



Dalai Lama congratulates Japan's first female Prime Minister Sanae Takaichi

Dharamshala: Tibetan spiritual leader the Dalai Lama has written to Japan's newly elected Prime Minister, Sanae Takaichi, congratulating her on becoming the country's first-ever female leader. In his letter, the Dalai Lama said, "No doubt your several decades of public service will serve you well in leading Japan at this crucial point in your country's history, when the world is facing great challenges."

Takaichi, 64, a hardline conservative known as Japan's "Iron Lady," made history by becoming the 104th Prime Minister of the country. Prime Minister Narendra Modi and External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar had also extended their greetings to the new Japanese Prime Minister. Praising Japan's long-standing commitment to peace, the Dalai Lama noted, "Having experienced immense suffering as a result of being attacked with nuclear weapons, Japan has steadfastly taken the lead in efforts to establish peace in the world. It has been a forthright champion



of nuclear disarmament." He further said, "Especially at times like these, when there is such uncertainty and upheaval in many parts of the world, it is vitally important that concerted efforts be made to resolve problems through dialogue and diplomacy." Welcoming Japan's choice of its first woman Prime Minister, the Nobel Peace Laureate wrote, "I believe that women are more compassionate and sensitive to the feelings of others -- qualities I first

learned from my own loving mother. Scientific evidence also shows that women are more sensitive to others' pain. I am therefore firmly convinced that if more of our leaders were women, the world would be a more understanding and peaceful place." "May I wish you every success in meeting the challenges and opportunities that lie ahead in strengthening happiness in Japan and the wider world," the Dalai Lama added.

AP Home Minister Anitha reviews on rains, urges officials to be vigilant



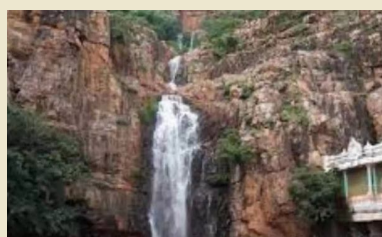
The government has heightened its alertness due to a severe low pressure area developing in the Bay of Bengal, expected to strengthen into a depression within the next 12 hours. It is forecast to move towards the coasts of North Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, and the southern coastline, with the potential for further intensification. In light of the situation, Home Minister Vangalapudi Anitha convened a review meeting with officials from the Disaster Management Authority to discuss preparations for anticipated heavy rainfall in the southern coast and Rayalaseema regions.

During the meeting, Minister Anitha advised that strong gusts of wind are expected, urging the public to avoid travel unless absolutely nec-

essary. She has directed that National Disaster Response Force (NDRF), State Disaster Response Force (SDRF), police, and fire services be made ready for immediate relief operations. Minister Anitha emphasised the importance of keeping district control rooms operational 24/7 and called for proactive measures to prevent loss of life and minimise inconvenience to the public. She underscored the necessity of disseminating timely warning messages regarding the weather conditions. To ensure public safety, Home Minister Anitha encouraged citizens to utilise the 24-hour toll-free numbers 112, 1070, and 18004250101 for assistance and information.

KTR and Harish Rao meets KCR to discuss on Jubilee Hills by-poll

Hyderabad: In a significant development ahead of the Jubilee Hills by-election, Bharat Rashtia Samithi (BRS) chief K. Chandrashekar Rao (KCR) convened a crucial meeting with the party's working president, K. T. Rama Rao (KTR), and former minister Harish Rao at the Erravelli farmhouse on Wednesday morning. The discussions reportedly focused on formulating campaign strategies, including road shows, for the upcoming by-poll. Additionally, the leaders addressed key political issues and the concern of potential defections among MLAs from the party.



Tomorrow (Thursday), KCR is set to meet with the Jubilee Hills in-charge to provide further direction regarding their campaign strategies in the constituency, underscoring the urgency and importance of the meeting.

Mahayuti govt allocates Rs 270 crore to 54 first-time elected MLAs of allies ahead of local polls

Mumbai: With a focus on local and civic body elections in Maharashtra, the BJP-led Mahayuti government has approved an allocation of Rs 270 crore, which amounts to Rs 5 crore each, for various development projects in the constituencies of 54 legislators from allies elected for the first time to the state Assembly. The State Planning Department has released a government resolution in this regard.

The Mahayuti comprising BJP, Shiv Sena and NCP are aiming to keep the victory march going after the state Assembly polls by winning the upcoming elections to 29 Municipal Corporations, all 247 Municipal Councils, 42 Nagar Panchayats, 32 Zilla Parishads and 336 Panchayat Samitis. The State Election Commission is in the midst of preparations for holding these elections before January 31 next year as per the Supreme Court



order.

As per the government resolution, the fund will be used for development works suggested by these legislators in their respective Assembly segments. Mahayuti sources said, "After releasing funds through the Rural Development Department in the Zilla Parishad areas and through the Urban Development Department in the jurisdiction of

Municipal Corporations and Municipalities through specialised schemes for the past few days, the Mahayuti government has turned its attention to the first-time elected legislators."

Sources admitted that "since the formation of the government in the state, the Mahayuti legislators have been demanding increased funds for development works. Initially, there was a

plan to provide a development fund of Rs 10 crore each to the ruling legislators." However, sources said that considering the strain on the government exchequer due to 'Chief Minister Majhi Ladki Bahin' and other schemes, as well as the additional expenditure to be incurred in providing financial aid to farmers hit by recent heavy rains and floods, the government has shelved its plan to provide Rs 10 crore each to the ruling legislators.

Sources reiterated that instead of giving to all Mahayuti legislators, now the government has taken a decision to allocate Rs 5 crore each to 54 legislators elected for the first time to the state Assembly. The government will soon release another government resolution to allocate Rs 2 to 2.50 crore each to other ruling Mahayuti legislators to avoid any discontent ahead of the ensuing local and civic body

elections in the state. These legislators have already made a strong representation to Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis and Deputy Chief Ministers Eknath Shinde and Ajit Pawar to release funds to launch various development works ahead of the local and civic body polls. Last week, the Urban Development Department approved a fund of Rs 509 crore for the Municipal Corporation and Municipalities. Of this, Rs 63 crore has been approved for Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis' Nagpur district and Rs 175 crore for Deputy Chief Minister Eknath Shinde's Thane district. The government's move is crucial as the ruling allies have been striving to fight local and civic body elections in alliance, but the pressure has been mounting from the local leaders and the rank and file to go solo and strike an alliance after the polls.

South Central Railway to run 1,010 special trains for festive season

Hyderabad, October 21, Metroudayam

South Central Railway is running 1,010 special trains for festive season, said South Central Railway General Manager Sanjay Kumar Srivastava. South Central Railway has taken appropriate measures to ensure smooth and hassle-free passenger train travel to control the extra rush during the festive season.

South Central Railway General Manager Sanjay Kumar Vastava briefed the media persons at Rail Nilayam in Secunderabad today i.e. October 21, 2025, about the arrangements made to effectively manage the special trains running in the zone and the extra festive rush. In this media conference, South Central Railway Principal Chief Operations Manager K. Padmaja; Principal Chief Commercial Manager, South Central Railway Iti Pandey, Principal Chief Security Commissioner, South Central Railway Sh. Aroma Singh Thakur, Divisional Railway Manager, Secunderabad Division Dr. R. Gopalakrishnan; DRM, Hyderabad Division Santosh Kumar Verma, Chief Public Relations Officer, South

Central Railway A. Sridhar and other senior officials were also present. Sanjay Kumar Srivastava explained that Indian Railways is planning to run more than 12,000 special trains to facilitate passengers during the festivals of Dussehra, Diwali and Chhath Puja.

Out of which 973 special trains are of South Central Railway. The General Manager informed the media that during the last one month i.e. from September 21 to October 20, 2025, the zone has run 1,010 regular & festival special trains between various destinations. He said that this is 47% more than the 684 special trains run during the same period last financial year. He said that 4.80 crore passengers travelled in regular express, passenger and special trains (arriving trains & departing trains) across South Central Railway during this period.

He told the media that 237 additional coaches have been added to various regular trains to provide travel accommodation to passengers on waiting lists. He said that additional stops have been set up for trains at some stations like Lingampalli, Hitech City, Cherlapalli and Malkajgiri



to reduce the load on important terminals in Hyderabad city. The General Manager explained about the comprehensive crowd control and facilitation measures taken at major stations across the zone. He said that as part of the crowd control measure, 26 holding areas have been set up on platforms at major stations in six divisions namely Secunderabad, Cherlapalli, Hyderabad, Lingampalli, Vijayawada, Rajahmundry, Tirupati, Raichur, Guntakal, Guntur, Nalgonda, Kacheguda, Nizamabad, Nanded, Aurangabad, Akola and Purna. He said that adequate seating, lighting, drinking water and toilet facilities have been provided in these holding areas.

Sanjay Kumar Srivastava said that CCTV surveillance is being done at all major stations with monitoring at station, zonal and Railway Board levels. He said that additional booking counters have been opened at eight stations namely Secunderabad, Vijayawada, Rajahmundry, Tirupati and Guntur. Additional staff from various departments like RPF personnel, ticket checking staff, Government Railway Police, maintenance staff etc. have also been deployed under the close supervision of the Divisional Officers. The General Manager highlighted that joint teams comprising officers and supervisors from departments like Operating, Commercial, RPF, Mechanical,

Electrical, Engineering and S&T have been formed for 24-hour surveillance at the stations during peak hours. In addition, war rooms/rail support facilities have been strengthened in all the divisions and zonal headquarters. Catering stalls at stations have been alerted to cater to the additional requirements. On-board catering services have been set up in coordination with IRCTC. He said that checks have been conducted to prevent cases of overcharging, unauthorised selling etc.

General Manager of South Central Railway inspects Secunderabad Railway Station. Later, General Manager of South Central Railway Shri Sanjay Kumar Srivastava thoroughly inspected the Secunderabad Railway Station, where he reviewed the crowd control measures, passenger facilities, security arrangements etc. The General Manager enquired about the passenger facilities, cleanliness in waiting halls, toilets, water arrangements etc. He was accompanied by Divisional Railway Manager of Secunderabad Division Dr. R. Gopalakrishnan and other officials.

Akaksh Preschool Students Visit Government School for the Hearing & Speech Impaired in Secunderabad

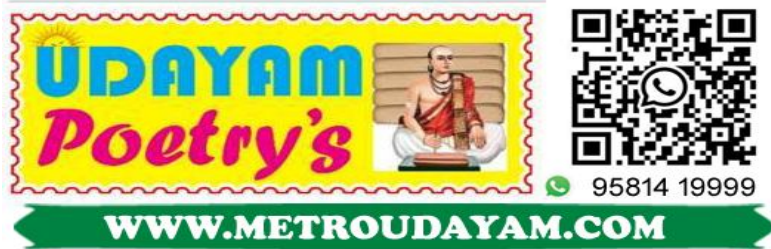
Hyderabad, metro udayam October 22

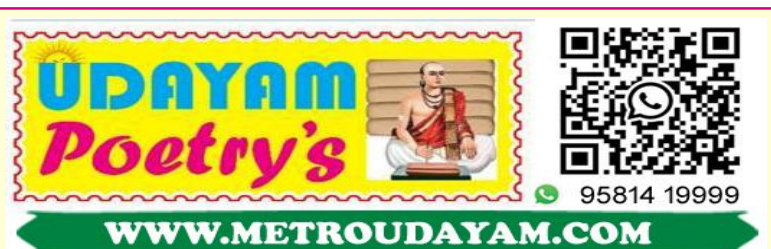

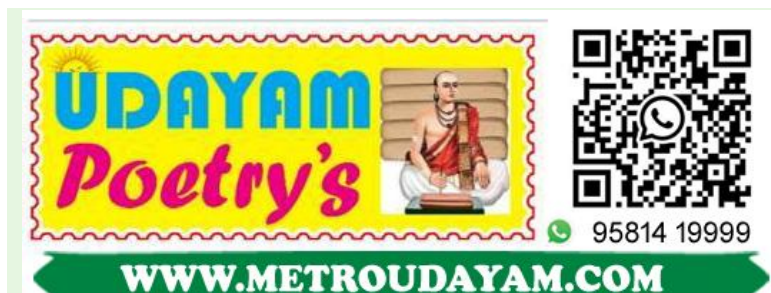

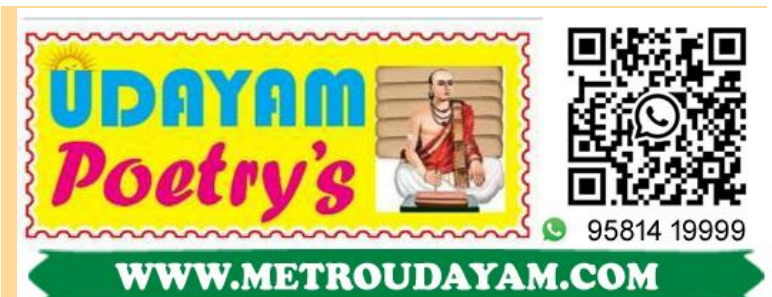

Minister Ponnamm Prabhakar Inaugurates Cotton Purchase Centre and Emphasises Quality Education

Minister Ponnamm Prabhakar has announced that cotton is now being purchased through the Kapas Kisan mobile app, following the inauguration of the Cotton Corporation of India (CCI) Cotton Purchase Centre in Husnabad, Siddipet district. During the event, he detailed the process whereby farmers will be allocated date slots for cotton purchases at ginning mills.

Currently, the support price for cotton stands at Rs. 8,100. Minister Prabhakar also mentioned that alongside cotton, rice and maize will be acquired from farmers. Efforts



are underway to raise awareness among farmers regarding the benefits of diversifying into ice cream production, horticulture, and sericul-

ture. In addition to agricultural initiatives, Minister Prabhakar stressed the importance of quality education. He conducted a video conference with officials regarding the Mahatma Jyotirao Phule Gurukul schools and asserted that paramount attention should be given to ensuring that all educational institutions achieve 100 per cent results. He also committed to progressing the Gauravelli project promptly to ensure adequate water supply for crops.

Don't be a stranger, mate: Adelaide welcomes 'one of cricket's true icons' Virat Kohli ahead of second ODI

New Delhi: As Virat Kohli returned to his favourite hunting ground in Adelaide for the second ODI against Australia, the South Australian Cricket Association (SACA) greeted the batting stalwart with a heartfelt message on social media. Kohli, who had retired from T20Is and Test cricket, returned to international cricket in the first ODI against Australia, seven months after the Champions Trophy victory.

For Kohli, Adelaide has been a successful hunting ground over the years. His first Test hundred came at the same venue during the Border-Gavaskar Trophy tour of 2011-12. He holds an impressive record at the ground,



having scored 975 runs in just 12 international matches, the most by an Indian at this venue. As Kohli stepped onto the field for the practice session, SACA shared a video of him entering

the ground with Kohli's previous post-match speech as a back-ground score.

After this series, India won't return to Australia for one-day internationals before the 2027

World Cup, meaning this series is expected to be the last time Kohli plays down under. "One of cricket's true icons, Virat Kohli returns to his beloved ground — training here for what may be his final appearance in international colours at Adelaide Oval," SACA shared on X.

"It has been an honour and a privilege to welcome one of the greatest to ever grace the game over many years. Thank you, Virat, for the memories, the magic, and the moments that will live on in the hearts of South Australians and cricket fans around the world. "You'll always be welcome at Adelaide Oval. Don't be a stranger, mate," the post read. Although the charis-

matic batter failed to make an impact with the bat, registering his first-ever duck on Australian soil, he will be aiming to uphold his impressive record at Adelaide in the second ODI, scheduled for Thursday.

When Kohli comes out to bat on Thursday, he will have the opportunity to surpass former skipper MS Dhoni's record for the most runs scored by an Indian batter in the 50-over format at Adelaide Oval on October 23. Dhoni has scored 262 runs in six games he played at Adelaide Oval, and Kohli has 244 runs in four games. He needs 19 runs to become the leading scorer at the venue in 50-over matches.

Mandhana continues her reign as No. 1 batter



India's opener Smriti Mandhana has strengthened her position at the top of the ICC Women's ODI Batter Rankings as the top players in the ongoing ICC Women's Cricket World Cup made progress in the latest rankings update. Mandhana notched up consecutive half-centuries in the tournament, most recently scoring 88 against England in Indore in what was a close loss for India. Mandhana's performance helped her improve her overall rating and extend her lead as the No. 1 ranked ODI batter to 83 points. England captain Nat Sciver-Brunt was her nearest competitor, having scored 191 runs in the tournament. Mandhana has been in excellent form recently, earning the ICC Women's Player of the Month award for September 2025 due to her performances in the ODI series against Australia prior to the World Cup.
