



ED recovers Rs 59 crore in raids linked to Lodha Developers fraud case

New Delhi: The Directorate of Enforcement (ED) has seized and frozen movable assets worth approximately Rs 59 crore after conducting extensive search operations across 14 locations in Mumbai as part of its money laundering probe against Rajendra Narpatmal Lodha and his associates, the ED said on Friday. The action on Wednesday was carried out under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act (PMLA), 2002. According to the agency, the searches resulted in the recovery of large quantities of cash, bank balances, fixed deposits, and several incriminating documents. Digital devices and details of immovable assets allegedly linked to the fraud, running into several crores of rupees, were also confiscated.



The money laundering investigation was launched on the basis of FIRs filed by the Mumbai Police against Lodha and others under various sections of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023. The FIRs pertain to charges of cheating, abuse of official position, unauthorised sale of assets, and fabrication of documents that allegedly caused wrongful losses exceeding Rs 100 crore to Lodha Developers Ltd

(LDL), a publicly listed real estate company. The ED probe has uncovered a complex web of alleged financial misconduct. "ED investigation revealed that Rajendra Narpatmal Lodha was involved in diverting/siphoning funds and assets of M/s Lodha Developers Ltd (M/s LDL) through unauthorised sale and transfer of company-owned immovable properties at undervalued prices to proxy entities and individuals connected to him, without the approval of the Board of Directors," the ED said in its press note. Investigators further found that Lodha and his associates fabricated Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) for land purchases at artificially inflated prices. According to the ED, the inflated amounts were allegedly siphoned off in cash through the original sellers, enabling Lodha to systematically divert company funds for personal gain. "Investigation reveals that Rajendra Lodha, along with his related persons, associates and entities, accumulated assets through these fraudulent activities, causing wrongful loss to M/s Lodha Developers Ltd," it said. The agency noted that further investigation is currently underway.

Congress candidate Naveen Yadav secures victory in Jubilee Hills by-election



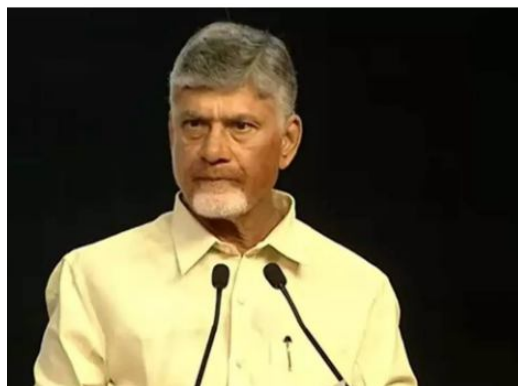

AP aims for \$1 Trillion investment with 20 lakh jobs, says CM Naidu

Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu has announced that Andhra Pradesh (AP) is poised to become a prime destination for investors, with no shortage of land available for new industries and projects. Speaking at the CII Investment Summit held in Visakhapatnam, he highlighted that the state has introduced 25 investment-friendly policies and is moving rapidly to allocate land for development.

Naidu revealed that AP has attracted \$20 billion in investments in just 17 months, generating the potential for 20 lakh jobs for the state's youth. He outlined ambitious goals for the future, aiming for \$0.5 trillion in investments and 50 lakh jobs in the coming years, with a target of \$1 trillion in the next decade.

The Chief Minister emphasised the state's infrastructural reforms and the establishment of an escrow account to facilitate industry incentives, along with a sovereign guarantee for investors. He expressed confidence that India is emerging as a global leader in attracting investments, with Andhra Pradesh acting as the gateway.



Speaking on the attributes of Visakhapatnam, which was recently declared a safe city, Naidu described it as "the most beautiful city in the country." He accentuated the central government's support under Prime Minister Modi's leadership, indicating belief in the ongoing reforms and the promise of a prosperous future for India.

The summit saw participation from over 522 foreign representatives across 72 countries, alongside 2,500 industrialists, reflecting a robust interest in various sectors such as aerospace, defence, and technology. Naidu also announced the potential establishment of innovative projects, including a Quantum Valley and Drone City in AP.

Highlighting the importance of green energy, Naidu noted ongoing efforts to generate 160 gigawatts of electricity through renewable sources and encouraged industry leaders to explore opportunities in sectors such as tourism, agritech, and logistics.

In closing, CM Chandrababu Naidu urged industrialists to leverage the abundant opportunities in AP, promising that the state government would assist in the provision of land and support for infrastructure projects, including a proposed Andhra Mandapam in Visakhapatnam for commercial exhibitions.

About 100 MoUs signed in tourism sector

Visakhapatnam: With delegates from over 70 countries exuding confidence in the alliance government, the Confederation of Indian Industry Summit-2025 that commenced on Friday saw an encouraging response, said Minister for Tourism, Culture, and Cinematography Kandula Durgesh.

After tasting Araku coffee, the minister said they are providing worldwide promotions for Araku Coffee. He inspected India's first robotic cafe set up by the Bean Board organisers and enquired about the robot's performance. Minister Durgesh stated if the tourism sector thrives, it leads to economic development, employment generation, and cultural exchange.

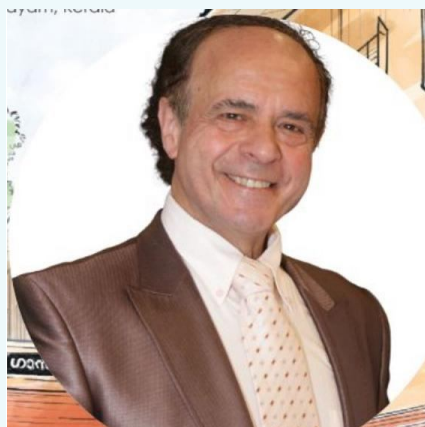
Minister Durgesh informed that the Trishul project on Kailasagiri will be made available soon, and preparations are underway to

Dr Konstantin Pavlidis Shares Global Wellness Insights at Orassy Healthcare Talk London

According to Dr. Pavlidis, many clients have reported benefits ranging from reduced anxiety, clarity, to better physical resilience.

His assistants, Andrei Miguel in London Eli Chan and Lydia Gerasimova, have been closely involved in delivering the assessments and supporting clients across different regions. Treatments are helpful for a wide range of physical and mental health disorders.

They also use a combination of light therapy, sound therapy, plasma therapy, magnetic, electric and Tesla plasma therapy.

Dr. Pavlidis described his ongoing mission as "building a bridge between measurable science and lived human experience. His work, he said, seeks to understand not just the symptoms of mental and physical distress, but the deeper mechanisms that connect the mind and body.
