



EAM Jaishankar to visit France and Luxembourg, hold talks with leadership

External Affairs Minister (EAM), S. Jaishankar, will be on an official visit to France and Luxembourg from January 4-9. During his visit to France, the EAM will meet French leadership and hold talks with the Minister for Foreign Affairs, Jean Noel Barrot.

In a statement, Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) said, "They will discuss the progress made under the India-France Strategic Partnership and matters of global importance. EAM will also address the 31st edition of the French Ambassador's Conference as the Guest of Honour." During his visit to Luxembourg, EAM Jaishankar will hold talks with Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs Xavier Bettel and the senior leadership. He will also interact with the members of the Indian community in



Luxembourg. In November last year, Prime Minister Narendra Modi met French President Emmanuel Macron on the sidelines of the G20 Summit in South Africa's Johannesburg. "Delighted to meet President Macron during the

Johannesburg G20 Summit. We had an engaging exchange on different issues. India-France ties remain a force for global good," PM Modi posted on X after the meeting. The two leaders had held a phone conversation in September last year,

exchanging views on efforts towards bringing an end to the conflict in Ukraine while reiterating India's consistent support for peaceful resolution of the issue and early restoration of peace and stability in the entire region. They had also spoken over the phone on August 21, 2025, coordinating their positions on the war in Ukraine in order to move towards a just and lasting peace. During their conversations over the past few months, the two leaders have reviewed and positively assessed the developments in bilateral cooperation across different sectors including economic, defence, science, technology and space. They had reaffirmed their commitment towards further strengthening of the India-France Strategic Partnership, in line with the Horizon 2047 Roadmap, the Indo-Pacific

Roadmap and the Defence Industrial Roadmap. PM Modi had thanked President Macron for accepting the invitation to the AI Impact Summit hosted by India in February 2026, and looked forward to welcoming the French leader in India. "On trade issues, we agreed to strengthen our economic exchanges and our strategic partnership in all areas — this is the key to our sovereignty and independence. Following up on the AI Action Summit held in Paris last February, we are working towards the success of the AI Impact Summit to be held in New Delhi in 2026. For more effective multilateralism, we agreed to work closely together in preparation for the French presidency of the G7 and the Indian presidency of the BRICS in 2026," Macron had posted on X on August 21.

CM Chandrababu hails historic first landing at Bhogapuram Airport

Chief Minister Chandrababu Naidu hailed the landing of the first aircraft at Bhogapuram Airport as a significant milestone in the airport's development. The aircraft, a special flight from New Delhi, touched down at the new facility on Sunday, an event Naidu commemorated on his X (formerly Twitter) account. In his remarks, the Chief Minister highlighted this achievement as another landmark moment for Andhra Pradesh's aviation sector. He described the successful validation flight as an auspicious development and extended his heartfelt congratulations to the people of North Andhra. Naidu expressed optimism that the establishment of



the airport would bolster regional connectivity and significantly accelerate the region's development. He also acknowledged Prime Minister Modi for his support of the project, assuring that Bhogapuram Airport would soon be open for public service, with commercial flights expected to

commence in June of this year. The Greenfield International Airport is under construction in Bhogapuram, located in the Vizianagaram district. On Sunday, a delegation including Union Minister of Civil Aviation Rammohan Naidu and Vizianagaram MP Kaliseti Appalanaidu arrived on the inaugural flight, where they received a grand welcome from district officials and airline representatives. The airport, being built with state-of-the-art technology, is reported to be 96 percent complete. The inauguration is scheduled for June 26th, with Naidu emphasising that the construction is ahead of the planned timeline, signifying North Andhra's progressive trajectory towards development.

New milestone for aviation, says CM Chandrababu Naidu on first validation flight in Andhra



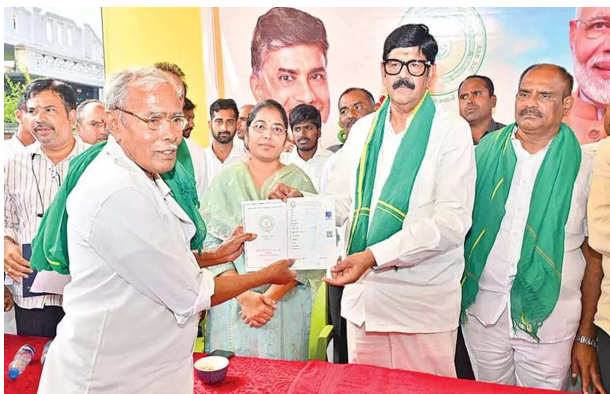
"Congratulations to the people of Andhra Pradesh, especially Uttarandhra, on the successful validation flight of the Bhogapuram Greenfield International Airport. Today marks a new milestone for aviation in the state, strengthening regional connectivity and giving a major boost to Uttarandhra as the region prepares to take off," the Chief Minister posted on 'X'. CM Naidu thanked Prime Minister Narendra Modi for his "vision, leadership, and commitment to the progress of Andhra Pradesh." "The airport, planned and initiated during the NDA government's tenure between 2014 and 2019, will be ready to serve our people with commercial flight operations from June," added CM Chandrababu Naidu.

Minister for Human Resources Development and Information Technology stated that "today is a landmark day" for Andhra Pradesh. "The successful validation flight at Bhogapuram Greenfield International Airport marks a decisive step in boosting connectivity and unlocking Uttarandhra's growth potential. Thanks to Hon'ble PM Shri Narendra Modi Ji for his vision and leadership. Conceived and initiated during the NDA government (2014-19), the airport will be ready for commercial operations from June 2026 - taking Uttarandhra to new heights," posted Lokesh. The first commercial validation flight landed successfully at the Bhogapuram Airport in Vizianagaram district on Sunday. The Air India flight from New Delhi landed at the Bhogapuram Airport, about 50 km from Visakhapatnam. Civil Aviation Minister Ram Mohan Naidu Kinjarapu and Vizianagaram MP Kaliseti Appala Naidu, along with senior officials, travelled by the test flight. The test flight landed on the 3.8 km-long runway, the longest in the country, built with the latest technology. "Happy to share this historic first landing at Bhogapuram. One smooth touchdown marking the first step toward a transformative future for the region," posted Ram Mohan Naidu on 'X'. He shared the video of the landing. The airport, being constructed by GMR Group in Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode on a design, build, finance, operate and transfer basis, is expected to be inaugurated in June 2026. GMR Visakhapatnam International Airport Limited (GVIAL), a subsidiary of GMR Group, is constructing the airport on 2,200 acres of land with an estimated cost of Rs 4,592 crore. According to GVIAL, 96 per cent of the airport works have been completed. Ram Mohan Naidu said Prime Minister Modi would inaugurate the airport in 4-5 months.

Anam distributes new pattadar passbooks

Nellore:

Endowments Minister Anam Ramanayana Reddy distributed new Pattadar passbooks with the State Emblem to farmers at Hasanapuram village of AS Pet mandal on Saturday. Addressing the gathering, he stated that the new passbooks will give the farmers full legal right on their land with land ownership right without scope for illegal occupation or land grabbing. To protect farmers, the coalition government, immediately after assuming power, had abolished Land Titling Act, he said. Describing Pattadar passbooks issued by the previous YSRCP government as equal to 'Fake Note', Anam alleged that the previous government had misused its power by issuing 1.05 lakh bogus pattadar passbooks in Nellore district against the total 23 lakh in 7,200 villages in the entire State with YS Jagan Mohan Reddy's photo printed on them. Later addressing the media, Minister Anam alleged that during its five-year tenure previous government has collected Rs 32,116 crore in the name of 'true up charges' from public. He said that considering the issue under humanitarian grounds, Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu decided to bear the burden of Rs 4,497 crore. He disclosed that they are considering to reduce power tariff in coming days. Atmakur RDO Pavani and other party leaders were present.

power is our power, unity is our weapon'.

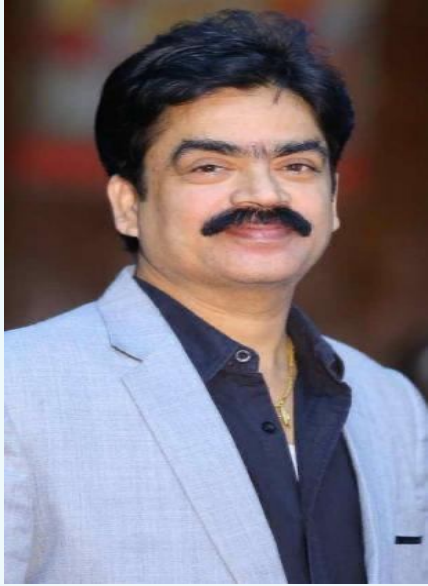

Concerns Mount Over Journalists' Accreditation in Telangana

.....Transparent Policy Needed to Protect Press Freedom: Dr. Jithender Rao

Hyderabad, metro udayam janavary 4..... Growing concerns are being raised over delays and lack of transparency in the journalists' accreditation process in Telangana, causing serious hardship to working journalists across the state. Telangana Youth Journalist Federation (TYJF) President Dr. Jithender Rao said that the accreditation system, meant to



recognise the role of journalists in a democracy, has become a source of distress due to prolonged delays and unclear procedures. Rao pointed out that journalists working in rural areas, district bureaus, small publications, and digital media platforms are the worst affected. Despite meeting professional standards, many genuine journalists are being denied accreditation, while the absence of clear eligibility guidelines and fixed timelines has created confusion and uncertainty. He stated that the lack of transparency in verification and rejection processes is undermining journalists' confidence and indirectly impacting press freedom. "Accreditation should be fair, inclusive, and merit-based, not arbitrary or discriminatory," he said.

The TYJF President urged the Telangana government to immediately announce a clear and transparent accreditation policy, fix timelines for processing applications, include journalist representatives in accreditation committees, and formally recognise digital, freelance, and rural journalists. Jithender Rao emphasised that journalists are not seeking privileges but recognition of their responsibility. He called upon the government to act swiftly to restore confidence among journalists and strengthen the fourth pillar of democracy.

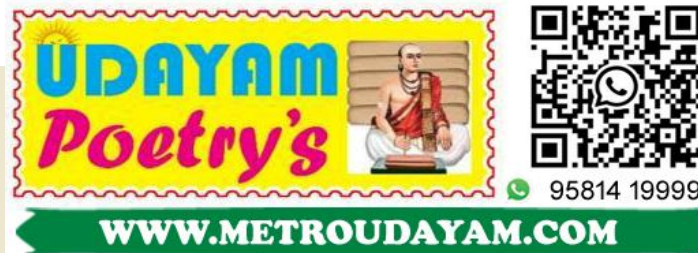
Boduppall Padmashali Association unveils the 2026 English calendar...

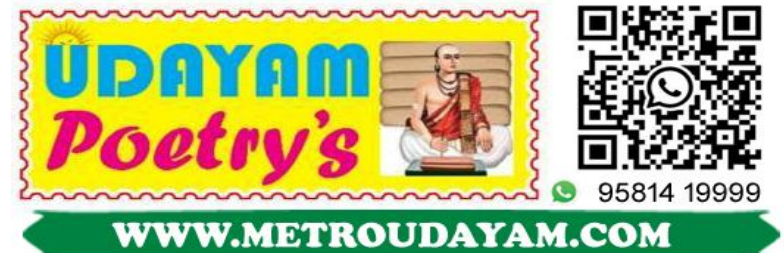

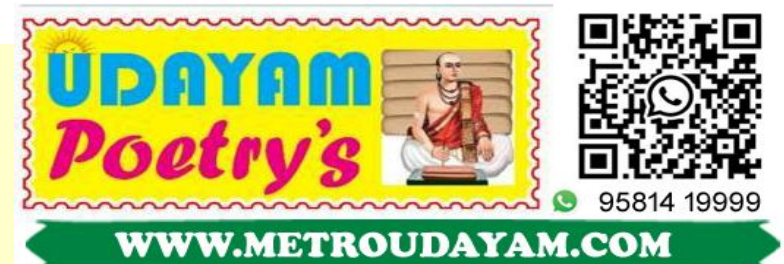

Although he is neither a government employee nor an outsourced employee, he is reportedly carrying out all the work at the Medipally Tahsildar's office with impunity. He is allegedly handling certificate verification and other tasks that should be done by revenue



officials, wielding significant influence. It is an open secret that he plays a role in facilitating transactions between Revenue Inspectors and those who visit the office. Strong allegations are being made that he plays a key role in easily providing crucial documents

such as house pattas and certificates. Locals say that he has close ties with Revenue Inspectors and also knows some key passwords related to the department. Due to this, allegations are mounting that he is responsible for irregularities involving the handling of unofficial documents, neglecting official duties. Furthermore, there are allegations that a house was constructed in Medipally, Survey Number 103, using forged documents. Reports suggest that despite multiple complaints regarding this matter, no action has been taken so far. Locals believe that if this continues, there is a risk of a scam involving fake land Pattas and caste certificates from the Tahsildar's office being exposed. It remains to be seen what action the Tahsildar's office will take regarding these allegations.
