

IndiGo to start flights from Navi Mumbai International Airport from Dec 25

Mumbai: Low-cost airline IndiGo on Saturday announced flight operations from the newly-opened Navi Mumbai International Airport (NMIA) starting December 25, connecting the airport to 10 cities across the country. IndiGo will connect the future-ready airport to 10 cities, including Delhi, Bengaluru, Hyderabad, Ahmedabad, Lucknow, North Goa (Mopa), Jaipur, Nagpur, Cochin, and Mangalore, the airline said in a statement.

The airline said it plans to expand operations at NMIA progressively by adding direct routes to more destinations in due course.

NMIA, the second airport in the Mumbai metropolitan area, is designed to complement Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport and meet growing demand for air travel from India's



financial capital. NMIA is expected to enhance regional connectivity and support economic development in western India due to its strategic location.

By enhancing regional connectivity and supporting economic development in western India, the launch of IndiGo's operations will connect the airport to its vast

domestic network of 95 airports across the country, it added.

The Navi Mumbai International Airport was inaugurated by Prime Minister Narendra Modi last month, as a major achievement in India's economic development and "a symbol of Bharat's aspirations". PM Modi said that Mumbai

welcomed its second international airport, marking a significant milestone in its journey to becoming Asia's premier connectivity hub. "Through this new airport, the farmers of Maharashtra will be able to connect with supermarkets in Europe and the Middle East as well," he observed.

NMIA will ease congestion at Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport and significantly increase India's aviation capacity.

The Navi Mumbai International Airport Private is designed to accommodate both domestic and international passengers, featuring state-of-the-art facilities. It includes a 3,700-metre runway capable of handling large commercial aircraft, modern passenger terminals, and advanced air traffic control systems.

Telangana High Court Website Hacked

Nara Lokesh Advocates for AI Integration at CII Conference in Visakhapatnam

The second day of the CII conference in Visakhapatnam featured a discussion on the topic of 'AI - Jobs in the Future', with Minister Nara Lokesh voicing his optimism about the role of artificial intelligence in job creation. He stated, "I believe that every industrial revolution will create more jobs."

Lokesh highlighted that Andhra Pradesh is adopting a three-pronged approach to embrace AI: reskilling, redefinition, and reimagining. He announced the development of a platform dedicated to skills enhancement, asserting that "Artificial intelligence is not a threat to humanity; it will shape humanity."

The Minister emphasised the pivotal role of the IT sector in fostering entrepreneurial growth, particularly in areas such as food processing. "We



aim to help business owners increase their earnings from Rs. 50,000 to Rs. 1 lakh per month, and those earning Rs. 5 lakh to reach Rs. 25 lakh," he explained. He reiterated that achieving these milestones is essential for propelling the state towards a \$2.4 trillion economy.

Concluding his address, Nara Lokesh expressed the government's eagerness to collaborate with local entrepreneurs, stating, "We are ready to bring about structural reforms."

CM Chandrababu collaborates with Atmosphere Core on tourism development in AP

In a significant meeting in Visakhapatnam, Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu engaged with representatives from Atmosphere Core Company, a prominent player in the global hospitality sector. The discussions, led by the company's South Asia Managing Director Sauvagya Mohapatra and Group Managing Director Salil Panigrahi, centred on the development of the modern tourism sector and the expansion of premium luxury hotels within the state.

During the meeting, CM Naidu inquired about the progress of several projects currently underway in Tirupati, Visakhapatnam, and Amaravati. Representatives from Atmosphere Core confirmed that all three projects are expected to be completed within the next three years. In response, Naidu assured his cooperation in facilitating the swift completion of these ventures.



The Chief Minister also explored the possibility of establishing adventure resorts in Gandikota and hill resorts in the Araku-Ananthagiri region. Furthermore, he expressed his intent to inspect the Bobbili and Vijayanagaram palaces to provide suggestions for their development as tourist attractions.

Atmosphere Core representa-

tives indicated a strong interest in constructing world-class resorts at Rishikonda, highlighting the potential for enhancing the region's tourism appeal. The meeting was attended by Minister Kandula Durgesh, Tourism Corporation Chairman Nookasani Balaji, and top officials from the Tourism Department, including Ajay Jain and Amrapali.

Hyderabad CP Sajjanar Issues Warning Over Fake Social Media Accounts

Hyderabad's Commissioner of Police, Sajjanar, has alerted the public regarding the misuse of his identity by cyber criminals who have created fake Facebook accounts in his name. These accounts have been sending fraudulent messages, particularly targeting Sajjanar's friends, with alarming requests like "I am in danger... send money immediately." In a statement shared on his official social media account, the Commissioner revealed that at least one individual has fallen victim to this scam, having already transferred Rs. 20,000 to the fraudsters. To combat this issue, Sajjanar shared a link to his authentic



Facebook page, emphasising that any other accounts operating under his name are entirely bogus.

The Hyderabad Cyber Crime Team is reportedly working closely with Meta to identify and remove these fraudulent accounts. Sajjanar cautioned the public against accepting friend requests or responding to

messages from individuals claiming to be celebrities, especially those requesting money. He advised that in such situations, it is vital to verify the authenticity of the messages by contacting the person directly via phone. The Commissioner underscored the importance of reporting suspicious activities, recommending that anyone encountering fake accounts involved in cyber fraud should contact the 1930 helpline or file a complaint at www.cyber-crime.gov.in. He concluded with a firm warning: "Stay alert... Stay safe," stressing the necessity of vigilance to protect personal information and finances from cyber fraudsters.

'Raymond will help us cross 20 lakh jobs': CM

Visakhapatnam: Marking a significant addition to Andhra Pradesh's manufacturing sectors, Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu virtually laid the foundation for three major Raymond Group projects on day-two of the CII Partnership Summit-2025 continued at Andhra University Engineering Grounds in Visakhapatnam on Saturday. Mother of Trees Saalumarada Thimmakka passed away

Saalumarada Thimmakka Dies at 114
Bengaluru India Mourns the Passing of a Green
Icon who passed away friday 14/11/2025.

India is paying tribute to environmentalist Saalumarada Thimmakka, affectionately known as "The Mother of Trees" who passed away at the age of 114 in Bengaluru. Her death marks the end of an extraordinary life dedicated to nurturing the earth and inspiring generations.



Thimmakka, born in Karnataka, became an environmental symbol despite having no formal education. Along with her husband, she famously planted 385 banyan trees along a 4.5 km stretch between Hulikal and Kudur. Over the decades, she cared for more than 8,000 trees, like her own children, transforming barren land into flourishing green corridors and uplifting ecological awareness in her community and across the country.

Her grassroots environmental work earned widespread recognition. She was honoured with the prestigious Padma Shri Award and received over 12 national honours, making her a celebrated figure in Indias environmental movement.

In her final years, Thimmakka faced several health challenges, including hip surgery, multiple hospitalisations, and angioplasty. Yet her spirit remained strong, and she continued to inspire through her message of simplicity, compassion, and devotion to nature.

A landowner named Kommu Tirupati has protested that some land



grabbers are encroaching on our land, which has been inherited since the Nizam era. He stopped the illegal encroachers who were illegally encroaching on land that does not belong to them and flattening it with a bulldozer and filed a complaint with the revenue authorities. Some people have set their eyes on the lands of Dalits located in Survey No. 789/1, 789/2/2, 789/3 near the Azmatnagar High Court Colony in Uppal. Some land has already been encroached on in these survey numbers and our Dalit lands are left without protection. Speaking to the Tirupati media on this occasion, Tirupati alleged that people named R Venkat Reddy and Sudarshan Reddy are encroaching on our lands by threatening and threat-

ening us, saying that they will kill us, by obstructing a person from the ST community named Jayaram. In the past, the government has given us land for livelihood. They said that they are living on this land by building houses, and that we have patta passbooks, and that even though we are still in the records, it is a wicked act to encroach on our lands. Since the Nizam era, the government has given us Dalits a patta passbook on the land given to us. But some people are encroaching on our survey number next to ours, saying that this is their land, and not their survey number, and are leveling the land with a JCB. They alleged that the police are also supporting the encroachers. They are doing the work without lis-



tening to the AD survey and saying that they will take the land if it comes to you. They complained that the revenue officials who received information while the land was being leveled with a JCB were threatening the revenue officials even though they came to the place and told them that this is government land. Tirupati warned that if they illegally enter their land and encroach on it, they will not be left alone.

We will file criminal cases if they illegally encroach on government land. They are encroaching on government land along with the adjacent patta land. We will not ignore those who are involved in encroachment. We will seize the bulldozer that is being used to level the land and register a case.

SUNDAY BOOK REVIEW

THE THREE RUNAWAYS.

I feel that,in the wake of a powerful human bomb blast triggered by a young,educated youth in New Delhi a few days ago,it is pertinent to read this book just to know how many innocent people are lured and trapped into the ever growing and hugely funded fatal business called TERRORISM.

Tomas Young,soldier,was fatally wounded in the Iraq war in 2004 and on the 10th Anniversary of the war in 2013 Young,from his death bed,wrote his last letter to George W Bush and Dick Cheney,telling them that the war was an avoidable and meaningless blood shed,loss of men,money,had caused deep agony and pain in the lives of millions of innocent people.The novel The Runaways by Pakistani writer Fatima Bhutto,covers the next four years from 2014 to 2017,telling us how innocent young boys and girls from Christian and Muslim communities were lured into the trap of militant groups,and Jihads against infidels,viewed as a corollary to the Iraq war.

The story begins with an intense scene that at once catches your attention and arouses your interest.You find a teenager at the break of dawn moving hurriedly through the hurly-burly of traffic at the airport.She is intensely conscious of the eagle-eyed,gun wielding security staff on the way.At the check in point when an armed man is verifying her passport,she becomes even more jittery and parrots out her answers to his probing questions.She is running away from the city of Karachi, with the fond hope that new light,happy times would dawn in her life.Now a few questions linger in your mind like who is she?why is she running away?and Where is she heading to?

The girl is Anita Rose,apparently running away from her festering poverty,from her loving yet mis-

guiding mother, and teasing girls at school. The only solace for this young girl is the company of her neighbor Osama, an elderly radical man forsaken by his family, who gives her avuncular love and care, calling her a lion. Every day, she visits this man to discuss news, poetry over tea and snacks and also to learn some English words which she jots down in her favourite red notebook. Osama often helps this girl with money, talks about the ways of the world. He sometimes takes her out in the evenings to his rendezvous in his heydays, the Press Club.

All of a sudden, Anita finds her elder brother Ezra ushering in a sea change in their poverty-stricken lives in general and in her life in particular as he gives her, among other things, the new name, Layla (which in Arabic means a dark beauty and an admission in the American School of Karachi, a place meant for the children of the rich and the elite.

Here Layla apes all new habits, picks up drinking, smoking e-cigarettes. Within no time, Layla becomes famous and everybody wants her. In the process she befriends Monty, the only son of a stinking rich and all powerful businessman in Karachi. This shy boy also wants Layla for her looks and courage. Monty is just mad about this siren on their high school campus. Layla is his world and she enjoys every bit of it.
