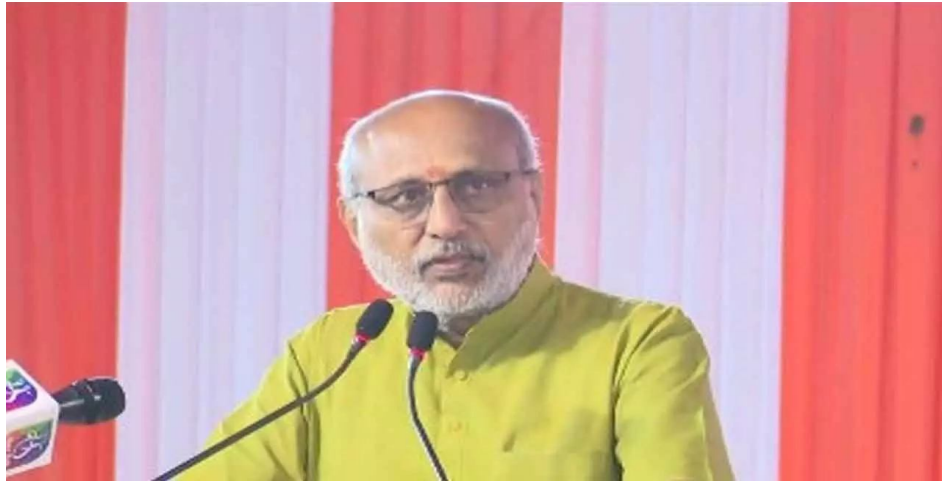




Vice President CP Radhakrishnan calls libraries temples of learning, empowerment

Vice President C. P. Radhakrishnan on Sunday described libraries as temples of learning, calling them spaces that nurture critical thinking and empower individuals and communities. Addressing the International Conference on 'Libraries Empowering Communities - Global Perspectives' through a video message, Radhakrishnan said that in today's digital age, libraries serve as knowledge hubs that enable people to access authentic information and counter misinformation. He observed that while technology offers easy access to information, libraries cultivate depth, reflection, and meaningful dialogue in society. The Conference was organised by the P. N. Panicker Foundation at Kanakakkunnu Palace, Thiruvananthapuram.

The event marks the 80th year of the organised library movement in Kerala, inspired by the vision of P. N. Panicker, revered as the Pioneer of India's Library and Literacy Movement. In his message, the Vice-President commended the P. N. Panicker Foundation for its sustained contribution to promoting reading culture, digital literacy, and community empowerment through knowledge dissemination. He noted that the Foundation's motto — "Vayichu Valaruka" (Read and Grow) — continues to guide the society towards enlightenment and inclusion. The Vice-President said that Shri Adi Shankaracharya travelled across Bharat to awaken spiritual awareness and unify diverse thoughts. He noted that countless other sages and thinkers have



enriched our civilisation with their wisdom, compassion, and vision. Reflecting on India's ancient civilizational ethos, the Vice President observed that the country's tradition of learning — from the Epics to modern libraries — continues to inspire the nation's pursuit of wisdom

and social progress. The Vice-President lauded Kerala's exceptional legacy in education and literacy. He paid rich tributes to P. N. Panicker, whose vision transformed libraries into vibrant community centres that brought books and learning closer to every citizen. Concluding his message, the

Vice-President said that libraries are dynamic spaces of learning, inclusion, and innovation. He emphasised the need to strengthen the network of public and community libraries across the nation by empowering people through the power of knowledge. The International Conference on November 2 and 3 at Kanakakkunnu Palace, Thiruvananthapuram, brings together experts, policymakers, library professionals, academicians, and digital innovators to deliberate on the evolving role of libraries in the knowledge society. The conference celebrates the enduring legacy of Kerala's library movement and explores strategies to enhance community participation, digital access, and sustainable knowledge ecosystems.

Three member committee formed to probe Srikakulam temple stampede

The investigation into the tragic stampede at the Kasibugga Venkateswara Swamy temple, which resulted in the deaths of 10 individuals, is currently underway. Following the incident, Srikakulam District Collector Swapnil Dinakar has ordered the formation of a three-member committee to delve into the details surrounding the tragedy. The committee comprises Tekkali RDO Krishnamurthy, Srikakulam ASP KV Ramana, and Endowment Department Assistant Commissioner Prasad. They are tasked with determining the causes of the stampede and will report their findings to the government.



The incident, which has garnered widespread attention across Andhra Pradesh, occurred during a significant gathering on Ekadashi in the month of Karthika, when large crowds flocked to the temple. Among the deceased are nine women and a 12-year-old boy, with two others sustaining serious injuries as they were trying to ascend the stairs for darshan of the deity on the first floor. Reports indicate that the stampede began when

the stair railing collapsed under the pressure of devotees, leading to a chaotic scene as individuals fell over one another. In the wake of this tragedy, prominent figures including Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Union Home Minister Amit Shah, Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu, and Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan have expressed their profound shock and condolences. A case has already been registered in connection with the incident.

KTR demands Telangana CM's apology for 'insulting' remarks on Army

Hyderabad: Bharat Rashtira Samithi (BRS) working president K.T. Rama Rao on Sunday demanded that Chief Minister Revanth Reddy immediately apologise for his 'shameful' and 'insulting' remarks on the Indian Army. The controversy erupted after Revanth Reddy, during his Jubilee Hills by-election campaign, stated that "When Pakistan kicked us, we failed to counter". His comment triggered outrage for undermining the courage and integrity of India's armed forces. Reacting sharply, BRS leader K. T. Rama Rao (KTR) said that such irresponsible and disgraceful comments are unbecoming of a person holding the Chief Minister's position. "To insult the Indian Army merely to score political points in an election rally is a new low, even by Revanth Reddy's standards," KTR said, demanding that the Chief Minister withdraw his



statement and tender an unconditional public apology to the Indian Army. The BRS leader stated that it takes immense hard work, dedication, commitment and love for the country to join the armed forces and put one's life on the line for the nation. "We are able to live safely, do politics and spend time with our families only because our soldiers are standing guard at the borders, enduring the most cruel and difficult conditions," he added. Questioning the intent behind Revanth Reddy's words, KTR asked, "What made you belittle

our Army and glorify Pakistan? What were you trying to achieve by humiliating our brave soldiers?" "For a man who was once caught with bags of cash, it is perhaps natural to worship goondas and rowdy sheeters. But as the Chief Minister of Telangana, you have a duty to show dignity and patriotism. Stop insulting the Indian Army and stop praising an enemy nation," he said. KTR said Revanth Reddy's comments have deeply hurt the sentiments of crores of Indians who hold the Army in the highest regard. "As the representative of Telangana, you must behave responsibly and honour the soldiers who protect our borders — not belittle them for your political theatrics," the BRS leader asserted. BJP has already condemned the Chief Minister's comments and demanded an apology from him.

Car sales hit record high in Oct, driven by GST rate cut: FM Sitharaman



New Delhi: India's passenger vehicle (PV) industry achieved its highest-ever monthly sales in October 2025, boosted by the recent GST rate rationalisation and strong festive season demand, according to industry data shared by Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Sunday. PV wholesales in the domestic market rose 17.23 per cent year-on-year (YoY) to 4,70,227 units in October 2025, compared to 4,01,105 units in the same month last year. "The PV industry in India reached a record high in terms of volumes in October, fuelled by the GST rate rationalisation and robust festive demand, as several carmakers recorded their highest-ever monthly wholesales," FM Sitharaman said in a post on social media platform X. This marks the best-ever monthly performance for the Indian car market, surpassing the previous record of 4,05,522 units set in January 2025. "This was the best-ever domestic monthly volumes, beating the previous record of 4,05,522 units in January 2025," the

Finance Minister added. Experts say that lower GST rates and attractive festive offers encouraged more customers to buy cars, helping several automakers post their highest-ever monthly sales. The trend also signals a strong consumer sentiment and growing confidence in the economy. Meanwhile, major automaker giants including Kia India, Skoda Auto India, Nissan Motor India, and Mahindra's Trucks and Buses has reported robust sales in the month of October, driven by strong festive buying due to GST reforms. According to data released on Saturday, Kia India achieved its best-ever monthly sales performance in October, with 29,556 units since entering the Indian market. As per the data, Skoda sold 8,252 units in October, which is its highest-ever monthly sales. Nissan Motor also followed suit and reported consolidated sales of 9,675 units, marking a 45 per cent month-on-month growth, and Mahindra and Mahindra's overall sales, including exports in the Trucks and Buses business, stood at 2,034 units.

Thaman brings Sarvepalli sisters onboard for 'Akhandha 2: Tandavam' background score

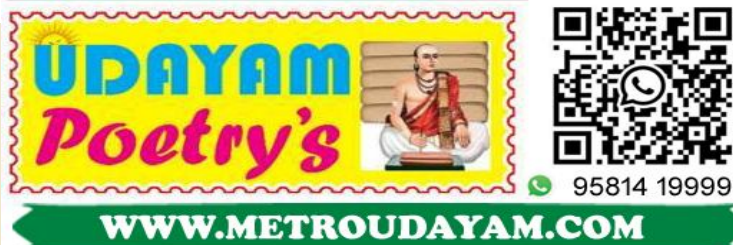

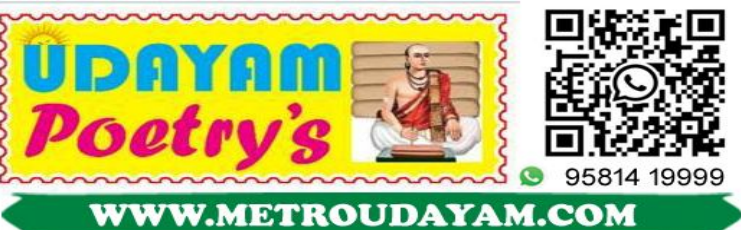

An eternally free digital

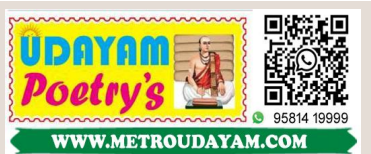


Ghost.

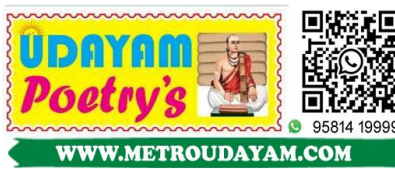

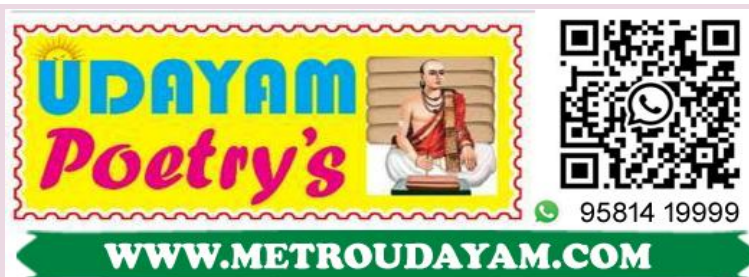

while laughter rings across your waters.

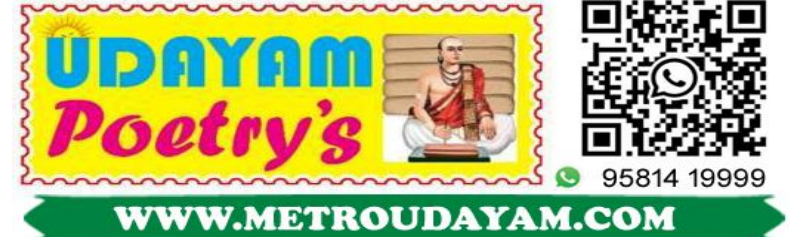

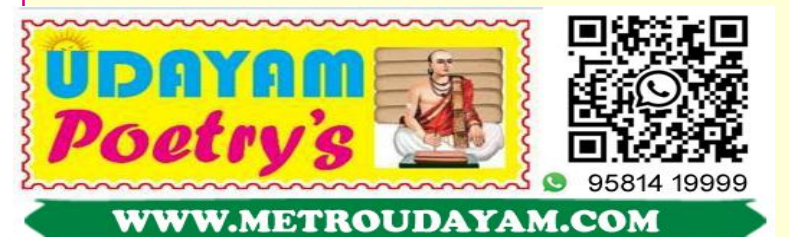

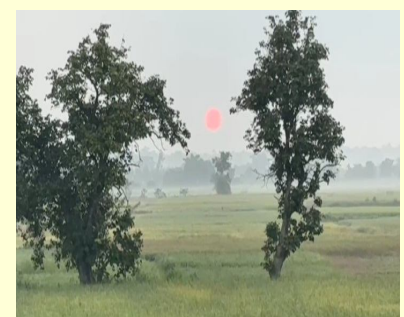

As natures beauty, young and old.

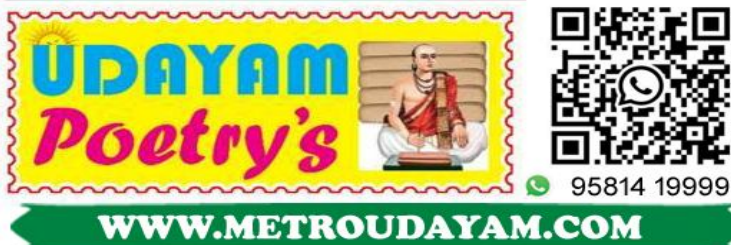
The morning walk, a perfect delight,

PM Modi accuses Congress-RJD of feud over CM face, invokes 'Jungle Raj' at Arrah rally

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Sunday launched a sharp attack on the Congress and the RJD, alleging that both parties are internally divided over who will be the chief ministerial face for the Bihar Assembly election 2025. Addressing a rally in Arrah, PM Modi claimed that Congress was initially unwilling to concede the CM post to the RJD.

"I want to share a secret. Congress was not ready to hand over the chief ministerial post to the RJD. In their closed-door meeting, RJD leaders allegedly put a 'katta' at the head of the Congress leaders and forced them to announce the CM face," PM Modi claimed. He alleged that the rift between the two allies has widened to the point where they are not even coordinating their manifesto or campaigns.

"This feud has intensified so much that they may start attacking each other after the elections," he said. PM Modi reiterated his Jungle Raj critique of the RJD era, describing it as a phase of fear and lawlessness. "Country-made guns, cruelty, misgovernance, corruption — that was Jungle Raj," he said. He cited a 2004 case of a government doctor posted in the Tarari block, who was allegedly kidnapped while returning home.

PM Modi also invoked the 1984 anti-Sikh riots, accusing Congress of honouring those responsible. "November 1-2, 1984 — Congress members carried out the Sikh massacre. Today's Congress still promotes the perpetrators. Neither Congress nor the RJD shows any remorse for their sins," he alleged. He further accused the RJD and Congress of supporting illegal immigrants and destroying Bihar's identity.

PM Modi also referred to "Operation Sindoor" and said India has shown its resolve to act against terrorism. "We go inside the homes of terrorists and eliminate them. Pakistan was shaken, but Congress-RJD were uncomfortable. You were proud of Operation Sindoor, your chests swelled with pride, but Congress-RJD didn't like it. The explosions were happening in Congress, and the sleep of the Congress's royal family was disturbed. To this day, both Pakistan and the Congress's dynastic leaders have not been able to recover from the shock of Operation Sindoor," he said. Speaking on Article 370, PM Modi reminded the gathering that his guarantee on Jammu and Kashmir had been fulfilled. "After 70 years of Independence, Article 370 was removed and the Constitution of India is now fully implemented in Jammu and Kashmir," he said. The Prime Minister said that the NDA has presented an honest and visionary manifesto aimed at accelerating Bihar's development, while describing the rival alliance's manifesto as full of lies and deception. "Every promise, every scheme is dedicated to the rapid development of Bihar. On one side is the honest manifesto of the NDA, and on the other are those of Jungle Raj," PM Modi said.

Washington's fluent 49 helps India level series with five-wicket win over Australia

Though all-rounder Washington Sundar didn't get to bowl, he stepped up when it mattered the most to smash an unbeaten 49 off 23 balls as India defeated Australia by five wickets in the third T20I at the Bellerive Oval on Sunday. Chasing 187, India's top seven contributed in patches, but it was Sundar's late flourish, laced with three fours and four sixes, that sealed the win for India with nine balls to spare and level the five-match series 1-1. The result also marked Australia's first defeat in six T20 Internationals at Hobart.

India began their chase with intent, as Abhishek looked in fluent touch to slice Xavier Bartlett for six, before carting Sean Abbott for two fours and a six. But the momentum shifted when Nathan Ellis struck twice in quick succession - Abhishek mistimed a pull and the top-



edge was caught by the keeper, while Shubman Gill was trapped lbw.

With both openers back in the hut, Suryakumar Yadav began stabilising the innings by hitting Ellis and Abbott for a six each, before slicing off Matthew Kuhnemann for a boundary. But Suryakumar fell in the eighth over when he chipped a slower ball from Marcus Stoinis to extra cover. Four overs later, Axar Patel fell when he was cramped for room

by a bouncer from Nathan Ellis and top-edged a pull to mid-wicket.

Amidst all this, Sundar's onslaught began by clobbering Ellis over mid-wicket for six, before pulling Matthew Kuhnemann for a boundary. He then turned the tide in India's favour by taking 19 runs off Sean Abbott in the 14th over - a tennis-style swat for four through deep extra cover was followed by a

powerful whip over square leg for six and pulling a short ball for another maximum.

Australia bounced back when Tilak Varma looked to scoop, but got it off the top edge and gave a simple catch to the keeper off Bartlett. With Jitesh Sharma scooping and driving for his boundaries, Sundar swung hard to clear backward square leg for six, before smashing a full toss from Stoinis over the bowler's head for four. Jitesh finished off the chase in style with a lofted drive over extra cover. Brief Scores: Australia 186/6 in 20 overs (Tim David 74, Marcus Stoinis 64; Arshdeep Singh 3-35, Varun Chakaravathy 2-33) lost to India 188/5 in 18.3 overs (Washington Sundar 49 not out, Tilak Varma 29; Nathan Ellis 3-36, Marcus Stoinis 1-22) by five wickets.
