



Naidu vows zero tolerance on political rowdyism

Tirupati: Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu on Friday asserted that the government would show zero tolerance towards rowdyism and criminal activities carried out under the guise of politics, warning that offenders could face externment from the state. Inaugurating the newly constructed district police office (DPO) here along with home minister V Anitha, the Chief Minister said protecting the sanctity of Tirumala — described as Kaliyuga Vaikuntha — and ensuring complete security for devotees was a top priority of the government. He stressed that the responsibility of instilling a sense of safety among pilgrims arriving from across the country and abroad rested with the police. The Chief Minister inspected the premises, received a guard of honour from



the police, and later recorded his observations and suggestions in the visitors' book. He urged the police to leverage technology for crime control, including drone-based patrolling and the collection of visual evidence. Police personnel, he said, must think several steps

ahead of criminals and use technology to track and apprehend them, advocating the concept of "visible policing and invisible police." With Vaikuntha Ekadashi approaching, the Chief Minister directed the police to remain on high alert and ensure that devotees face

no inconvenience and that no untoward incidents occur in and around Tirumala and Tirupati. Warning against any compromise on law and order, Naidu said that those indulging in settlements, intimidation, and violent acts in the name of politics would be dealt with sternly, irrespective of their political affiliation. He recalled that his government had a track record of sending even party members to jail if they were found involved in illegal activities. Criticising the previous government, he alleged that law and order had deteriorated during its tenure and that the sanctity of Tirumala had been undermined. He cited incidents involving road blockades, public intimidation, and alleged custodial and criminal excesses, and called for the extensive use of CCTV cameras and drones to

gather evidence in such cases. The Chief Minister said the government would not tolerate practices such as blocking roads, performing animal sacrifices, splashing blood on posters, or spreading fear in society. He also warned that strict action would be taken against those indulging in character assassination and posting obscene content on social media, adding that such activities were under government surveillance. Naidu congratulated the Tirupati police for their efforts in curbing ganja and drug trafficking, preventing red sanders smuggling, and effectively implementing the Preventive Detention Act. District in-charge minister Anagani Satya Prasad, DGP Harish Kumar Gupta, senior officials, and public representatives were present at the event.

KCR to lead BRS stir over Palamuru-Rangareddy project

Hyderabad: In a major political offensive, BRS President K Chandrashekar Rao is set to visit the Palamuru-Rangareddy Lift Irrigation (PRLI) project site to directly confront the Congress government over its alleged neglect of the scheme. The visit aims to expose how the "lifeline of South Telangana" is being sidelined, depriving the region of essential irrigation and drinking water. During a high-level meeting of former ministers and senior leaders at his Eravelli farmhouse on Friday, the BRS chief directed party ranks to maintain an unwavering focus on the irrigation crisis. Sources indicate that KCR cautioned leaders against being distracted by government tactics, such as the phone-tapping probe or the Formula E legal notices. "The government will try to divert public attention with these notices, but you must not deter from the goal of exposing the severe injustice meted out to the people of South Telangana," he reportedly told the gathering. Also Read - Palamur project: BRS to mount pressure on govt, conduct 3 mega public meetings The BRS is planning a massive public outreach programme after Sankranti, featuring three major rallies in Rangareddy, Nalgonda, and Mahabubnagar. To educate the masses, KCR has instructed leaders to utilise PowerPoint presentations, pamphlets, conferences, and folk songs to explain the technical and financial aspects of the project in simple language. Specific



emphasis will be placed on the BRS government's expenditure and the status of the project before the change in power. BRS leaders intend to highlight that while critical works remain pending, the current government has prioritised the Kodangal Lift Irrigation scheme, which they allege was launched purely for "commissions." Concluding the meeting, the BRS President remarked that the government's "honeymoon period" is over. Vowing to build sustained pressure, he stated that the party would now hold the administration accountable for the "420 promises" made to the people of Telangana.

AP govt to disburse January month elderly pension a day before on Dec 31

The Andhra Pradesh government has delivered positive news for pensioners, announcing that social security pensions for January will be disbursed on December 31. This proactive decision is aimed at ensuring beneficiaries do not encounter inconvenience during New Year celebrations, particularly as January 1 is designated as an optional holiday. The accelerated timeline intends to prevent any delays in pension distribution, allowing pensioners across all categories—including the elderly, disabled, and widows—to receive their payments punctually. To facilitate this move, the government has issued explicit guidelines to the administrative machinery. All village and ward secretariat staff have been instructed to prepare the necessary cash by December 30, and officials are to liaise with banks in advance to ensure seamless pension distribution. Additionally, banks will be notified ahead of time to avoid any issues with cash availability. In a



further commitment to ensuring that no beneficiary is overlooked, the government has put arrangements in place for those who may not receive their pensions on December 31. Remaining pensions will be disbursed on January 2. This decision underscores the government's determination to alleviate financial pressures for numerous families reliant on pensions during the festive season. Beneficiaries have expressed their satisfaction with this timely initiative.

Telangana: Sankranti holidays likely from 10-16 January

The School Education Department has announced holidays for the Sankranti festival for seven days in Telangana. i.e from January 10th to 16th. Initially, holidays were scheduled for January 11th to 15th, but the government has confirmed January 14th as Bhogi, January 15th as Sankranti, and January 16th as Kanuma. With January 10th falling on a second Saturday, the holidays have been revised accordingly. Schools are set to reopen on Saturday, January 17th. An official announcement from the Education Department is expected to be released shortly.

Cold wave grips AP, Telangana as temperatures drop

The cold weather is making residents in the Telugu states shiver, with temperatures falling day by day. Many districts in Telangana and Andhra Pradesh are experiencing single-digit readings, leading to a reluctance among people to venture outdoors. The Meteorological Department has indicated that this severe cold snap is expected to persist until December 31. Following that, a rise in temperatures is anticipated, signalling a respite from the cold. Weather experts predict a normal winter at the start of January, although colder conditions are expected to return around Sankranti. After that, temperatures are forecasted to decrease again during the last week of the month. The Hyderabad Meteorological Centre has alerted that temperatures across Telangana may be 3 to



4 degrees below normal in the coming four to five days.

Telangana Weather Analysis and Warnings for the Next Three Days: The Hyderabad Meteorological Centre reports that lower-level winds in Telangana are predominantly blowing from the east and southeast. This shift is likely to exacer-

erbate the cold over the next three days, with dry weather forecasted for Saturday, Sunday, and Monday. Minimum temperatures in certain areas of the state are predicted to drop by 2°C to 3°C below the seasonal average. Andhra Pradesh Weather Update Conditions in Andhra Pradesh are also trending towards cooler temperatures, with dry weather expected. The forecast suggests that temperatures will remain 2 to 3 degrees lower than normal over the next few days. Notably, intense cold continues to affect the Paderu agency area of Alluri district, where temperatures have been recorded at 5 degrees Celsius in Minumuluru, 6 degrees in Araku, and 9 degrees in Paderu. The meteorological department has warned that further declines in temperature may be forthcoming.

East Coast Railway Advances Major Infrastructure Upgrades in Bhubaneswar, Puri and Visakhapatnam to Double Train Originating Capacity.

We're expanding coaching terminals, enhancing sectional and operational capacities in various cities to meet rising passenger demand and reduce congestion. This move will upgrade our railway network and improve nationwide connectivity" - Shri Ashwini Vaishnaw, Union Minister of Railways, Information & Broadcasting, and Electronics & Information Technology. In view of the rapid sustained growth in demand for travel, the capacity of major cities under East Coast Railway to originate new trains needs to be doubled from the current level in the next 5 years.

The current infrastructure at Bhubaneswar, Puri and Visakhapatnam serving passenger needs is being augmented to meet the requirements of upcoming years.

The works for doubling the originating capacity by the year 2030 in these cities would include the following actions:

- Augmenting the current terminals with additional platforms, stabling lines, pit lines, and adequate shunting facilities
- Identifying and creating new terminals in and around the urban areas
- Developing maintenance facilities, including mega coaching complexes
- Increasing the sectional capacity with traffic facility works, signaling upgradation,



and multitracking required for handling increased trains at various points

While planning for increasing capacity of terminals at Bhubaneswar, Puri and Visakhapatnam, nearby stations will also be considered so that capacity is evenly balanced. For example:

- At Puri, two additional full-length Integrated Pit Lines are under construction to supplement the existing six; the entire coaching maintenance facility is proposed to be shifted to a new second coaching terminal depot on the sanctioned Puri-Konark new line (Final Location Survey proposed), and a large-scale coaching complex is planned on this line.
- At Bhubaneswar, the new

Bhubaneswar New Station is being developed as a satellite coaching terminal with a maintenance facility of two pit lines at Mancheswar and dedicated connectivity; due to space constraints new depots are proposed in nearby areas.

- At Visakhapatnam, a DPR for yard modification providing five additional lines, six additional passenger platforms, ten stabling lines and Electronic Interlocking is under consideration of Railway Board; Jaganadhpuram station on the proposed Kottavalasa-Anakapalle bypass line is being planned as a mega coaching maintenance depot and large-scale complex to serve as satellite station.



To support increased train volumes, multiple sectional capacity enhancement projects are progressing, including automatic block signalling and flyovers in Puri area; pit line electrification, safety fencing, fourth lines and bypass surveys in Bhubaneswar area and several third/fourth/fifth/sixth lines, flyovers and bypass projects in Visakhapatnam area.

A comprehensive plan covering Bhubaneswar, Puri and Visakhapatnam among the 48 major cities identified by Indian Railways is under implementation. The plan includes works already sanctioned, under progress or proposed to achieve the goal of doubling train-handling capacity in a time-bound manner.

While the plan to double the capacity is by 2030, capacity will

be increased progressively over the next five years, ensuring that the benefits of capacity addition are realized immediately.

This will help in meeting the traffic requirement progressively over the years. The plan will classify actions under three categories, i.e., immediate, short-term, and long-term.

The proposed plans will be specific, with clear timelines and defined outcomes. East Coast Railway is planning to increase train handling capacity across its divisions, ensuring that not only terminal capacity at Bhubaneswar, Puri and Visakhapatnam is enhanced but also sectional capacity and operational constraints at stations and yards are effectively addressed.

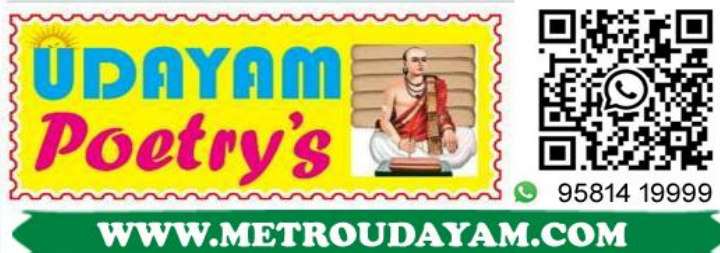
ment of Peerzadiguda Municipal Corporation was mentioned several times even in the Assembly.

Telangana TET Hall Tickets Now Available for Download



The Education Department of Telangana has announced the release of hall tickets for the Teacher Eligibility Test (TET), which can now be downloaded from the official TET website. The examinations are scheduled to take place over several days: January 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 11, 19, and 20. Candidates will take for online exams in two sessions, from 9:00 AM to 11:30 AM and 2:00 PM to 4:30 PM. A total of 237,000 candidates have registered for both Paper-1 and Paper-2 of the test. Following a recent Supreme Court ruling stating that TET is compulsory for all in-service government teachers, approximately 70,000 individuals, including contract teachers employed in Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas (KGBVs), have also submitted applications. The School Education Department has indicated that results are expected to be released between February 10 and 16.

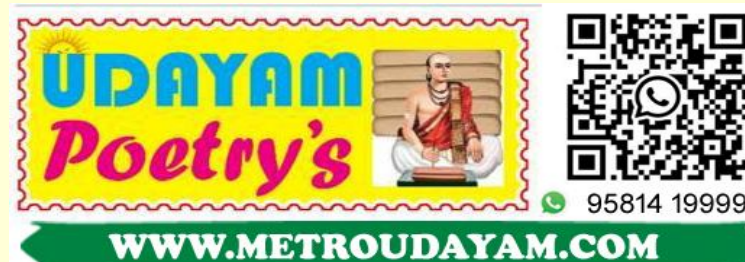
Julio Ribeiro is a retired Commissioner of Police, Indian Ambassador, author, journalist, social activist, and he lives in Mumbai. In his long and eventful career of three decades (retired in 1989), Ribeiro solved many trick cases, faced lots of challenges and flak while tackling terrorists in the Punjab, as the Commissioner of Police in Mumbai, won the hearts of millions of people, respect from colleagues, and subordinates, and often tasted cold shouldering of his superiors and political bosses! Even now, aged 97, he writes informative and critical articles in newspapers often on burning issues, has written two books.

In his 390 page autobiography, BULLET FOR BULLET... MY LIFE AS A POLICE OFFICER, Ribeiro shares with the readers many fascinating and wonderful things that have moulded his life and career. Divided into 22 small, highly readable chapters, it tells us the story of his life from the days of his selection and training as an IPS officer down to the present times in Mumbai where he is "busier than while he was in service".

In the chapter, THE BROTHERHOOD OF OFFICERS, Ribeiro talks about his personal relationships not only with his subordinates but also with the officers of other departments at the district level. Though as the

SP he would normally be very busy but when free he used to meet other officers and their families at their homes, eating food, playing sports and games. This practice helped him forge a bond of trust and cooperation among all the departments at the district level. Ribeiro feels for the younger officers today who don't mingle and build a personal bond with their subordinates, let alone officers of other departments, as he used to.

Talking about his experiences as the DCP Zone-3 in Mumbai, Ribeiro narrates two trying incidents. When Labour leader George Fernandes was to address a huge public meeting, the Shiv Sena under Hitler-like Bal Thackeray planned to disturb the meeting. Ribeiro set a tight bandobast as per the instructions of the Commissioner. Minutes before the commencement of the meeting, the Commissioner told Ribeiro that both the Shiv Sena and the State Government wanted to disturb the Fernandes' meeting, he should be lenient towards the Shiv Sena cadres. It would be very interesting to read how Ribeiro tackled the situation from that point.

On another occasion Ribeiro had a big show down with the Shiv Sena when they caused a riot during the visit of the then Central Finance Minister Morarji Desai to Mumbai. Many Shiv Sena Sainiks were killed in the police firing ordered by Ribeiro!

Ribeiro feels that his 6 year stint as DIGP CRPF

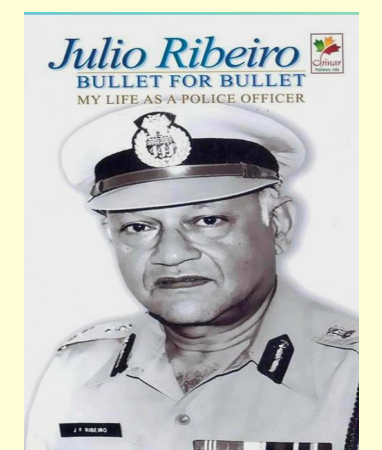
in Hyderabad was a mixed fare. Though he had good relations with other IAS and IPS officers in AP then, some of his superiors as usual didn't like his way of working. Soon Ribeiro got postings back in Mumbai.

What fascinates the reader is Ribeiro's way of tackling and viewing the interesting and wonderful things, be it his clandestine night out with the CM, or the biggest diamond heist in the State that happened during his times as ACP (crime) in Mumbai. In particular the series of episodes that marked the cold war between him and the Commissioner of Police tells the commoner a lot about the internal squabbles.

Assuming the most coveted office-Commissioner of Police Mumbai, was a dream come true for Ribeiro who was born and brought up in Mumbai. During his 40 month tenure, Ribeiro did his best to the people of his favorite city and all that attracted the focus and attention of the Centre and got him a positing in Delhi.

Read this book for the way he writes about the sensitive political developments and 'burning' law and order issues in Gujarat that virtually air-lifted him over night from Delhi and put him in the post of DGP Gujarat. The chapter TO AND FRO show cases the best of Ribeiro and his philosophy of policing.

The biggest and riskiest challenge that Ribeiro faced came at the fag end of his long career. In the chapter, PUNJAB, he tells us how he was called to the house of PM



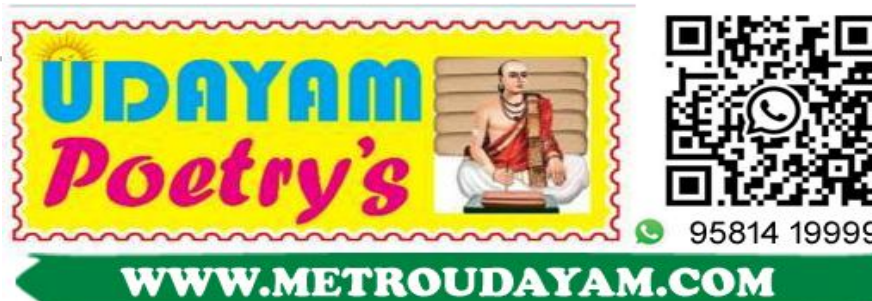
Rajeev Gandhi in the wee hours one day and from there he was dashed direct in a special plane to the burning Punjab to be the DGP, Punjab. Though from day one Ribeiro took up the challenge in right earnest, the terrorists greeted him by killing seven policemen who were on the way to court to produce a notorious terrorist!

Read it to know how Ribeiro took control of the situation, earned the epithet, BULLET FOR BULLET, an expression coined by a journalist, survived the first murder attempt by the terrorists (He escaped by the skin of his teeth their second attempt also in Romania where he was our Ambassador after his retirement).

What is the secret behind his success? one may ask. Ribeiro says that to be a successful police officer, he has followed two principles throughout his career- 1) Always honest and upright. 2) Always on the people's side.

Every police officer must read this inspiring book.

'Akhandha 2: Thandavam' faces financial blow despite strong opening run

Nandamuri Balakrishna's much-hyped sequel Akhandha 2: Thandavam directed by Boyapati Srinu may have enjoyed a promising start at the box office, but the film is now being widely discussed in trade circles for the significant financial loss it has incurred. Despite decent footfalls and sustained interest in the initial weeks, the numbers tell a sobering story when weighed against its massive budget. While the makers have not officially revealed the production cost, industry trackers and trade estimates peg Akhandha 2: Thandavam at a hefty budget of around ₹200 crore. This figure reportedly includes production expenses, star remuneration, extensive marketing, and wide-scale release costs, making it one of the most expensive projects in Balakrishna's career. After the last-minute postponement on December 5th, released on December 12, 2025, the film opened to an encouraging response, collecting approxi-



mately ₹21.20 crore (India net) on its first day. The initial buzz helped the film cross ₹80 crore in India gross within the first week. The momentum continued into the second week, suggesting a steady theatrical run rather than a sharp drop. However, the overall worldwide box-office collections have fallen well short of expectations. As per box-office tracking portals, Akhandha 2: Thandavam has managed to gross around ₹107.85 crore globally, with approximately ₹95.85 crore coming from India and about ₹12 crore from overseas markets. While these figures would be respectable for a mid-budget film, they are far from suffi-

cient to recover a ₹200 crore investment. A distributor from the Andhra Pradesh-Telangana circuit, speaking candidly about the outcome, said, "The opening was strong and Balakrishna garu's fan base did its job in the first few days. But the business expectations were set extremely high due to the budget. At this level, even a ₹100-crore-plus gross is not enough. Recovery has been very tough for most buyers. Akhandha 2 did not collapse at the box office, it failed to translate its mass appeal into long-term sustainability across all regions. The film also could not surpass the lifetime collections of some of Balakrishna's earlier blockbusters, further adding to the disappointment." In the end, Akhandha 2: Thandavam stands as a clear example of how soaring budgets can outweigh decent box-office performance. Despite loyal fan support and a respectable run, the film's financial outcome underscores the growing risk associated with mounting production costs in big-ticket Telugu cinema.
