New Delhi: The Vice President of India, C.P. Radhakrishnan, will be on a day-long visit to Bihar on Sunday, during which he will attend key cultural and spiritual engagements.

part of his official itinerary, the Vice President will serve as the Chief Guest at the closing session of the third edition of 'Unmesh - International Literature Festival' in Patna. The festival has become a significant platform for literary exchange and cultural dialogue, bringing together writers, poets, and intellectuals from across India and the world.

"During his visit, the Vice President will grace the valedictory session of the third edition of Unmesha - International Literature Festival in Patna, as the Chief Guest. The Vice President will also visit Shri Chamunda Devi Mandir at Katra, Muzaffarpur," Vice



President's Secretariat mentioned in a press release.

In addition to his participation in the literary event, the Vice President will also visit the revered Shri Chamunda Devi Temple in Katra, located in the Muzaffarpur district, where he is scheduled

to offer prayers. His arrival in Katra is expected at around 1.00 p.m. A dedicated helipad has been constructed near Bhadayee Chowk, approximately three kilometres south of the temple, adjacent to NH-527C, to facilitate his arrival by helicopter.

In preparation for the Vice President's visit, the Muzaffarpur district administration has undertaken extensive arrangements. The temple premises and surrounding roads have been cleaned and repaired, and the temple has been adorned with decorative banners and traditional bandanwars. Authorities have also erected barricades on both sides of the approach roads to control crowd movement and ensure security.

Senior officials, including District Magistrate and SSP Sushil Kumar, conducted thorough inspections on Saturday. Two helicopters were used to conduct aerial test runs, and access routes were cleared of obstructions, including makeshift huts along the path. Residents are eagerly awaiting the arrival of the Vice President.

CM Revanth Reddy addresses concerns on Bharat Future City, says it is to benefit future generations

Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy has publicly condemned what he describes as the politicisation of the Bharat Future City initiative. Speaking at the foundation stone-laying ceremony for the Future City Development Authority (FCDA) building and the Green Field Radial Road-1 in Mirkhanpet, Rangareddy district, Reddy expressed frustration at the misinformation surrounding the project, particularly allegations regarding his own land ownership in the area. In his address, CM Reddy underlined that Future City is designed for the benefit of future generations, drawing parallels with historical precedents such as Hi-Tech City, Shamshabad Airport, and the Outer Ring Road (ORR). He emphasised the importance of laying foundations for the future, citing the need to learn from developments initiated by former leaders like Chandrababu Naidu and Y.S. Rajasekhara Reddy. Reddy remarked, "How many more years will we continue to look to foreign countries? Give us ten years, and we will create a city that will make New York forget the standard of living it has set." Reddy went on to highlight the long-term vision for Bharat Future City, which he claims will include a dry port linked to the Machilipatnam Greenfield Highway and a proposed bullet train connection from Future City to Amaravati. Additionally, he confirmed plans for underground power lines within the city. "Our objective is to attract Fortune 500 companies to Bharat Future City over the next decade. The government is committed to making this vision a reality," Reddy stated. He urged local residents to cooperate with the government to overcome any minor issues, promising immediate assistance from officials. Furthermore, Reddy pledged that by December 2026, the Singareni Corporate Office would be constructed on ten acres allocated for this purpose. He assured attendees that he and his administration will hope to foster investment and business activities within Future City, reaffirming their dedication to solving residents' concerns. The event was attended by Deputy Chief Minister Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka, Minister Sridhar Babu, other ministers, MLAs, MLCs, corporation chairmen, and senior officials.



Telangana Aims for \$1 Trillion Economy by 2034: CM Revanth Reddy

In a bold announcement, Chief Minister Revanth Reddy stated that Telangana should strive to become a \$1 trillion economy by 2034 and a \$3 trillion economy by 2047. This declaration was made during the inauguration of the Advanced Technology Center (ATC) at Mallepalli ITI. Speaking at the event, CM Reddy emphasised the importance of equipping students with practical skills alongside their academic education. He revealed that discussions have been held with Tata Technologies to enhance skill development among the youth, contributing to the establishment of ATCs in collaboration with the company. "The automobile industry offers vast job opportunities, yet there is a significant shortage of skilled workers within the state," Reddy noted, citing feedback from automobile traders. To address this issue, 65 ATCs have been developed at an investment of ₹2,400 crore, with around 200 admissions per centre. The Chief Minister also announced the approval of an additional 51 ATCs and proposed a monthly stipend of ₹2,000 for trainees. Reddy stressed that Telangana's progress is rooted in the aspirations and struggles of the unemployed population. He voiced concerns about the job market, advising young people, "Don't think that you will secure employment abroad merely through software courses." Highlighting success stories, he mentioned that individuals trained at ATCs have landed jobs in Germany, earning substantial salaries of ₹3.5 lakh per month. He further urged the youth to focus on acquiring technical skills, which he deemed essential for success in today's job market. In addressing social issues, he expressed regret over the involvement of engineering students in cannabis-related cases, urging them to avoid substance abuse that could harm both themselves and their families.

India proposes 'Chhath Puja' for UNESCO heritage status, PM Modi highlights in 'Mann Ki Baat'

New Delhi: In his latest 126th episode of 'Mann Ki Baat' address on Sunday, Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced that India is actively working to include Chhath Puja in UNESCO's Intangible Cultural Heritage list, a move aimed at "recognising the deep cultural and spiritual significance of the festival". The Prime Minister emphasised that Chhath Puja is not just a ritual but a vibrant expression of ecological harmony, devotion, and community participation. Chhath Puja, predominantly celebrated in Bihar, Jharkhand, eastern Uttar Pradesh, and parts of Nepal, honours the Sun God and Chhathi Maiya. Devotees offer prayers at riverbanks and ponds, observing rigorous fasts and rituals that span four days.



The festival is known for its emphasis on cleanliness, environmental awareness, and collective celebration, often involving entire neighbourhoods and families. Prime Minister Modi highlighted how Chhath Puja reflects India's ancient traditions of nature worship and sustainable living. He noted that the festival's rituals - such as offering

'arghya' to the setting and rising sun - symbolise gratitude and reverence for natural forces. Chhath is a festival that connects us to rivers, sunlight, and purity. It is a celebration of faith and nature. The announcement follows the successful inclusion of Durga Puja in UNESCO's Intangible Cultural Heritage list in 2021, which brought global recognition to Bengal's iconic celebration. The Prime Minister expressed hope that Chhath Puja would similarly gain international acknowledgement, showcasing India's rich cultural diversity and spiritual depth. Efforts are underway by the Ministry of Culture and other stakeholders to prepare the nomination dossier for UNESCO, which involves documenting the festival's

history, practices, and community involvement. Cultural experts and historians have welcomed the move, ecology, and social unity. The Prime Minister's mention of Chhath Puja in 'Mann Ki Baat' will spark enthusiasm among devotees and cultural advocates, especially in regions where the festival is a cornerstone of identity. If accepted, Chhath Puja will join the ranks of globally celebrated traditions, reinforcing India's position as a custodian of living heritage. The initiative reflects a broader push to preserve and promote India's intangible cultural assets on the world stage, ensuring that festivals rooted in local traditions receive the respect and visibility they deserve.

Similarly, cases were also registered earlier against Lochali Kumara Swamy and Gomangi Nani Babu at Visakhapatnam Government Railway Police Station.

Guest speaker Naganaboyina Nageswara Rao, Chairman of

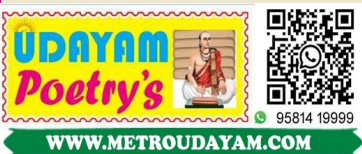
