Shri Anup Kumar Satpathy, a 1993 batch IRTS officer, has carved a distinguished career marked by unwavering dedication, decisive leadership, and remarkable results across multiple railway zones. From his tenure as Divisional Railway Manager (DRM) of Waltair Division to his current role as Principal Chief Safety Officer of South East Central Railway in Bilaspur, Satpathy's journey exemplifies the storied legacy of Waltair—a division with over 135 years of history that has produced top railway leaders, including General Managers and Railway Board Members.

Exemplary Leadership at Waltair Division

As DRM of Waltair Division under East Coast Railway, Satpathy earned the affectionate title of "People's DRM" through his strict yet empathetic approach, emphasizing transparency, zero tolerance

for corruption and indiscipline, and a four-point commitment: protecting the division's reputation, advancing infrastructure, and ensuring satisfaction for staff, officers, passengers, and customers. His bold decisions tackled long-avoided issues, including transferring long-serving officials despite pressures, while conducting surprise checks to safeguard railway properties and maintain accountability. Under his guidance, Waltair flourished across safety, infrastructure, passenger amenities, asset management, human resources, and revenue innovation. The division achieved its highest-ever

revenue of over Rs 9,000 crores in FY 2023-24—five years ahead of the national average. Scrap disposal hit record highs, with 17 lakh tonnes in just 360 days and revenue surging 710.65% to surpass Rs 32.7 crores from the previous year. Non-fare revenue reached Rs 5.25 crores in 2022-23, exceeding targets by 65%.

Passenger services transformed with the conversion of ICF to modern LHB coaches for 7 drivers and 11 originating train pairs, enhanced sanitation drives, anti-trespassing penalties, and public awareness on littering and safety. The One Station One Product stalls at seven stations boosted local artisans, earning widespread acclaim. Infrastructure milestones included pushing for platforms 9 and 10 at Visakhapatnam station, an underbridge at Gopalapatnam after years of delay, and 100 km of doubling work in 2022-23. Visakhapatnam station became



South India's first to earn Right Station Certification and Green Railway Station Certification in January 2023. At the 67th Railway Week Awards, Waltair clinched a record 14 shields for best performance.

Trailblazing Roles and National Recognition

Satpathy's impact extended beyond Waltair. He served in logistics at South Eastern Railway, Waltair, South Central Railway, East Coast Railway, as Chairman/Recruitment and Senior Divisional Operations Manager in Nagpur, Transportation Planning Manager at Eastern Railways (July 2023), and Principal Chief Operations Manager (PCOM) at North Eastern Railway (NER) with additional PCCM charge. He received the National Award in 2000 and Railway Minister's

Award in 2002.

His expertise shone during Mahakumbh 2025 at Prayagraj, where NER contributed to operating over 17,000 trains (exceeding the 13,000 plan), with enhanced facilities like 4,244 extra coaches, 175 passenger amenities, 48 platforms, 31 FOBs, 554 ticketing counters, and robust medical/emergency support. Hon'ble Railway Minister Shri Ashwini Vaishnaw personally commended the Rail Karmayogis, including IRTS officers like Satpathy, for this unprecedented effort.

Following a heartfelt farewell from NER, Satpathy now leads as Principal Chief Safety Officer at South East Central Railway, Bilaspur, ready for new challenges. His legacy of innovation, integrity, and people-centric leadership continues to inspire Indian Railways.

Youth Leader Abdul Nayeem's Birthday Celebrated Grandly



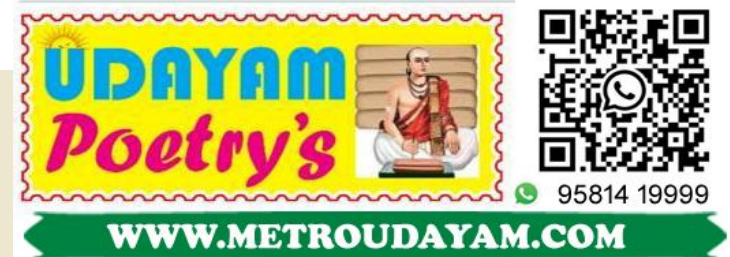

Vijay Hazare Trophy: Sarfaraz powers Mumbai to 4th straight victory, Maharashtra, Punjab score big wins

Jaipur: Out-of-favour India batter Sarfaraz Khan smashed a blistering 157 off 75 balls as Mumbai defeated Goa by 87 runs in an Elite Group C clash of the Vijay Hazare Trophy at the Jaipuria Vidyalya ground on Wednesday. Sarfaraz, 27, reached his third List A century in just 56 deliveries, as his explosive knock, featuring nine fours and 14 sixes, dismantled Goa's bowling attack. Mumbai's middle order capitalised on the conditions after Goa elected to field first. Yashasvi Jaiswal, returning from acute gastroenteritis, and Musheer Khan

added 70 runs for the second wicket before Jaiswal fell for 46. Brothers Sarfaraz and Musheer then combined for a 93-run third-wicket partnership before the former cut loose. He scored 104 runs off 46 balls against spinners Misal and Lalit Yadav, while captain Shardul Thakur plundered 26 runs in a single over from Shubham Tari. Hardik Tamore's quickfire 53 off 28 balls and Tanush Kotian's unbeaten 23 off 12 deliveries propelled Mumbai to their second-highest List A total. Chasing 445, Goa stumbled early after openers Arjun Tendulkar and

Kashyap Bakle failed to build on their starts. Abhinav Tejraana fought back with a century off 70 balls, adding 117 runs with Lalit for the fifth wicket. Captain Deepraj Gaonkar's explosive 70 off 28 balls delayed the inevitable, but Goa were eventually bowled out for 357, giving Mumbai their fourth straight win in the tournament. Meanwhile, Punjab registered a convincing six-wicket victory over Himachal Pradesh, thanks to Sukhdeep Bajwa's four-wicket haul and fifties from Prabhsimran Singh and Anmolpreet Singh. Bajwa's four wickets helped

Punjab restrict Himachal Pradesh to 227, with Naman Dhir chipping in by taking two scalps. In reply, Punjab's batsmen made light work of the target. Prabhsimran top-scored with 84, while Anmolpreet contributed a steady 72. Dhir then completed an all-round performance by remaining unbeaten on 50 to guide Punjab home with six wickets in hand. On the other hand, Maharashtra delivered a commanding all-round performance to register a comprehensive 129-run victory over Uttarakhand.

Why Madhuri Dixit doesn't want to remember her early days in Bollywood without vanity vans and luxuries



Mumbai: Bollywood actress Madhuri Dixit recently opened up about her early days in the film industry. Speaking exclusively to IANS, she recalled a time when luxury and convenience on sets were virtually non-existent. Talking about shoots in places like Ooty, Madhuri reminisced how actors and crew often had to make do without vanity vans, proper amenities, or comforts, with hairdressers and assistants braving the outdoors just to keep everyone ready. While she cherishes the passion that defined those times, Madhuri admits she prefers not to dwell on those days. However, the 'Devdas' actress also highlighted that the sacrifices made back then were driven purely by a deep love for the craft. Madhuri Dixit stated, "When we were shooting in Ooty, we used to find some jungle to go to. And then our hairdressers and all used to stand with all shawls. I don't want to remember those days. They were quite... But through it all, I think we enjoyed ourselves. I mean, we loved what we did. And we all came together because of that love. And we were ready to make those sacrifices. At that time, we didn't even know it was sacrifices. It was way of life at that time."

The 'Hum Aapke Hain Koun' actress also spoke about how filmmaking has evolved over the years. She also reflected on the journey from her debut film "Aabodh" to her latest release drama "Mrs Deshpande." When asked what it was like being directed in the 1980s and 1990s, and how much the filmmaking landscape has changed from "Aabodh" to "Mrs Deshpande," Dixit reflected on the evolution of the industry over the years. "I think at that time there were only five or six very organized producers, like Yash Chopra, B R Chopra, Subhash Ghai, Rajshri Productions, and a few more, and the rest was pretty unorganized. Today, it is very organized. Back then, we relied more on spontaneity; today, we can prepare for a role. You get a script, along with amenities such as the RVs, where you can chill after every shot or get ready. At that time, we did not have all this; we used to sit under the sun, with an umbrella over our heads," explained Madhuri.

includes big-ticket star vehicles, promising straight Telugu films, and high-profile dubbed releases.

Leading the race is Prabhas' The Raja Saab, a much-anticipated entertainer that marks the superstar's return to a festive release window after years of pan-India spectacles. The film is expected to draw massive footfalls, riding on Prabhas' global fan base and Sankranthi's family audience pull. Equally significant is

the season is Anaganaga Oka Raju, starring Naveen Polishetty. Slated as a light-hearted family entertainer, the film aims to capitalize on Naveen's strong connection with younger audiences and urban families. Among the medium-budget films, Bhartha Mahasayulaku Wignyapathi and Nari Nari Naduma Murari are also locking the festive window. These films are expected to cater to niche and family audiences, adding variety to the Sankranthi lineup.



Meanwhile, Sharwanand's Nari Nari Naduma Murari had earlier been rumored to skip the festival race, but the makers have now confirmed a Sankranthi release and are set to begin promotions this week, firmly placing the film in the competition. On the dubbed front, two major titles are entering the fray. Jana Nayagan, believed to be Vijay's final film, is expected to enjoy strong traction among Telugu audiences despite being a dubbed release. Meanwhile, Parasakthi, featuring Siva Karthikeyan, has already generated curiosity due to its content-driven

Kareena Kapoor Khan calls 2025 a 'difficult year' for her family: We cried a lot

the attack, for the first time, went on record to elaborate on the terrifying incident during an appearance on the talk show 'Two Much with Kajol and Twinkle Khanna', hosted by Kajol and Twinkle Khanna. The actor had revealed that along with him, his younger son Jeh and their nanny were among the victims of the knife attack.

Recalling the incident while in conversation on the talk show, Saif described how the event unfolded in the middle of the night while his family, including wife Kareena Kapoor Khan and their children, were at home. He said, "We had just gone to sleep, and Kareena had been out, and I had finished watching the movies with the boys, and they had gone to sleep. It was actually quite late, around 2 o'clock in the morning. Kareena came back, we had a small chat, and then we went to sleep." He elaborated, "Suddenly the maid came in, and she said that somebody was there in Jeh's room and asking for money. I barged into Jeh's room in the dark, and I saw this guy standing over his bed with a knife." Saif further explained that the attacker had already injured Jeh and was trying to flee. "While poking the knife at Jeh and the nanny, he had already slightly cut Jeh on his hand and had also hurt the nanny while he was poking a knife at them."

He further said, "I kind of walked in, and I saw this guy, and I thought that he was smaller than me, which



means he was not very large, and so I jumped on him. Jeh later told me that it was a big mistake and suggested that I should have punched or kicked him or something. But I jumped, and we started this fight, and then we both went crazy. He had these two knives, and he just started slashing all over me, and I tried to remember my training, and I blocked him a couple of times here and there. I suddenly felt this thump in my back, and that was really very hard and bad." He added, "At that point, he had cut me everywhere—my neck and my back—and there
