



## NTR changed the course of history: CM Chandrababu Naidu

Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu on Sunday paid rich tributes to former Chief Minister N. T. Rama Rao on his death anniversary, saying that the leader changed the course of history with unparalleled welfare and development schemes. The national president of Telugu Desam Party (TDP) recalled the services of NTR both as an actor and a political leader.

CM Chandrababu Naidu, who is the son-in-law of NTR, took to 'X' to remember the late leader's pro-poor schemes. "On the occasion of the 30th death anniversary of the extraordinary leader, the man of the era, the benefactor of the poor, 'Anna' Nandamuri Taraka Rama Rao, I pay my heartfelt tribute to that great soul," CM Naidu posted.



"'Anna' NTR, who shone like a guiding star in the cinematic firmament and was an invincible force in the political arena, was a valiant hero who rewrote the history of generations. He is forever memorable to all of us for his struggle to uphold the self-respect of the Telugu people to the highest level," said the Chief Minister. CM Naidu wrote that NTR changed the course of history with unparalleled welfare and development

schemes such as two-rupee-a-kilo rice, social security pensions, construction of permanent houses, free electricity for farmers, local self-governance through the Mandal system, property rights for women, and irrigation and drinking water projects for Rayalaseema. He called the TDP founder an inspiration and said that the path he laid is worthy of emulation.

A. Revanth Reddy also paid tributes to NTR, the former Chief Minister of the united Andhra Pradesh.

Union Minister for Civil Aviation K. Ram Mohan Naidu also took to 'X' to pay tributes to NTR.

## Spl helpline to improve TTD Kalyana mandapams management: EO

Tirupati: TTD Executive Officer Anil Kumar Singhal directed officials to set up a special helpline to further improve the management of TTD Kalyana Mandapams, while reviewing the matter with officials in TTD Administrative Building on Saturday. He instructed them to establish a helpline number to collect feedback from devotees. He also suggested that feedback regarding TTD Kalyana Mandapams be collected directly from devotees through local Srivari Sevaks, which would help in preparing plans to understand management issues and the facilities required. He stated that bringing the management of Kalyana Mandapams under the FMS (Facility Management Services) framework would make it easier to maintain cleanliness and provide better amenities. The EO advised officials to gather feedback on various aspects of TTD Kalyana Mandapams across the country, including compound walls, toilets, Kalyana Vedita, decoration arrangements, suitability for conducting marriage functions, parking facilities, leakage issues during the rainy season, water stagnation in the premises, security, and other related matters. He said that collecting such feedback would help in providing improved facilities for devotees.



## Chief Minister Revanth Reddy Denounces Claims of Corruption in Singareni Collieries

Chief Minister Revanth Reddy has strongly condemned the allegations of a scam within the Singareni Collieries, dismissing reports from several newspapers suggesting that coal has gone missing. Reddy asserted that there is no tolerance for irregularities under his administration and emphasised that tenders for Singareni would only be awarded to experienced firms, ensuring complete transparency and integrity. Speaking at a public meeting after laying the foundation stone for various development projects in Khammam worth ₹362 crore, Reddy stated, "Some newspapers are spreading propaganda that a scam has occurred in Singareni. There is no room for irregularities in this government. We have not allowed any irregularities during



the two years of Congress rule." The Chief Minister expressed concern that such misinformation not only misleads the public but also empowers political opponents, whom he referred to as Maricha and Subahu. He urged the media

to resolve any disputes privately, rather than involving government matters, and called for journalists to seek clarifications directly from him before publishing any news about his ministers. "I will be available 24 hours a day to provide details to the media," Reddy stated. "If news about our ministers is published without proper verification, it damages my reputation and fosters misconceptions about my leadership. There will be no compromise on such matters."

## BJP will introduce 'One District, One Product' policy if voted to power in Bengal: PM Modi

Prime Minister Narendra Modi said on Sunday that Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) will introduce the One District, One Product (ODOP) policy in West Bengal if the party comes to power in the state Assembly elections scheduled later this year. "Every district of West Bengal has its own speciality. The common people here have intelligence, talent, and ability. BJP will prepare a plan for each district. As a result, the people of the district concerned will benefit the most. If the BJP comes to power in West Bengal, it will introduce the ODOP policy in the state for the promotion of district-specific products," the Prime Minister said while addressing a public rally at



Singur in Hooghly district of West Bengal on Sunday. Speaking on the occasion, the Prime Minister also accused the Mamata Banerjee-led West Bengal government of depriving the people of West Bengal of Central schemes to "settle scores" with him and the BJP. "I can understand Trinamool Congress' apathy towards me

and the BJP. But they are actually leaving the people of West Bengal to suffer by denying implementation of centrally-sponsored development schemes in the state," he said. According to him, the Union government has opened a digital platform for fishermen throughout the country. "Various states are registering the names of fishermen in their respective areas. But in West Bengal, it has been put on hold. I repeatedly write letters to the West Bengal government of this state. The Chief Minister, Mamata Banerjee, does not read my letters. But let her officers read them. The Trinamool Congress government is not helping in the registration of fish-

ermen in the 'Matsyajibi Yojana' here. The Trinamool is playing with the future of the fishermen of the state," the Prime Minister said. Speaking on the occasion, PM Modi also accused the West Bengal government of deliberate non-cooperation in procuring land for raising barbed fencing at the state's international borders with Bangladesh so that infiltrators from the neighbouring country can enter the state freely and become the Trinamool Congress' permanent vote bank. He also said that the current state of the law-and-order situation in the state is the greatest deterrent towards attracting new investments. "Only a stable law and order sit-

uation would attract new investments to the state. But currently, a 'mafia-raj' is prevailing in West Bengal, where a syndicate tax is imposed on everything. BJP will end this syndicate tax. This is Modi's guarantee," the Prime Minister said. He concluded his speech saying, "A BJP-led government in West Bengal would gift the people of the state a corruption-free and violence-free ambience where the safety of women would be the priority." "There will be no more atrocities against women like that in Sandeshkhali. There will be no more rapes and molestations at educational institutions. Only you voters can ensure that," the Prime Minister said.

## The Teacher Who Turned Disability into Success

**"Not for a Salary... but for Life"**  
- Headmaster Burra Ramesh

A government school headmaster in Telangana has drawn praise for transforming the lives of several children with mental and physical disabilities, demonstrating how focused support can turn vulnerability into strength.

Headmaster Burra Ramesh, currently serving at the Primary School Kadvendi, Devaruppula Mandal, Jangaon District, has become a well-known name in the local education community for his work with differently-abled students.



Moved by a First-Grade Child:

The turning point in his current school came with a first-grade student, Akshith, who was unable to speak, lived with an intellectual disability and had lost his mother.

The boy is being raised by his father and grandmother, while his only elder sister is also mentally challenged, placing the family under severe emotional and financial strain.



According to staff, Akshith could not sit calmly in class or attend school regularly, which in many schools might have led to neglect or exclusion.

Instead, Ramesh began working with him personally every day, using patient interaction, speech exercises, simple action songs and constant encouragement to keep the child engaged.

Visible Change in the Classroom:

Over time, observed a marked change in Akshith's behaviour and abilities.

He started speaking, singing small action songs, showing interest in studies and expressing affection for school, which staff describe as a "remarkable turnaround" for a child once considered unresponsive.

Education activists point out that such progress underlines the importance of early, school-based intervention and inclusive teaching methods for children with special needs.

Officials say the case is now informally cited as an example of how regular government schools can support differently-abled children when teachers are trained and motivated.

Track Record Across Multiple Schools:

Ramesh's efforts are not limited to Kadvendi; colleagues say he has followed a similar approach in earlier postings as well.

\* At Nawabpet School, he worked with a student named Sathish, helping him overcome disability-related learning barriers and continue his education.

- At Gummadavelli Upper Primary School, he mentored Kumar., a differently-abled student who was at risk of dropping out.

- At Siripuram Upper Primary School, he guided Srikanth, a student with mental disability, towards a more independent and purposeful routine.

Local educators say these individual success stories have gradually built Ramesh's reputation as a headmaster who treats disability as a challenge to be addressed, not a reason to give up on a child.

Link to Disability Support Schemes:

With the support and encouragement of the District Collector, several of these students are now receiving a monthly disability assistance of ₹4,000, providing crucial financial relief to their families.

Officials note that this support aligns with state social security and disability pension initiatives that aim to reach children with high support needs.

Ramesh has also assured that similar disability pension assistance of ₹4,000 per month is being pursued for Akshith, with the cooperation of district authorities.

Welfare officers say that teacher referrals often play a key role in ensuring eligible children are enrolled in such schemes.

"Not for a Salary... but for Life":

Colleagues describe Ramesh's approach as rooted in patience, empathy and a belief that every child can learn if given the right support.

Parents in the area say his work has helped change community attitudes, reinforcing the idea that disability need not be a permanent weakness when schools and families work together.

Locals have begun referring to him as a "teacher who works not for salary, but for life," capturing the sentiment that his efforts go beyond routine duty.

In a district where resources are limited and classroom challenges are high, educators say teachers like Burra Ramesh remain rare—but their impact on children with disabilities can be lifelong.

## Are the public's problems invisible to the officials and rulers ?

They questioned whether the officials, who pass by the area regularly, are unable to see the condition of the road. They angrily asked whether the rulers, who chant about development before elections, are unable to see the people's problems after coming to power, or are they simply

watching the situation with their eyes closed? They questioned whether the authorities are unconcerned about the people who are falling on the road and suffering injuries. They warned that if the road is not repaired immediately, they will launch large-scale protests.

## Blackspot Road Safety Awareness Programme Held at Nacharam

While MLA Kale Yadhiah alleged that Bheem Bharat had been tak-



ing bribes from him for the past ten years, Bheem Bharat responded by holding a press conference in Moinabad on Sunday and gave a strong counter-response. Bheem Bharat stated that the allegations made against him are completely false and refuted them.

"If you truly have courage and guts, you must publicly present the evidence that I took bribes. You must state where, when, and how much you gave, otherwise, you must publicly apologize by rubbing your nose on the ground in front of the Ambedkar statue in Chevella," he demanded.

Tell me where you want me to come, I am ready for the proof. Otherwise, you will face the

same incidents that recently occurred in Shabad everywhere," he warned sternly. Bhimbharat said that he would bring this matter to the attention of the Congress party high command and would accept whatever action the high command takes. However, he made it clear that if no action is taken, he would see how Kale Yadhiah roams around in Chevella.

Bhimbharat said that he had remained silent until now based on the assurances given by the Congress leaders, but he would no longer tolerate the harassment of party leaders and workers. He stated that more than a hundred people from the constituency come to him every day to tell him about their problems, and he is working to resolve them by speaking with the officials.

Bhimbharat made sensational allegations that Kale Yadhiah, using an incident with which he had no connection, had filed several cases against him, including invoking the PD Act, and had conspired to kill him. He said that he survived only because of the grace and blessings of the people.

## We will transform Boguladona village into a model village:-

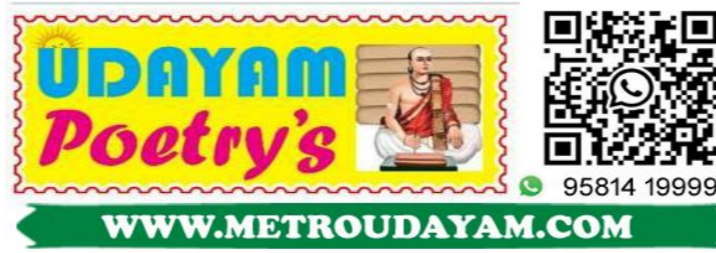

Let every heart vibrate in blissful harmony.

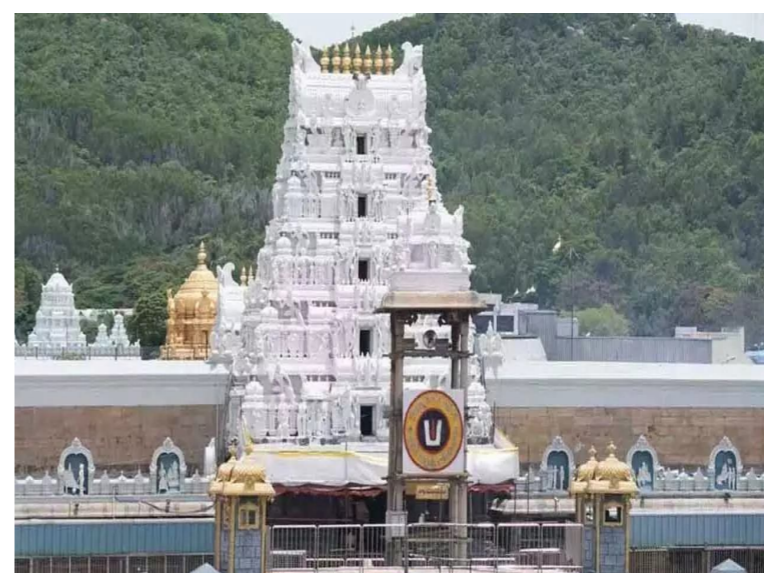

## TTD announces Ratha Saptami Celebrations in Tirumala on 25 January

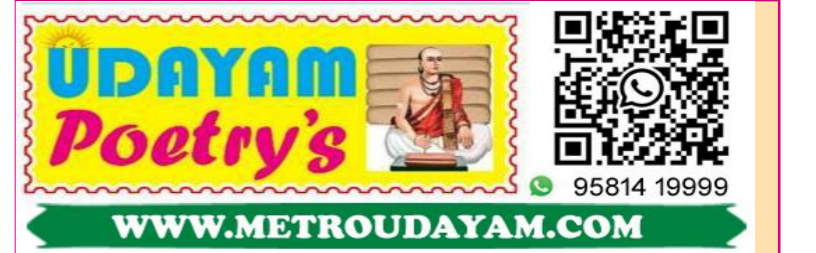
