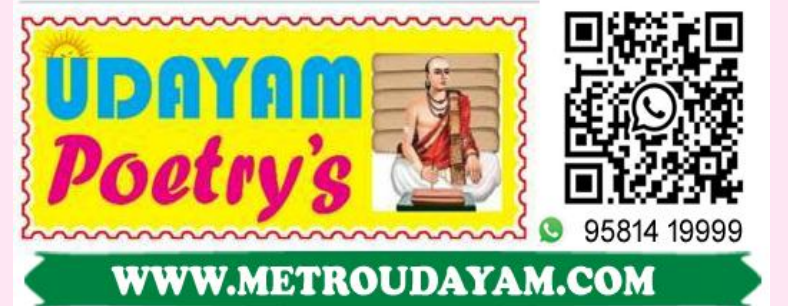

Abhishek, Varun retain top spots in T20I rankings

New Delhi: Despite many players making a surge in the ICC Men's T20I rankings, India duo of Abhishek Sharma and Varun Chakravarthy have retained their top spots in the batting and bowling charts, respectively. Despite going wicketless in the recent Super Fours outing against Pakistan in the Asia Cup, Chakaravarthy bowled an economical spell of 0-25 that helped control the scoring rate and has consolidated his place at the top with a 14 rating-point gain. Seam-bowling all-rounder Hardik Pandya is up six places to 60th place in bowlers' rankings, while retaining top spot in all-rounders' rankings in the shortest format. Abhishek, meanwhile, has managed to hold on to the top spot due to his quickfire 38 against Oman in India's final



group stage encounter, before smashing a match-winning 74 to chase down Pakistan's total of 171 on Sunday. His teammate, left-handed batter Tilak Varma, who helped finish the chase against Pakistan with an electric 30 not

out off 19 balls, has gained a position to be at number three in the batters' rankings. In terms of other rankings gainers through the Asia Cup, Pakistan leg-spinner Abrar Ahmed has surged to number four in bowlers' rankings following a significant leap of 12 places taking his tally to 703 rating points. It comes on the back of him returning with a miserly spell of 1-8 against Sri Lanka that helped Pakistan revive their campaign. Abrar had earlier picked up 2-13 against the UAE, though he endured a subdued outing against India (1-42). Bangladesh's left-arm pacer Mustafizur Rahman also returned to the top 10 after a six-place jump, recovering from a brief dip in form last week. So far, he has claimed six wickets at an average of eight in his last two matches, reaffirm-

ing his value in the T20I setup. Pakistan's Haris Rauf (up nine places to 28) is the other notable gainer in the bowling charts. In the batting rankings, Sahibzada Farhan climbed 31 places to reach 24th spot after a fluent 58 off 45 balls against India, while Hussain Talat made a staggering jump of 1474 places to joint 234th following his match-winning knock against Sri Lanka. Bangladesh's Saif Hassan also made a mark, rising 133 places to 81st after his 61-run effort in the Super Four stage. Among all-rounders, Pakistan's Faheem Ashraf moved up 12 places to joint 39th, rewarded for his consistent control with the ball, while Sri Lanka's Wanindu Hasaranga climbed to seventh place after picking four wickets in his last two outings.
