



Putin thanks PM Modi for making efforts to resolve Ukraine conflict

New Delhi: Russian President Vladimir Putin on Friday thanked Prime Minister Narendra Modi for his efforts in resolving the ongoing conflict in Ukraine, stating that he has had "very informative and useful conversation" with the Indian leader since arriving in New Delhi on Thursday evening. "Thank you very much for the invitation and for yesterday's very good evening, with our friendly yet at the same time informative and very useful conversation. We had the opportunity, and I was given the opportunity, to talk in detail about what is happening specifically in the Ukrainian sphere and what we are doing together with several other partners, including the United States, to address the issue of a possible peaceful resolution to this crisis," said Putin in his opening remarks ahead of the 23rd India-Russia Annual Summit at the Hyderabad



House. "Thank you for your attention. And, thank you for your efforts to resolve this situation," he added with PM Modi sitting next to him. The Russian President highlighted that India-Russia relations truly have a very deep historical character. "No matter how we characterize them, no matter

what epithets we adorn them with, what matters is the content. And the content is very profound. We value this very much. And we see that you, esteemed Mr. Prime Minister, are also devoting a great deal of personal attention to this," he said. He highlighted that, over the past years, both sides have

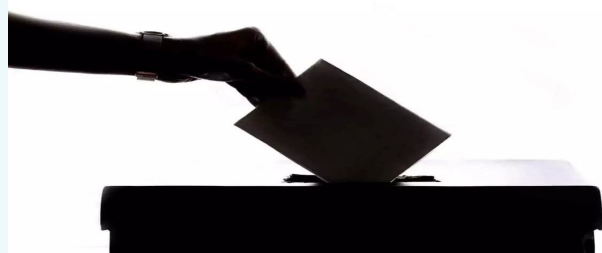
accomplished a great deal of work in developing relations and as both economies develop, the opportunities for cooperation are also expanding. "We are developing new areas related to high technology, related to the development and joint work in aviation, space, high technology in the broad sense of the word, and artificial intelligence. We have very trusting relations in the area of ??military-technical cooperation. We intend to move forward in all these areas. This only further underscores the level, nature, and trust of our ties," commented President Putin.

As they sat down for the meeting, the Russian President stated that teams from Moscow and New Delhi have "worked very well" in the lead-up to his visit. "A number of significant documents have been prepared. We have the opportunity to discuss some of them further and discuss other things further. And I am

confident that we will conclude today's work with a positive result," he concluded.

Earlier, taking the India-Russia Special and Privileged Partnership ahead, PM Modi warmly welcomed President Putin at the Hyderabad House to participate in the 23rd India-Russia Annual Summit. With both countries sharing a long-standing and time-tested bond, the two leaders are holding comprehensive and detailed discussions aimed at further strengthening the bilateral relations. The Russian President's itinerary on the second and final day of this State Visit remains packed as he is scheduled to attend a business event and will be hosted by President Droupadi Murmu for a banquet in the evening. Putin will also participate in a business event at Bharat Mandapam, aimed at strengthening commercial and investment engagement.

Over 13,000 candidates in the fray as Telangana Gram Panchayat polls kick off



Hyderabad: A total of 13,127 candidates remain in the electoral race for the 3,836 Gram Panchayats scheduled for the first phase of elections, which will be held on 11th December. The State Election Commission (SEC) officially released the final list detailing the total number of candidates in the fray. According to the data, a significant 395 Sarpanchas were elected unanimously. Conversely, there were at least five villages where no nominations were filed. Consequently, the polls on 11th December will proceed for the remaining 3,836 Gram Panchayats. Regarding the elections for ward offices, the SEC notified polls for 37,440 ward offices, with the total number of candidates in the fray standing at 67,893. Officials reported that 9,331 ward offices saw candidates elected unanimously, while 149 ward offices received no nominations. The election will, therefore, be conducted in 27,960 ward offices. A notable number of candidates withdrew their candidature: 8,095 individuals withdrew from the Gram Panchayat contests, and 9,626 candidates withdrew their nominations for the ward offices.

Telangana minister announces housewarming of Indiramma houses soon

Minister Ponguleti Srinivasa Reddy has announced that three lakh Indiramma houses are currently under construction in various stages across the state. Speaking to the media at the Telangana Secretariat, he revealed that one lakh of these homes are expected to be ready for housewarming soon, with plans to complete the housewarming for all three lakh houses by March next year. Minister Reddy also outlined plans for the second phase of the Indiramma housing project, which is set to commence in April 2024. He added that a strategy has been developed for constructing Indiramma houses in core urban areas, with plans for ground-plus-four buildings aimed at providing housing for the underprivileged. In addition, the minister announced that houses will be built in all directions adjacent to the Outer Ring Road (ORR), with a target of constructing 10,000 houses in each location. These homes will be offered to middle-class families under a no-profit, no-loss scheme. Detailed plans for the urban housing initiative will be unveiled at an upcoming global summit.



CM Chandrababu Advocates for Innovative Learning Approaches at Mega PTM



In a recent address at the Mega Parent-Teacher Meeting (PTM) held in Bhamini, Parvathipuram Manyam district, Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu emphasised the importance of integrating innovative programmes into the educational system. He urged that children should engage in learning through play and music alongside their studies, fostering a more enjoyable and enriching educational experience. Highlighting the intelligence of today's youth, Naidu stated, "It would be beneficial if they could read with interest, even for a short time." He recognized a global trend of declining populations, asserting that in the future, India will be the nation with the highest number of children. The Chief Minister expressed confidence that such programmes will provide a solid foundation for students to excel in all subjects. He further encouraged parents and teachers to identify the strengths and weaknesses of their children, suggesting that any shortcomings be addressed promptly to assist in their overall development. Chandrababu's call for a more playful and engaging approach to education aims to create well-rounded individuals ready to tackle future challenges.

IndiGo issue raised; Kavach system, AI push dominate Question Hour

New Delhi: The Rajya Sabha on Friday witnessed exchanges and important disclosures during a truncated Question Hour, which was dominated by the nationwide IndiGo flight disruption crisis. Trinamool Congress floor leader Derek O'Brien appealed to Chairman C.P. Radhakrishnan to extend Question Hour by at least one hour, saying, "Due to the ongoing IndiGo crisis, nobody can go anywhere. Members are stuck; let us utilise the time productively."

The Chair, however, declined, stating that Union Minister Kiren Rijju had already addressed the issue in detail earlier in the day. Earlier during question hour, in a significant statement on India's Artificial Intelligence ambitions, Union Electronics &



IT Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw informed the House that over 200 events have been organised across the country involving nearly two lakh students and teachers as

part of preparations for the India AI Impact Summit 2026.

"Prime Minister Narendra Modi has given the vision to democratise technology. We are building an inclusive AI ecosystem accessible to every citizen," Vaishnaw said, outlining initiatives in AI skilling, research and startup support. The Railways Ministry also came under detailed scrutiny. Responding to a starred question by BJP MP from Odisha, Sasmit Patra, on the progress of the indigenous anti-collision system 'Kavach 4.0', Union Railways Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw shared the latest deployment figures and timeline for covering the entire high-density network.

A poignant moment came when a member from Kerala raised the horrific November

2025 incident in which a 19-year-old college student was critically injured after being kicked out of a moving train near Varkala by a drunk male passenger. The MP sought details on compensation and enhanced women's safety measures in trains. Minister Vaishnaw assured the House that Railways has sanctioned enhanced ex gratia compensation for the victim and is expediting installation of CCTV, panic buttons and increased deployment of RPF personnel in women's coaches. The first half of the day thus saw the Upper House discuss technology, rail safety and passenger security, even as hundreds of flights remained grounded outside, keeping many, including members and staff, stranded.

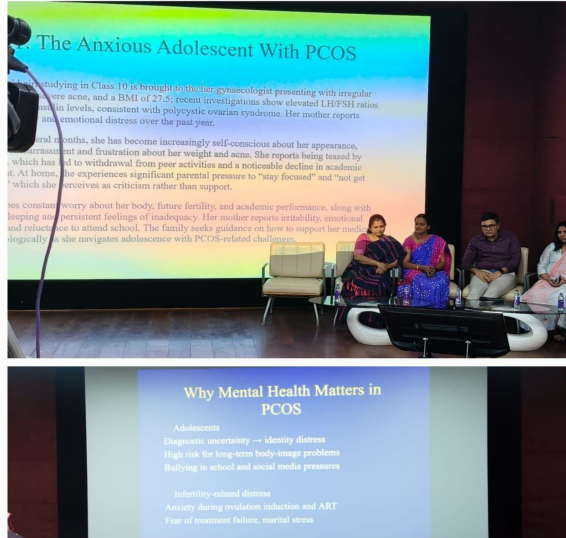
KIMS Hospital Hosts Successful PCOS and Mental Health Awareness Program

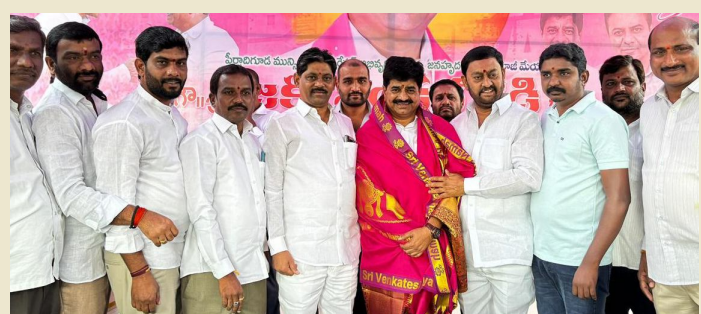

We welcome the development of Hyderabad city as a cosmopolitan city, but at the same time, the people are likely to face difficulties due to the merger of suburban municipalities with GHMC without public consultation, said Boduppall Federation Chairman Dr. Rapolu Ramulu. Speaking to this effect at a press conference organized at the Federation office on Friday, he condemned the



merger of Boduppall Municipal Corporation with the Secunderabad zone along with the municipalities and corporations around Hyderabad, and the merger of Dammaiguda with LB Nagar zone. He said that they welcome the development of Hyderabad city as a cosmopolitan city, but that it has been divided in an inappropriate manner

without consulting the people and in a way that is inconvenient for the people. He said that it would be convenient for the people if the Boduppall Municipal Corporation is merged into the LB Nagar zone instead of the Secunderabad zone. Dr. Rapolu Ramulu appealed to the GHMC officials to necessarily merge Boduppall into the LB

Nagar zone for the convenience of the people. He said that some villages in Ghatkesar and Pocharam municipalities are not yet developed, and merging them into the greater one will increase the tax burden on the people of those villages, and he asked the government to identify such areas and provide tax relief. In this context, he suggested that the government continue to operate as municipalities for some time. Boduppall Federation Vice Chairman Edla Srinivasa Reddy, President Abraham Lincoln, General Secretary Gaddam Yadagiri, and others participated in this meeting.

A Prajavani NGO team visited the Mandal Primary School in Ramanthapur on Friday. Speaking on the occasion, they said that there are 255 students from class 1 to 5, four teachers, and this school also has nursery, LKG, and UKG classes. The Telangana state government is working with the aim of making government schools comparable to private schools. Admissions have increased significantly



cantly in recent times. Due to the transfer of teachers in government schools, there are only four teachers in the school that

should have seven teachers. He said that this school, which has more than 230 students, is deprived of the opportunity

ty to study due to the lack of teachers. There are also no educational voluntary teachers. Although the school has its own building, there are few classrooms. Mid-day meals are being served according to the government menu. They said that students are facing a lot of difficulties due to the lack of a playground. The leaders demanded that a part of the small pond in Ramanthapur be converted into a playground and a playground be provided to the students. Prajavani NGO President Eram Srinivas, General Secretary Vijay Kumar, Vampu Laxman, Goli Krishnaiah and others participated in this program.

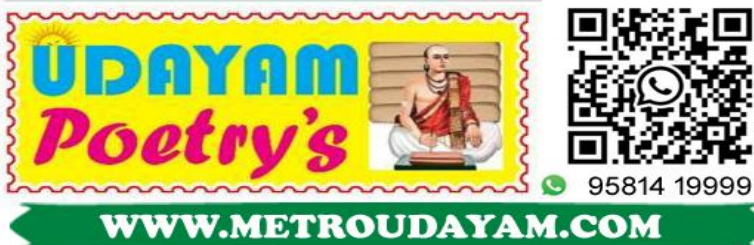
State Minister Kondapalli Srinivas Meets Visakhapatnam Railway DRM Lalit Bohara

For every obstacle, is an opportunity in sight.

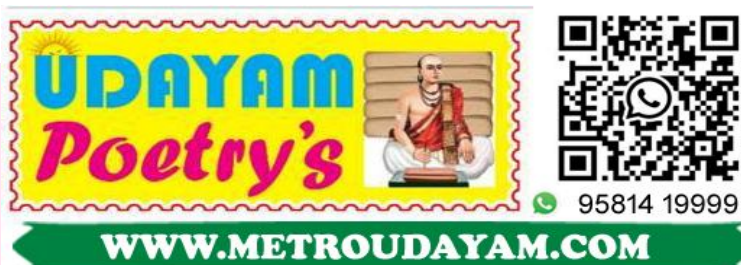
The path ahead is tough, the journeys long,

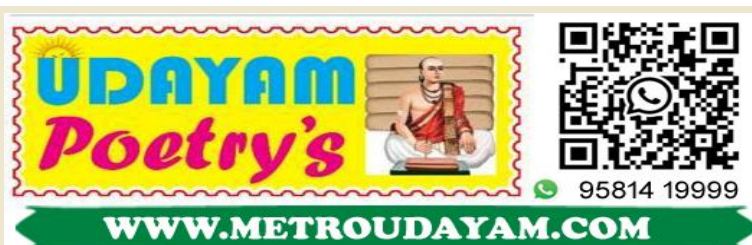

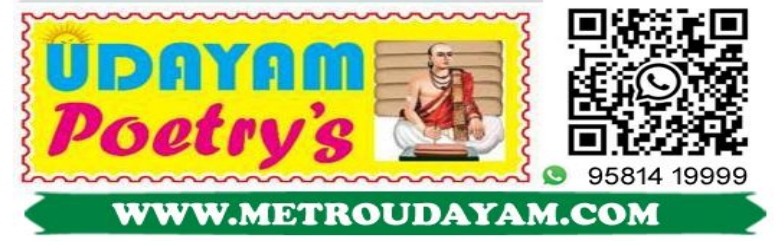
Andhra badminton star Kidambi Srikanth with Dr. Aleem Siddiqui

की भक्ती हो यह दोनों भी बातें हमारी परीक्षा के ही माध्यम हैं।

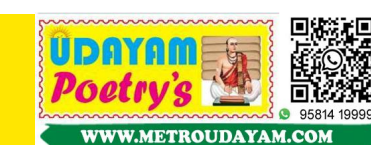
ऐसे देखा जाये तो हमारे खयाल में यही आता है के

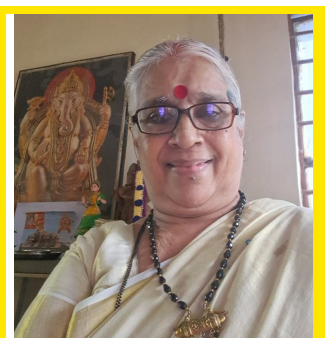
