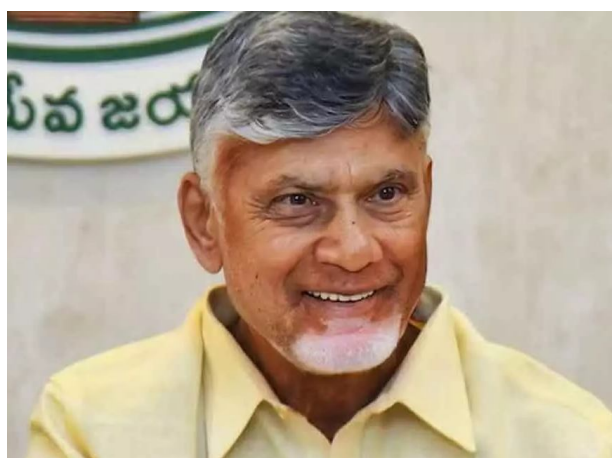


CM Chandrababu orders compensation to Konaseema explosion victims

In the wake of the tragic fireworks explosion in the Konaseema district, Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu has instructed officials to provide a compensation package of Rs. 15 lakh to the families of the deceased. He pledged that the government will extend all possible support to the affected families. During a meeting at the Secretariat attended by Home Minister Anita and officials Suresh and Ake Ravikrishna, a detailed report regarding the explosion was presented to the Chief Minister. The report highlighted that 14 workers were engaged in manufacturing materials at the same location when the incident occurred. Officials indicated that a spark, originating from the use of hard materials, ignited the area where the manufacturing activities were taking place. Alarming, the report revealed a significant lapse in adherence to safety regulations. The Chief Minister emphasised the need for regular inspections to ensure compliance with safety rules prior to the issuance of manufacturing licenses. He proposed the installation of CCTV cameras at manufacturing sites, along with ongoing monitoring via a control room. To enhance safety



measures, CM Chandrababu outlined plans to implement online purchasing for explosive materials, thereby increasing oversight on acquisitions and manufacturing processes. He stressed that any manufacturing centres failing to meet regulatory standards, or operating without proper authorisation, should be strictly prohibited. Furthermore, he ordered the immediate filing of cases under the PD Act against those violating safety regulations and mandated that all fireworks manufacturing facilities must comply with existing laws. The Chief Minister also insisted that workers at these centres should possess personal insurance to safeguard their welfare.

Nara Lokesh seeks partnership with New South Wales to Boost innovation

Andhra Pradesh Minister Nara Lokesh has proposed the establishment of an Andhra Pradesh-New South Wales (AP-NSW) Innovation and Industry Partnership aimed at fostering collaboration in advanced manufacturing, startups, and green technology. This initiative was discussed during Lokesh's courtesy visit to New South Wales Premier Chris Minns as part of his ongoing tour in Australia.



During the meeting, Lokesh expressed his desire to facilitate an agreement between the Andhra Pradesh and New South Wales governments focused on innovation, trade, and skills development. He highlighted the importance of linking NSW innovation clusters with emerging hubs in Andhra Pradesh, specifically in Visakhapatnam, Amaravati, and Anantapur. The Minister urged NSW companies involved in sectors such as renewable energy, medical technology (meditech), agricultural technology (agritech), and logistics to consider

investing in Andhra Pradesh's industrial corridors. Furthermore, he advocated for enhanced collaboration between educational institutions in New South Wales and Andhra Pradesh, encouraging joint research and development initiatives in clean technology, artificial intelligence, and sustainable infrastructure. Lokesh also extended an invitation for a delegation led by the NSW Minister to attend the Partnership Summit-2025, which is set to take place in Visakhapatnam.

Home Minister Anitha Highlights Women Empowerment Initiatives and Police Tribute

On Tuesday, October 21st, Home Minister Vangalapudi Anitha emphasised the government's commitment to women empowerment and protection, citing the introduction of the Shakti app as a significant step in this direction. Her remarks came during the observance of Police Commemoration Day, where she paid tribute to police martyrs. Anitha noted the effective operation of the Eagle Team, established to combat drug and marijuana trafficking, and highlighted initiatives under Operation Safe aimed at raising awareness among students. She explained that cyber stations have been established, along with the installation of CCTV cameras and drones, to enhance security. Praising Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu for his efforts in safeguarding the state's citizens, the Home Minister affirmed the ongoing initiatives aimed at improving public safety. Earlier, CM Naidu also paid his respects to the fallen police officers during the event, which was attended by AP DGP Harish Kumar Gupta and several other senior police officials.



Chief Minister Revanth Reddy attended the Police Commemoration Parade at Gosha Mahal in Hyderabad as the chief guest, commemorating Police Martyrs' Commemoration Day. During the event, he unveiled a new Police Martyrs' Memorial and paid homage to the brave police personnel who lost their lives in the line of duty. The Chief Minister expressed the deep trust and confidence that the police instil in society, emphasising their unwavering commitment even in the face of danger. He stated, "On one side, blood is being shed... there are many heroes who have sacrificed their lives for our protection." Reddy reminded the audience of the importance of remembering the sacrifices made by police officers for the nation, particularly on this occasion which is observed annually on October 21 across India. The CM honoured the memory of several fallen officers, including



Greyhounds commandos T. Sandeep, V. Sridhar, and N. Pawan Kalyan, who died combating anti-social forces, as well as Assistant Commandant Banothu Jawaharlal and Constable B. Saidu. Highlighting the recent loss, Reddy affirmed his government's support for the family of CCS Constable Empalli Pramod Kumar, who died in Nizamabad just three days prior. He announced a comprehensive sup-

port package for Kumar's family, including ? 1 crore in ex-gratia, his last drawn salary until retirement, a government job for a family member, and 300 square yards of land. An additional Rs 16 lakhs will be provided from the Police Security Welfare fund, alongside Rs 8 lakhs from the Police Welfare fund.

Furthermore, a 200-yard plot of land will be allocated in Gajularamaram to the families of 33 policemen who lost their lives in a Maoist attack in Orissa on June 29, 2008. Reddy praised the Telangana Police Department for its effective policies and modern technological methods, which have earned it the top ranking in the country according to the India Justice Report 2025. He noted the department's recognition from the Ministry of External Affairs for its successful passport verification process and expressed hope that Telangana Police continues to excel in maintaining public safety and peace.

Jagan slams CM Chandrababu Naidu over unfulfilled promises

Amaravati: YSR Congress Party President and former Andhra Pradesh CM Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy on Monday slammed Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu and his coalition government over not fulfilling the promises made to people before the elections. He asked whether even a single "lamp" has actually been lit in these 18 months of governance. Jagan Mohan Reddy recalled the promises made by Chandrababu Naidu, including Rs 3,000 monthly allowance for unemployed youth, Rs 1,500 per month for every woman, Rs 4,000 pension from the age of



50, Rs 20,000 annual aid to every farmer besides PM-Kisan, Rs 15,000 rupees per year for every child in every family, three free LPG cylinders per house-

hold every year, and free bus rides for women in all routes and services. He said none of these assurances have turned into reality. Instead of lighting new lamps, Chandrababu Naidu and his allies have extinguished the ones that were glowing brightly during the YSRCP government from 2019 to 2024, Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy said in a post on 'X'. Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy stated that schools, hospitals,

agriculture, welfare, transparency, and law and order have all suffered under the present regime. He reminded that during YSRCP's rule, nearly 30 welfare schemes through Direct Benefit Transfers lit up every household, but the current coalition has only spread darkness and despair across Andhra Pradesh. Meanwhile, YSRCP leader and former minister Gudivada Amarnath welcomed IT Minister Nara Lokesh for finally admitting the success of the \$4.2 billion Pinnapuram Solar, Wind and Pumped Storage Hydro Project, a visionary initiative that was conceived, facilitated, and

implemented under the leadership of then Chief Minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy. "Ironically, the same Nara Lokesh, who once ridiculed and made sarcastic comments about this deal for political mileage, is now shamelessly trying to take credit after its global success. His selective memory and opportunistic PR stunt only expose his hypocrisy and desperation for relevance. The truth remains that it was Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy's vision, determination, and global outreach that turned Pinnapuram into a reality, not Lokesh's tweets or empty words," he added.

Later, everyone came one by one and paid their respects to the Martyrs Stupa. Additional SP Upender Reddy read the names/roll of honor of the martyrs of this year.

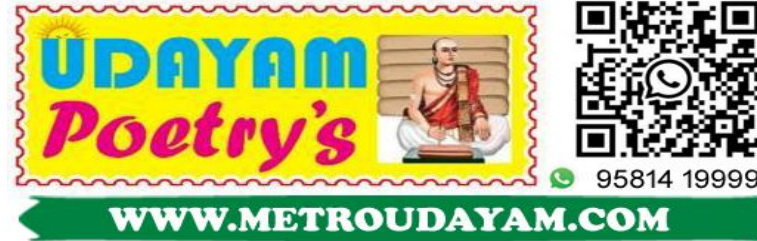

Grandly Sadar Festival in Hyderabad Cheppal bazar



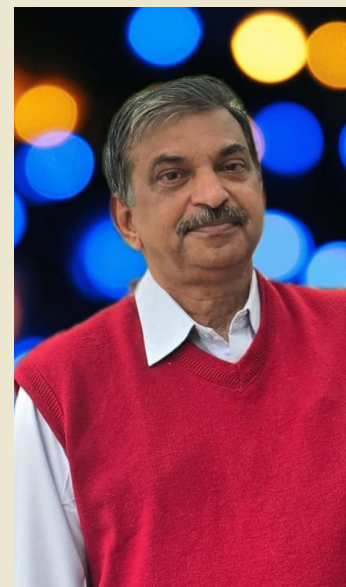

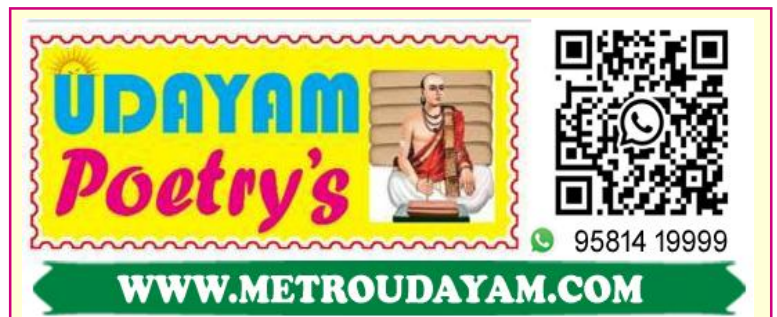

Massive fire breaks out at dye factory in Bengal's North 24 Parganas

A massive fire broke out at a dye factory in Khardah of West Bengal's North 24 Parganas district in the early hours of Tuesday. The fire spread rapidly due to the storage of chemicals inside the factory. Explosions were also heard one after another from the spot. The fire also engulfed a nearby T-shirt making factory. About 20 fire engines are at the spot fighting hard to bring the situation under control. However, according to reports, the source of the fire has not yet been reached by the firefighters. It was unclear whether any workers were trapped inside. The cause of fire is still not known. More details were awaited. According to police sources, the fire broke out at around 4 30 a.m. The entire area over Ishwaripur in Khardah was covered in black smoke as flames rose from the dye factory. The police and fire brigade were immediately informed. Realising the seriousness of the situation, about 20 fire engines reached the scene.



"Since it is a dye factory, there are a lot of chemicals in stock. As a result, the fire spread quickly. The neighbouring T-shirt making factory has also caught fire. Explosions were heard from inside the factory. A huge contingent of policemen is at the spot," said a senior police officer of Khardah police. The Barrackpore Commissioner of Police Murlidhar has already reached the spot. A fire brigade official said, "The fire broke out inside. The fire in the nearby T-shirt making factory will be brought under control soon. However, it will take some time to control the fire in the dye factory. We have not yet been able to know whether anyone was inside the factory." The residents of the area were in panic after the massive fire. However, unless the fire is doused, it is not possible to know what caused the blaze, said the officials.

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ARRANGEMENTS MADE FOR EFFECTIVE CROWD MANAGEMENT BY WALT AIR DIVISION

During the Diwali festive season and Chhath puja, railway stations and trains are experiencing a significant increase in footfall.
