



PM Modi to spell out reforms in maritime sector

Mumbai: Prime Minister Narendra Modi will address the Maritime Leaders Conclave and chair the Global Maritime CEO Forum at India Maritime Week (IMW) 2025, on Wednesday, during which he will spell out the reforms in the maritime sector. The Global Maritime CEO Forum, the flagship event of IMW 2025, will bring together CEOs of global maritime companies, major investors, policy-makers, innovators, and international partners to deliberate on the future of the global maritime ecosystem. The Forum will serve as a key platform for dialogue on sustainable maritime growth, resilient supply chains, green shipping, and inclusive blue economy strategies.

PM Modi in his post on X on Tuesday said, "Looking forward to being in Mumbai tomorrow, 29th October, to attend programmes relating to the ongoing India Maritime Week 2025. I will speak at the Maritime Leaders Conclave and also chair the Global Maritime CEO Forum. This is a great forum to build col-



laborations in the maritime sector and highlight India's reforms in the same."

The Prime Minister's participation reflects his deep commitment to an ambitious, future-oriented maritime transformation, aligned with the Maritime Amrit Kaal Vision 2047. This long-term vision, built on four strategic pillars - port-led development, shipping and shipbuilding, seamless logistics, and maritime skill-building - aims to position India among the world's leading



maritime powers.

IMW 2025 serves as the Union government's premier global platform to translate this vision into action, bringing together leading stakeholders across shipping, ports, shipbuilding, cruise tourism, and blue economy finance, said the government release. Under the theme 'Uniting Oceans, One Maritime Vision', the conclave, which began on October 27, will conclude on October 31. It will showcase India's strategic

roadmap to emerge as a global maritime hub and a leader in the Blue Economy. IMW 2025 will draw participation from over 85 countries, featuring more than 1,00,000 delegates, 500+ exhibitors and 350+ international speakers. Meanwhile, Union Minister for Ports, Shipping and Waterways Sarbananda Sonowal on Tuesday said that India's maritime sector forms the backbone of its economy, with over 95 per cent of the nation's trade by volume moving through the sea. Under the Net Zero by 2070 commitment, India aims to reduce carbon emissions per ton of cargo by 30 per cent by 2030 and 70 per cent by 2047, making the sector a key driver of climate action. Minister Sonowal emphasised that flagship initiatives such as the Sagarmala Programme, Maritime India Vision 2030, Harit Sagar Guidelines, and the Maritime Amrit Kaal Vision 2047 place sustainability, innovation, and climate responsibility at the core of India's maritime growth. "As we look toward Amrit Kaal 2047, our goal is not only to expand

maritime capacity but also to make it greener, smarter, and more resilient," said Minister Sonowal. "With our unique geography along key global trade routes, India is poised to become a hub for green shipping corridors, connecting domestic and international markets through clean energy trade," he added. India's first national shore-power standard will enable vessels to draw clean electricity while docked, significantly reducing port-side emissions. Ports like Jawaharlal Nehru Port Authority (JNPA) are leading the shift with battery-powered trucks and electric logistics systems toward zero-emission operations, said the minister. "The maritime transition cannot be achieved in silos - it demands partnership among governments, industry, financiers, and technology leaders," Minister Sonowal said. "Together, we can ensure that the seas that connect us also unite us in purpose - to create a future where maritime trade drives both prosperity and sustainability," he noted.

Pawan Kalyan directs officials to take relief measures on war footing amid rains



Cyclone Montha is currently causing significant disruption across Andhra Pradesh, with heavy rains affecting several districts as the storm approaches the coast. The state government remains on high alert and is coordinating efforts to assist those in the cyclone-affected areas. Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan convened a meeting with officials to assess the situation and gather updates on the damage inflicted by strong winds and incessant rainfall. Officials from the Deputy CM's office have been in regular contact with collectors from Dr. BR Ambedkar Konaseema, Krishna, Bapatla, Prakasam, Sri Potti Sriramulu Nellore, and Tirupati districts.

In light of the severe weather, Deputy Kalyan has directed the urgent restoration of electricity services, as many areas have reported downed power lines and uprooted poles due to fallen trees. He has urged residents to seek safe shelter, emphasising that despite the cyclone's weakening, heavy rain continues to pose risks. Further directives were issued to ensure that people in rehabilitation centres receive adequate food and accommodation. Kalyan also warned of the overflowing Gundlakamma River in Prakasam district and the Penna River in Nellore district, advising residents to remain vigilant. Once the rainfall abates, the Deputy Chief Minister emphasized the need to initiate sanitation programs and ensure the provision of safe drinking water to prevent further health issues among the population.

Flash Flood warnings issued for AP and Telangana states amid rains

The India Meteorological Department (IMD) has issued warnings of imminent flash floods in the Telugu states of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh. Heavy rainfall is expected to trigger flooding in these regions, along with parts of Maharashtra and Vidarbha, posing a serious risk in the coming hours. The IMD has specifically indicated a potential threat of flooding across Andhra Pradesh in the next six hours, while Telangana, Vidarbha, and Marathwada could face similar conditions within the next 24 hours. Areas at risk include low-lying regions where waterlogging and road inundation are anticipated. The coastal region of Yanam and the districts of Guntur and Prakasam in Andhra Pradesh are particularly under threat.

In Telangana, districts affected com-



prise Adilabad, Nirmal, Nizamabad, Jagtial, Kamareddy, Karimnagar, Siddipet, Warangal Urban, Warangal Rural, Jangaon, Yadadri Bhuvanagiri, Mahabubabad, Medak, Medchal-Malkajgiri, and Peddapalli. In Maharashtra's Marathwada region,

Nanded, Hingoli, and Parbani are also expected to experience adverse weather conditions.

Additionally, the Vidarbha region (Maharashtra) has been alerted, with flash flood warnings issued for the districts of Buldhana, Akola, Amravati, Wardha, Yavatmal, and Nagpur. In light of this unfolding situation, the IMD has urged the public to avoid flood-affected areas and stay away from streams, canals, and ponds. Travellers are advised to monitor weather updates before heading out. Farmers are advised to relocate crops and livestock to safe zones. Local authorities have been instructed to prepare emergency personnel in readiness for the storms ahead.

AP CM Chandrababu

conducts aerial inspection of cyclone Montha-affected areas

In the wake of Cyclone Montha's devastation, Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu has embarked on an aerial inspection of the affected regions. Flying over severely flooded areas in Bapatla, Palnadu, Krishna, Eluru, and Dr. BR Ambedkar Konaseema districts, the Chief Minister is assessing the extent of the damage caused by the cyclone. Following the aerial overview, Naidu is scheduled to visit Allavaram mandal's port in Konaseema district, where he will travel by road to inspect the inundated crop fields impacted by the heavy rains. The visit aims to gather firsthand information on the disaster's effects and to plan necessary recovery measures for the affected communities.

INTER-ZONAL SAFETY AUDIT CONDUCTED IN VISAKHAPATNAM-BOBBILI SECTION



A special Safety Audit Team from Northeast Frontier Railway, Maligaon (Guwahati), led by Shri Uttam Prakash, Principal Chief Safety Officer, conducted an extensive audit on the Visakhapatnam-Bobbili Section to review and assess various safety parameters at major stations and level crossings.

The inter-zonal safety audits are being conducted regularly by multi-disciplinary teams of senior railway officers to ensure strict compliance with safety norms and the effective implementation of all rules and guidelines governing safe train operations. During the inspection, the team examined Curve No. 8 between PDT-KTV (Km

855.236 to 855), Kottavalasa Station Yard including its Points & Crossings, the Major Bridge between Alamanda-Korukonda on the middle line, engineering-operated level crossing gate between Komati - Donkinavalasa, Bobbili Station and its Relay Room, Komati Yard, Traction Sub-Station at Komati, Level Crossing Gate RV-323, Coaching Crew Lobby, Accident Relief Medical Equipment Van at Visakhapatnam, Accident Relief Train, New Coaching Complex, Running Room, and the Route Relay Interlocking Cabin at Visakhapatnam. The audit team comprised Shri Uttam Prakash,



Principal Chief Safety Officer; Shri Atul Rane, Chief Passenger Traffic Manager; Shri Ranjan Behra, Chief Communication Engineer; Shri Satish Chandra Prasad, Chief Rolling Stock Engineer (Coaching); Shri Bharat Lal Meena, Chief General Engineer; Shri Debjit Mishra, Chief Electrical Loco Engineer; Shri Ashish Kumar Sinha, Deputy Chief Safety Officer (S&T); Shri Satyabrata Saha, Deputy Chief Safety Officer (Engineering); and Shri Ramesh Kumar Mahto, Deputy Chief Safety Officer (Traffic). The team was accompanied by Shri K. Rama Rao, ADRM (Operations), Shri Anand Kumar Mutatkar, Senior

Divisional Safety Officer, and other branch officers of Waltair Division.

Divisional Railway Manager Shri Lalit Bohra interacted with the audit team and reviewed the safety observations. He stated that such periodical inter-zonal inspections serve as an effective mechanism to evaluate safety performance, identify systemic deficiencies, and recommend corrective measures. Zonal Railways submit their audit reports followed by action-taken reports to the Ministry of Railways, which are subsequently analyzed by the Railway Board to frame necessary directives for continual improvement in safety standards.

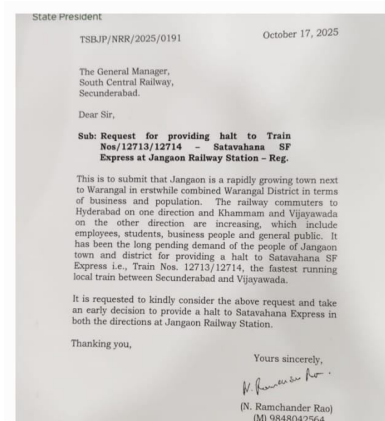
Jangaon station: BJP Dist President Souda Ramesh

Apparvasi ghat Indian indentured giityas of Mauritius

On 2nd November 2025

An event of commemorating the 191 th anniversary celebrations of indentured immigrants will be celebrated. This is an annual ceremony to pay tribute in honour of the girmitya the indentured Indian immigrants of those that left India and arrived in Mauritius. The venue will be Aapravasi ghat from 8 am -845 This is an auspicious programme, it will be a yaj ceremony, prayers, tribute, lighting of lamps and Shradhanjali with offering and flowers. The girmitya arrival celebration committee is pleased to host this event. The girmitya are significant and honouring the ancestors is an auspicious event. Dr Sarita Bodhoo, Dr Sadhana Ramlallah and Rita Ramlallah have organized this. Background to indentured Indians in Mauritius. The Girmityas of Mauritius were indentured laborers from India who were brought to the Mauritius island

between 1834 and 1917 to work, on sugar plantations. The Aapravasi ghat is a UNESCO world heritage site in Port Louis, Mauritius that has served as an immigration depot for indentured labourers that were taken to the island between 1834-1920. Its now preserved as a historical site with a museum. It is a significant memorial to history of indentured labour and roots of Mauritian society. According to Dr Sarita Bodhoo in an interview to Le Matinal 2nd November has been a public holiday since 2001 thanks to the government. Her uncle Mr Beekrumsing Ramlallah, had the Aapravasi ghat recognised. Beekrumsing Ramlallah has started this ceremony recognizing the Girmityas from November 2 1834 to May 1924. According to Dr Sarita Bodhoo India had also celebrated Indentured Memorial Day for the first time on 15 September 2025. This was organised by the Syama

Prasad Mookherjee Port Authority in Kolkata. Dr Sarita Bodhoo was present as a special guest. India has indicated its intention to have this site in Kolkata, on the banks of the Hooghly River, recognised as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The first 36 indentured labourers left the port of Kolkata on 15 September 1834 and arrived in Mauritius on 2 November 1834. They had travelled across the Kala Pani and had overcome various obstacles and many difficulties to work in the fields for Arbutnotin Antoinette Phoolliyar,

पेश आना चाहिए यह बात बहुत ही अच्छे से सविस्तर से समझाई गई है।

मालिक इब्न हारिसे अश्तर (र.) को लिखे इस पत्र में किसी पर भी अत्याचार ना करने की हिदायत (मार्गदर्शन) करते हुए इमाम अली इब्न अबू तालिब अलैहिस्सलाम फरमाते हैं के "ऐ मालिक! रियाया (प्रजा) के लिए अपने दिल के अंदर दया और कृपा व प्रेम को जगह दो उनके लिए फाड़खाने वाला दरिंद (हिंस्र पशु) ना बन जाओ की निगल जाना गनीमत (संतोषजनक बात) समझते हो। इसलिए कि रियाया में दो किस्म (प्रजा में दो तरह) के लोग हैं। एक तो तुम्हारे दीनीभाई (धर्मबंधु) और दूसरे तुम्हारे जैसी मख्लूक ए खुदा (ईश्वर की सृष्टि)।" (अब्बास बुक एजेन्सी, लखनऊ द्वारा प्रकाशित हिंदी पुस्तक नहजुल बलागह, पत्र क्रमांक 53, पुष्ट क्रमांक 646)।
